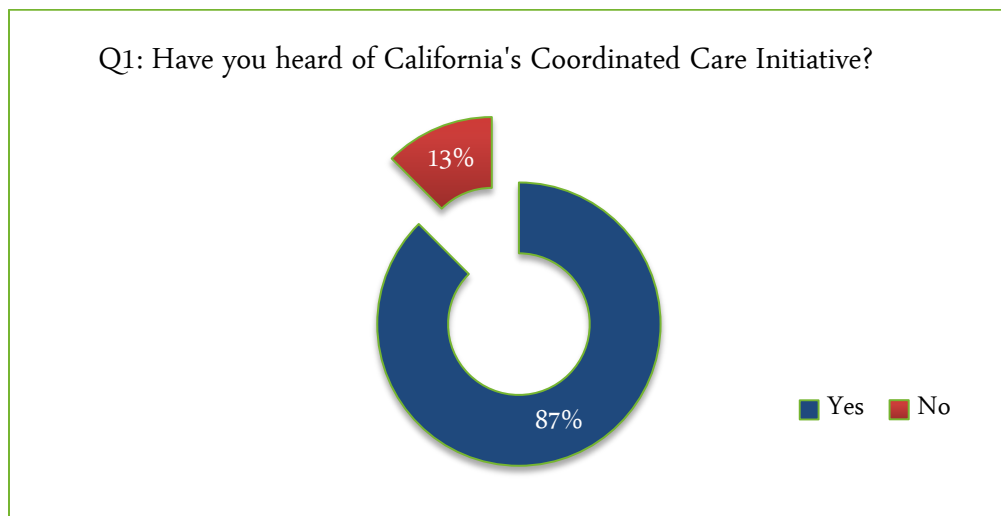


In January 2014, the County of San Diego's Long Term Care Integration Project (LTCIP) was awarded a two-year grant from The SCAN Foundation to serve as the Regional Coalition for San Diego County. As the Regional Coalition, the LTCIP is charged with supporting Long Term Services and Supports (LTSS) policy development and advancement, and supporting the implementation of the Coordinated Care Initiative (CCI) in San Diego County.

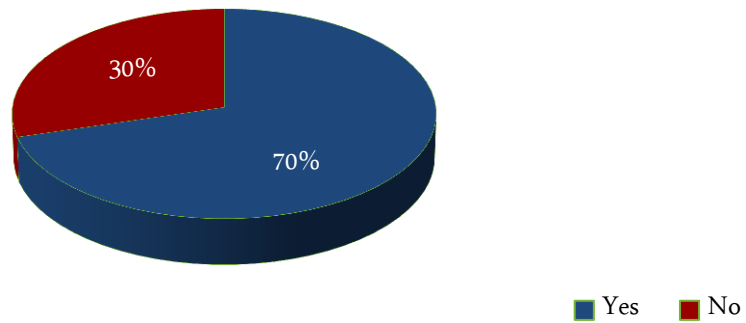
To gauge the understanding of CCI among LTCIP stakeholders, the LTCIP developed and conducted a survey through the CCI Advisory Committee. The ultimate goal of the survey was to use the results to inform CCI outreach/education efforts and development of outreach materials. This project was supported by the grant from The SCAN Foundation - advancing a coordinated and easily navigated system of high-quality services for older adults that preserve dignity and independence. The survey was comprised of 15 questions that were specifically phrased to not only gain a sense of LTCIP stakeholder understanding of the CCI but also to utilize the survey as a means to educate stakeholders about CCI. The survey was administered electronically through survey monkey and was sent by the Chair of the CCI Advisory Committee to a total of 606 LTCIP stakeholders. The LTCIP received 105 responses, which equates to a 17% response rate. The survey questions and their results are as follows:



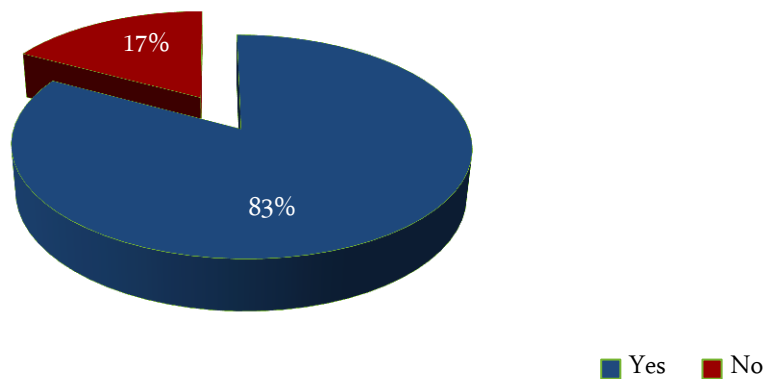
Response Totals: Yes – 91 | No – 13 | Skipped – 1

Q2: Have you participated in any training or presentations on CCI?



