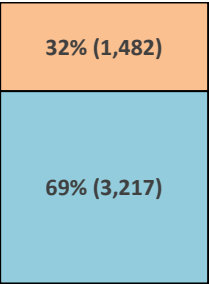

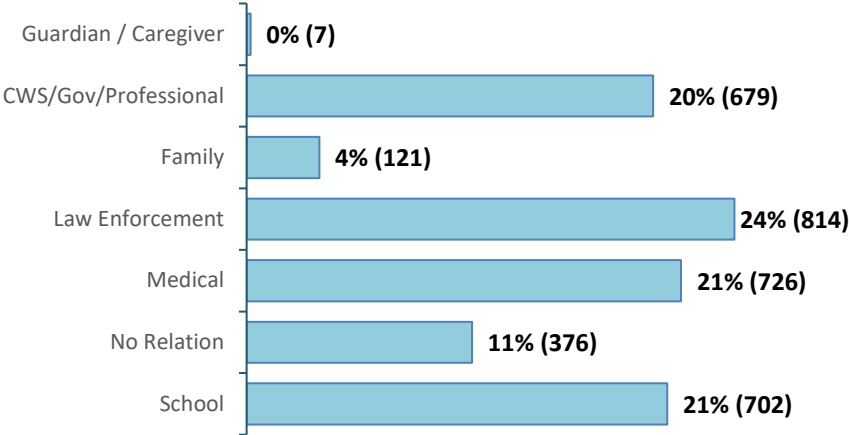

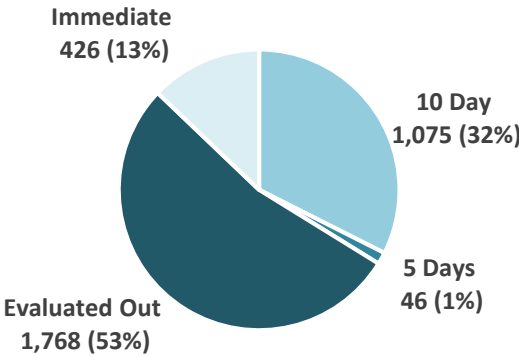

