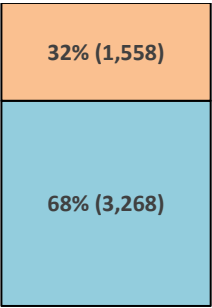

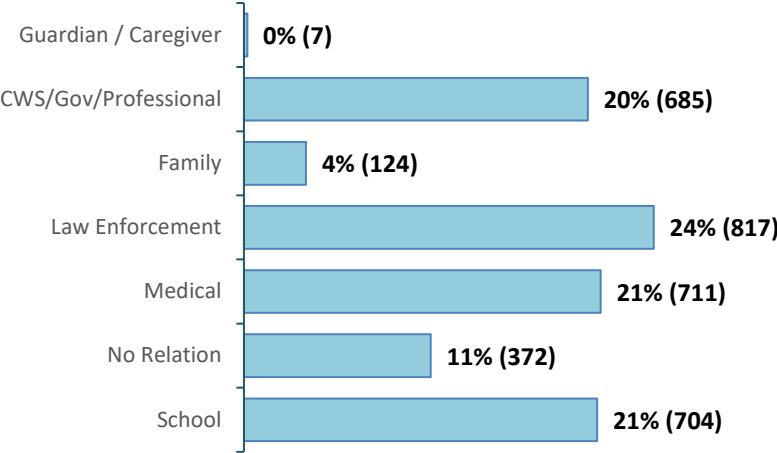

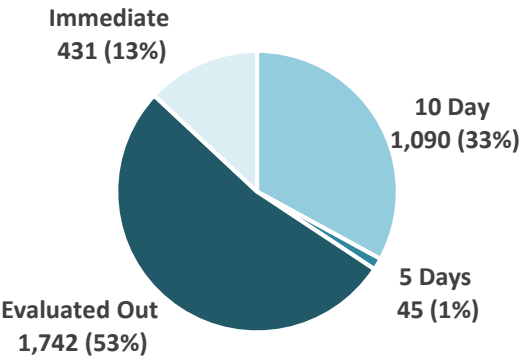

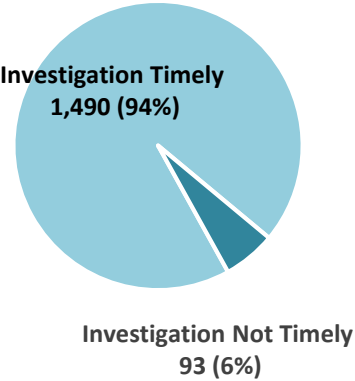

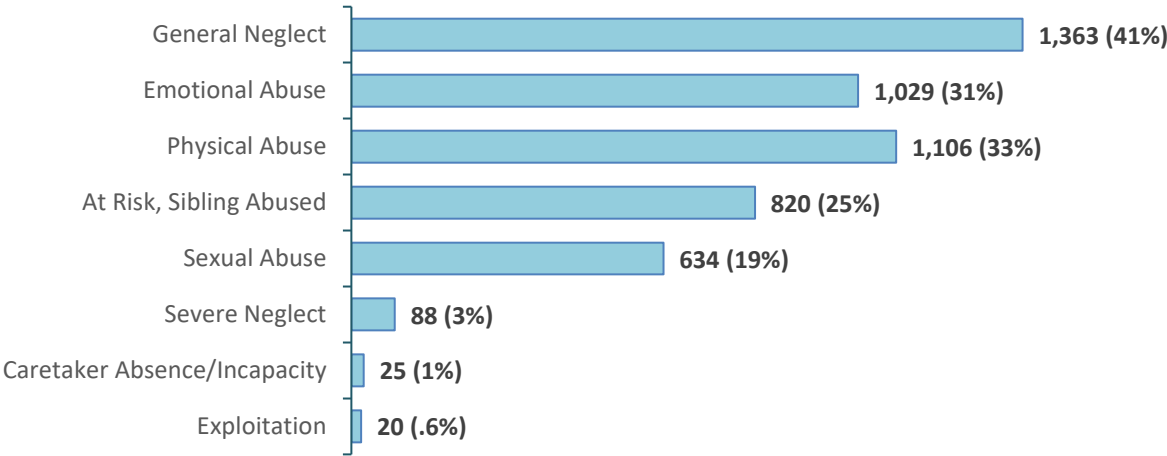
REFERRAL RESPONSE TYPE

