The presentation focused on the various entities working together to provide affordable housing, assistance for mental health services, and ending homelessness. There is a new County staff member: Director of Integrative Services, Dr. Luke Bergman. The County of San Diego was notified in late June 2018 that Tri City Medical Center intends to suspend their Crisis Stabilization Unit (CSU). BHS is working on adding and expanding CSUs in the area. Registration for Suicide Prevention Training scheduled for September 12th is now open and free to attend.
