I. Welcome/ Introduction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Piedad called the meeting order at 10:03 AM. 	
II. Approval of April 2016 Minutes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Approval of April 1, 2016 minutes was moved as written. (Dasha Dahdouh) 	
III. Chair's Report (Piedad Garcia)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Board of Supervisors (BOS) approved the preliminary budget plan for Fiscal year 2016 – 2017, which will expand the programs and staffing for Behavioral Health Services (BHS). Including Project One for All. Project One for All is a homeless project for SMI and was directed by the BOS and directs the HHS to develop an implementation plan which will be presented to the Behavioral Health Advisory Board and the BOS in May. The Plan will include work with HCD and other housing authorities to leverage housing subsidies with services. Allocation letters were sent out to contractors by BHS, to be reviewed and discussed with program monitors. BHS Adult & Older Adult team will began workgroups with AOD providers and Narcotic Treatment Providers for recommendations, input and feedback. AOA is working with the City of San Diego on SMART Pilot project for clients with primary drug addiction for Recovery Center services, linkages and connections to Residential Treatment and Sober Living. The Faith Based Task Order 3 & 4 – North Inland did not receive any proposal response. Suggestion for a reaching out strategy and proving further information to possible providers. 	
IV. QI Updates (Tabatha Lang)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Notice was sent via email regarding State Surveys (YSS & MHSIP) that will take place from May 16 – 20. A few added data questions were added, for all CYF clinicians about their use of homework with clients and the knowledge of grievance and appeals process. THE CYF Clinician survey was sent on May 4, 2016 with deadline of May 13, 2016. Cultural Competence Plan Updates were emailed April 29, 2016 for team to review and provide feedback by May 13, 2016. Recommendations and comments will be provided at the June 2016 CCRT meeting. The Health Outcomes Management System (HOMS) has been enhanced and trainings will be provided. Further information will be sent via email. The state has contracted the CA Institute for Behavioral Health Solutions (CHIBS) to provide training on the 1115 Waiver (DMC) state and countywide. San Diego is currently waiting for a training timeline. 	

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V. MHSA Plan Update (Adrienne Yancey)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The MHSA Annual Update for 2016 – 2017 has been released for review. To download go to http://sandiego.camhsa.org/. If you have any comment or questions please see link for contact information. BHS community forums for 2017 – 2018 planning to start in August. MHSA has its own process for addressing issues, complaints and grievances about MHSA planning and process. The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) requires that the local issue resolution process be exhausted before accessing State venues. San Diego County BHS MHSA Issue Resolution Process handout was distributed.

Committee Updates <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Education and Training (Charity White-Voth) Children’s Update (Edith Mohler) 	Education and Training: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Committee has been meeting monthly to review and discussed existing tools and research new tools for organizational and individual assessment prior to presenting it to the team. Children Update: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Currently developing a new specialized treatment program that will provide services to LGBTQ for Fiscal year 2016 - 2017. The program will provide mental health counseling, assistance with permanent supportive housing, sexual health education, life skills training, employment development and education support. Children’s Mental Health Well-Being Celebration on Tuesday, May 4, 2016 was very successful. 	
VII. WET Update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Workforce Education and Training (WET) was a one-time funding for a maximum of 10 years to spend and the funds have been steadily decreasing. Further review into using unspent funds is in the process, a recommendation to extend certain programs that are close to achieving sustainability. For Fiscal year 2016 – 2017, approximately \$2,200,000 in CSS funds will be transferred to MHSA WET component to continue funding and the need for additional WET Funds will be evaluated annually.
