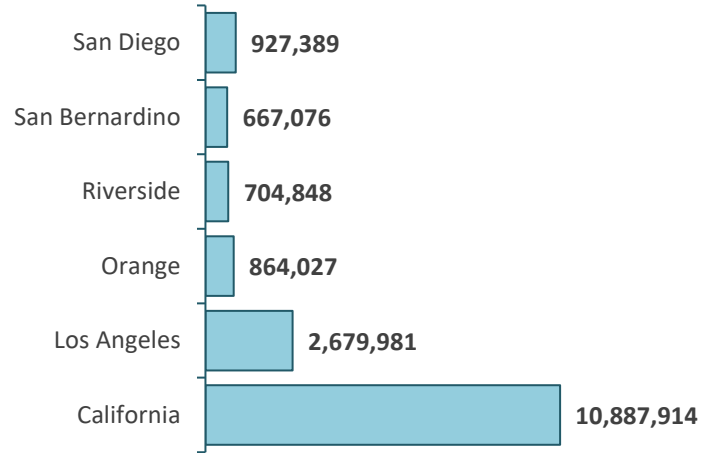

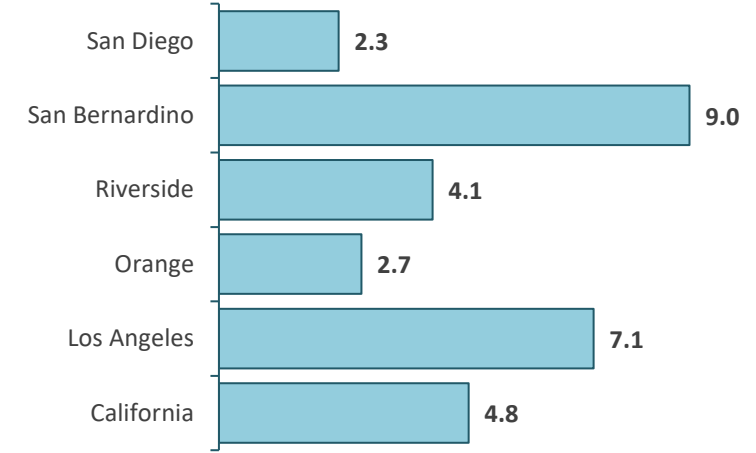

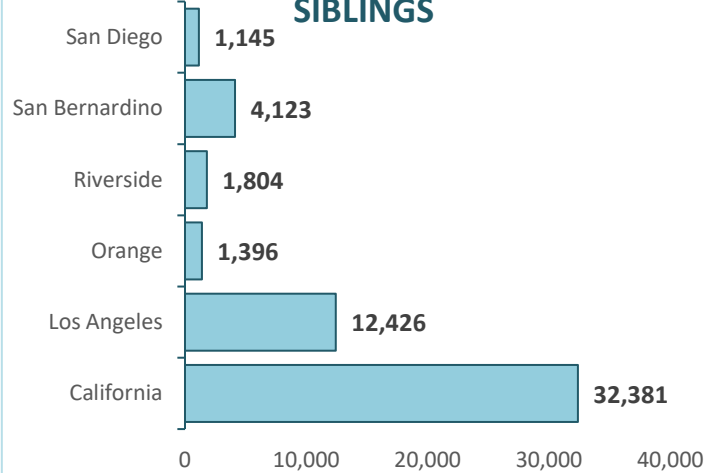
TOTAL CHILDREN IN OUT-OF-HOME



