- Community Program Planning (CPP) Process: Per the Mental Health Services
 Act (MHSA, 2004), planning, implementation, and evaluation of programs and
 services made possible through MHSA funds need to involve the community;
 Counties receiving MHSA funding need to collaborate and partner with
 consumers and share information and resources.
- County of San Diego General Management System (Enterprise-wide goals)
- Community Experience Partnership (CEP): Departmental initiative to integrate
 data and community feedback and priorities to inform and support planning and
 program development to equitably improve behavioral health and wellness
 across the Behavioral Health Continuum of Care.

Implementing BHS CE Activities





- The department facilitates community engagement efforts through <u>three</u> primary mechanisms:
 - BHS Staff BHS' Communication & Engagement (C&E) Unit leads internal and external messaging and engagement efforts for the department (established November 2022)
 - County Staff outside of BHS individuals and teams external to the department that support behavioral health-related engagement activities
 - Contracts (Various)