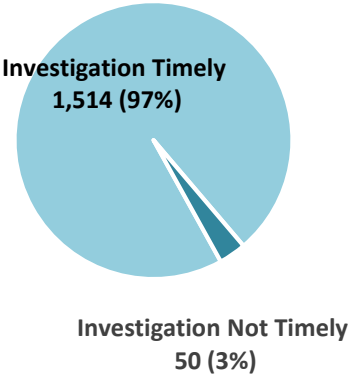

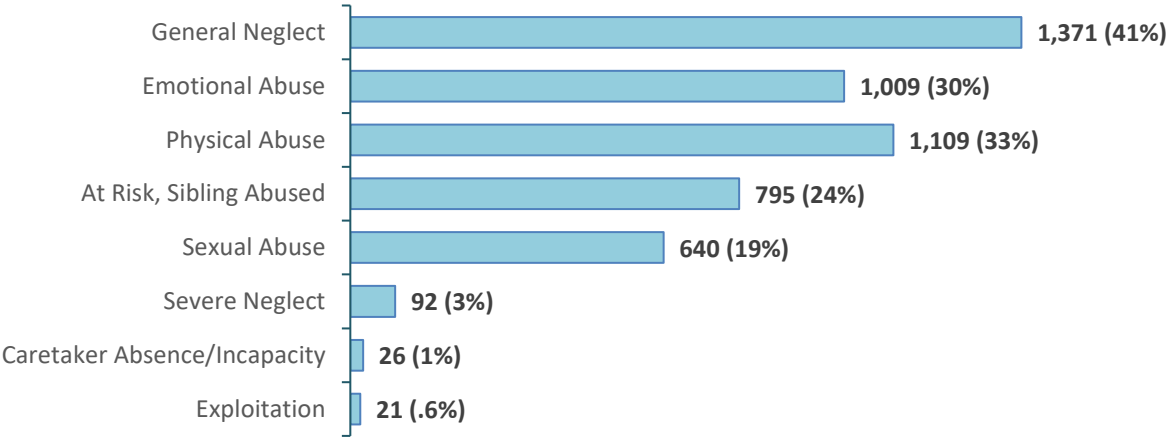
REFERRAL RESPONSE TYPE



TIMELINESS TO INVESTIGATION

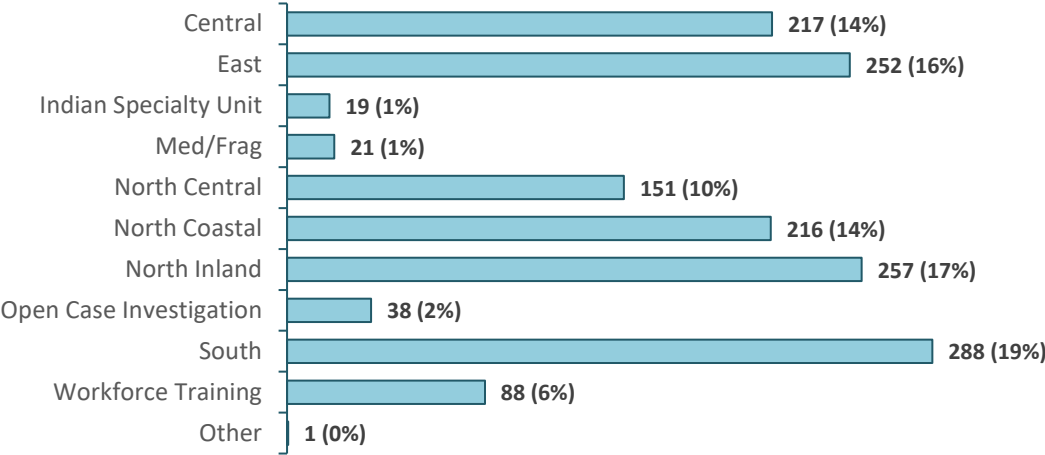


