

RECOMMENDATION 4: EXECUTE AGREEMENTS





Cooperative Agreement with State Department of Rehabilitation

Provides adults experiencing serious mental illness vocational services and support in achieving placement in competitive employment

- Renew revenue agreement with DOR from July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2029
- Increase in revenue match dollars not to exceed \$0.4 million annually

Revenue Agreement for Driving Under the Influence Program

Licensed by State Department of Health Services (DHCS) for provision of DUI programs

 Increase licensed DUI programs in San Diego County from three programs to four programs, with a new program to be in the HHSA North Inland region