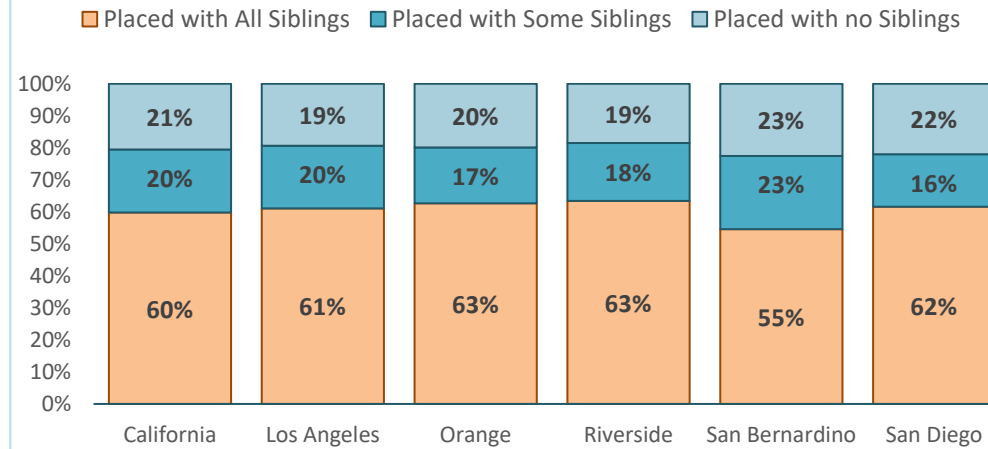
RATE OF CHILDREN IN OUT-OF-HOME CARE PER 1,000 CHILDREN



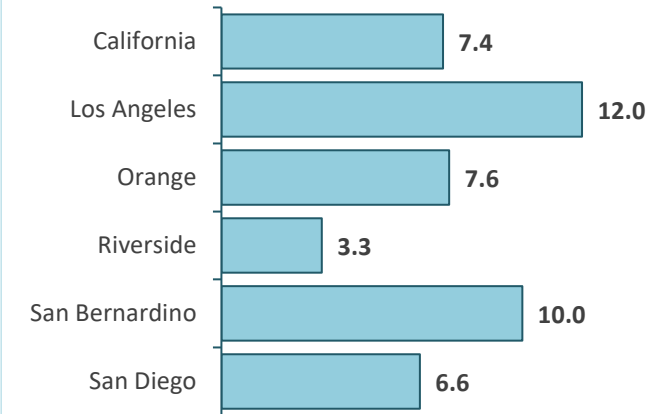

