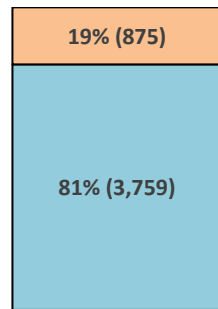

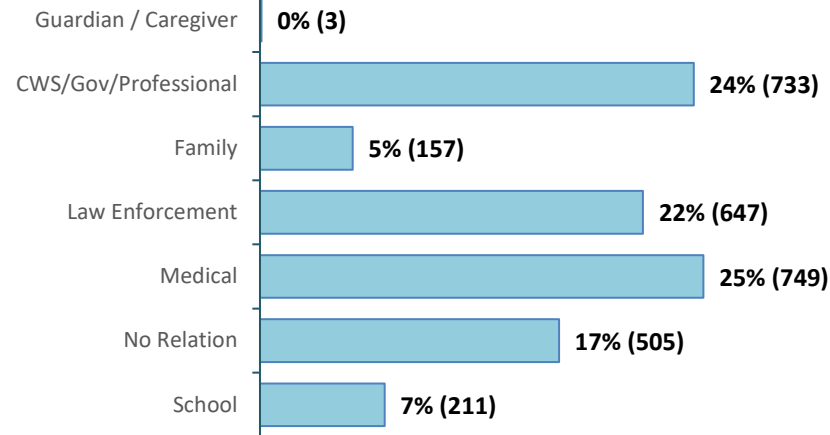

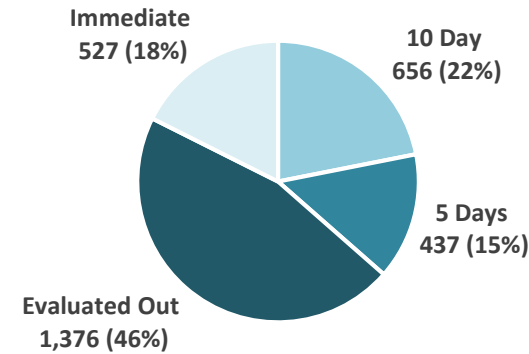

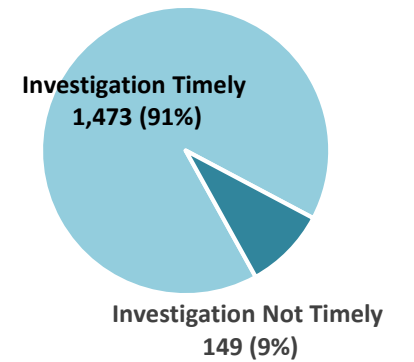

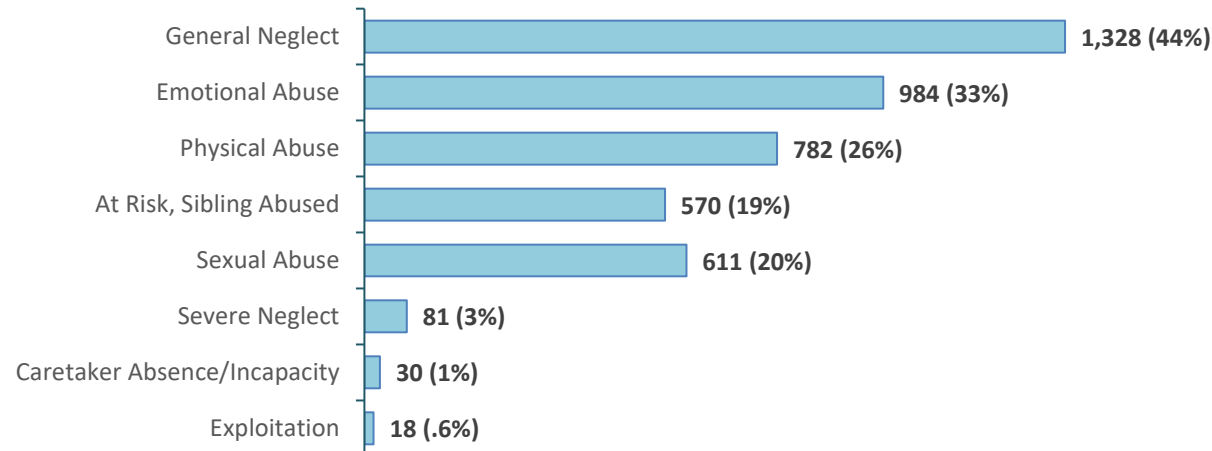
