

PREVENTION STRATEGY

The County of San Diego utilizes environmental prevention strategies and a community-change model to prevent substance use problems and support healthier behavior choices throughout the region. Through active engagement with the community, key stakeholders, and the public health and public safety sectors, County behavioral health prevention initiatives reduce a variety of harms and problems related to substance use through four major initiatives:

- The Alcohol Policy Panel of San Diego County addresses underage drinking issues in San Diego County communities and across the border
- Methamphetamine Strike Force addresses the personal, community and environmental impact of methamphetamine
- The Marijuana Prevention Initiative focuses on youth use of marijuana
- The Prescription Drug Abuse Task Force addresses the illicit use of prescription drugs in the region

Access to Services

Treatment services shall not be refused to clients based on race/ethnicity, disability, culture, religion, gender, sexual orientation, or the inability to pay, if the client meets the County's eligibility population requirements.
