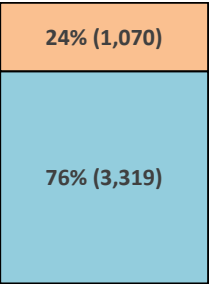

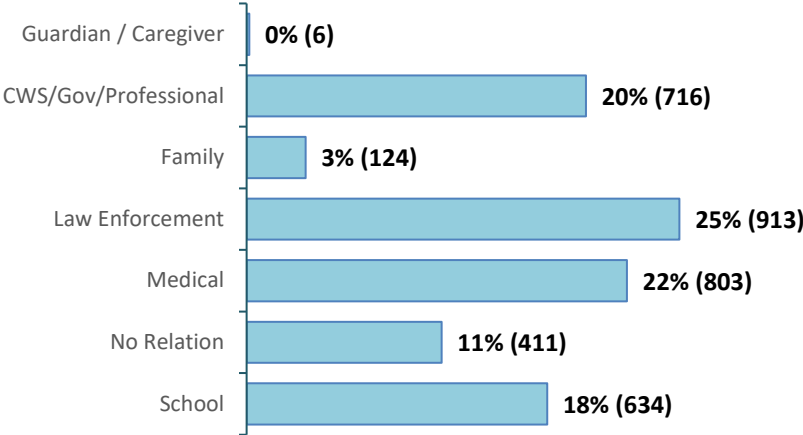

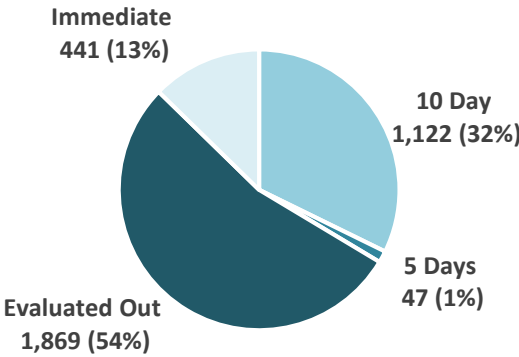

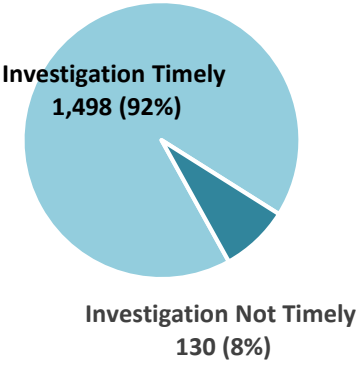