REFERRAL RESPONSE TYPE



TIMELINESS TO INVESTIGATION

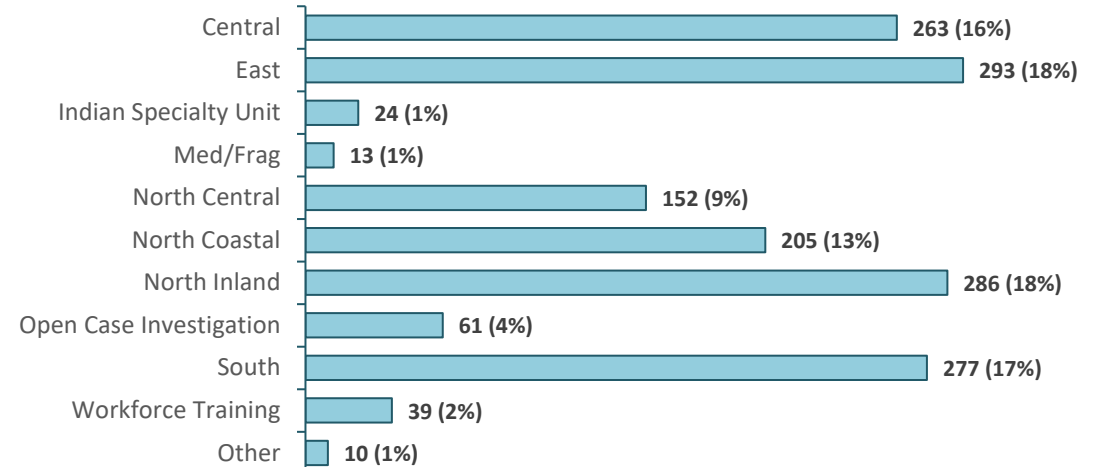


ALLEGATION TYPE

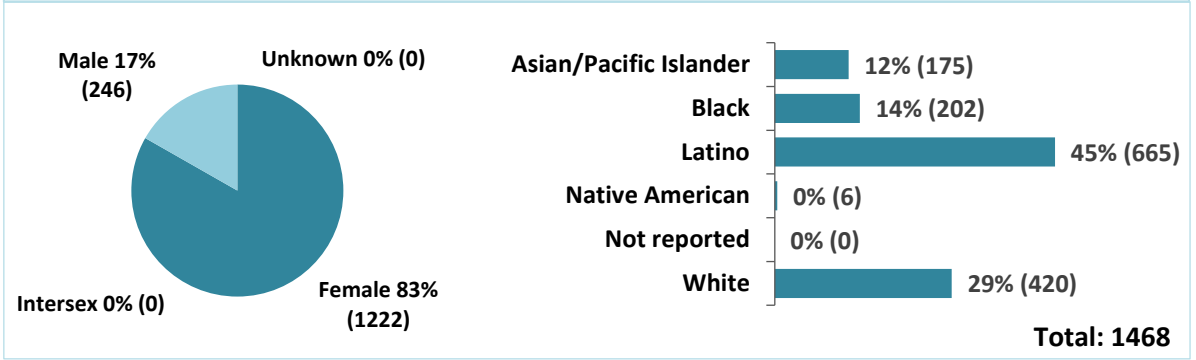

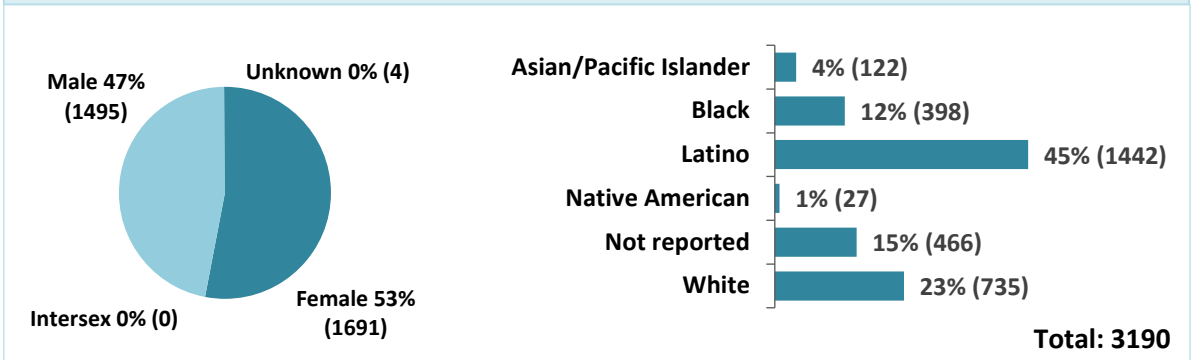