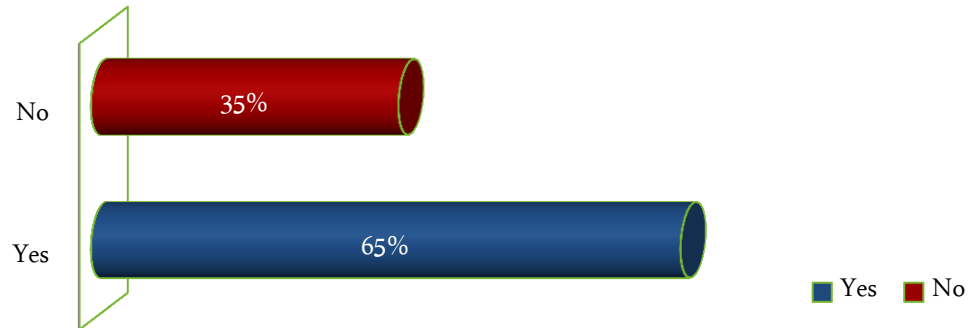
Response Totals: Yes – 74 | No – 31 | Skipped – 0

Q3: Did you know that CCI impacts those who receive both Medicare and Medi-Cal benefits as well as those who receive Medi-Cal benefits only?



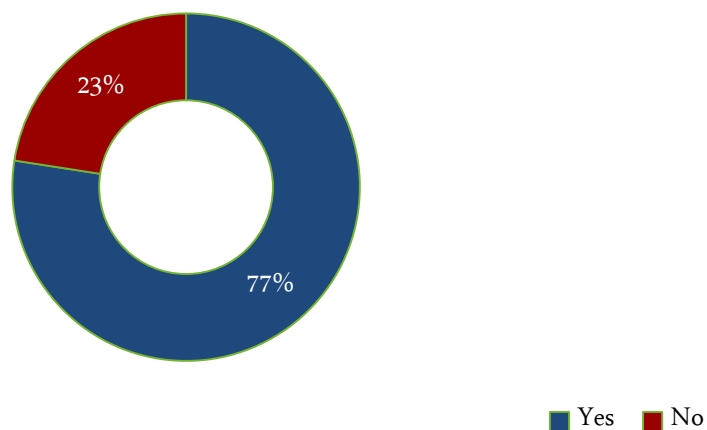

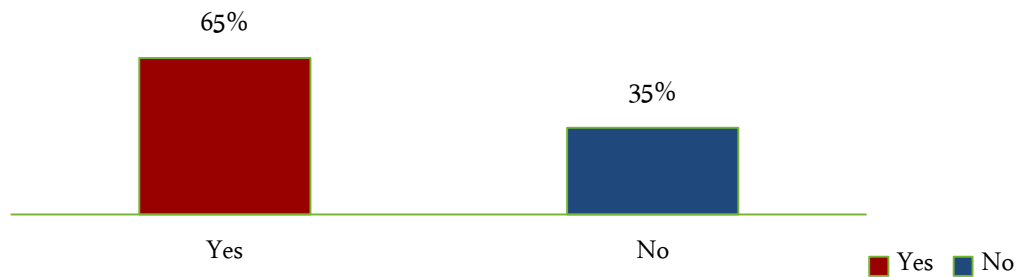

Q5: Did you know that Cal MediConnect began in San Diego County on April 1, 2014 with voluntary enrollment?



