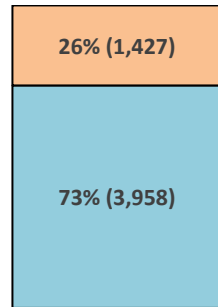

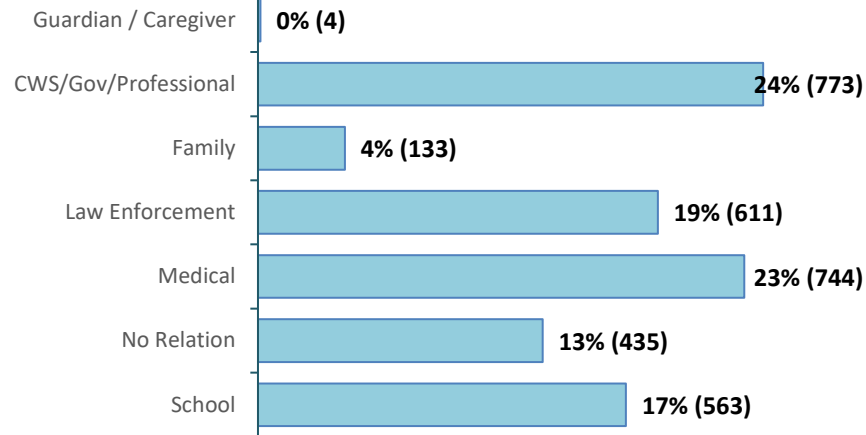

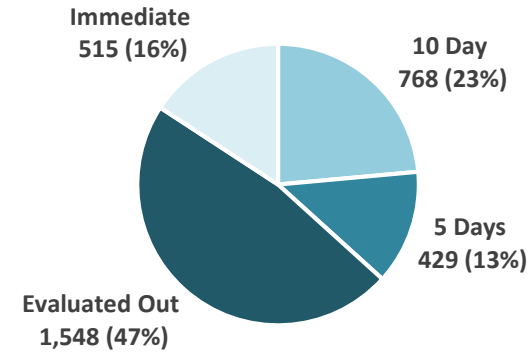

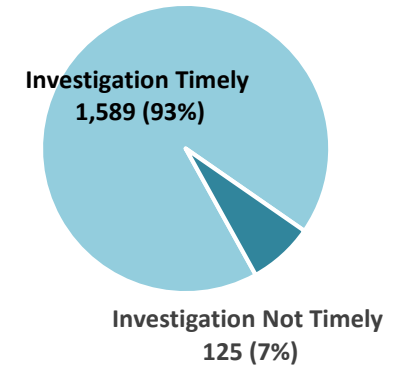

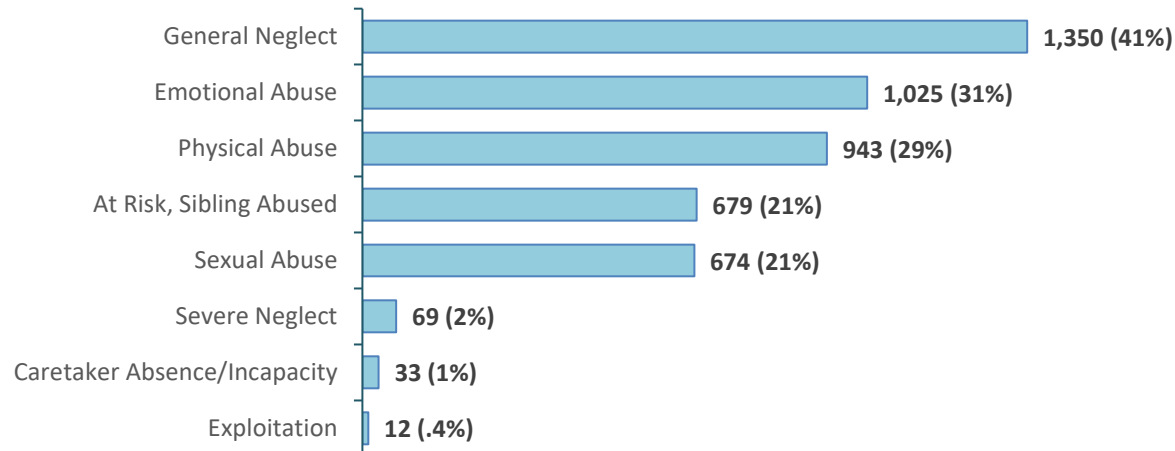