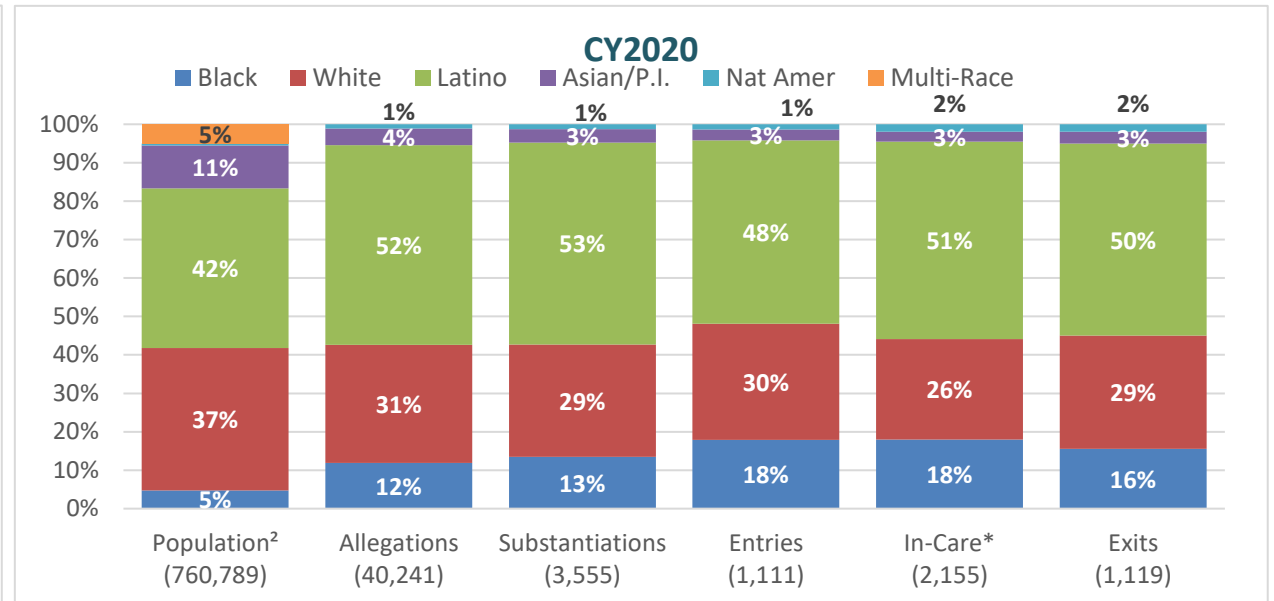
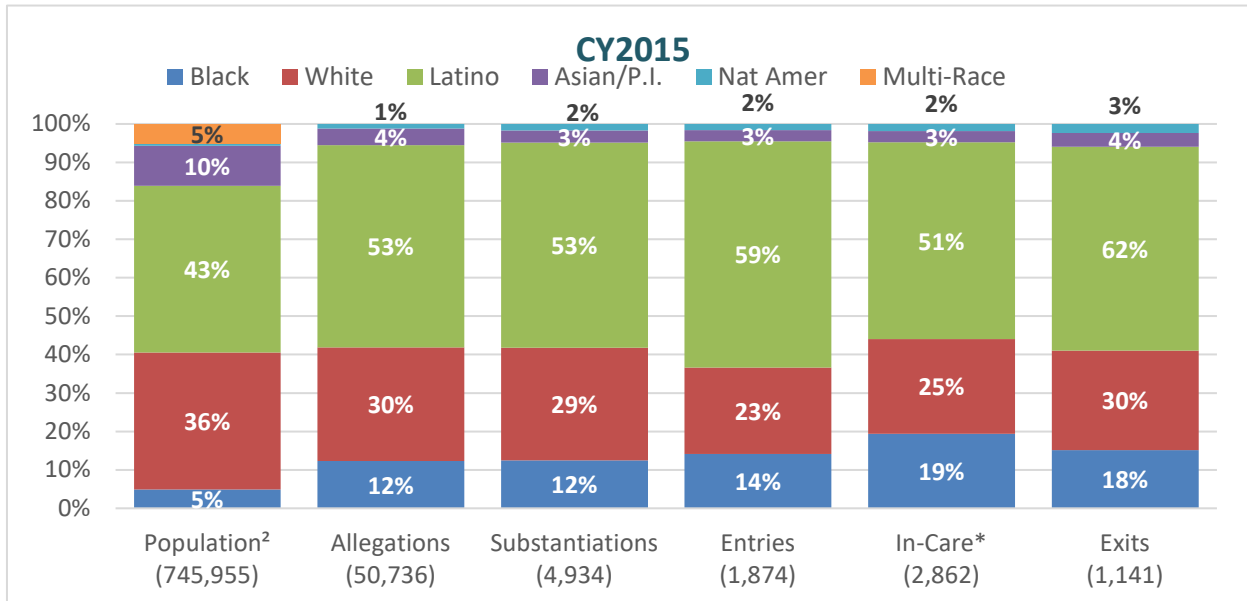
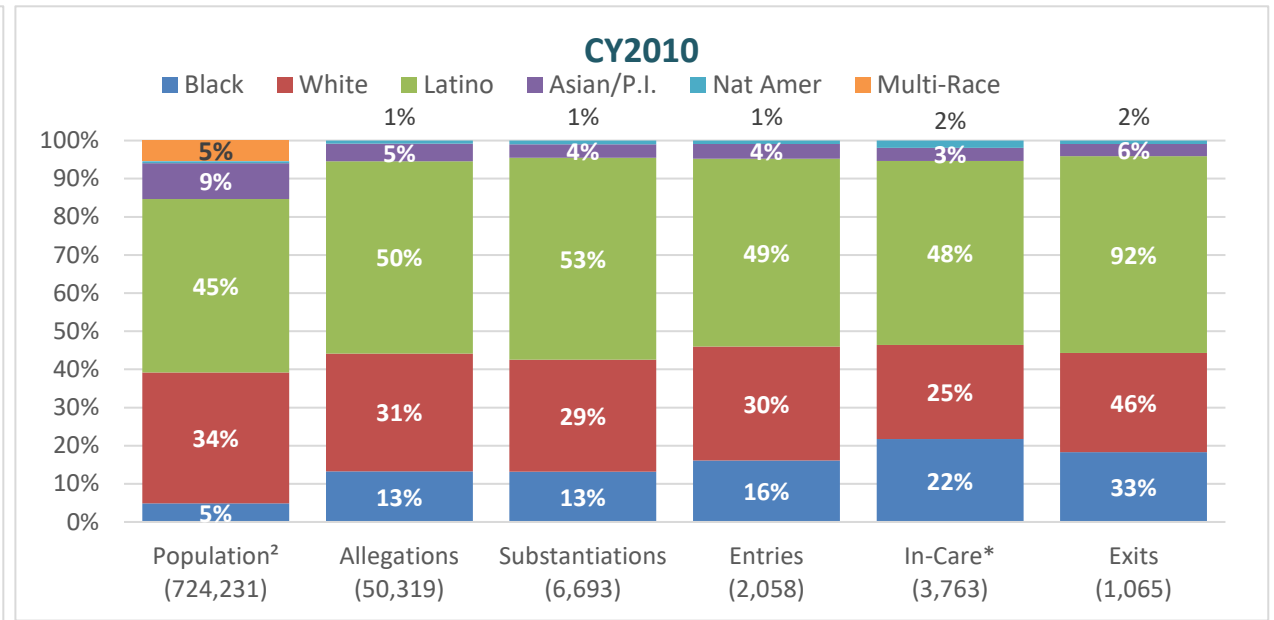
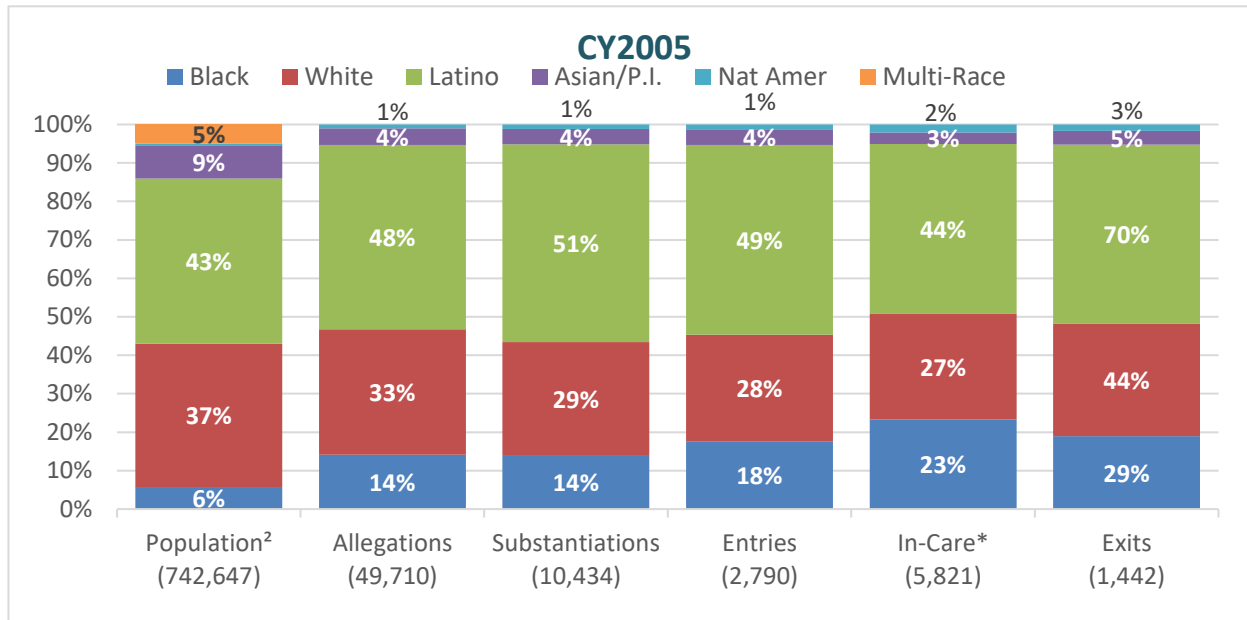
Children (age 0-17) in Investigated Referrals (August 2021)

