



BEHAVIORAL HEALTH ADVISORY BOARD ACTION ITEM OCTOBER 3, 2019

APPROVAL OF 2019 DATA NOTEBOOK

Annually, local Behavioral Health Advisory Boards (BHAB) are asked by the California Behavioral Health Planning Council to complete a Data Notebook. This helps local boards fulfill their mandate to report on program goals, needs, and provide input to the legislature and the public. Participation informs advocacy decisions by the California Behavioral Health Planning Council.

The County of San Diego Behavioral Health Advisory Board has taken the following action:

Month	Action
August BHAB Meeting	Chair announced the topic and timeline for the Data Notebook Project, which aids the California Behavioral Health Planning Council's advocacy for behavioral health services.
September BHAB Meeting	Staff distributed draft suggested responses to BHAB, including County data (Informational Item)
September	BHAB Members reviewed draft responses, and relayed suggestions to staff.
October BHAB Meeting	BHAB votes on submission of Data Notebook final draft, after discussion of any pending changes, as needed. (Action Item)

It is THEREFORE, staff's recommendation that your board vote to approve the draft data notebook and authorize staff to submit it to the California Behavioral Health Planning Council ahead of the October 15th deadline.