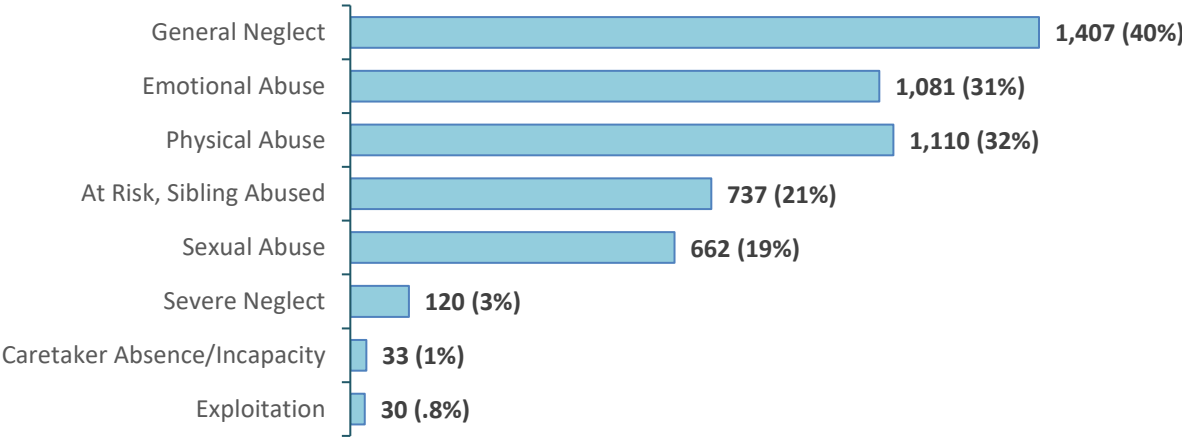
REFERRAL RESPONSE TYPE



TIMELINESS TO INVESTIGATION

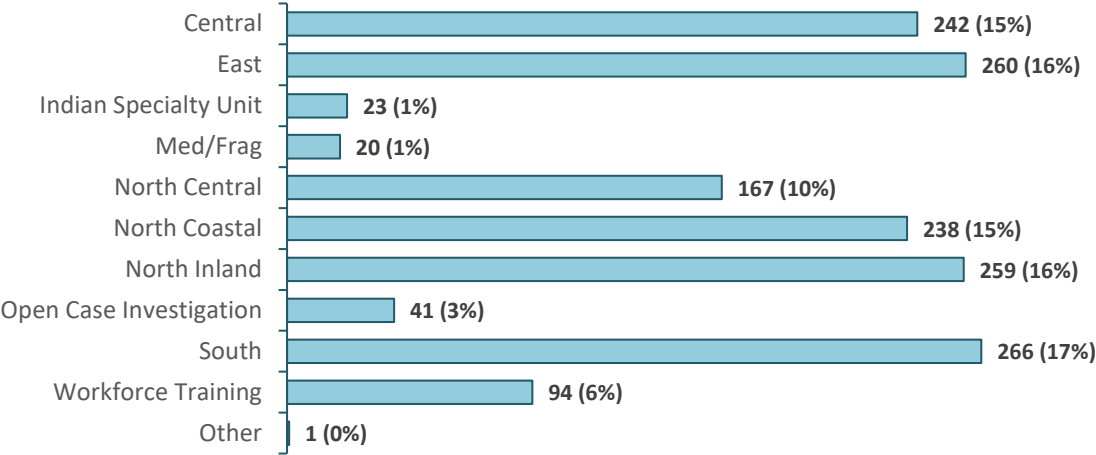


ALLEGATION TYPE

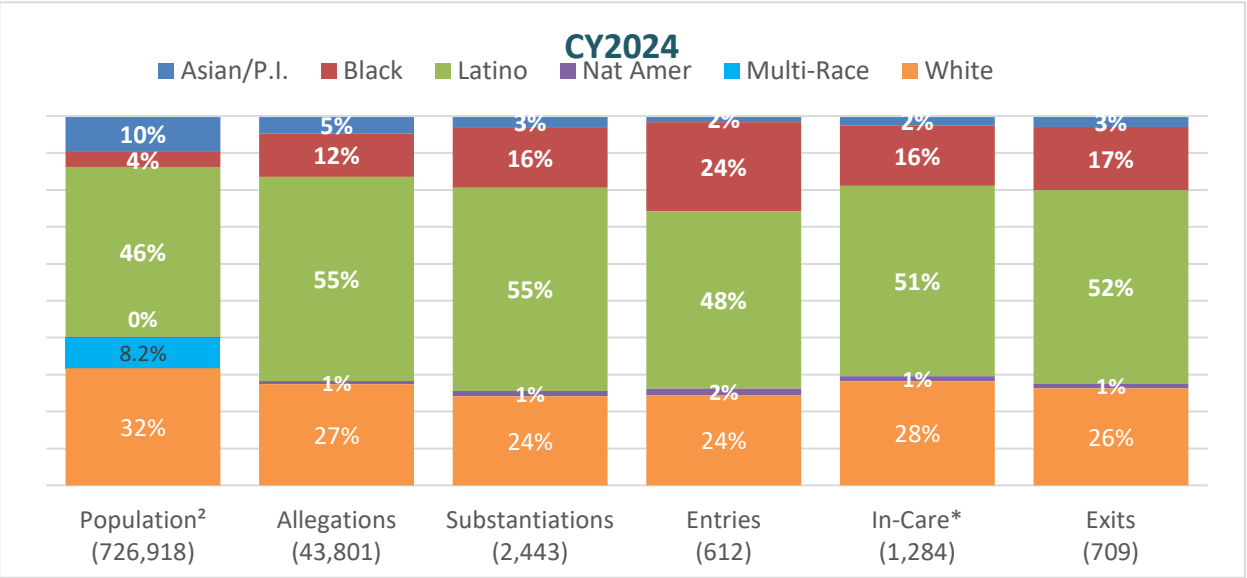

