# WOMEN'S SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER PROGRAMS

The County of San Diego offers substance use disorder treatment and recovery programs to meet the special needs of women. These programs are for women with children, women without children, pregnant women, and adolescents. Treatment programs for women are located throughout the County and services may include:

- Residential treatment and recovery programs,
- · Case managers who provide support and referrals,
- · Childcare,
- · Children's mental health services.
- Transportation to and from services,
- · Language services,
- · Work preparation activities, and
- Classes for improving self-esteem, parenting, life skills, and healthy relationships.

#### **Access to Services**

Services shall not be refused to clients based on race/ ethnicity, disability, culture, religion, gender, sexual orientation, or the inability to pay, if the client meets the County's eligibility population requirements. Clients who are CalWORKs eligible shall not be charged fees. Clients who are DMC eligible shall not be charged fees unless there is Share of Cost (SOC).

# **OUTPATIENT PERINATAL SERVICES**

Outpatient services are available to women, and pregnant or parenting women and adolescent females age 15 and older. Women may utilize the outpatient perinatal programs outlined below or access coed programs outlined in the adult services brochure.