Ethnicity and Path through Child Welfare Services ¹



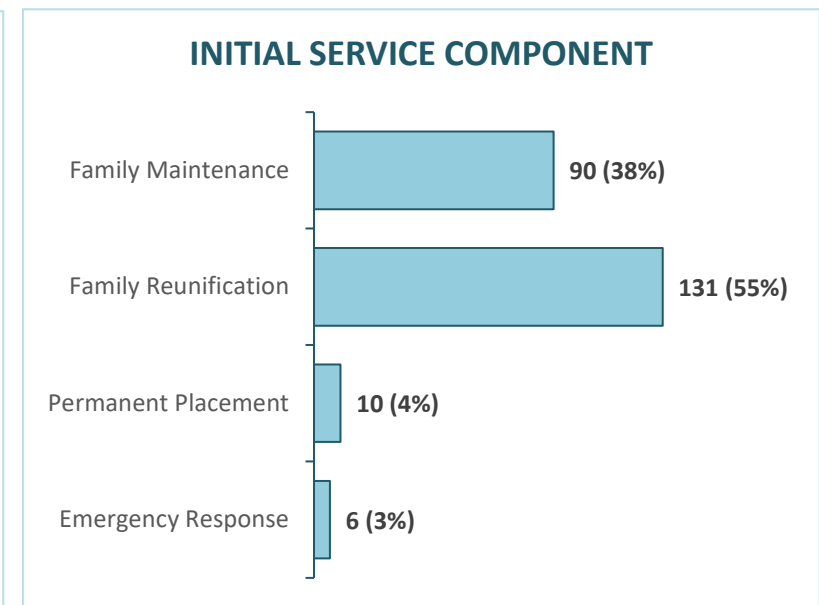
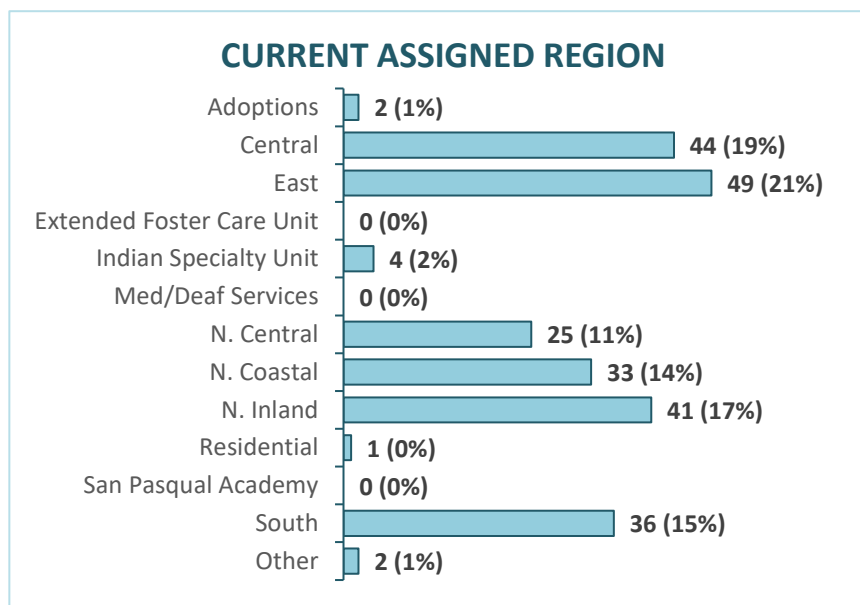
