<b>III. Chair's Report</b> (Piedad Garcia)	Contractors are scheduled to receive the allocation letters for FY 16-17 budget on 4/11/16. In July 2016 a request for the approval of the implementation of the 1115 Waiver will be presented to the Board of Supervisors.	
<b>IV. AOT/Laura's Law Update</b> (Charity White-Voth)	The Assisted Outpatient Treatment (AOT) contract was officially awarded on January, 1 2016; the program began accepting clients on 3/28/16. Natalie Blair reiterated that referrals for AOT come through the In Home Outreach Team (IHOT) programs. Ms. Blair provided an overview of the nine criteria that must be met in order for clients to qualify for AOT.	
<b>V. Recovery Culture Progress Report</b> (Dr. Todd Gilmer)	Dr. Gilmer discussed the Recovery Culture Progress Report (RCPR), a provider evaluation survey tool funded by Mental Health Services Act Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSAOAC) that focuses on the recovery orientation of programs implemented by the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA).	Piedad Garcia will discuss the RCPR with the BHS Director of Operations and Executive Team and will report their feedback to CCRT at the May 2016 meeting.

QI Updates</b> (Dasha Dahdouh)	All program managers will be given two weeks to complete the Cultural Competence Program Annual Self Evaluation (CC-PAS) starting on Monday, April 4, 2016 through Friday, April 15, 2016. Cultural Competence Plan updates will be finalized and the document will be sent for review in April 2016. The final EQR report was received and will be posted on the Technical Resource Library (TRL)