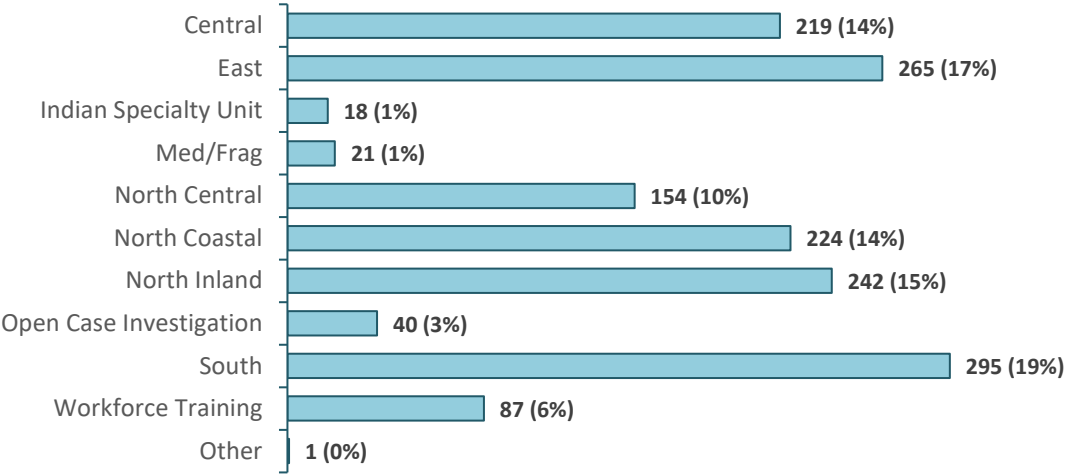


ALLEGATION TYPE

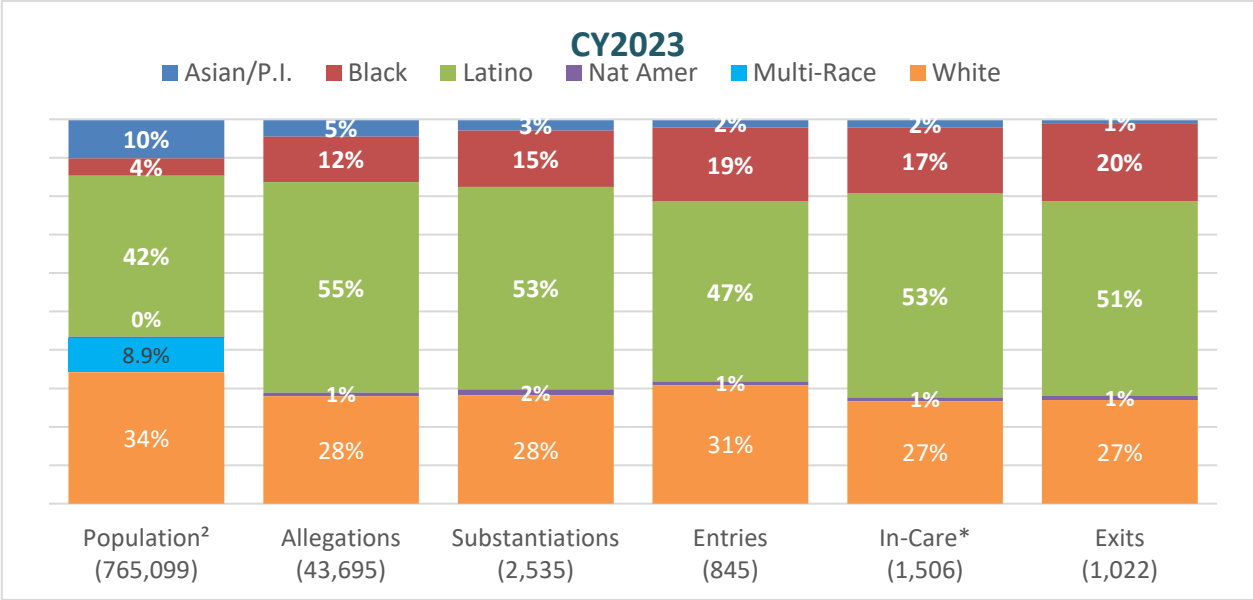

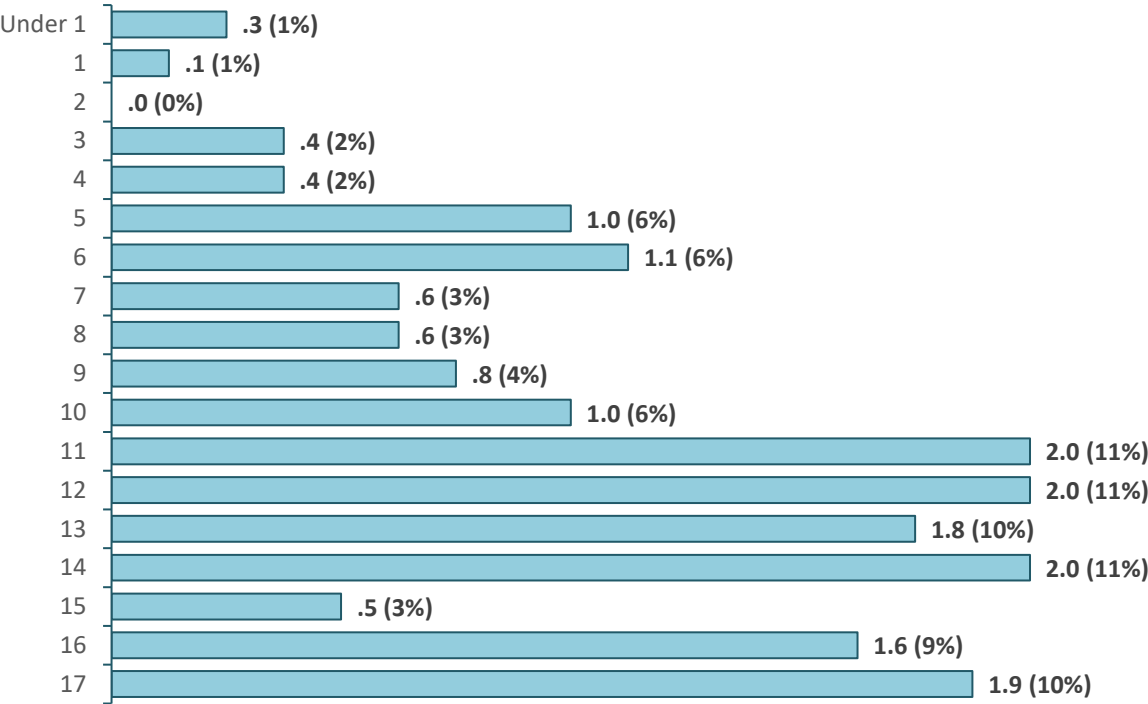

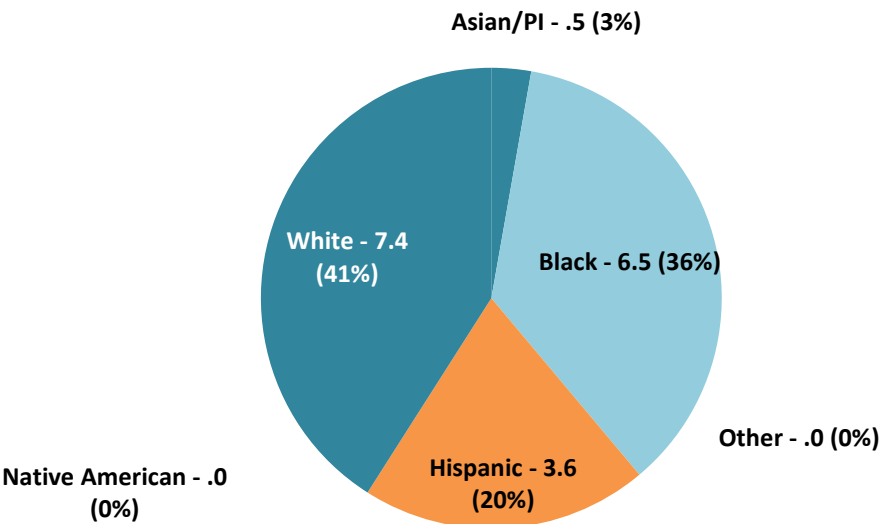

Clients at Polinsky Children's Center by Age



