Director's Update (Dr. Luke Bergmann/ Connie German-Marquez on behalf of Piedad Garcia)	 Alfredo and Luke attended the National Association of County Behavioral Health & Developmental Disability Directors Conference. Conference emphasized movement between health care and criminal justice settings. On March 26, 2019, another Board Letter is going forward during the Board of Supervisors meeting. This letter announces there will be activity around three initiatives that were referenced by Chairwoman Dianne Jacob. Adult and Older Adult update: Structural changes are taking place: Two chief level positions have been added to the system. Cecily Thornton-Stearns has been promoted to the Assistant Medical Services Administrator position. The second chief will be added in the next upcoming months. Housing, moving forward with the No Place Like Home, approximately 75 units and 45 million requested in NOFA. It has also expanded to include homeless families with children and youth that has a serious emotional condition. Adult Council/Ad Hoc Workgroup continues to meet, and they are developing a summary of findings and recommendations. First Binational Conference on Human Trafficking: Traumatic Effects on Individual Mental/Physical and Border Communities occurred March 8, 2019, Piedad and Charity attended. Asylee Shelter for migrant families Migrants continue to be screened at the County shelters. An average of 75 to 100 migrants' families are being screened after being processed by I.C.E, per week.

MHSA Update (Martin Dare)	 Piedad was not able to attend the Adult Council meeting because herself, Charity and Dr. Nelson are providing training for County staff deploy to the asylee shelter on culturally sensitive trauma informed in care and selfcare. 3 RFPS's – Justice Involved RFP's were posted as a Notice of Intend two weeks ago. Two step-downs from IMD and FU Care that are very close to posting or might have already posted as a Notice of Intend to Award.
