PURPOSE OF THIS TRAINING



WHY ARE YOU RECEIVING THIS TRAINING?

- The County of San Diego is implementing a program to distribute medication called naloxone that reverses opioid overdose, to address the record number of overdose deaths in the community.

- You have been identified by your site management as staff who will be trained to distribute naloxone to those your organization serves who may be at risk of an opioid overdose or be in contact with those at risk.

WHAT ARE OPIOIDS?



Opioids are a class of drugs that include the illegal drug heroin, synthetic opioids such as fentanyl, and pain relievers available legally by prescription, such as oxycodone (OxyContin®), hydrocodone (Vicodin®), codeine, morphine, and many others. **EXAMPLES OF OPIOIDS**

Effects of Opioids:

- Drowsiness
- Confusion
- Nausea
- Constipation
- Euphoria
- Slowed breathing

- Heroin
- Codeine
- Oxycodone (OxyContin, Roxicodone, and Percocet)
- Hydrocodone (Vicodin, Norco, Lortab)
- Morphine (MS Contin and Kadian)
- Hydromorphone (Dilaudid and Exalgo)
- Fentanyl (Actiq, Fentora, Duragesic, Subsys, Abstral, and Lazanda)




