More education and outreach needed for prescription medication plans for OA clients. 22 different programs (inpatient and outpatient) in San Diego. Mentioned a few: KIVA (inpatient, residential treatment facility for women,) New Connections (men & women transitioning out of prison,) sobering downtown program (detox for 4 hours). 12 steps program, use of medication (if necessary and approved.) Jeanne celebrated 60 years of sobriety. All: Discussion of treatment model for OA population.
