BHS is actively working to identify alternative sources of funding to support housing for clients. 	
	 Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System: The implementation of the DMC-ODS will provide more services for those suffering from substance use disorders and improve our local oversight, monitoring and delivery of this system of care for County of San Diego. DMC-ODS delivery system will be effective July 1st. ASAM placement tool will be utilized. Under DMC, there will be licensed clinicians and overnight staff for residential treatment programs. 	
IV. MHSA Update (Adrienne Yancey)	 MHSOAC has approved Innovation funds to support a human-centered design process. The proposed human-centered design will engage a consultant for the design process and will seek an organization that is skilled in technology industries and academia that includes the end-user in all stages of design.