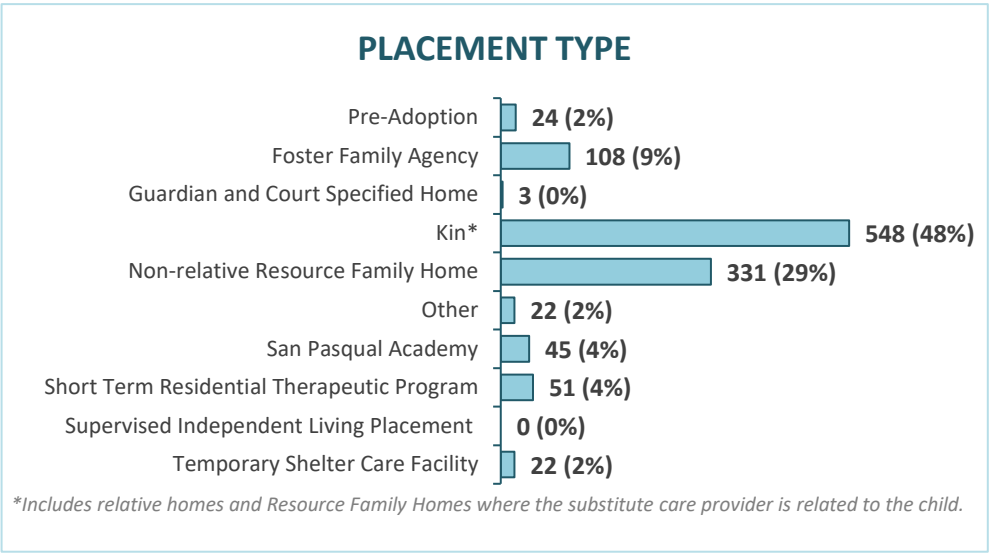
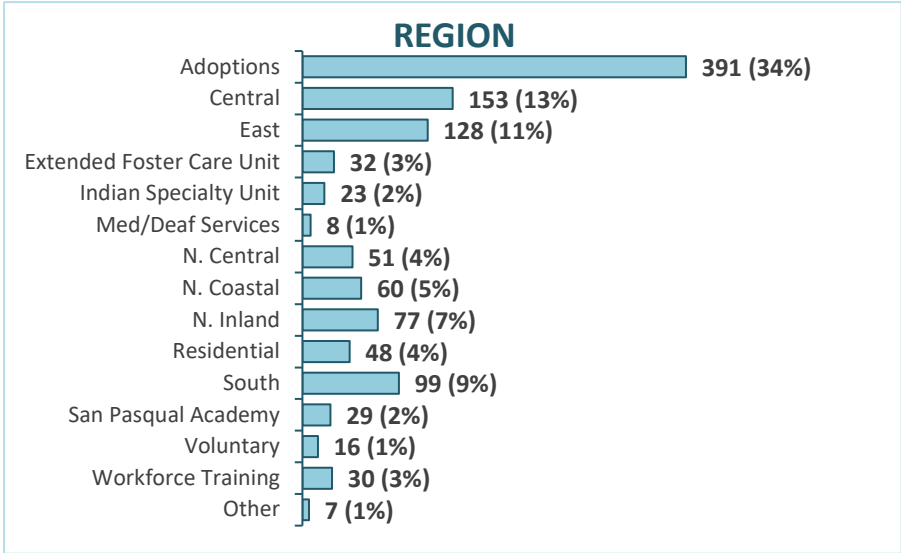
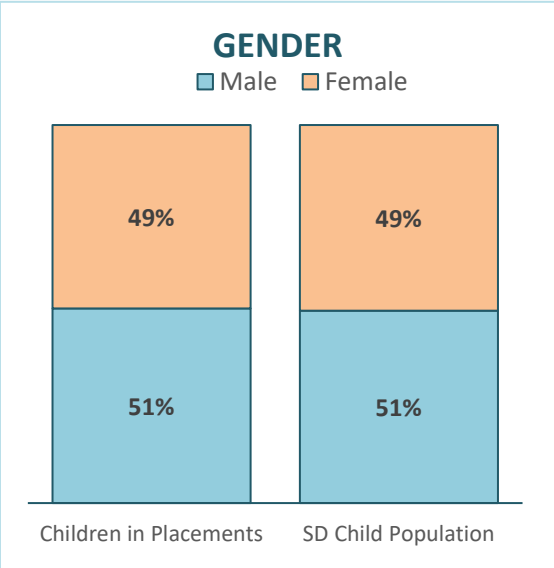
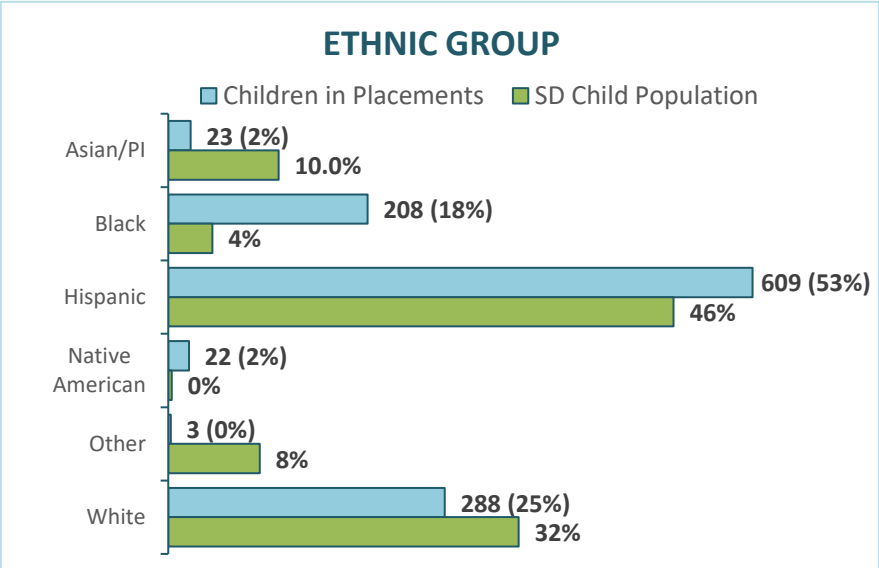