ALLEGATION TYPE

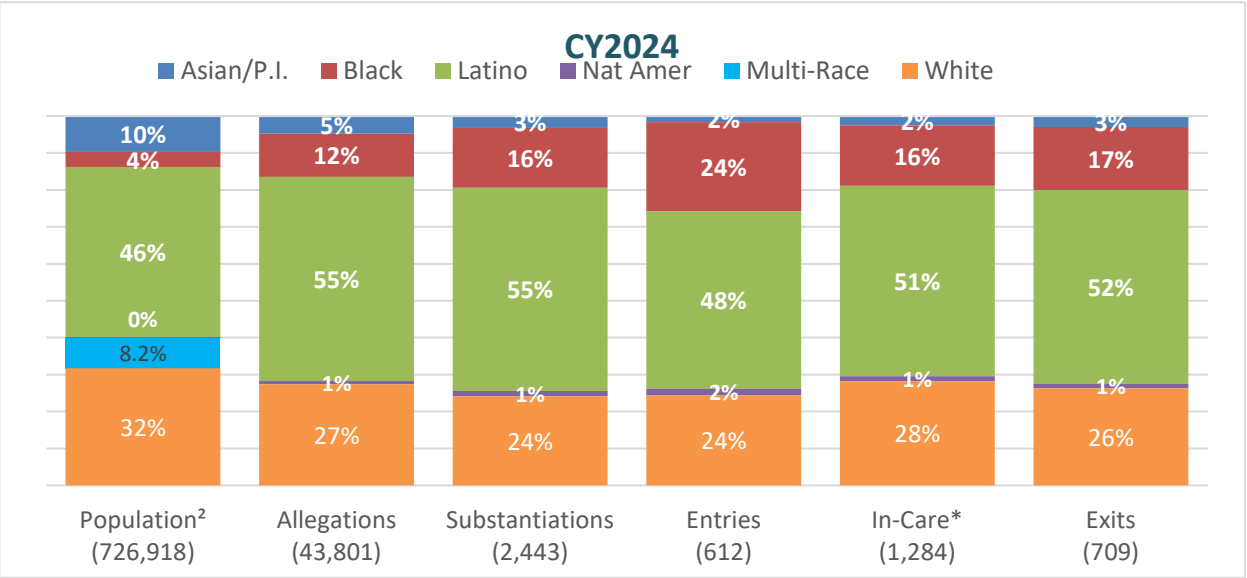

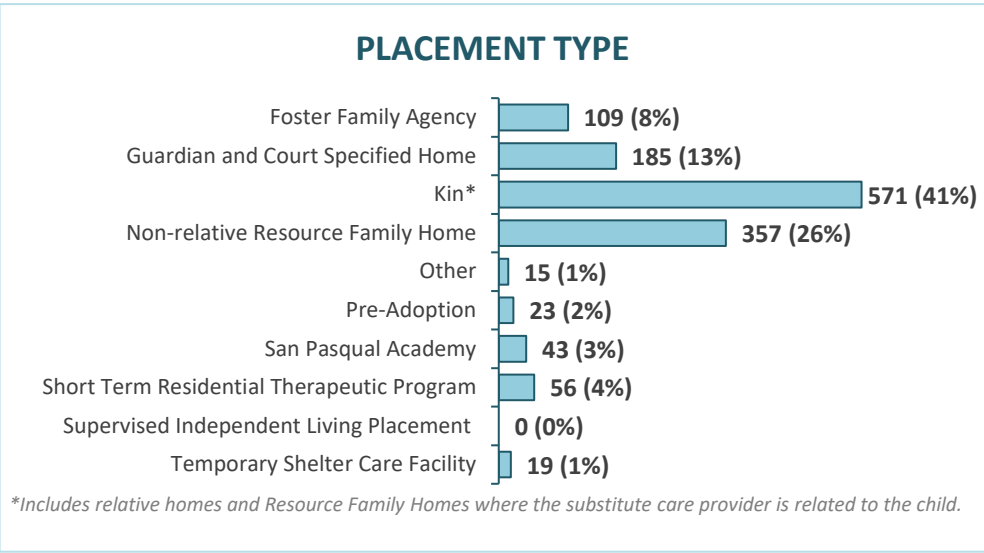
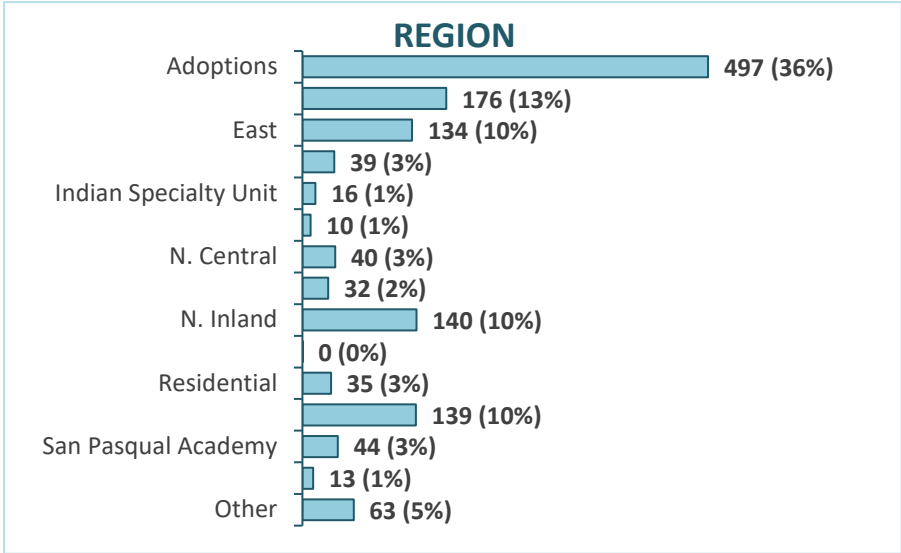
