- I. Welcome and Introductions (Delrena Swaggerty)
- II. Approval of Minutes- December 14, 2015 (Delrena Swaggerty)
 - Approved

III. Current Events in the Community:

- A. Regional Center- (Dan Clark)
 - Regional Center San Bernardino is back in operation after the December, 2015 events. Enhanced security has been established. In San Diego, the regional center was closed temporarily as a safety measure. Security is being re-assesed.
 - There is still space for the Working for Individuals with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (IDD)and Mental Health Needs training scheduled for Friday, January 15, 2016.
 - The SDRC continues to work on the MHSA Psychiatric Navigation project to do research
 and statistical analysis regarding the in-patient psychiatric hospitalization of person with
 developmental disabilities and a mental health diagnosis as well as to develop additional
 supports to enhance the service outcomes for these youth. Anticipated outcomes include
 reducing the length of hospitalization and the rate of recidivism.
- B. Weather impact at County of San Diego facilities (Yael Koenig/Dr.Sidelinger)
 - Minimal impact reported at contractors facilities.
 - Due to roof damage and flood, the Medical Records office at the Health Services Complex-Rosecrans was moved to the Psychiatric Hospital.
 - The Pharmacy at the Health Services Complex Rosecrans was moved to a mobile library outside the building to support outpatient medication dispensing.
 - Minor leaks were reported at some other County facilities.

IV. Mental Health Services Act (MHSA)- Update (Gary Ulmer-Goodrich)

The MHSA October 2015 Forums data compiling process is almost completed. The next step is
the writing of the report for the MHSA Plan Annual Update and the HHSA Annual Operational
Plan. The team is planning to have a draft document for executives review by February 2,
2016.

- D. Foster Youth Mental Health Bill of Rights- Questions to Ask About Medications (Yael Koenig)-Handout
 - California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) and California Department of Social Services (CDSS) developed a Foster Youth Mental Health Bill of Rights brochure for youth and parents served by behavioral health services with information on questions they can ask their service providers.
 - This brochure will be made available to all service providers to place at their waiting rooms.
 - CORs will be sharing the brochure with CYF Program managers in January 2016.
- E. Behavioral Health Advisory Board (BHAB) Suicide Prevention Workgroup (Yael Koenig)- Handout
 - BHAB member, Supervisor Dave Roberts proposed that BHAB established a Suicide Prevention Workgroup (Workgroup).
 - BHAB voted and approved the creation of the Workgroup.
 - The Workgroup developed 12 recommendations of which 10 were approved by the BHAB.
 - BHS and other County partners will conduct a feasibility review and will share recommendations with BHAB
 - County staff will conduct a feasibility review of the recommendations and share with BHAB.

VIII. Directors Report (Alfredo Aguirre)

- A. Community Care Reform
 - The State is working on forming a state county-partering team. San Diego was asked to be involved and Alfredo Aguirre accepted the appointment. Yael Koenig is the alternate.
 - There are 5 workgroups, San Diego needs to be part of one.
 - Community Care Reform may bring changes in the BHS system to address needs of foster care and interface with Child Welfare Services.
 - California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), California Department of Social Services (CDSS) and California Welfare Director Association (CWDA) and Behavioral Health Directors Association (CBHDA) will all be involved.
- B. MHSA Mid-Year Enhancements
 - An increase in revenue sources provided the opportunity to look at program enhancements in the San Diego system of care .
 - Enhancements were determined based on the following variables:
 - 1. Programs currently in the Mental Health Service Act Plan.
 - 2. Enhancements that could occur as early as February 1, 2016.
 - 3. Proposed enhancement aligned with the high level priorities identified during the October 2015 BHS community Engagement forums.
 - 4. Community needs.
- C. Mid-Year Enhacements to Children, Youth and Families Behavioral Health Services (Yael Koenig):
 - Augmentations to Psychiatrists rates.
 - Program that offer treatment services will be transitioning to Full Service Partnerships. This will allow the county to offer an array of services without creating silos.
 - Short-term residential alcohol and drug program shifting from 21 to up to 30 day program.
 - System capacity Increase.
 - Language capacity Increase.
 - Enhancements of Behavioral Health programs serving Probation Youth.
 - Alcohol and Other Drug services for women and children.
 - Training.