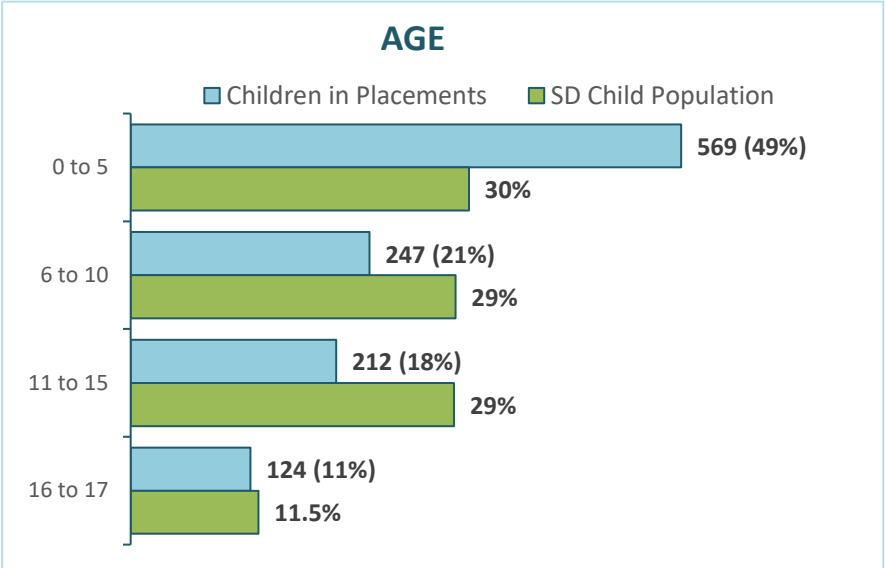


Placements (Age 0-17) - First of each month - Monthly Average of Fiscal Year to Date (July 2025 - Oct 2025)

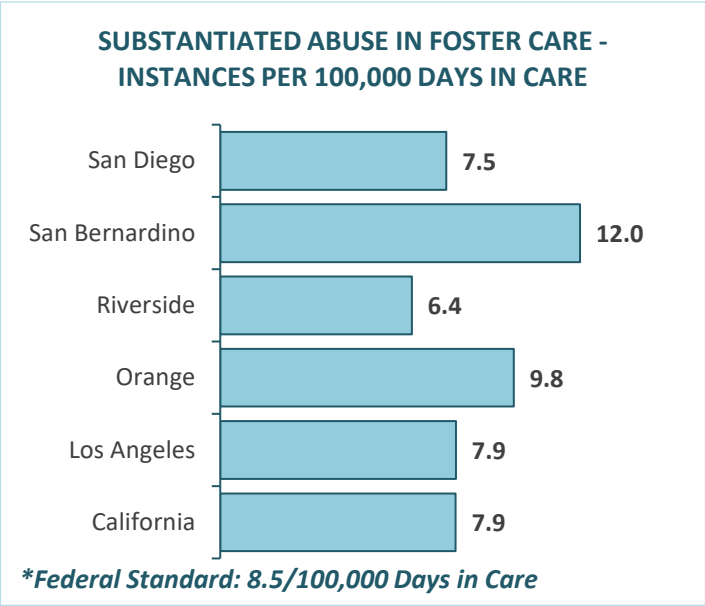