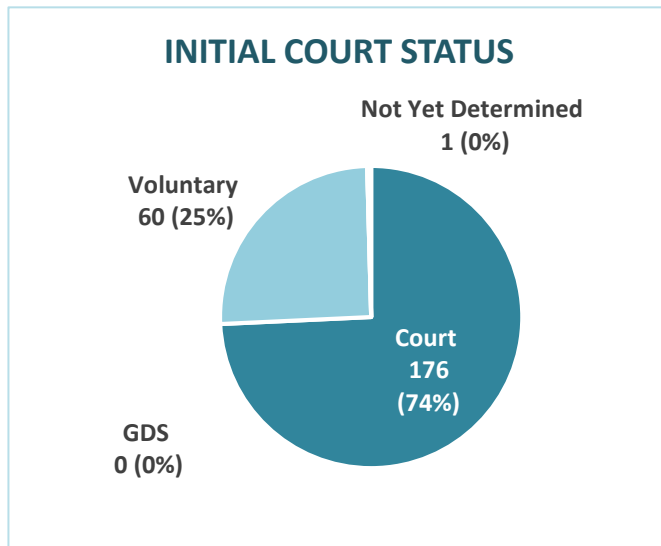
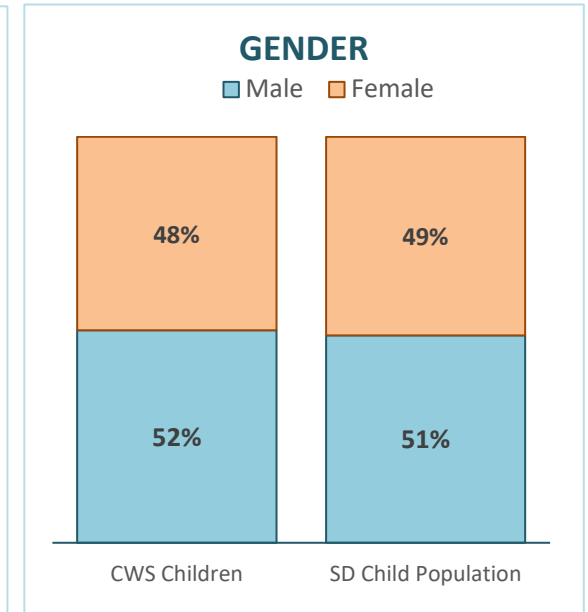
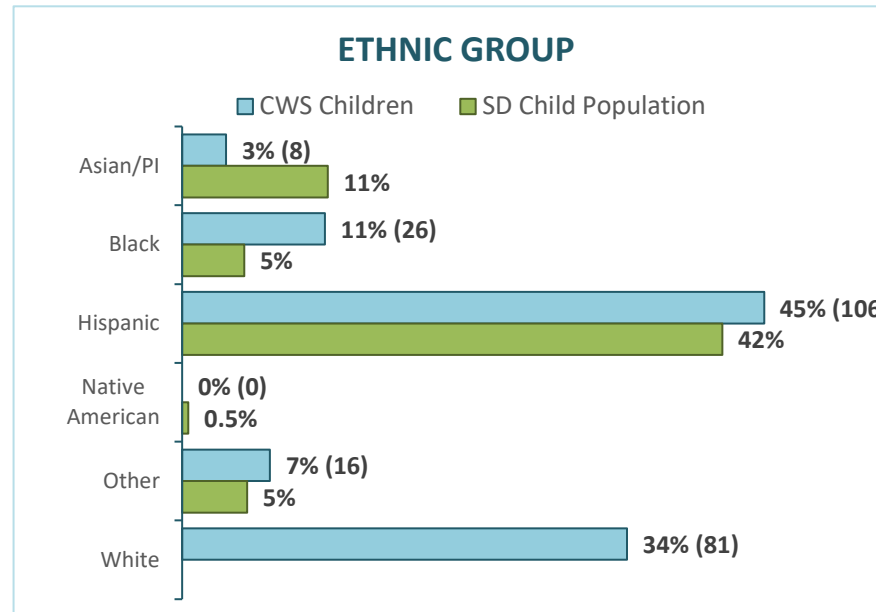
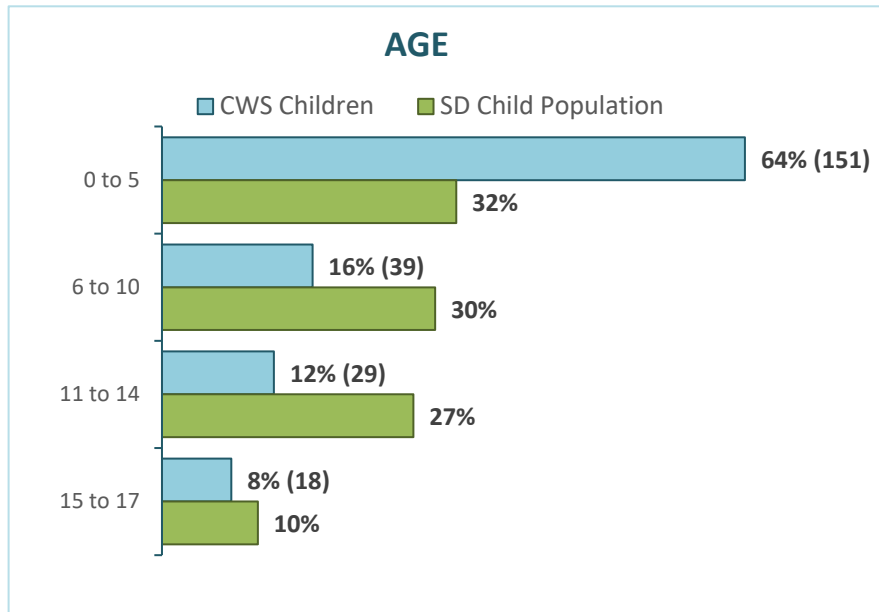