REFERRAL RESPONSE TYPE

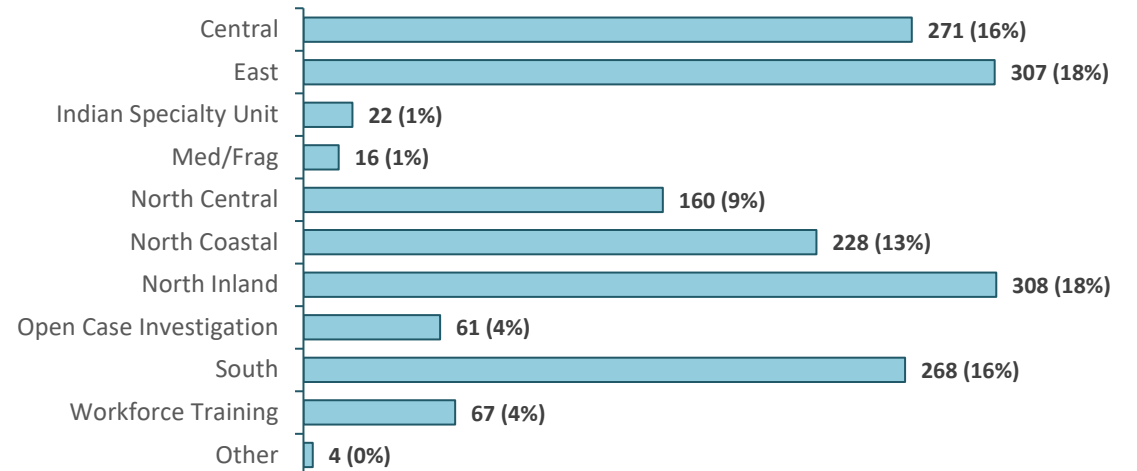


ALLEGATION TYPE

Ethnicity and Path through Child Welfare Services ¹



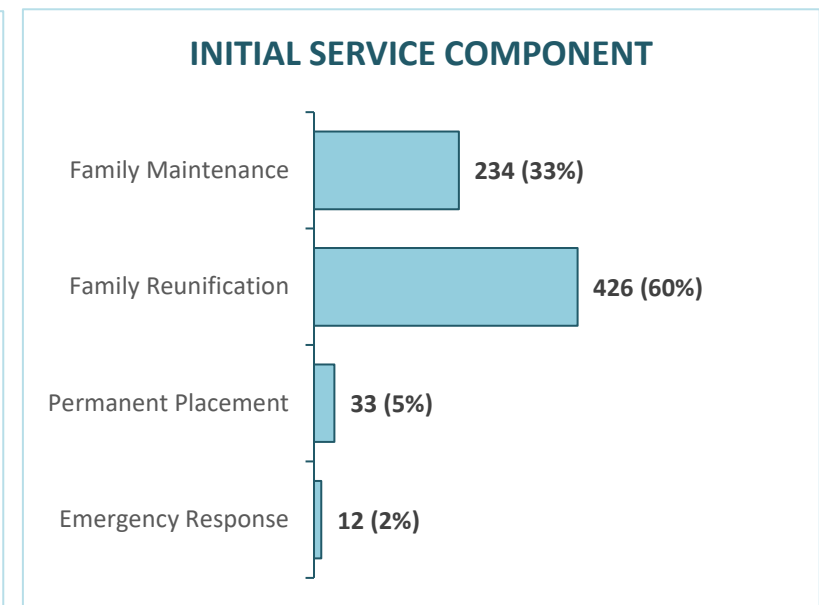
