The 1115 Waiver draft plan will be presented to the BHAB and BOS in September 2016 for recommendation and support. Charity informed the 100 Homeless Person Project Request for Proposal (RFP) was sent out. The hybrid model integrates 2 service components in 1 contract. One component for individuals with SMI with cooccurring and the 2nd component for AOD clients with primary diagnosis of substance use. IV. QI Updates (Liz Miles)	 The Cultural Competence Plan (CCP) was submitted to the state on July 1, 2016. The 3-Year Strategic CCP will commence development in October or November with input and recommendation from the CCRT. The Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSOAC) will be conducting a site visit to get feedback on the implementation of the PEI regulations that went into effect July 1, 2016. A state ADS audit revealed that CLAS standards within ADS programs are not being monitored. A CLAS component was distributed for CCRT members to review and provide feedback for ADS programs to use. 	
V. Committee Updates • Education and Training (Charity White-Voth)	 Education and Training: Cultural and Linguistic Competence Policy Assessment (CLCPA) from George Town University has been reviewed and modified to best serve San Diego County. The modification would need to be approved by George Town University. The goal is for CLCPA to replace the annual CC-PAS. CCRT to discuss recommendations and presentation to BHS executive team.
