1. Call to Order	<p>Paul Ling, Chair, 12:18pm</p> <p>a. Welcome & Guest/Member Introductions</p> <p>b. Confirmation of quorum: 5 present at this time</p>		
2. Standard Business	<p>a. Public Comments/Announcements: Members or non-members: none</p> <p>b. Approval of 4/22/2021 Meeting Minutes: Motioned by Shirley King; Seconded by Faye Detsky-Weil. Unanimous.</p>		
3. Subcommittee Goal Discussion	<p>a. Members discussed, revised and updated all housing subcommittee goals (attachment HOUSING Annual Goals - 2021-05-27)</p> <p>b. Lorelei Taylor presented information on three areas of potential focus for Housing subcommittee for further future discussion.</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;">a. 1. Congregate Living: Star City in San Francisco is an example. Affordable; growing area; community looks after each other. Add-in-services on site like physicians, similar to Pace model. Could be in locations of shopping malls no longer in use.</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;">b. 2. Golden Girls: Seniors co-housing as a way for seniors to stay in their homes. ElderHelp of San Diego has a home matching service. Huge demand for these types of rooms in SD. Could it be a County program? ElderHelp as potential guest speaker for future subcommittee meeting.</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;">c. 3. Aging in Place: 90% of people polled would like to remain in their homes during senior years. Post-Covid it is expected that less people will want to go to care homes.</p> <p>c. Shirley King went over new legislation for The Home Safe Program by APS that lowers its eligibility age from 65 to 60 and extends case management services. This program provides case management in order to prevent at risk seniors from losing their homes. Shirley to pursue guest speaker from this program to our committee.</p> <p>d. Faye Detsky-Weil discussed possibility of getting information that comes into the AIS call center regarding housing. Faye to request further information through Jana Jordan.</p> <p>e. Paul Ling discussed his visit to Tierrasanta Village of SD which he found to be more of a social club than an age-in-place co-op. He also attended the Capitol Weekly housing policy conference. Takeaways were: renters voices need to be heard and there is no current housing bubble.</p>