ABUSE IN FOSTER CARE - INSTANCES PER 100,000 DAYS IN CARE



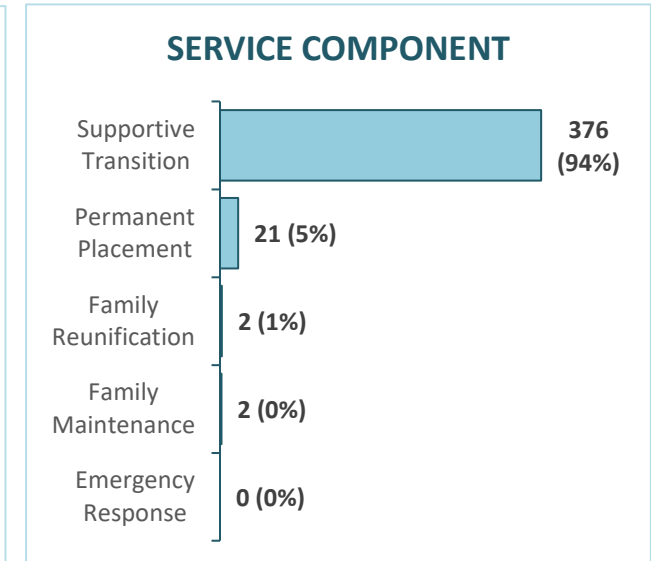
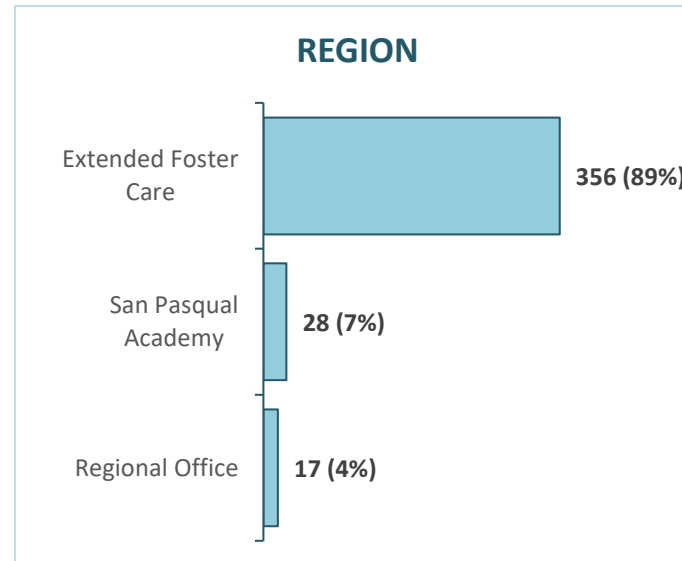
