

**Directions to the Miramar Officers' Club:**

**From I-15:** Exit on Miramar Way (**not** Miramar Road). Proceed west on Miramar Way to the Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) Miramar **Main Gate**. Present your driver's license and registration. Continue straight through two stop lights and one four way stop intersection. Turn right onto Anderson Ave., go approximately 3/4 mile. The Officers' Club is the last building on the left next to the Flying Leatherneck Aviation Museum. We will be in the large room at the back of the building. There are numerous handicapped parking spaces available behind the building.

**From Miramar Road:** Enter via the **North Gate**. The North Gate is between Camino Ruiz and Kearny Villa Rd. Present your driver's license and registration. Continue straight through stop sign at Delta. Turn right at the first stop light onto Elrod Rd., continue to the end of the street. Turn right onto Anderson Ave. The Officers Club is the last building on the left. We will be in the large room at the back of the building. There are numerous handicapped parking spaces available behind the building.

**If you do not have a Military ID card, tell the guard you are attending the Military Women's Luncheon. A guest list will be provided to security.**