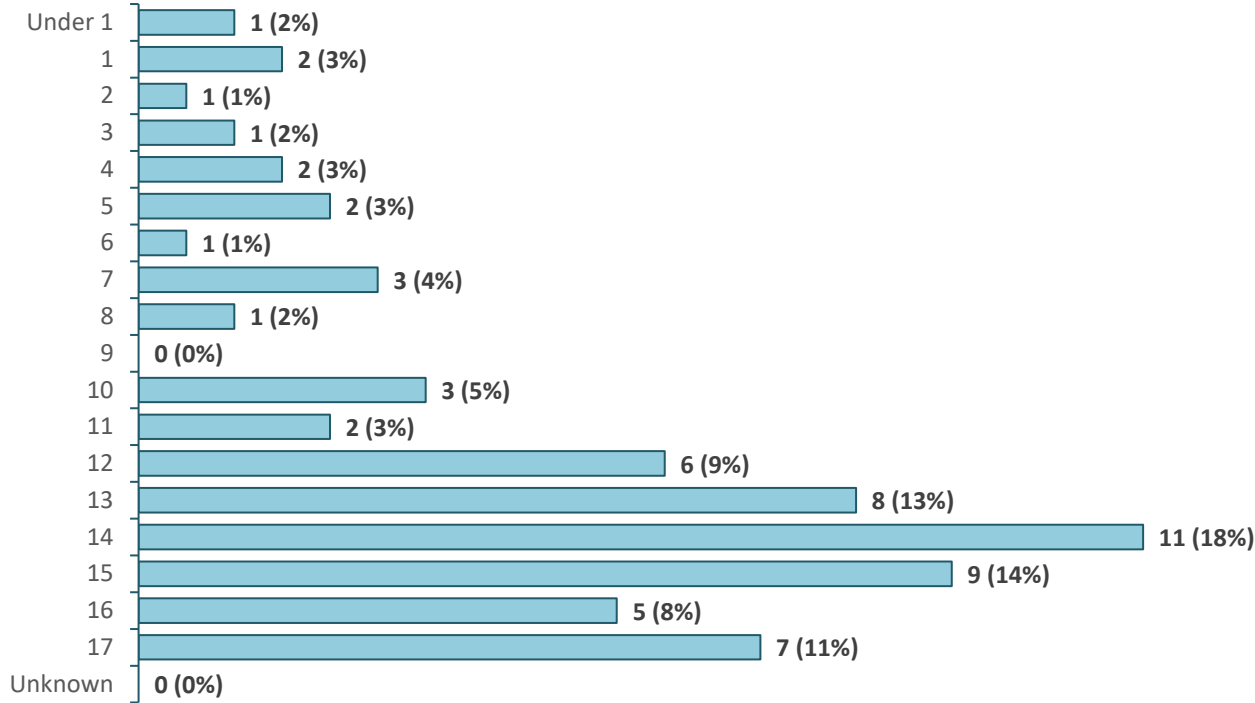

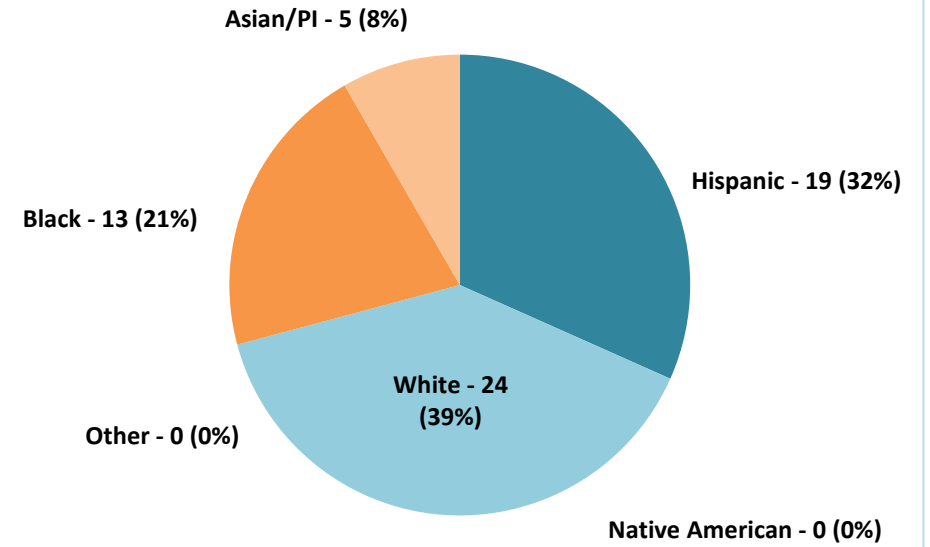

Clients at Polinsky Children's Center by Age (Monthly Average)



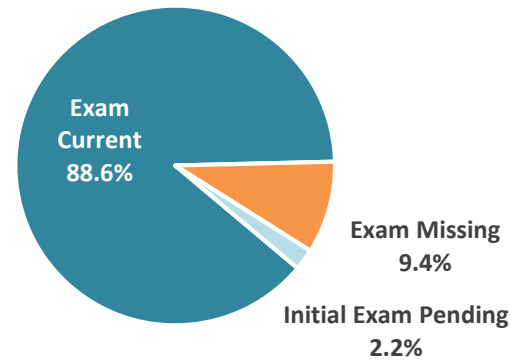
Clients at Polinsky Children's Center by Ethnicity (Monthly Average)