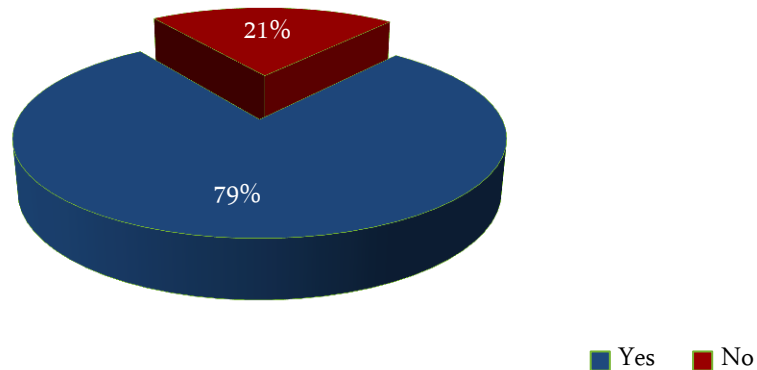

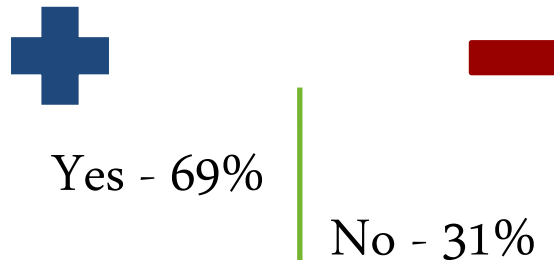

Q7: Did you know that Cal MediConnect plans in San Diego County are provided by Care1st, Community Health Group, Health Net and Molina Healthcare?



