<p>IV. MHSA Update (Adrienne Yancey)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The counties MHSA INN 18 is on hold, pending a schedule date to be presented at MHSOAC. Recap: the proposed project is to decrease negative consequences from untreated behavioral health issues for expectant, new mothers and fathers. Through coordination with the Public Health Nurses Home Visiting Programs, they will engage pregnant women, their partners, and parents with young children that have already been identified by Public Health Nurses as having need for treatment services. The County of San Diego is seeking the approved use of MHSA Innovation funds from the MHSOAC, for the use of \$100,000 in Innovation funds to support a human-centered design process. The proposed human-centered design will engage a consultant for the design process and will seek an organization that is skilled in technology industries and academia that includes the end-user in all stages of design. <p>BHS Community Engagement Forums Update:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The RFP for the 2018 Community Forums will soon be released.