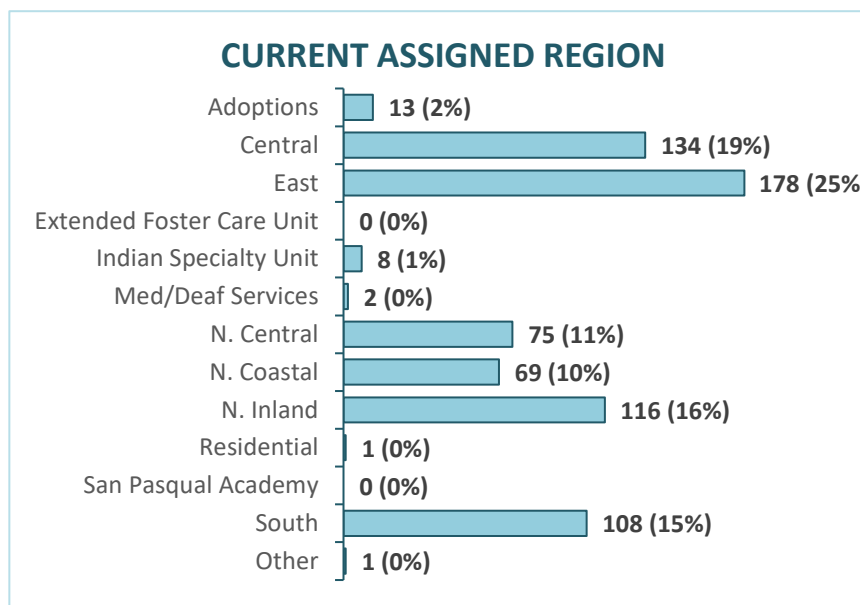
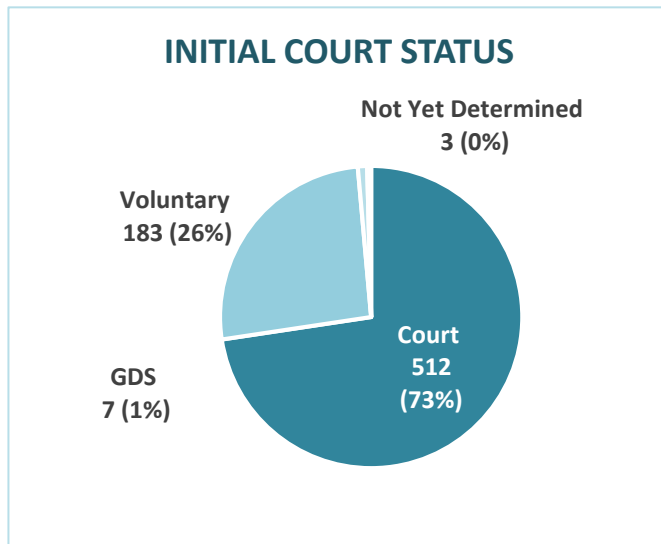
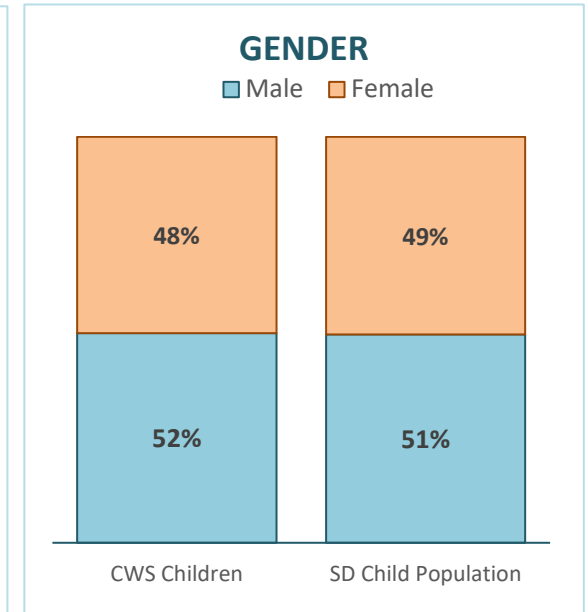
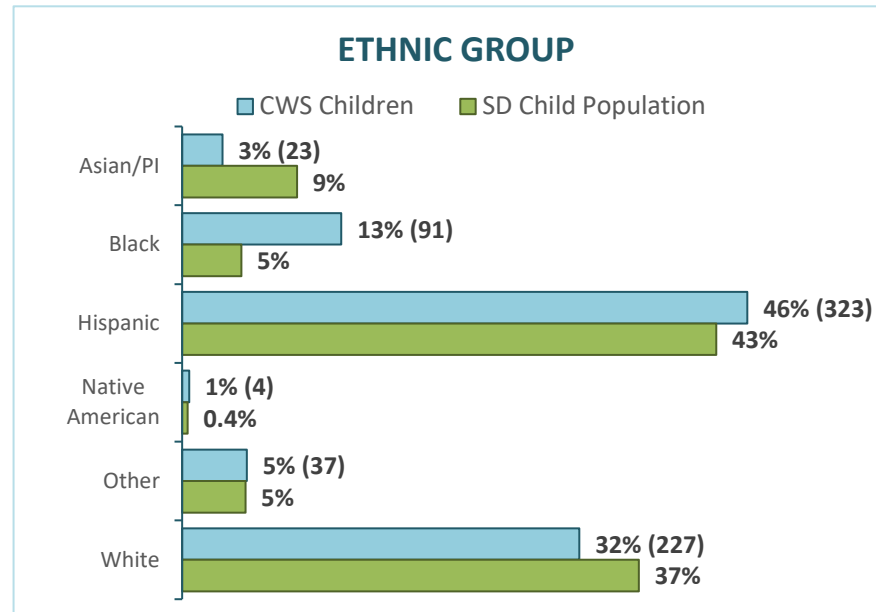
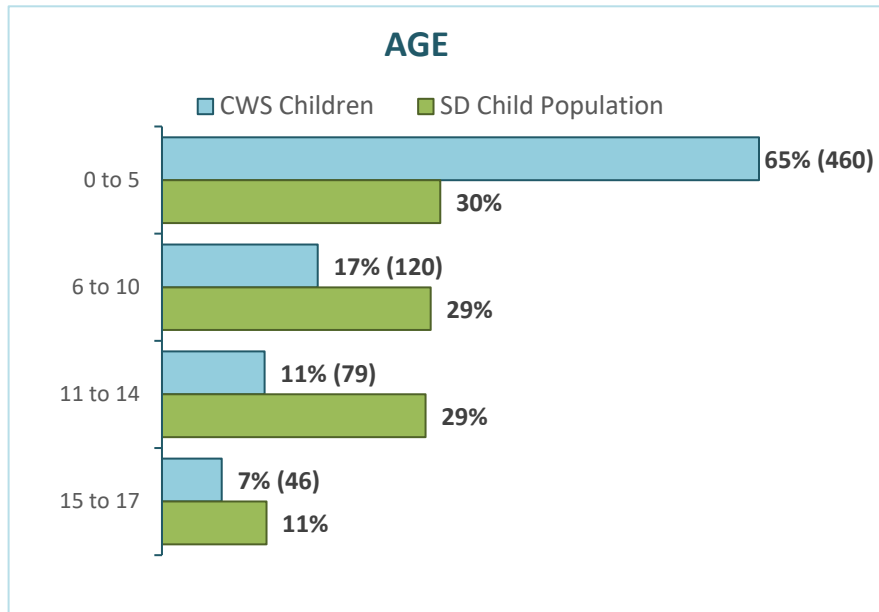