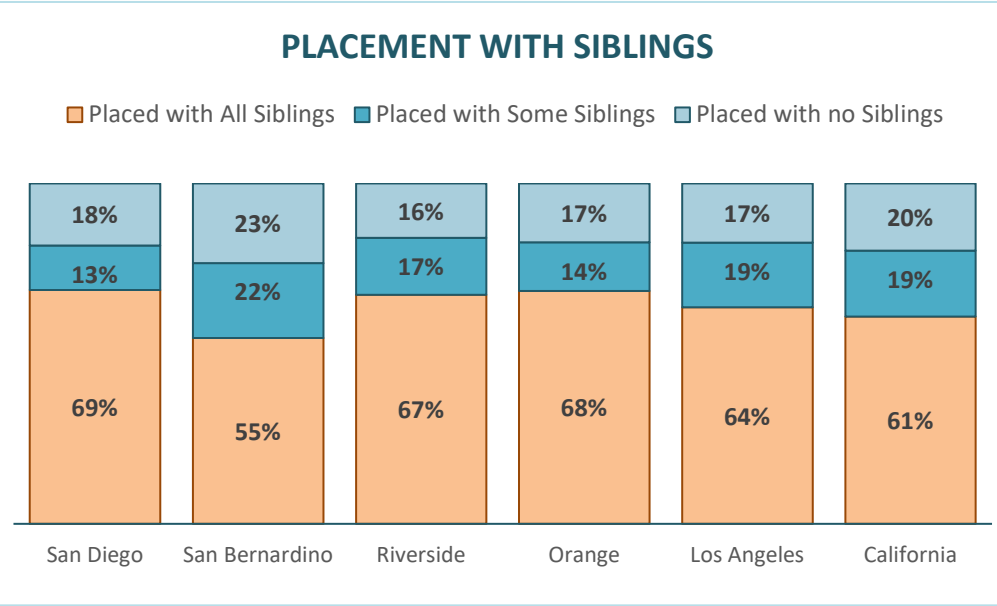
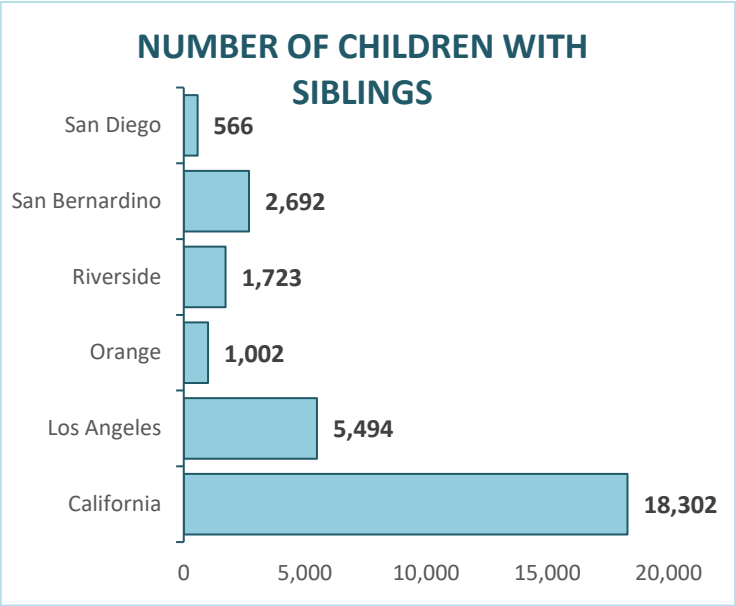
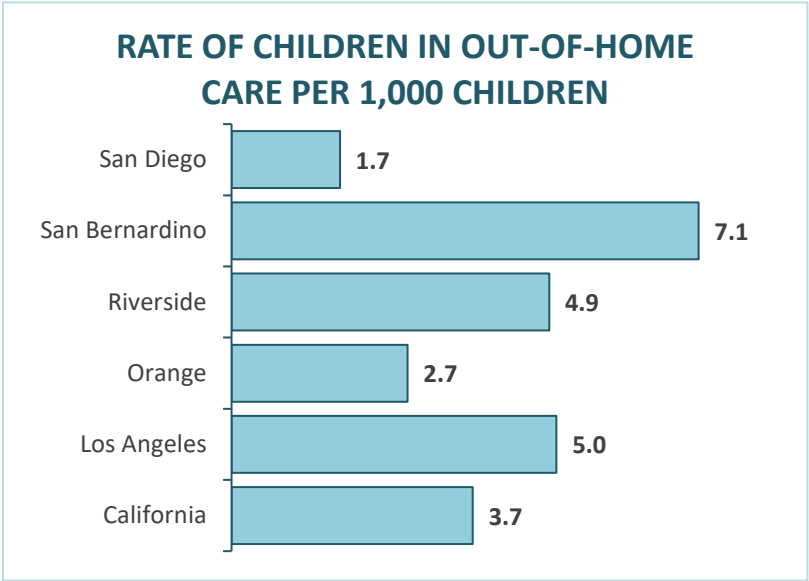
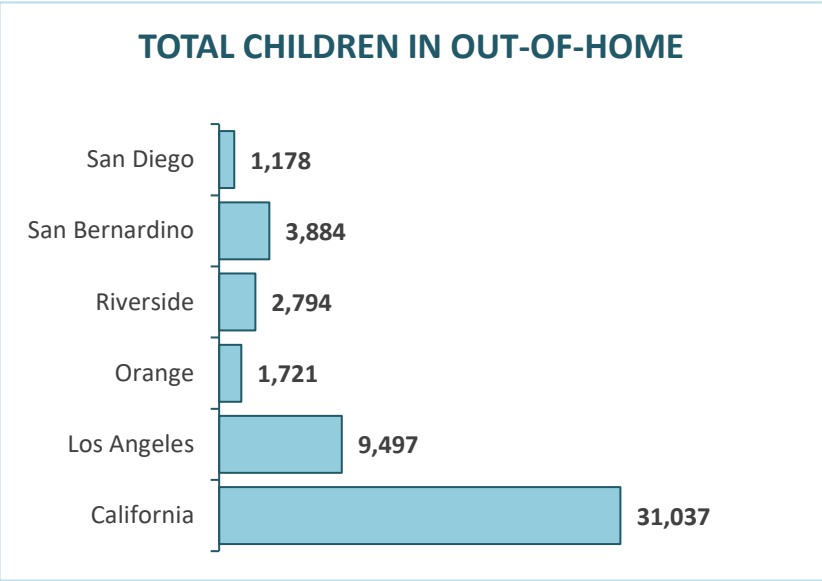
