Alcohol and Other Drugs (AOD) Prevention Subcommittee

The purpose of the CE subcommittee is to collaborate with BHS to improve community engagement through outreach and inform the community about behavioral health services in a culturally responsive manner.

The purpose of the CJ subcommittee is to collaborate with BHS to establish coordination with the County and communities to stay informed, engaged, and responsive to issues that intersect criminal justice and mental health.

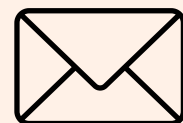
