3. Guest Speaker	Kimberly Pearce (APS Program Manager for the Home Safe Program) and Marisa Arellanes (APS Program Supervisor for the Home Safe Program) spoke about Home Safe: Homeless Prevention and Diversion Program . Home Safe is a California program started as a 3-year pilot in July 1, 2019 by DSS Housing and Homeless Bureau in 24 counties with \$15m in state funding. Program goal is to support the safety and housing stability of APS clients experiencing or who are at risk of being homeless. For APS clients only; all cases reported to APS are screened for this program. Program provides in-depth case management, links to services, and financial assistance (hotels, back rent, housing deposits, utility bills, legal fees, deep cleaning, moving expenses, relocation assistance). Current stats: 174 clients so far; 80% of all referrals become cases; 67% women/33% men; 13% resolved before become cases; 15% dropped out of program; Avg \$ spent per client is \$4,518; 80 days is avg length of time case is opened. Top three interventions: enhanced case management, hotels, and back rent.