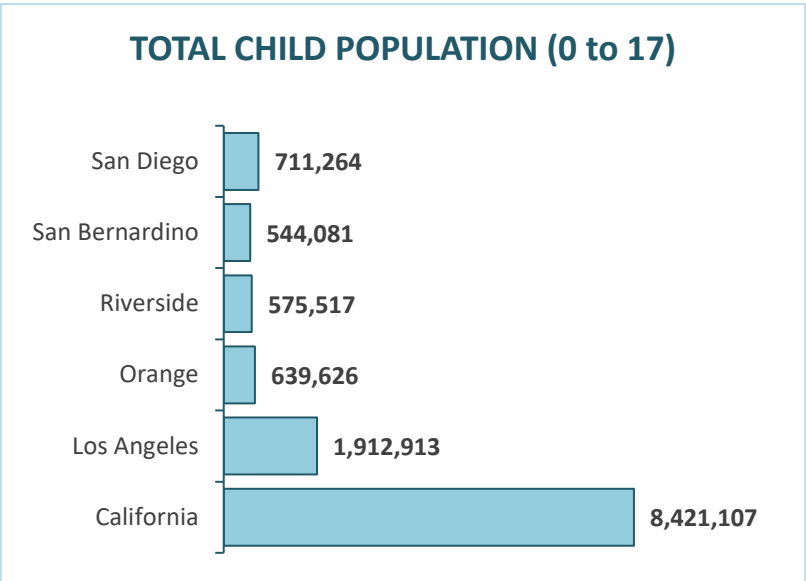
RATE OF SUBSTANTIATED ABUSE IN FOSTER CARE JUL2024-JUN2025

Placements - Five counties with the highest child population comparison (On July 01, 2025)

