



Assertive Community Treatment Programs



Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) programs provide the highest level of community-based outpatient mental health care. ACT adopts a “whatever it takes” approach to care, with services provided several times a week, including weekends and holidays. All programs serve adults and have 24/7 on-call availability.



Services Offered

Depending on the need, services may include:

- Rehabilitation and recovery
- Psychiatry
- Nursing
- Intensive case management
- Linkage to substance use treatment
- Supported employment
- Peer support
- Supportive housing
- Payee services
- Transportation



Who is Eligible?

Participants must be adults living with a serious mental illness or co-occurring substance use condition, experiencing homelessness or at risk of homelessness, and in need of intensive mental health services.
