

Child and Family Team Meeting Three Questions

Per Welfare and Institution Codes (WIC) 832, to promote more effective communication needed for the development of a plan to address the needs of the child or youth and family, a person designated as a member of a child and family team may receive and disclose relevant information and records, subject to the confidentiality provisions of state and federal law. Information exchanged among the team shall be received in confidence for the limited purpose of providing necessary services and supports to the child or youth and family and shall not be further disclosed except to the juvenile court with jurisdiction over the child, subject to the privileges and confidentiality requirements of state and federal law, or as otherwise required by law. Civil and criminal penalties may apply to the inappropriate disclosure of information held by the team. Please do not document information the family/youth has requested not to be shared. General language will be used to convey the necessary information to preserve the privacy of the family/youth.
