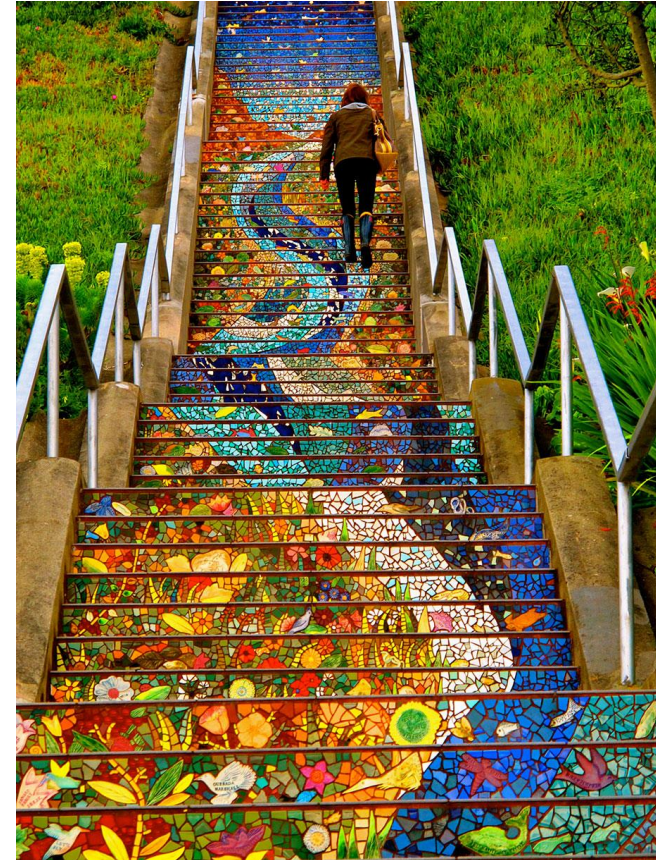

AAP-CA3 SBHI Achievements

County of San Diego Board Memo



- Access and Capacity Challenges: Systemic barriers, workforce shortages, and limited infrastructure have created unequal access to behavioral health services, leading to delays and unmet needs in underserved communities.
- The Optimal Care Pathways (OCP) Model will quantify service gaps and optimize care delivery.
- Emphasis on early intervention, prevention, and culturally responsive services.



Development of Youth OCP Framework (Part 1)



1. Creation of a Children, Youth, and Transition Age Youth (TAY) Behavioral Health Continuum Framework
 - Collaboratively develop framework for ages 0-25 to improve behavioral health services.
 - The framework will address gaps in care, align with policy changes, and integrate with the Optimal Care Pathways (OCP) Model.
2. Key Deliverables
 - Interim Report: Immediate strategies, resourcing plans, and a development roadmap within six months.
 - Final Report: Comprehensive framework with recommendations for implementation and sustainability within 18 months.

Development of Youth OCP Framework (Part 2)



3. Optimizing Medi-Cal Payments

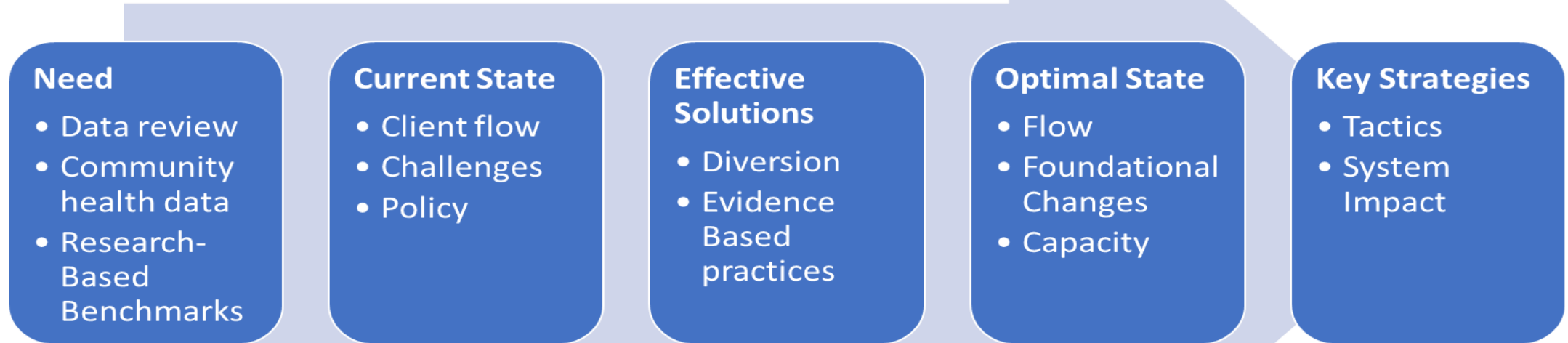
- Identify opportunities to improve reimbursement models for Medi-Cal-covered behavioral health services.
- Ensure sustainability and efficiency in payment structures for service providers.
- Ensure that funding mechanisms align with the key service improvements outlined in the Framework.



What is the "OCP" Model?



- The Optimal Care Pathways (OCP) model guides investments in behavioral health services
- Quantifies optimal service utilization across the continuum of care
- Prioritizes clinically appropriate, community-based care in the least restrictive setting
- Utilizes research, best practices