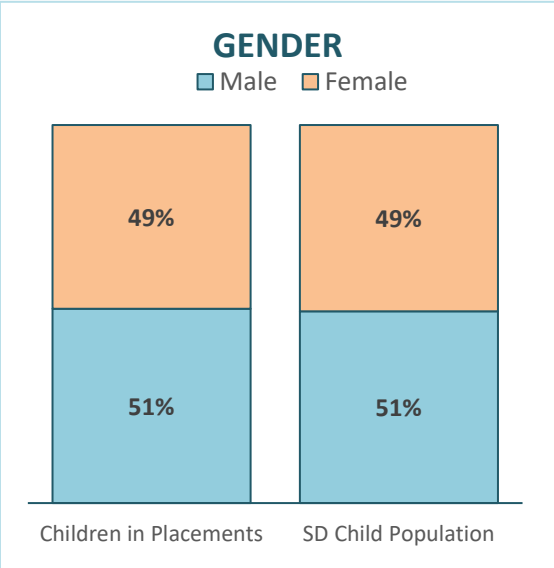
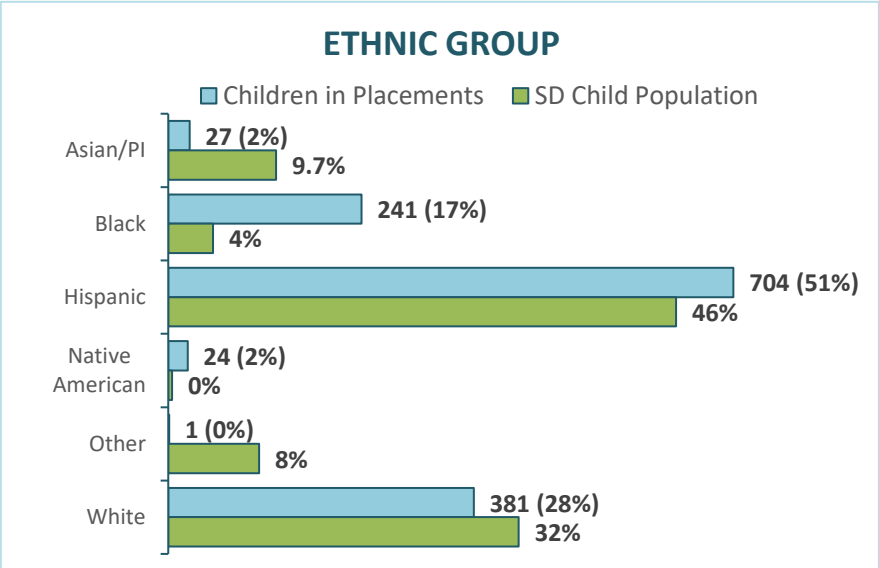
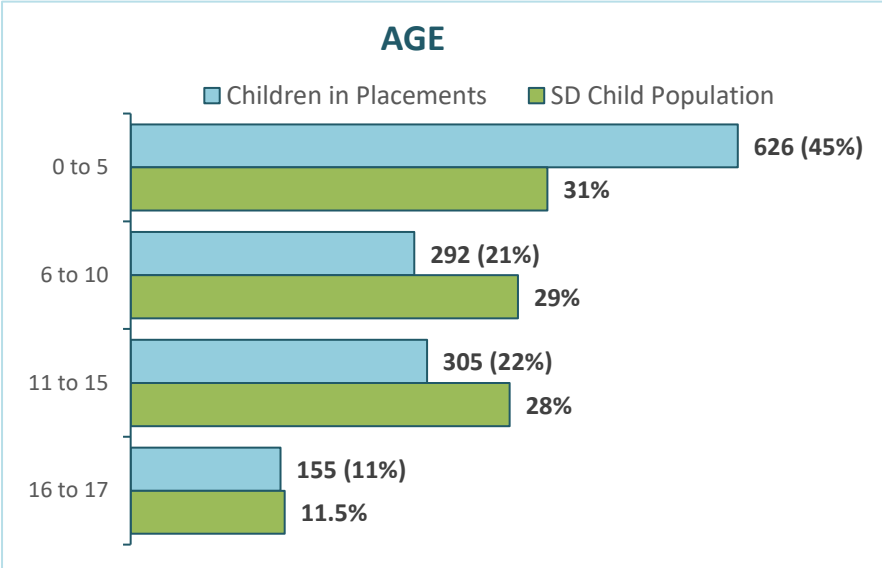