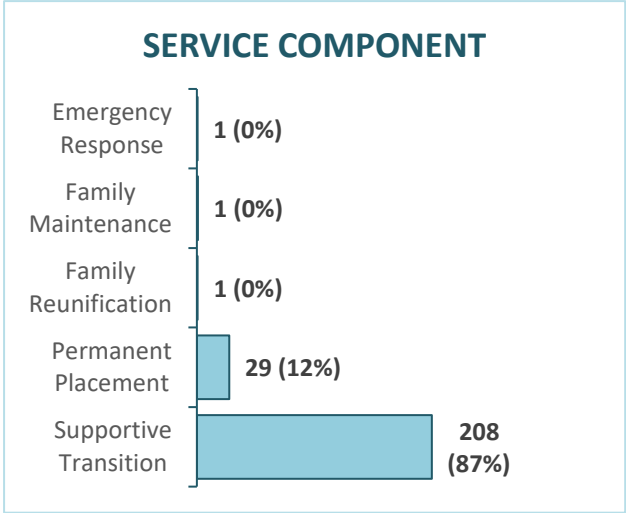
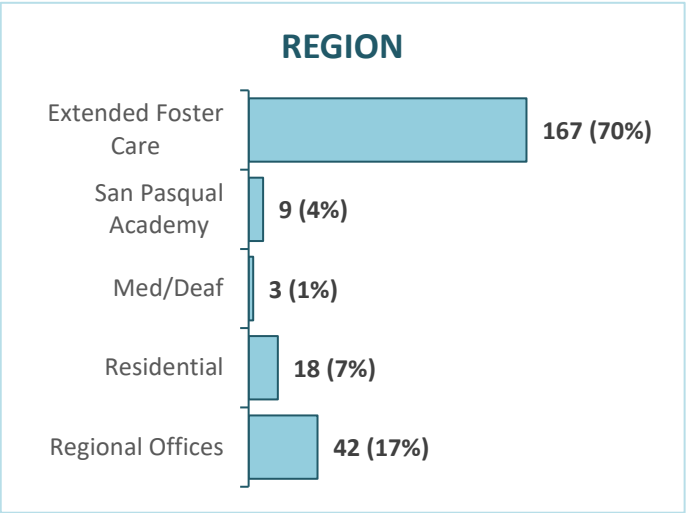
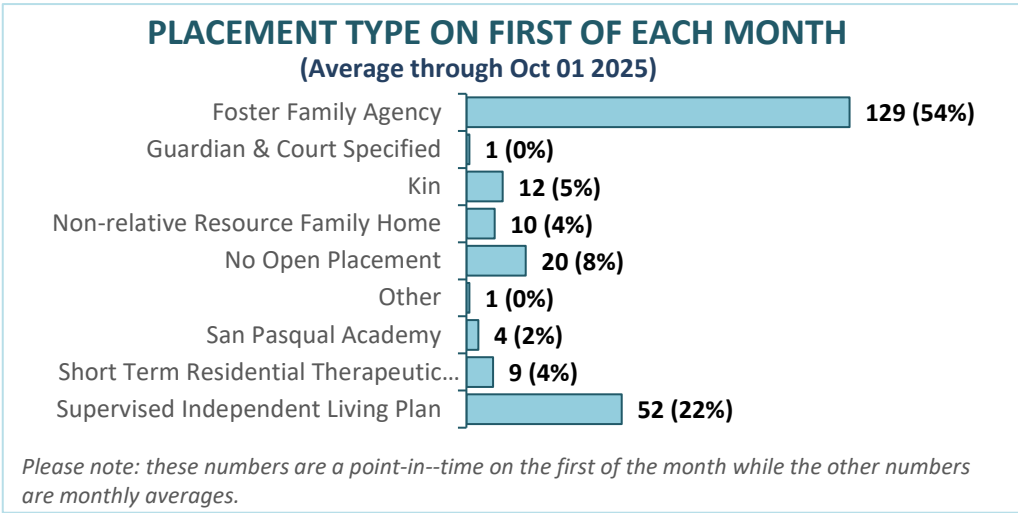
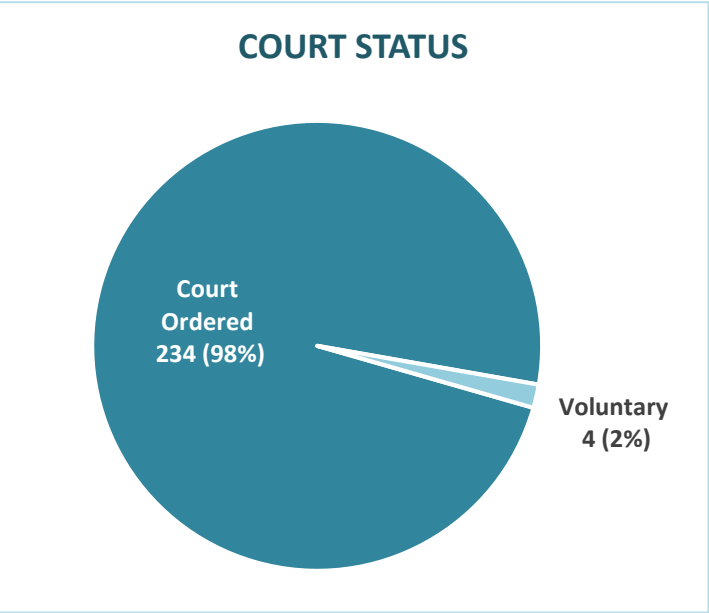