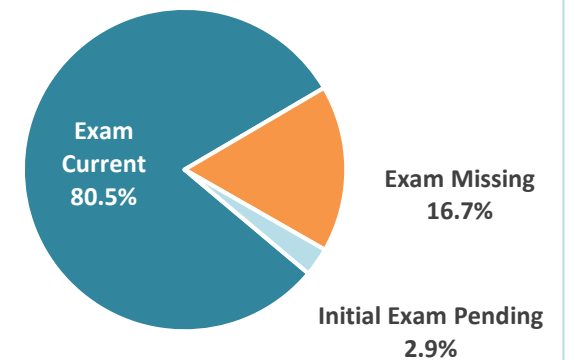

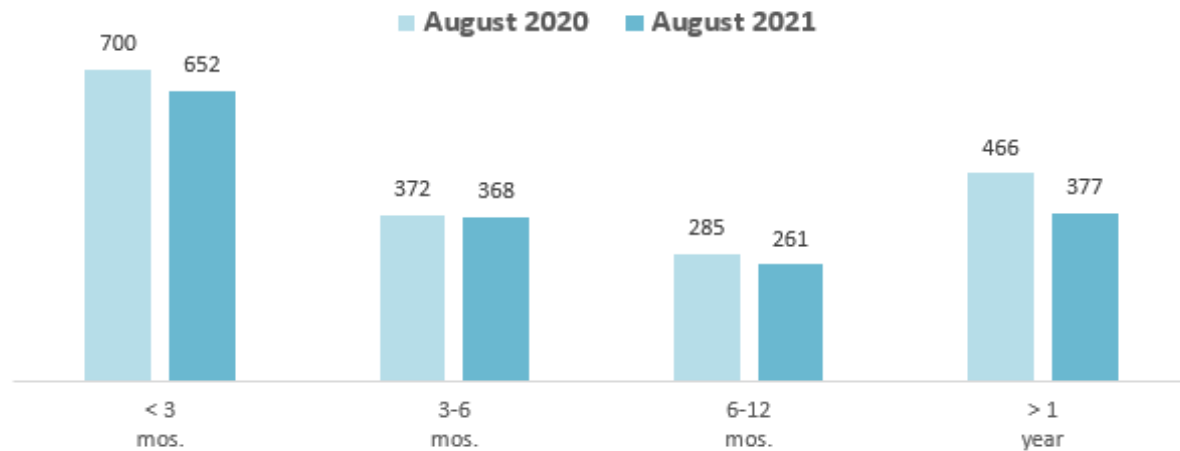

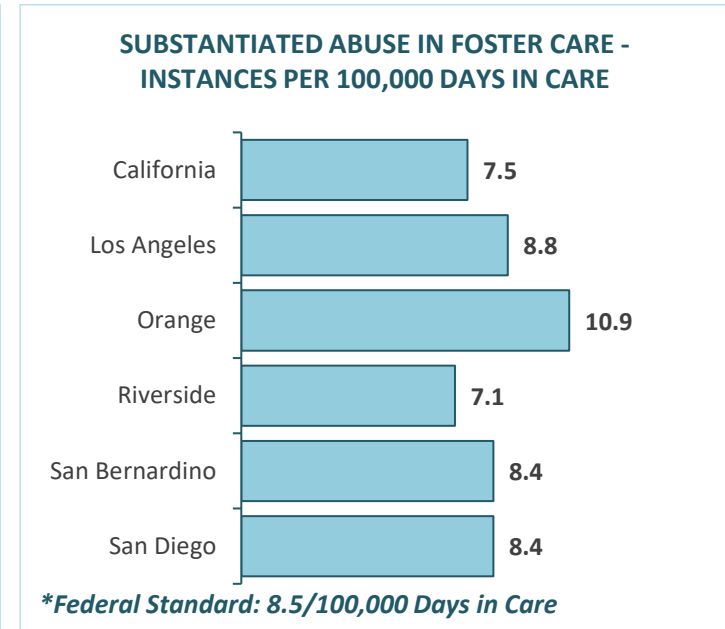
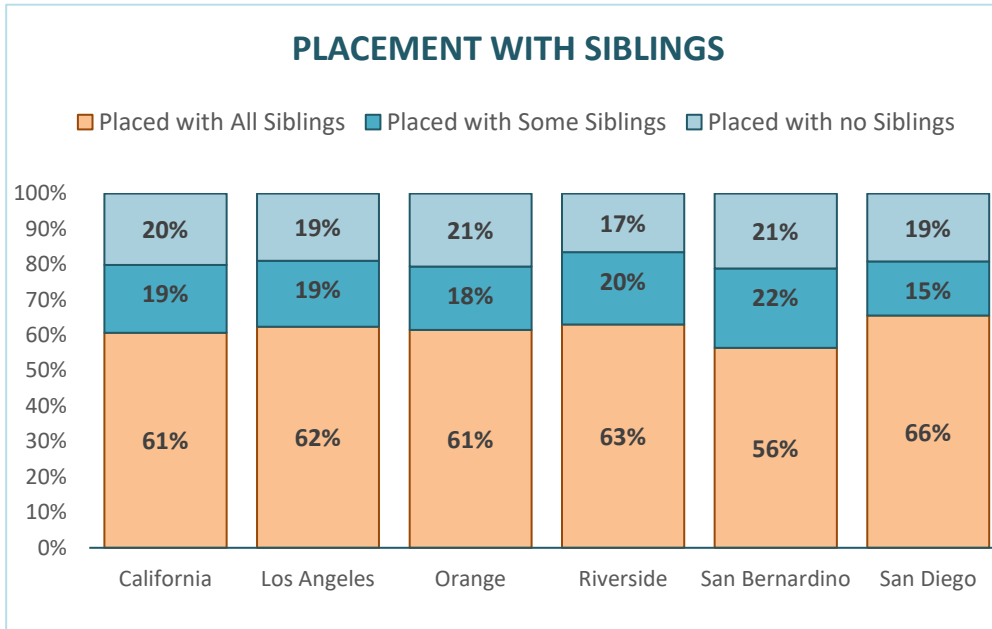
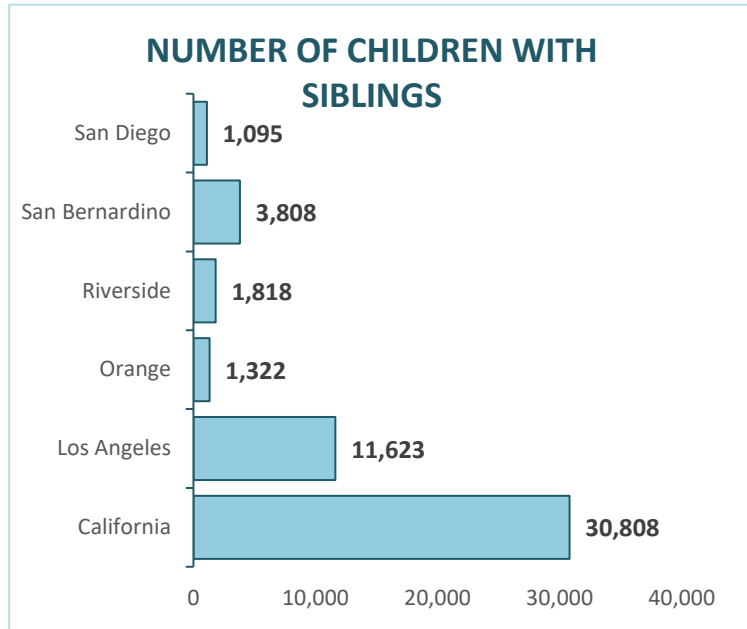