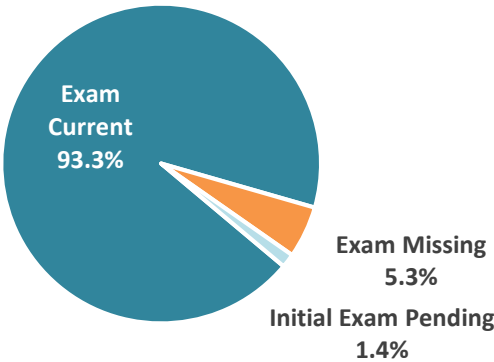
Clients at Polinsky Children's Center by Ethnicity



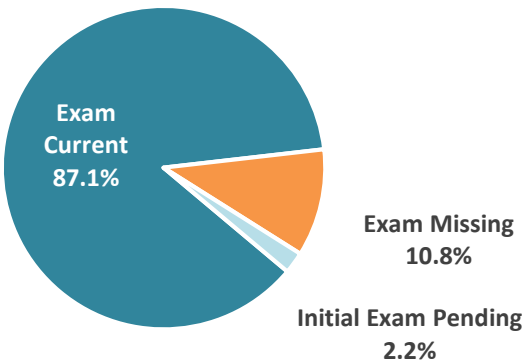

Placements - Five counties with the highest child population comparison (On October 01, 2024)

