Chair's Report</b> (Piedad Garcia and Charity White-Voth)	<p><b>Behavioral Health Advisory Board</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dr. Luke Bergmann provided an update on the Continuum of Care</li> <li>Development started in North Coastal and North Inland as a result of reducing psychiatric acute care beds at Tri-City and Palomar</li> <li>Development is under way for a Crisis Stabilization Unit at Palomar—Includes eight recliners, 24/7, LPS</li> <li>In the process of developing a CSU in Vista and Oceanside</li> <li>Up to 14 Crisis Residential Treatment Beds will be coming online around the 78 Corridor, proposals expected by mid-January</li> <li>A non-law enforcement Crisis Mobile Response Team is being developed in Vista, expected to be finalized within the next six months</li> <li>Third Avenue Complex: Scripps and UCSD are exploring the possibility of a joint venture for care coordination with a variety of treatment services on one campus</li> </ul>	<p><b>Action Item:</b> Review data on Medi-Cal population and penetration rate of Behavioral Health Services in East and South Region</p> <p>Review Interpreters Report with additional data on age populations based on need</p>

QI Updates</b> (Liz Miles)</p>	<p><b>External Quality Review</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>External Quality Review (EQR), an annual review conducted by the State, is scheduled for January 7<sup>th</sup> through January 9<sup>th</sup></li> <li>EQR will be reviewing quality, timeliness, and access <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Over 40 different sessions during the EQR</li> </ul> </li> <li>The County is required to conduct 15 focus groups this year made up of clients, staff, and contractors <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Examples of Focus Groups: Parents and Caregivers, Foster Parents and Caregivers, Adult Clients in East County, and ROAM</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