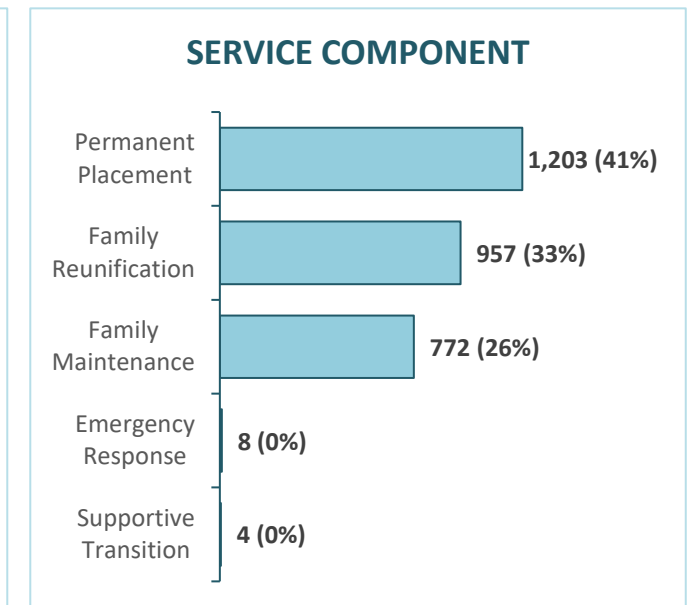
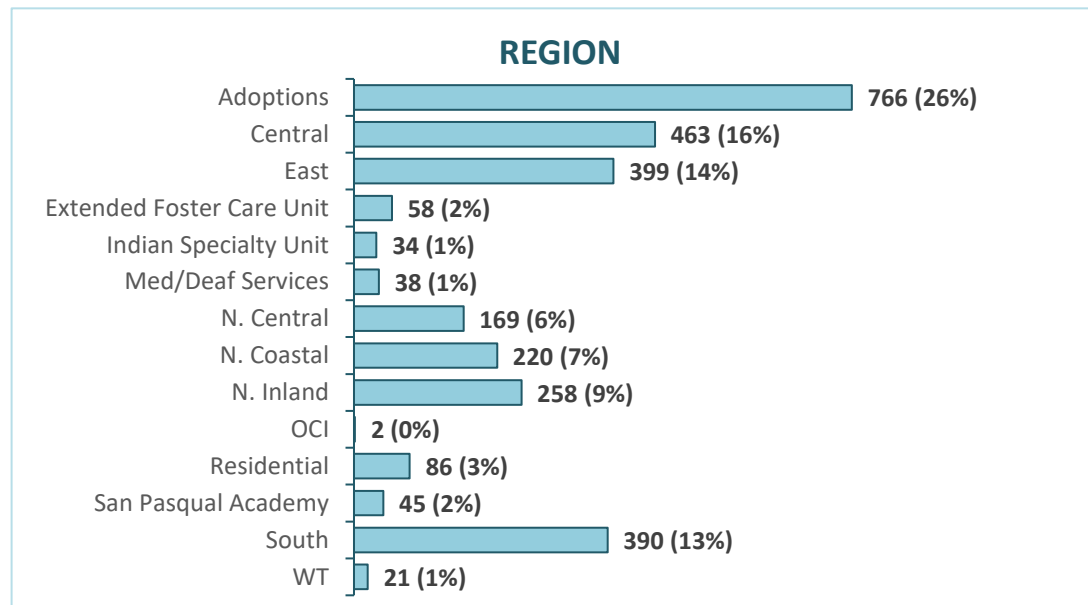
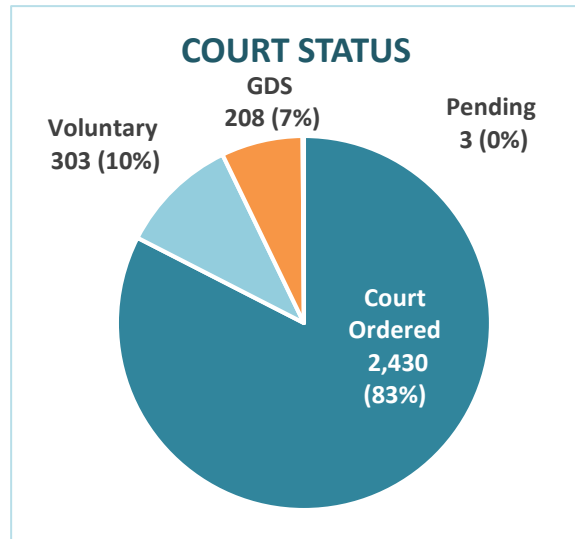