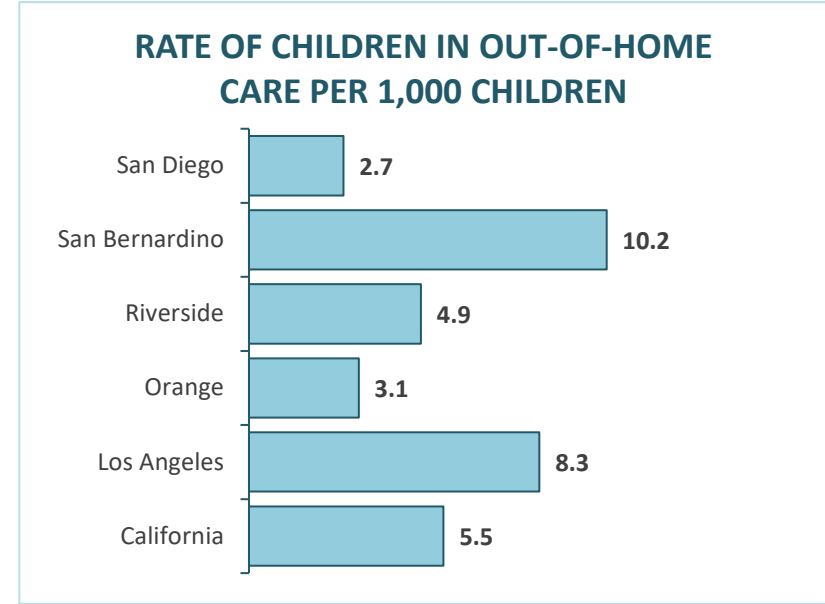
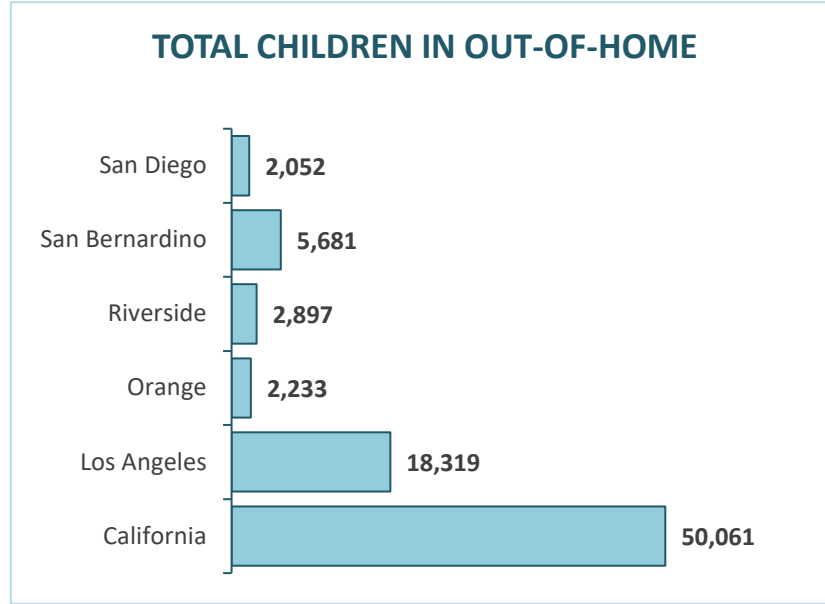
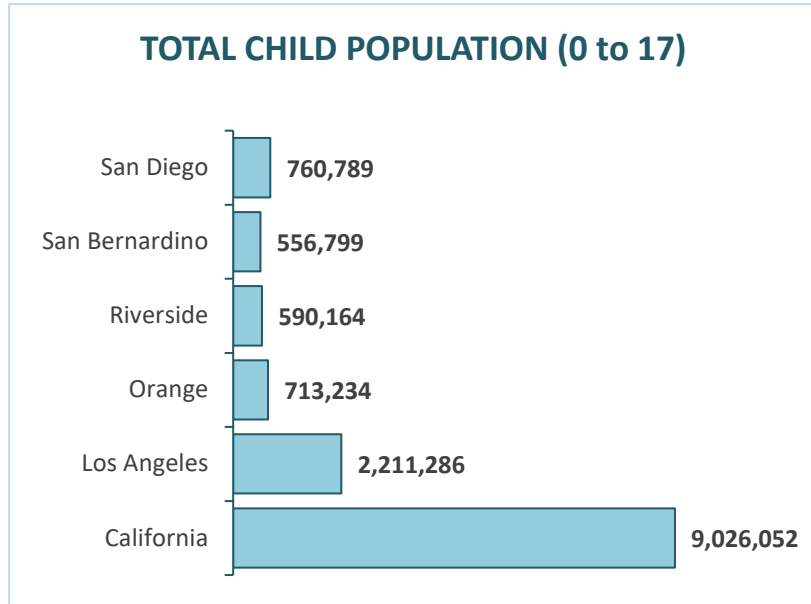


RATE OF SUBSTANTIATED ABUSE IN FOSTER CARE APR2020-MAR2021