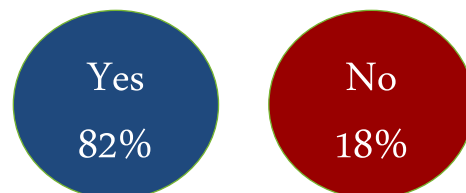

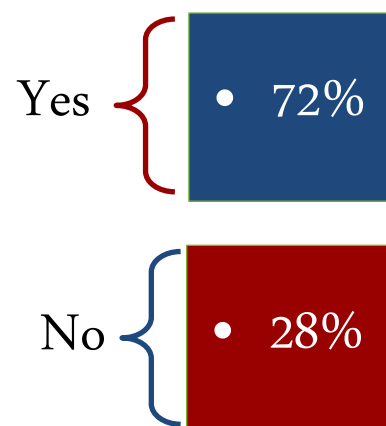

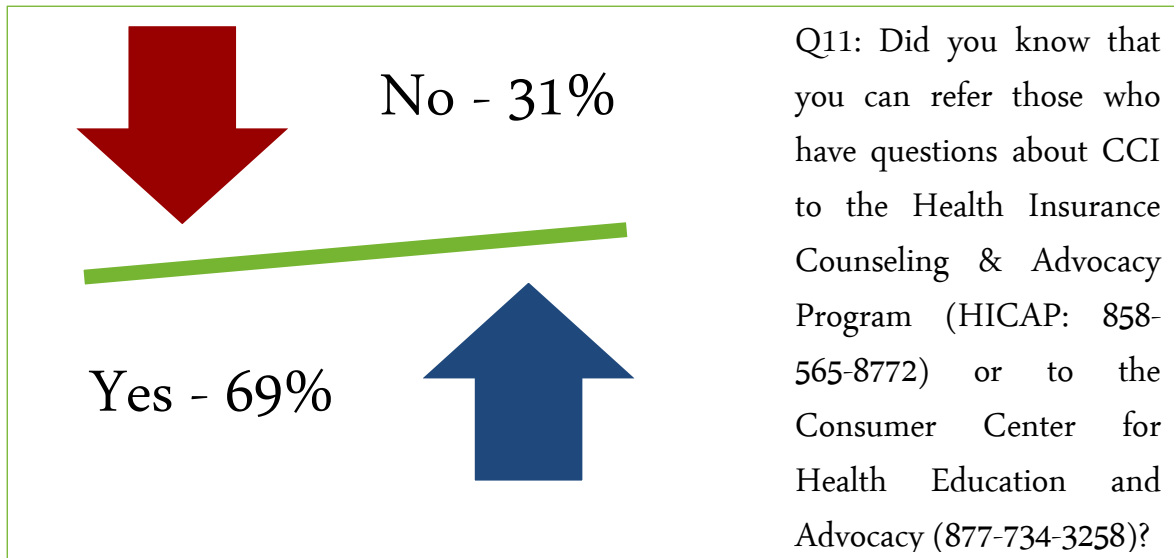

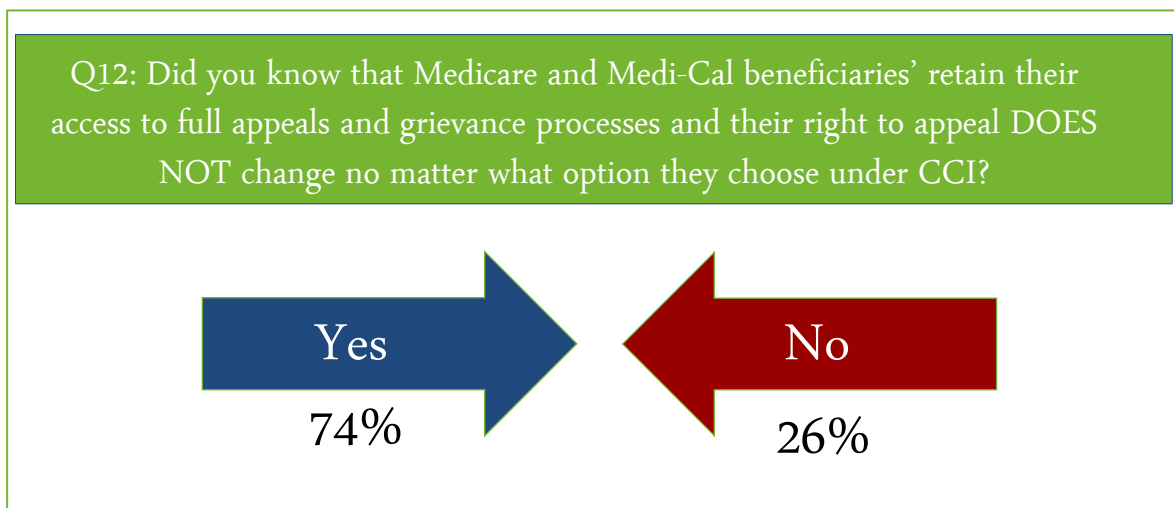

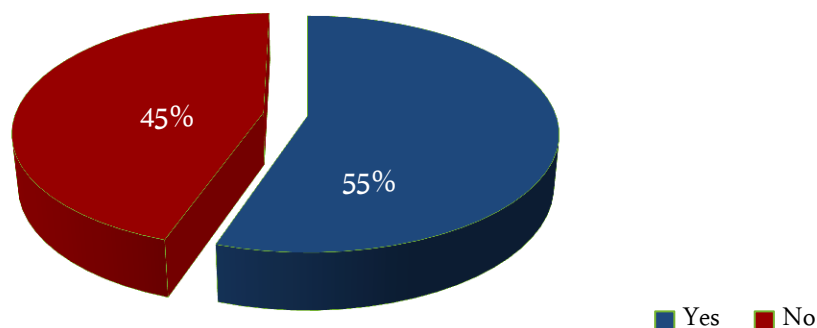

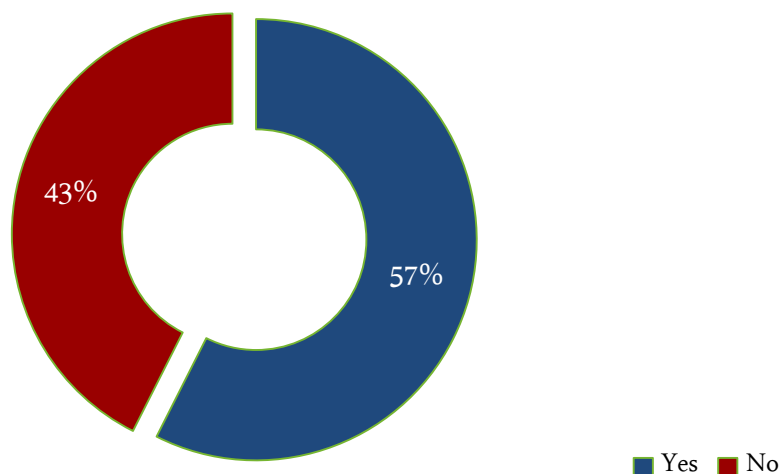