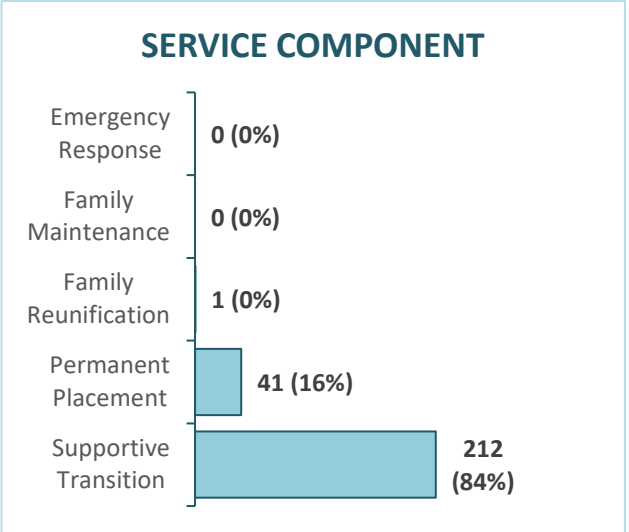
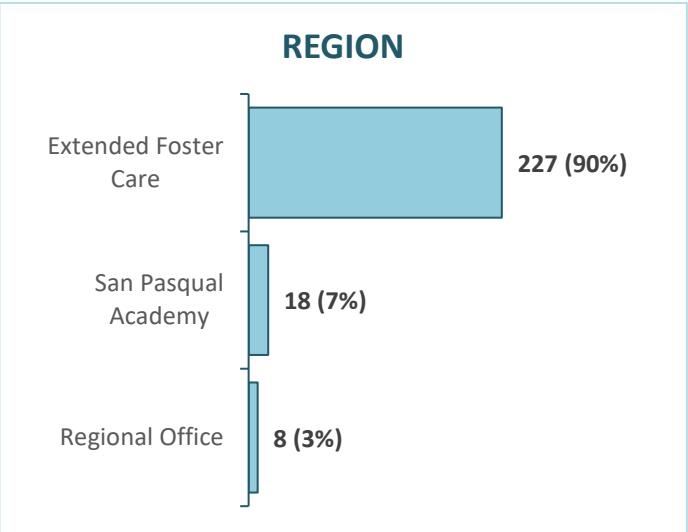
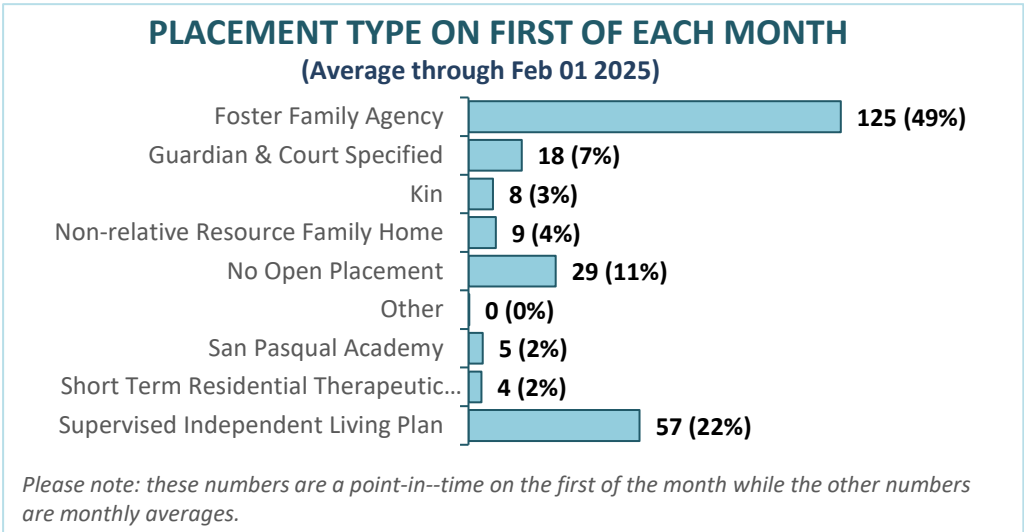