Placements (Age 0-17) - First of each month - Monthly Average of Fiscal Year to Date (July 2024 - Jun 2025)

Placements - Five counties with the highest child population comparison (On April 01, 2025)

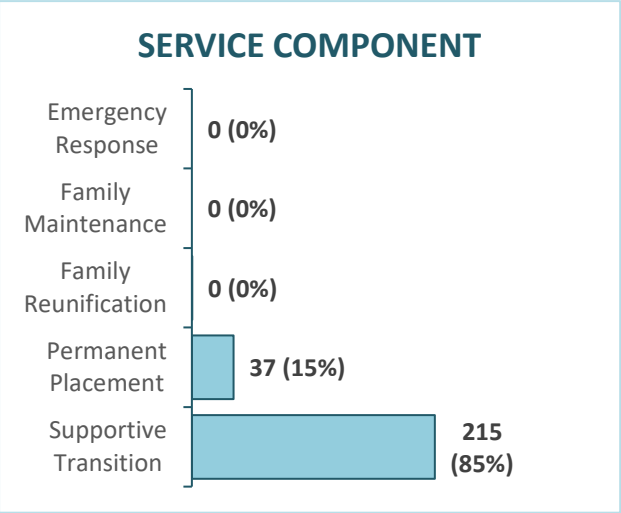
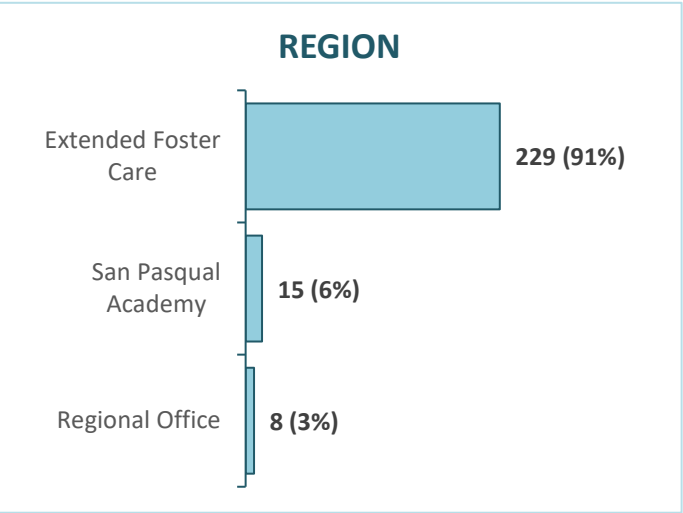
