I. Call to Order

Meeting called to order by Amanda Berry at 1:01 p.m. Executive Committee members present: Amanda Berry, Chair; Minola Clark Manson, 1st Vice Chair; Dr. Gaurav Mishra, 2nd Vice Chair; and Robin Sales, Member-at-Large. II. Approval of the Meeting Minutes of March 19, 2026

III. Non-Agenda Public Comment

Total of one (1) in-person comment and one (1) E- Comment was received.

In-Person Comment:

- Robert Alm reported that the committee's unanimous approval of the Lanterman-Petris-Short (LPS) subcommittee had been viewed as controversial, given leadership's historical and current reservations, and that early committee activities had resulted in multiple attempts and threats to remove him, reflecting bullying behavior and underscoring the board's responsibility to identify gaps in behavioral health services and advocate when critical issues within the continuum of care—such as LPS—were being overlooked.

E- Comment:

- KMarie requested a formal response regarding concerns that their loved under LPS conservatorship are not receiving adequate support, citing inconsistent documentation, loss of communication after requesting progress notes, and concerns about a potentially premature step-down placement.

IV. Chair's Update

Public comment: Total of one (1) in-person comment was received.

- Robert Alm stated concerns about procedural irregularities and inaccurate guidance at the previous meeting and requested that the prior vote be reconsidered as well as requested County Counsel present for future meetings.

Chair's Update

Amanda Berry, Chair, BHAB, provided the following update:

- All BHAB Members will continue to be reminded of the mandatory Clerk of the Board and Ethics training requirements, as the board has not yet reached full compliance.
- A motion has been made to meet with County Counsel to obtain clarity on the bylaws, the Brown Act, and the structure of subcommittees.

ON MOTION of Amanda Berry, seconded by Robin Sales, the Executive Committee approved having a meeting with County Counsel prior to the May BHAB General meeting to get clarity on bylaws, Brown Act, and subcommittee clarifications.
