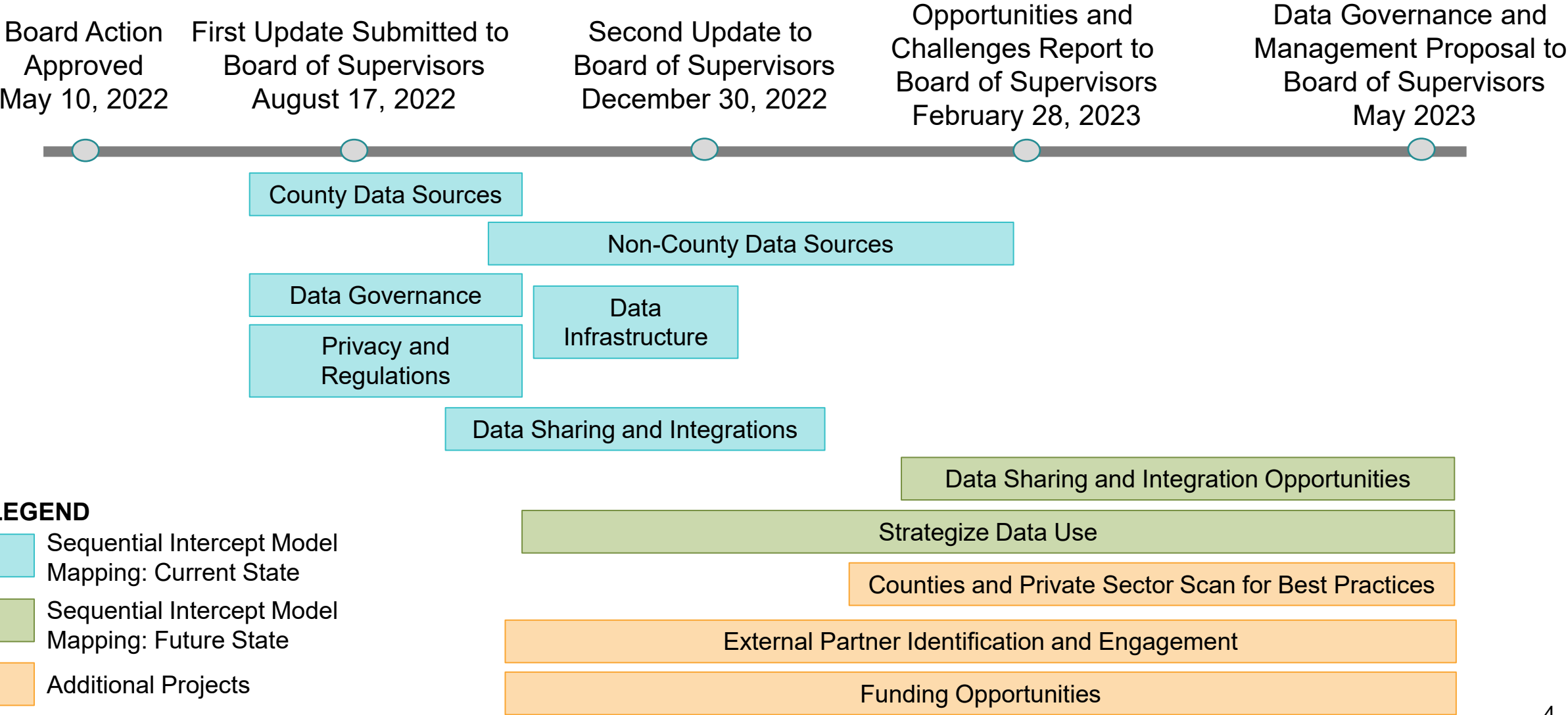

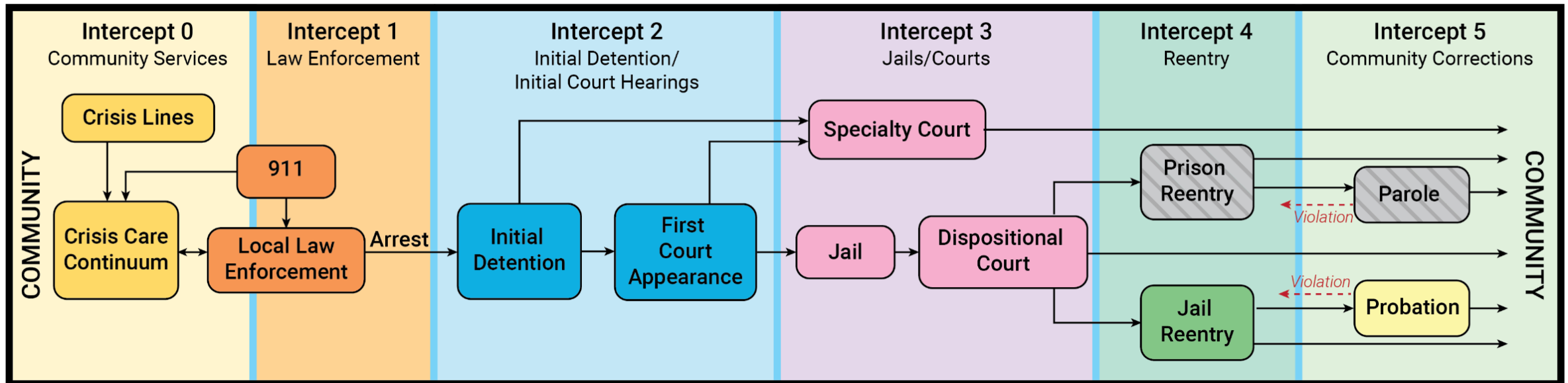
PROJECT TIMELINE

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ANNA'S STORY*



Anna, a 48-year-old female at Las Colinas Detention and Reentry Facility, is referred by San Diego Sheriff Department's Reentry staff to the County's Community Care Coordination (C3) program to provide housing upon release and also help transition back to the community.

Anna has a history of bipolar disorder, substance use, hypertension, poor medication adherence and was experiencing homelessness at the time of her arrest.

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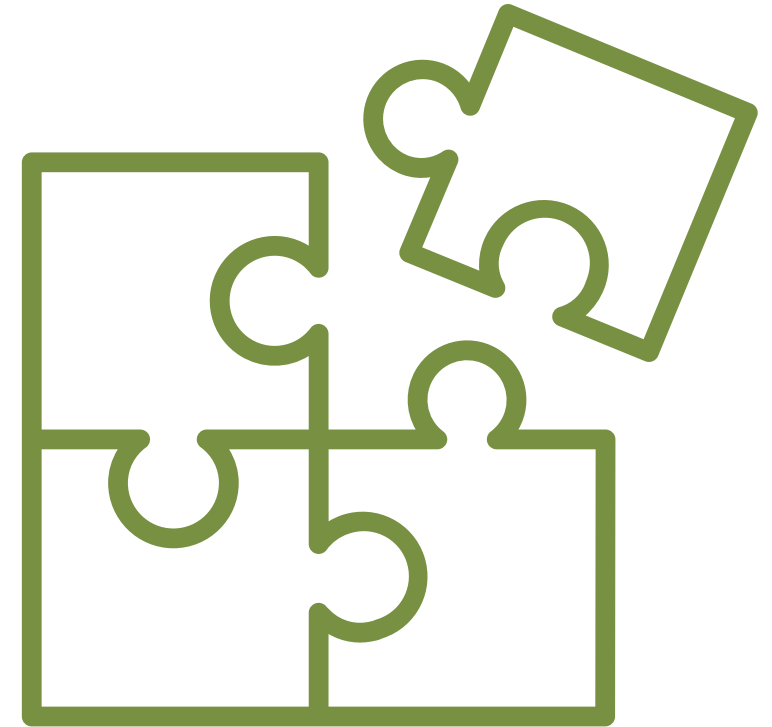