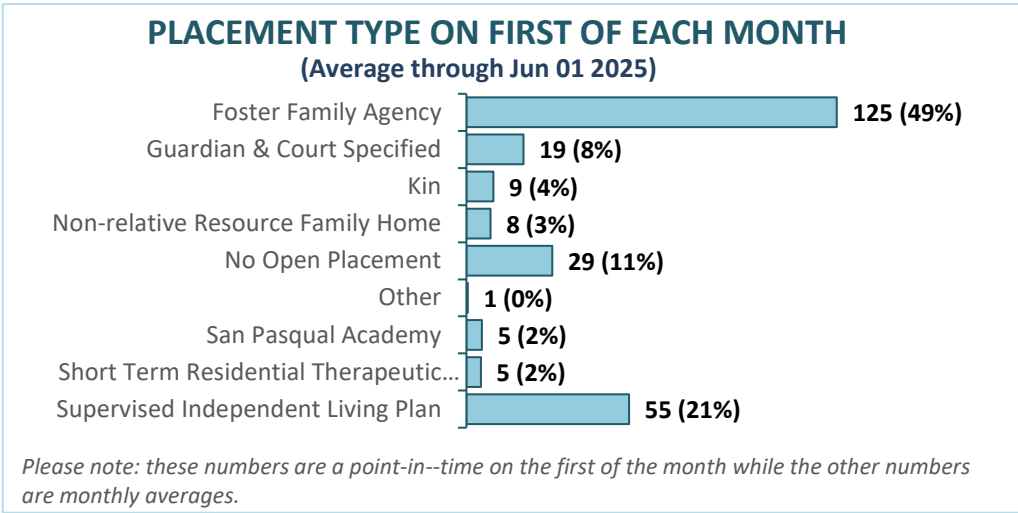
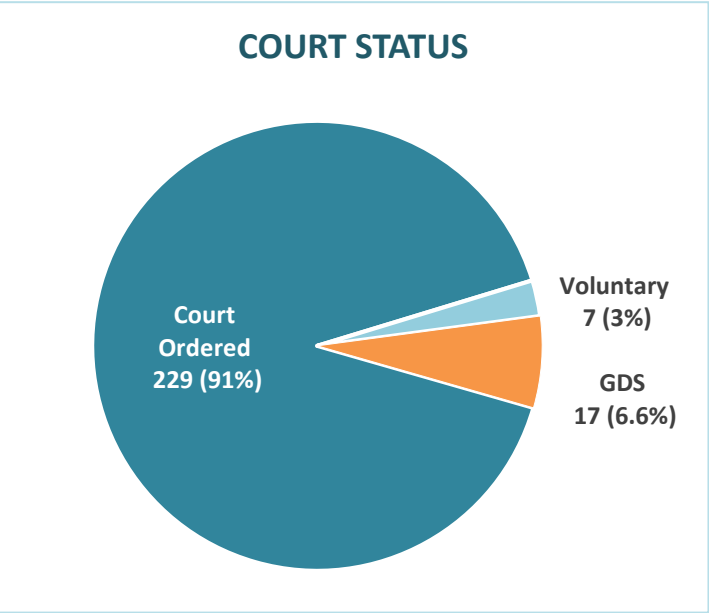
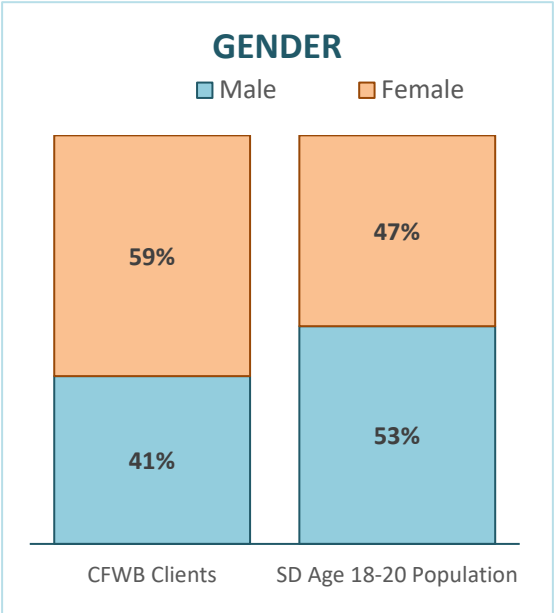
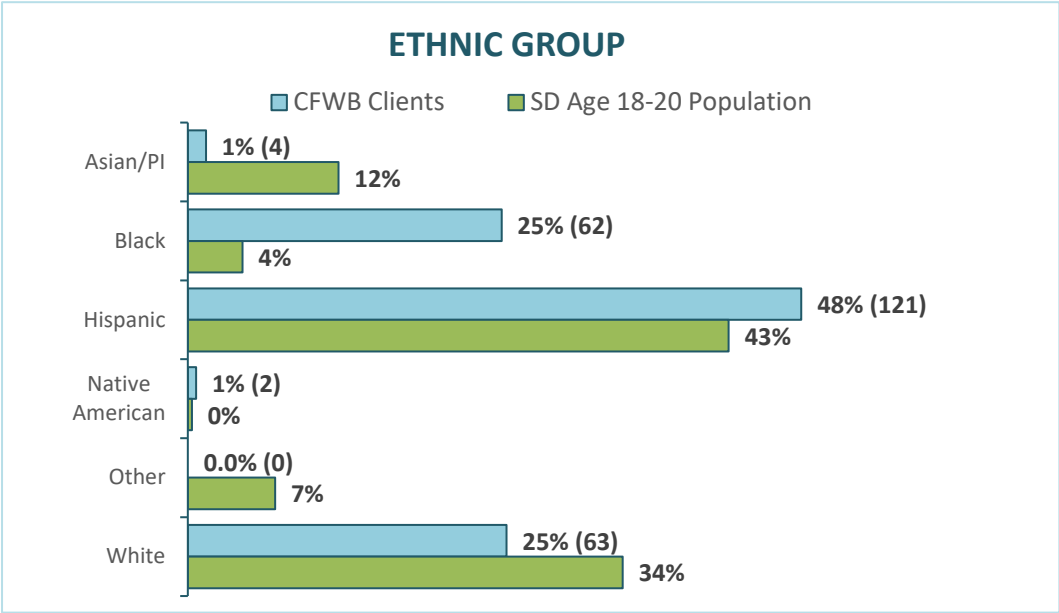


Extended Foster Care (Age 18-20) - Monthly Averages of Fiscal Year to Date (July 2024 - June 2025)
