BHS Director’s Update <i>Jason Miller for Piedad Garcia</i> 12:20-12:25pm	Behavioral Health Services (BHS) and SDHC joint efforts at the San Diego Convention Center <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Home Finder had approximately 40 subsidies that were still available out of their 100 total subsidies • BHS has been working with SDHC and Regional Task Force on the Homeless (RTFH) to data match the list of individuals at the Convention Center



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Most recent list had more than 1,130 total individuals at the Convention Center • BHS was checking to see which individuals were already connected to programs and who was potentially eligible but not connected • Home Finder was able to enroll and submit 26 sponsor-based subsidy applications in one week • Some ACT programs have sponsor-based subsidies available, but they do not have treatment slots available • BHS amended one of the new Telecare ACT programs in order to include 25 general ACT treatment slots <p>San Ysidro Senior Village (SYSV) is in the lease-up process</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 12 MHSA-dedicated units in San Ysidro • Project-based vouchers through SDHC for all PSH units • First development to lease up during the COVID-19 pandemic • Aging and Independence Services and Serving Seniors are offering two free meals a day to the tenants