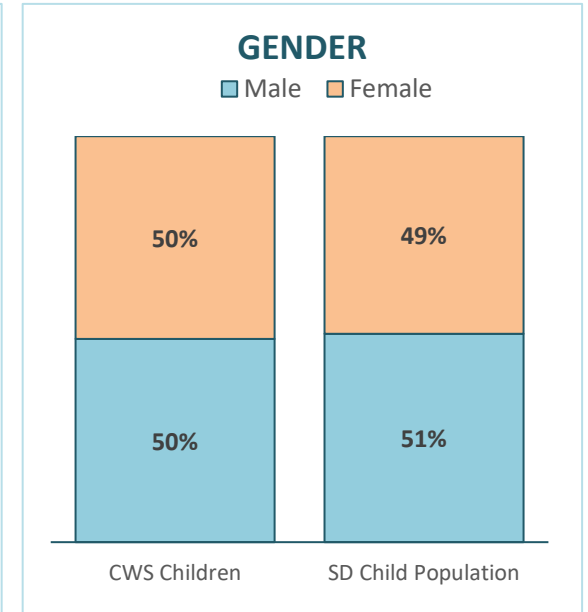
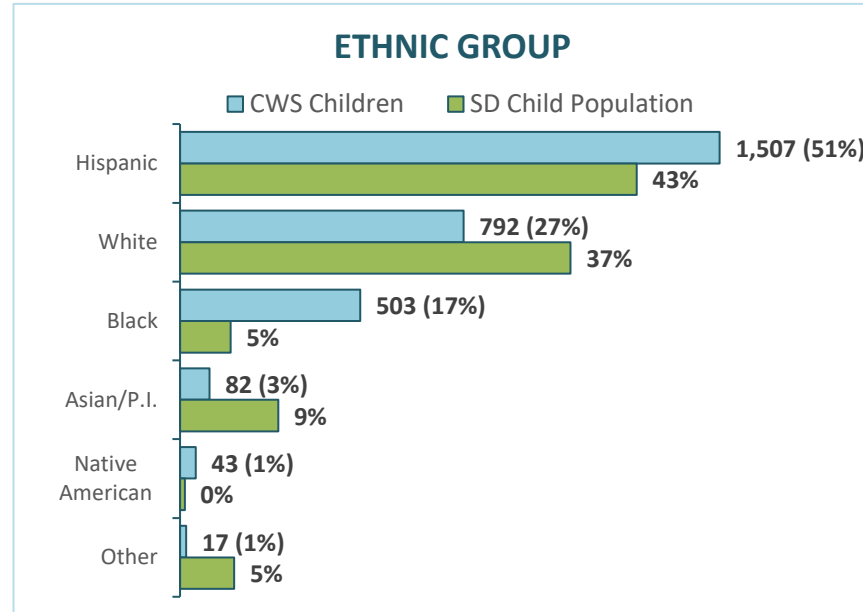
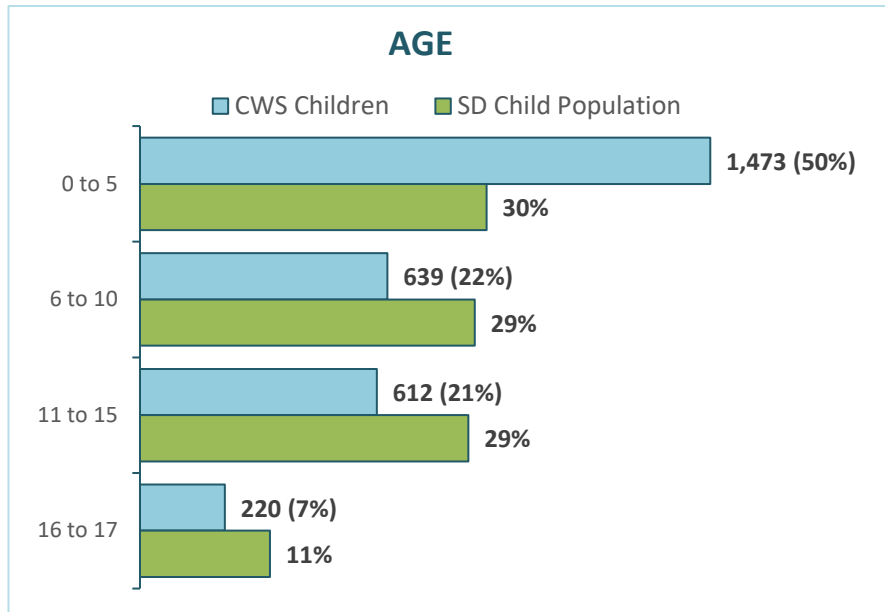


