Charity shared the most recent presentation was co-facilitated with Piedad on the topic of self-care and vicarious trauma.</li> <li>The team is currently working on dates for BHS to provide further presentations and trainings.</li> </ul> <p><b>HHSA Ten Year Road Map</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Charity shared the Ten-Year Road Map accomplishments for Behavioral Health Year Two (Fiscal Year 2017-18). This document is still in draft form. The Roadmap is a dynamic, living document, updated annually to incorporate new priorities from our community partners &amp; HHSA/Behavioral Health Services (BHS) leadership.
