San Diego County Crisis Stabilization Units (CSU)





Crisis Stabilization Units (CSUs) provide immediate mental health support and treatment services in a calming setting to individuals with serious behavioral health needs. CSUs can help to deescalate a person's level of distress, prevent or treat a behavioral health crisis, and reduce acute symptoms of a mental health condition. Individuals may be admitted voluntarily or may be brought in on a Welfare & Institutions Code (WIC) 5150 hold. The goal of CSUs is to connect individuals to ongoing care and avoid the need for higher levels of care.

Who Can Access a CSU?

The County of San Diego (County) offers crisis stabilization services to children and adults at various locations countywide, see below for more details. County CSUs generally serve individuals who are Medi-Cal eligible or enrolled, uninsured, or very low income however anyone in need of services can access services at the CSU.

Locations

The County currently has six CSUs – five for adults and one for children and adolescents. All CSU locations accept walk-ins. Services are tailored to each person and are provided on a short-term basis, up to 24 hours.