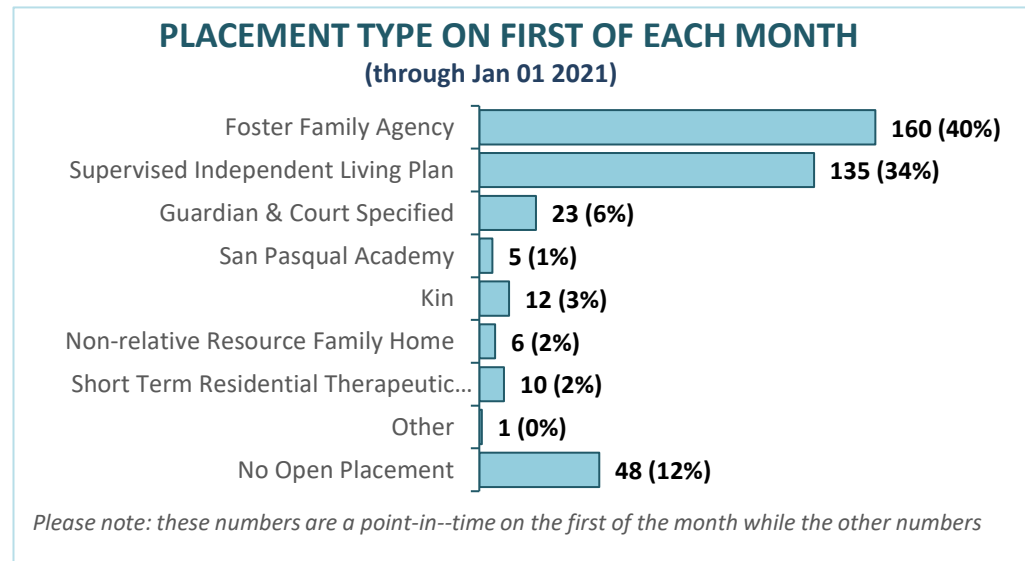
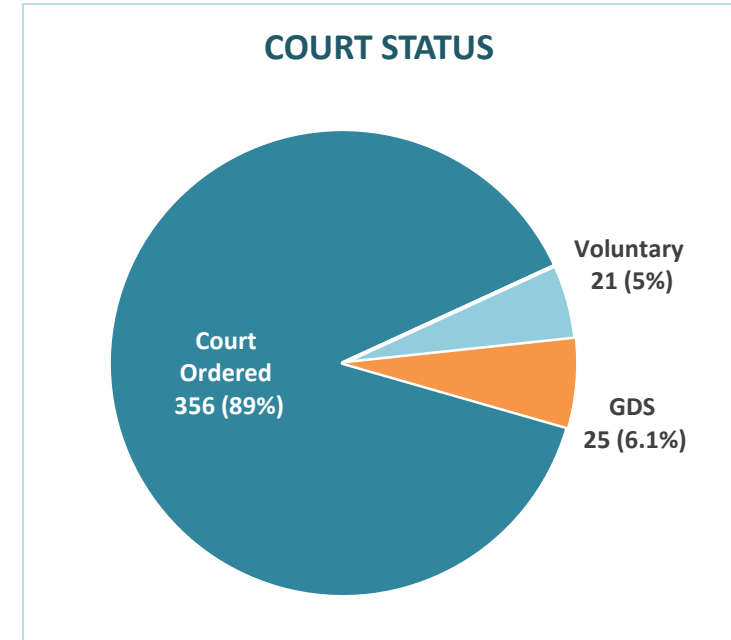
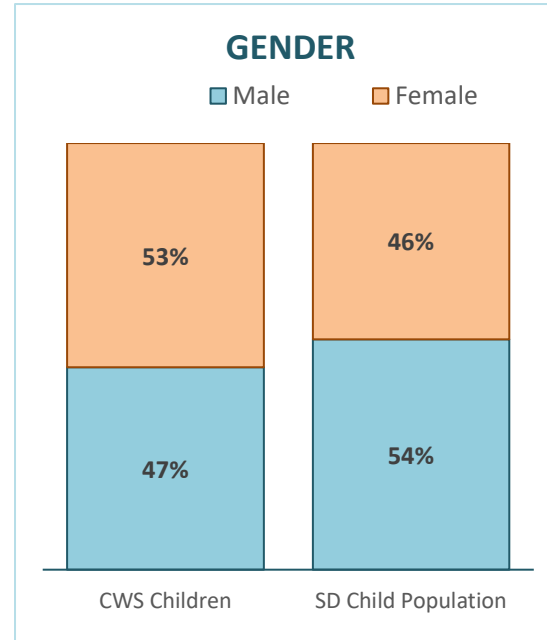
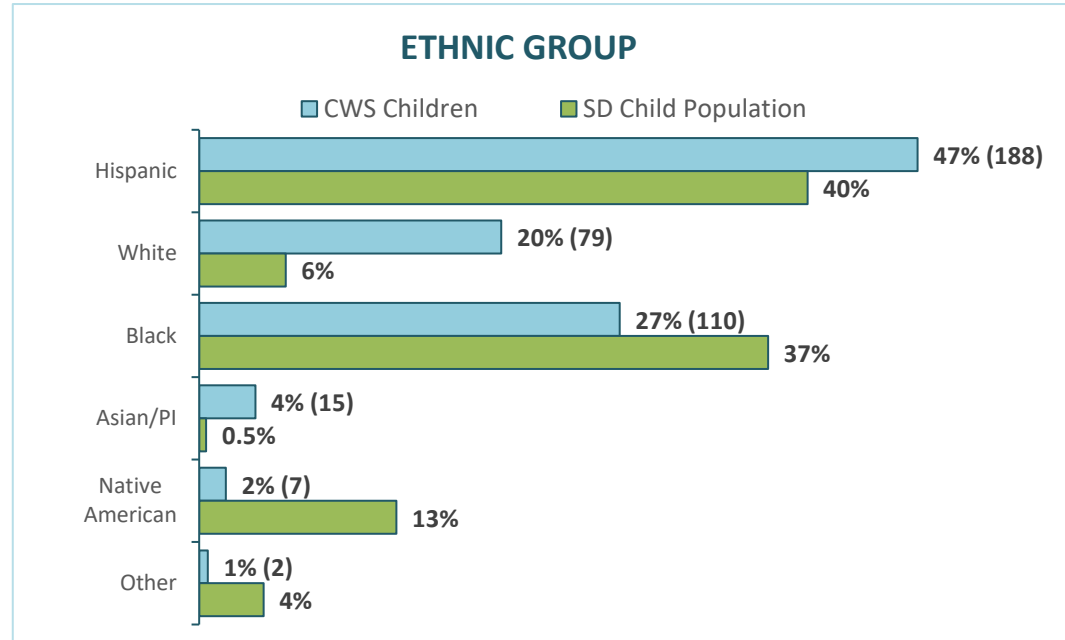