Cases Open each month - Monthly Averages FY2021/22 (through January 2022)

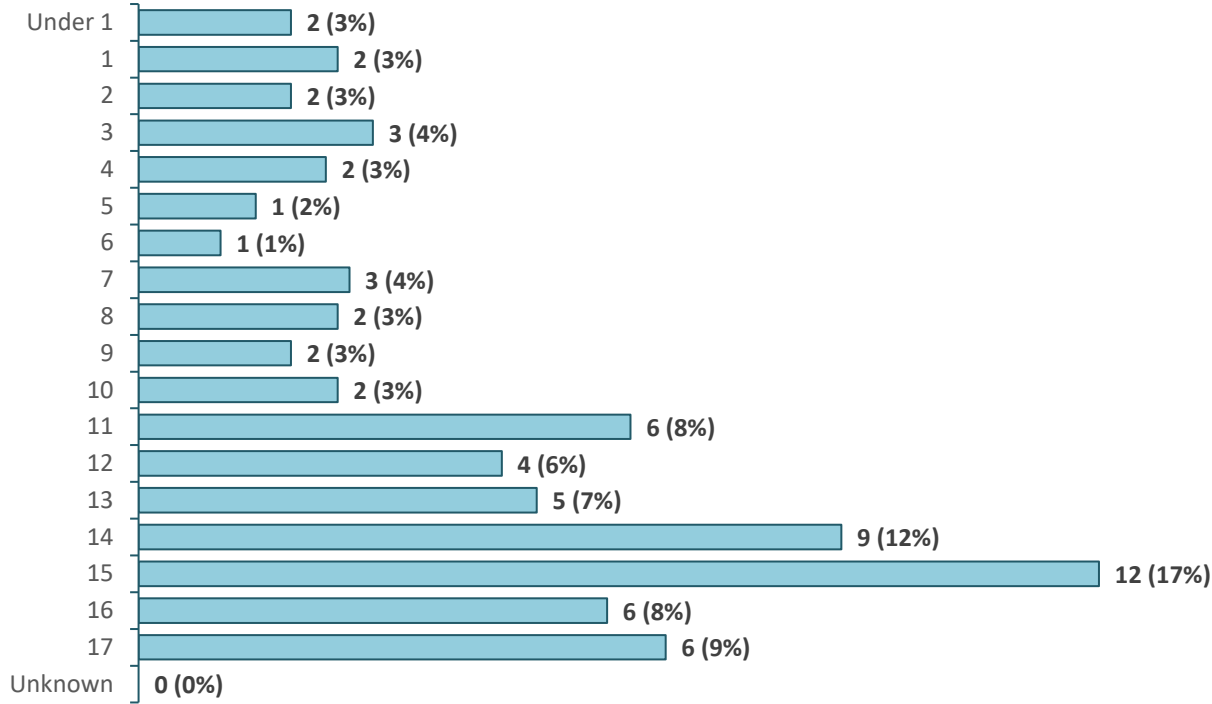

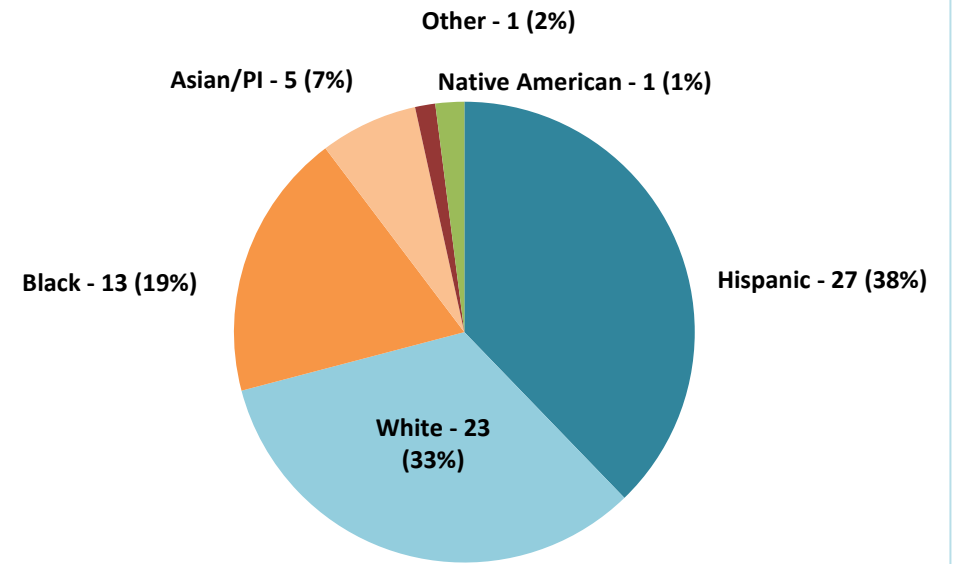


Polinsky / Adoption Finalizations / Petitions / Medical & Dental Exams - Monthly Average (through Jan 22)

Clients at Polinsky Children's Center by Age (Monthly Average)



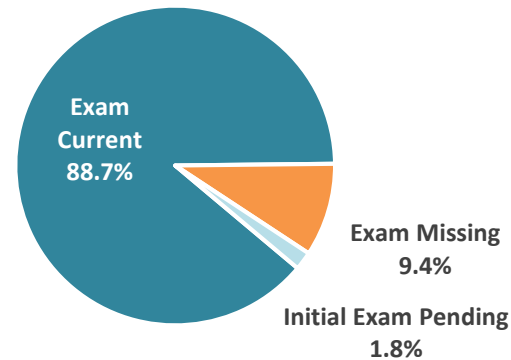
Clients at Polinsky Children's Center by Ethnicity (Monthly Average)



