

# **Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Special Populations Report, FY 2019-20 Methodology**

**Total Unique Clients**: Unduplicated count of all clients (using State\_Client\_Number), by program, who had an open episode in SanWITS during the fiscal year (could admit, discharge, or be open the entire year). Unless otherwise specified, the most recent episode (admission) is reported for each client. Clients may be open in effect to an episode in previous fiscal years or may be new clients.

Homeless: Client's living situation just prior to intake, collected at program admission.

**LGBTQ:** Client's self-reported sexual orientation and gender are endorsed as something other than heterosexual and are not missing. The sexual orientation field is not required in SanWITS and may have substantial missing data.

**Justice System:** Client's self-reported involvement with the justice system. The responses as entered into SanWITS are recoded into the following categories:

YES= Admitted under other diversion from any court under CA Penal Code, Section 1000; Awaiting trial, charges or sentencing; Incarcerated; On parole from any other jurisdiction; On probation from any jurisdiction; Post-release Community Service (AB 109) or on probation from any federal, state, or local jurisdiction.; Under parole supervision by CDC

NO = No criminal justice involvement

UNKNOWN = Client unable to answer; Blank

+ AB109: Client's self-reported involvement with the justice system. Counted if Post-release Community Service (AB 109) is endorsed in SanWITS.

**Military:** Prior or current service in the military.

**Level of Care (LOC)**: Level of Care of the program associated with the episode in SanWITS.

Race/Ethnicity: Clients respond to separate Race and Hispanic Origin questions in SanWITS. For purposes of comparison and consistency, we have analyzed the data as a single Race/Ethnicity variable (Primary\_Race\_Ethnicity); any person subscribing to Hispanic Ethnicity has been classified as Hispanic irrespective of Race. If the response for Ethnicity is not Hispanic, the Primary Race/Ethnicity category is displayed. The Race groups are recoded as follows:

WHITE = White

AFRICAN AMERICAN = African American

ASIAN = Cambodian, Chinese, Filipino, Guamanian, Hawaiian Native, Asian Indian, Japanese, Korean, Laotian, Mien, Other Pacific Islander, Hmong, Other Asian, Samoan, Vietnamese

NATIVE AMERICAN = Eskimo/Alaskan Native, Native American

OTHER/MIXED = Other Non-White, Sudanese, Chaldean, Ethiopian, Somali, Iranian, Iraqi

UNKNOWN = Unknown

Age: Client's age as of January 1, 2020.

**Gender:** Client's self-reported gender.

Medi-Cal Beneficiary: Clients who are at least partially covered by Medi-Cal.

Drug of Choice: Client's reported primary drug of choice at admission into the program

ALCOHOL=Alcohol
HEROIN=Heroin
COCAINE=Cocaine/Crack
METH=Methamphetamine

MARIJUANA=Marijuana/Hashish




OTHER OPIOIDS=Non-Prescription Methadone, Other Opiates or Synthetics, OxyCodone / OxyContin OTHER=Barbiturates, Ecstasy, Inhalants, None, Other (specify), Other Amphetamines, Other Club Drugs, Other Hallucinogens, Other Sedatives or Hypnotics, Other Stimulants, Other Tranquilizers, Over-the-Counter, PCP, Tranquilizers (e.g., Benzodiazepine), Blank

Employment: Client's employment status at program admission. Includes whether the client is in school at the time of admission.

**Living Situation:** Client's living situation just prior to intake, collected at program admission.

**Dual Dx:** Any mental health diagnosis reported by the client.