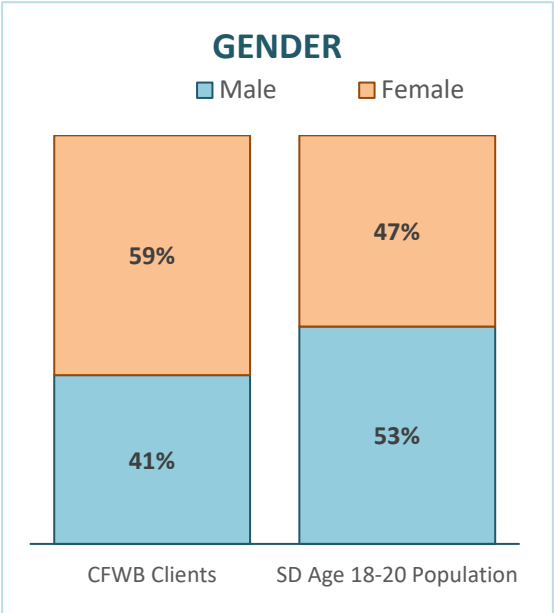
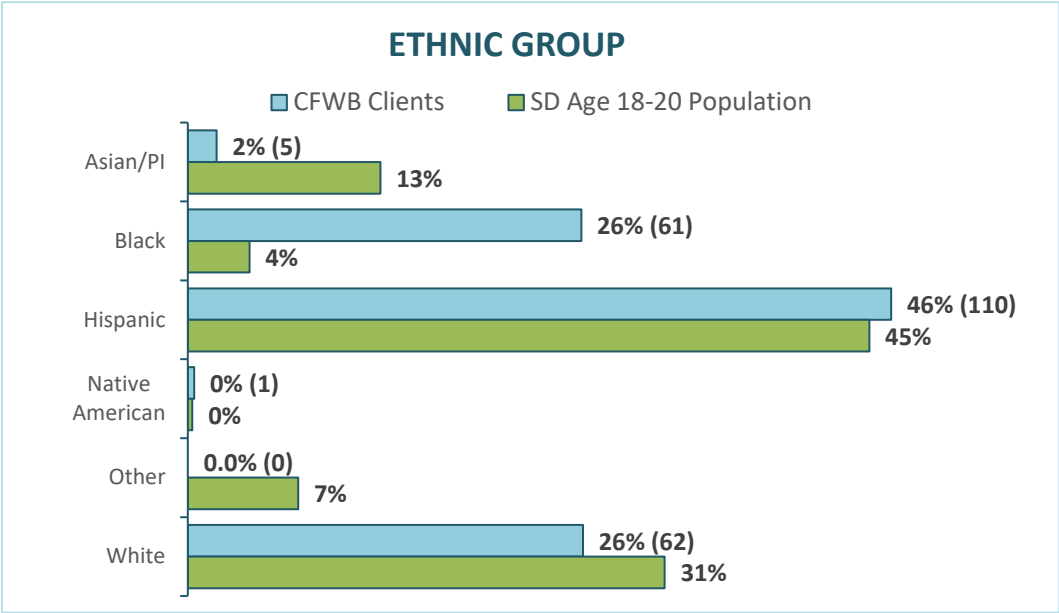


Extended Foster Care (Age 18-20) - Monthly Averages of Fiscal Year to Date (July 2025 - October 2025)