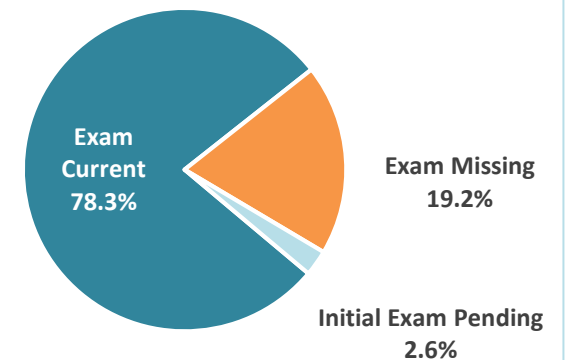

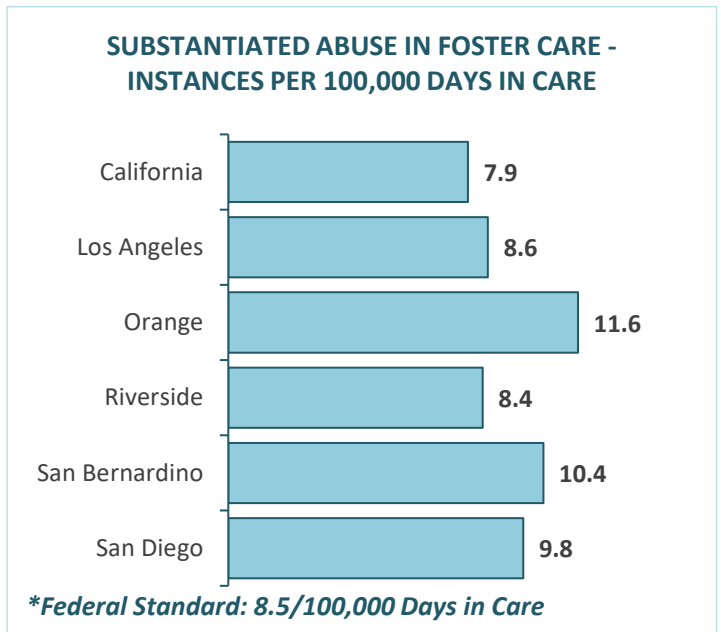
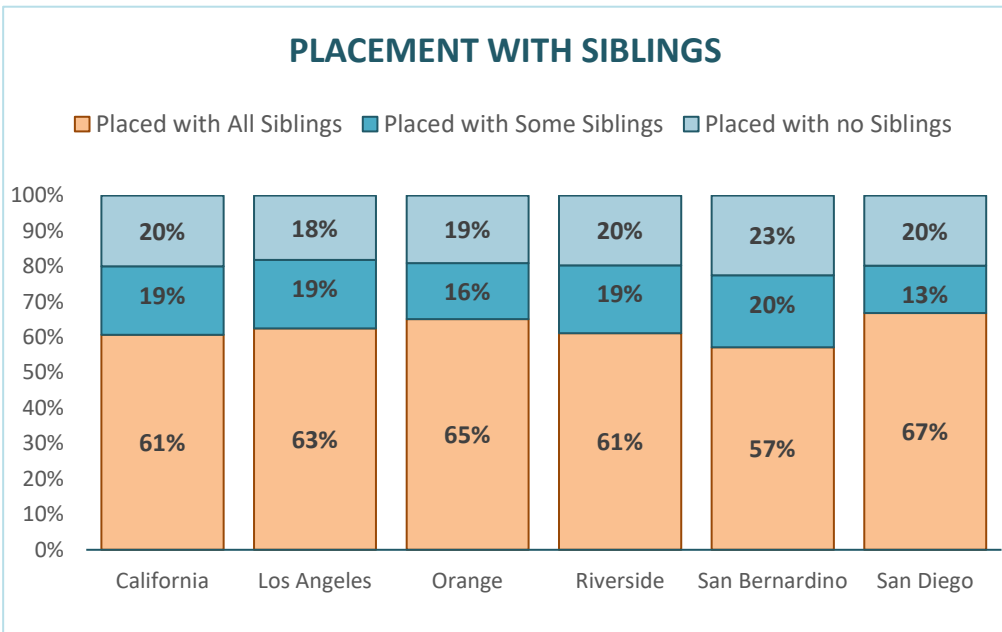
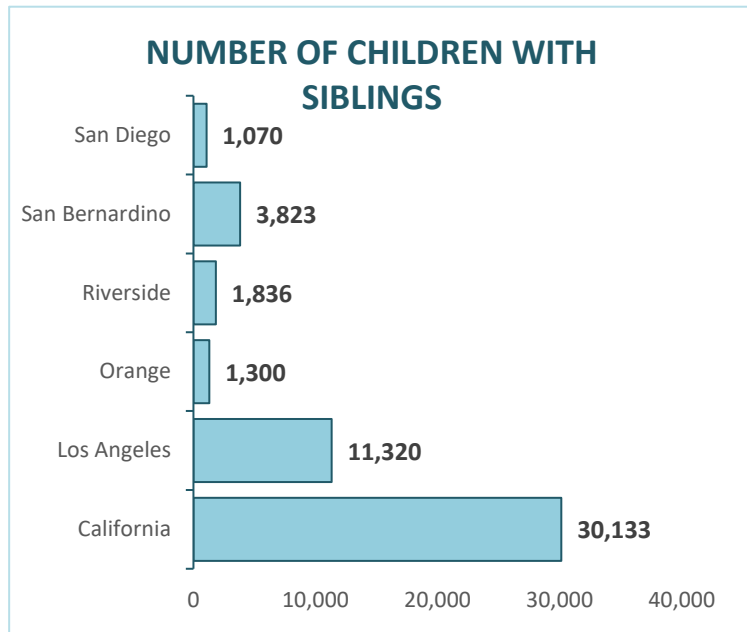
