Home Safe Grant: Kim Gallo</li> <li>AIS received a grant for the State Home Safe Program, which is a program specifically to address Adult Protective Services clients at risk of homelessness due to their abuse. We hope to have this up and running by July. We were notified that we were awarded \$500,000, which the County will match. More to report in the coming months.</li> <li>b. Board Letters: Alzheimer's Project 2019 Annual Report: Caroline Smith (Action)</li> <li>This Board letter is scheduled for March 12th. The recommendation is to receive the Alzheimer's Project 2019 Annual Report. The draft report was provided in the agenda packets. C. Smith provided an overview of the Alzheimer's Project and the annual report including statistics such as there are 84,405 San Diegans age 55 and older living with Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementias (ADRD), ADRD is the sixth leading cause of death in the United States and is the third leading cause of death in San Diego County.  [M/S - L. Fields/R. Bahmani: Unanimous]</li> <li>c. Legislative Update: Caroline Smith</li> <li>AIS is tracking four bills. We received two of them late Friday. Next month we should have many bill numbers to provide for you. AIS reviews bills and forwards a position recommendation to the HHSA Executive Office, which forwards the recommendation to the County's Office of Strategy and Intergovernmental Affairs, which decides the official County position. There is no County support on AB50 yet, but the County did formally support AB2233, which was the version of the bill from last year. We are monitoring a bill specific to Alzheimer's, AB388, that requires the State to create a public awareness campaign around the healthy brain initiative and provide eight pilot counties with a three-year grant opportunity to develop healthy brain initiative activities. There are two new bills, AB426, which deletes the certification by a medical professional on IHSS, and SB228, which creates a master plan on aging.</li> </ul>