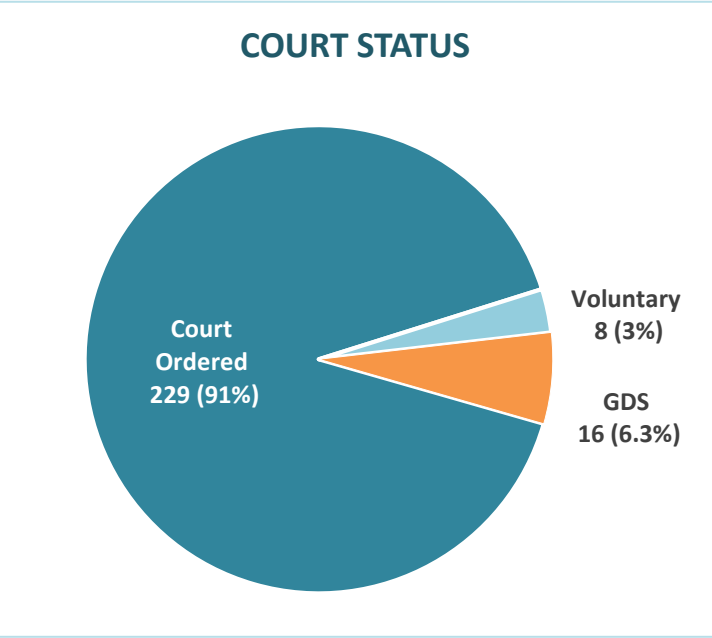
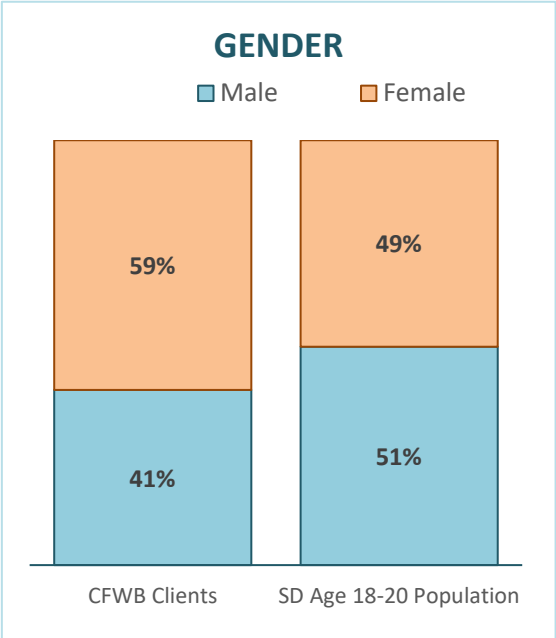
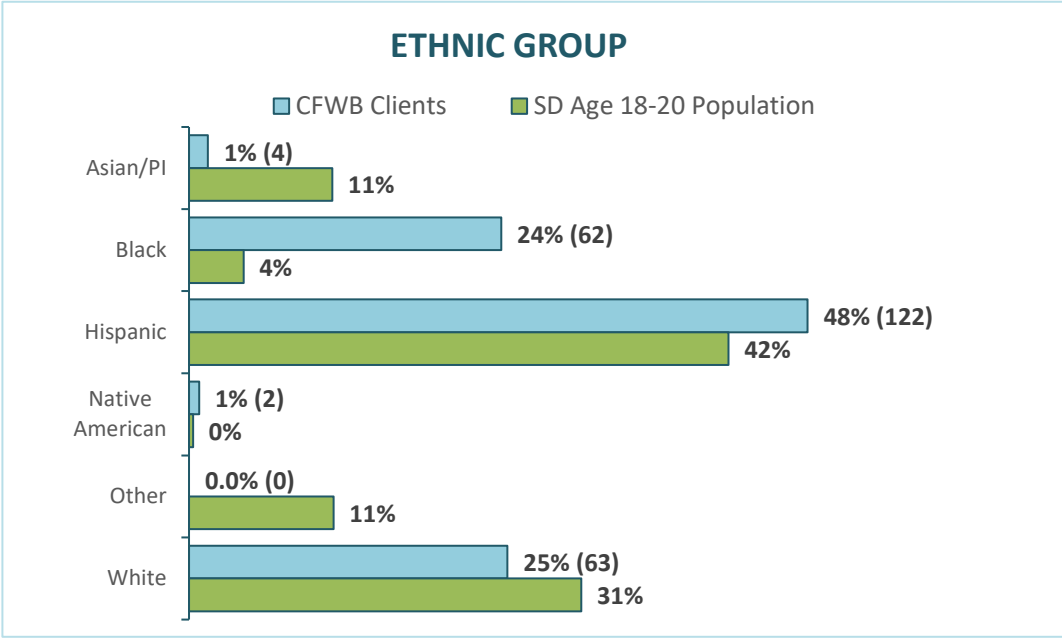