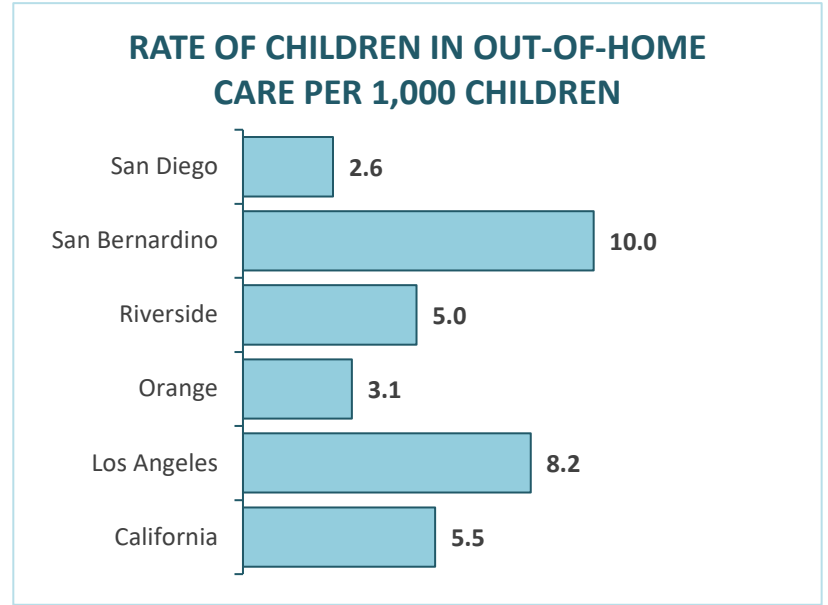
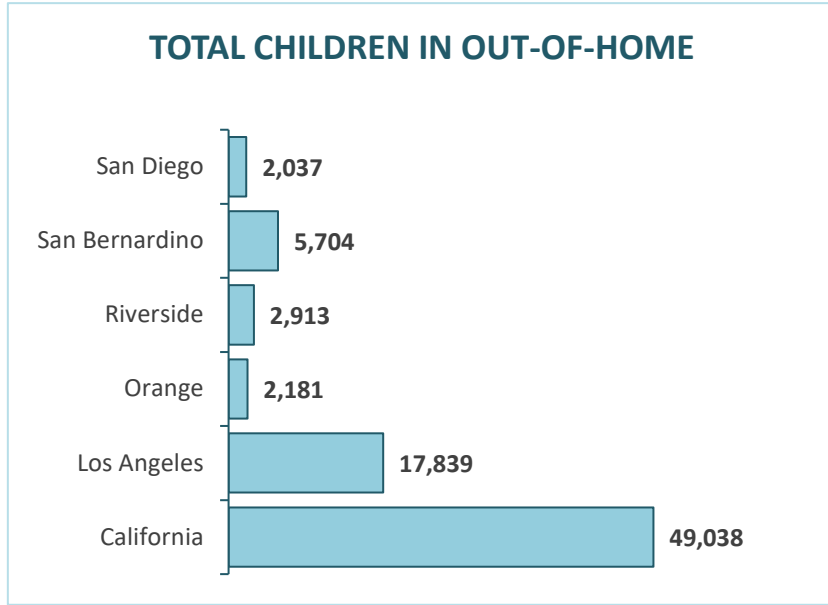
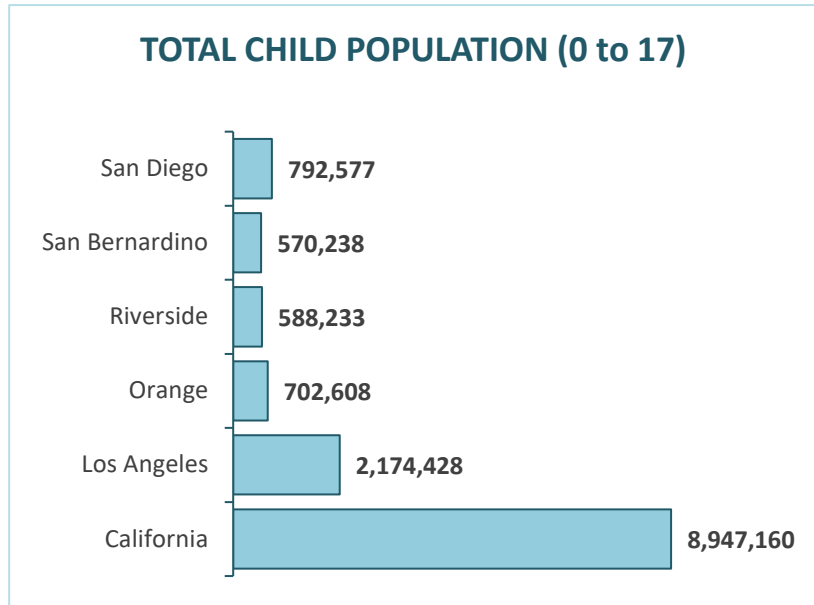


RATE OF SUBSTANTIATED ABUSE IN FOSTER CARE OCT2020-SEP2021
