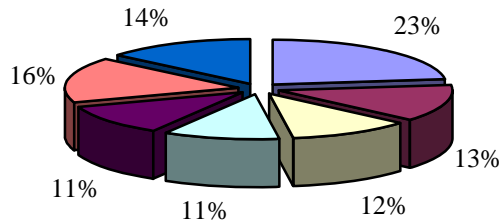

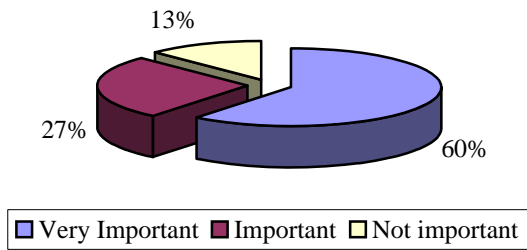
If you had better access to a computer, would you be likely to:



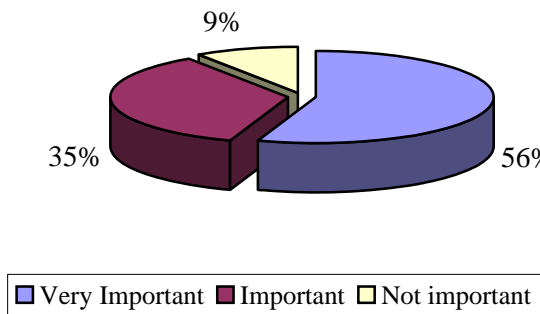
If you could access some of your personal health information, which items would be important to you?



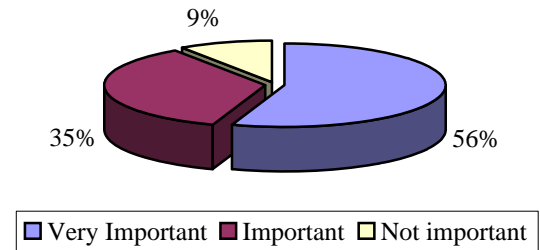
How important is computer training at no cost?
