<p>IV. Co-Chair Updates</p>	<p>Adrienne Berlin made a suggestion to invite the San Diego Police Department to speak to the Housing Council regarding the recent crimes against homeless individuals. It was announced Alpha Project offered to place homeless individuals in their office lobby until the suspect in these incidents is identified and arrested.</p> <p>Thomas Thiesen noted the need to have a unified approach to end homelessness in the County. Alfredo Aguirre encouraged the Housing Council members and guests to attend the upcoming Behavioral Health Advisory Board (BHAB) meeting to present their concerns and ideas on how to end homelessness. Piedad Garcia noted the importance of having the business community involved in the goal of ending homelessness.</p> <p>Ronda Gibbs announced she is working on a pilot program that uses a model that combines the traditional ILH and master leasing approach to make units available to clients. Ronda was invited to present on the pilot program which is currently in its beginning phase.</p>
