BHSA Updates (03/06/2025)





Key Activities To-Date re: Community Engagement:

- Mar 2024: Proposition 1 (Prop 1) passed by California voters
- Aug 2024: Last Community Engagement Update provided at BHAB General Meeting; California Department of Healthcare Services (DHCS) notes plans for phased guidance for counties to begin Jan 2025
- **Sept 2024:** BHS initiates internal review of its community engagement mechanisms and processes
- Dec 2024: DHCS releases draft BHSA County Policy Manual for Public Comment; BHAB Director's Report discusses community engagement transition
- Jan 2025: Additional community engagement transition details provided via BHS Notice and presentation at BHS System of Care (SoC) Combined Council Meeting
- Feb 2025: Reconfiguration of existing BHS-led convenings and input sessions begin; DHCS releases finalized BHSA County Policy Manual (02/20/2025)

- August 2025: DHCS provides county behavioral health departments with an overview of IP Requirements and Submission, CPP, IP Data, Statewide Behavioral Health Goals, and County Provider Monitoring and Oversight via webinars 08/14/2025 & 08/26/2025

BHSA Updates: State IP Template





The first BHSA Integrated Plan (IP) will cover Fiscal Years 2026-2029 and be due June 30, 2026.

A State IP template will include required sections on the following topics:

- County Demographics and Behavioral Health Needs
- Plan Goals and Objectives
 - Community Planning Process
- Comment Period and Public Hearing
- County Behavioral Health Care Continuum Capacity
- Services by Total Funding Source
- Behavioral Health Services Fund Programs
- Workforce Strategy
- Budget and Prudent Reserve

Annual and intermittent updates are not subject to stakeholder engagement requirements for the IP outlined in section 3.B.1 of the manual.





CE Planning (BHAB Meeting, 10/02/2023)





- Key requests regarding implementation of input/engagement activities:
 - Hold more activities in neighborhood and community spaces
 - Co-facilitation with partners
 - More smaller groups rather than larger listening sessions
 - Incentives for participation and follow-thru to show how community input is being implemented
 - More balanced representation at input activities
 - Advanced notice
 - Multiple means of obtaining input

CE Planning (BHAB Meeting, 10/02/2023)





- Key recommendations from BHAB CE Subcommittee (8/16 Jamboard):
 - Maintain multiple formats (i.e., interviews, focus groups, input sessions, questionnaires)
 - Geographic regions, as well as group/population specific input sessions of varying sizes
 - Enhance dissemination of static questionnaire and leverage this questionnaire more
 - Have hard-copy, translated versions of questionnaire
 - More promotion on social media (not just posts but consider making polls or events on platforms such as Facebook if platform has that functionality)

Additional Strategies (Page 3 of draft CPP Plan handout)

In addition to the community engagement approaches and activities previously approved to support CPP (see Action Items – 10/02/23 BHAB Monthly Meeting), department staff are:

- Collaborating with other teams to assess the addition of CPP activities and/or questions about BHSA topics into other engagement opportunities being led by County peers
- 2. Engaging community groups and organizations who have already led/are championing efforts related to behavioral health priority areas (see Page 5) and coordinating focused discussion opportunities to support more continuous, collaborative planning in the region
- 3. Integrating questions about BHSA topics into other BHS community engagement activities focused on priority areas (e.g. BHSA topics at an engagement activity for Youth OCP)
- 4. Integrating questions about BHSA topics into activities with community coalitions, councils, and collaboratives with diverse and/or larger membership bases
- 5. Piloting less formal, short-form input opportunities (1-2 questions) at in-person outreach and education events on BHSA topics
- 6. Sharing information via existing and new BHS webpages


