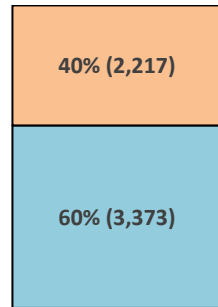

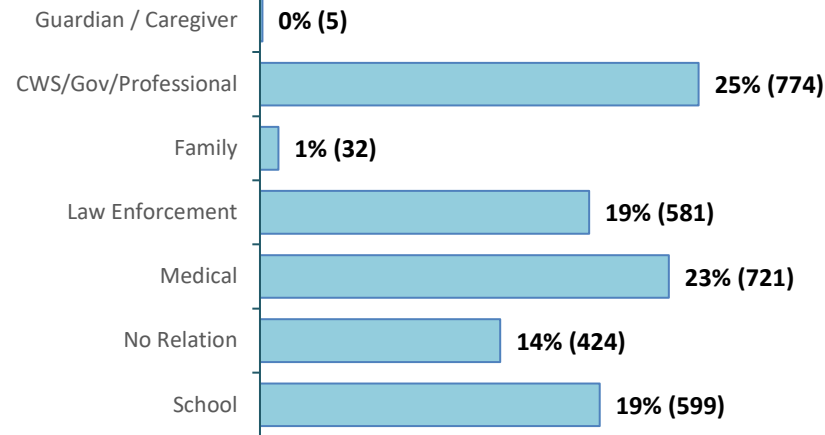

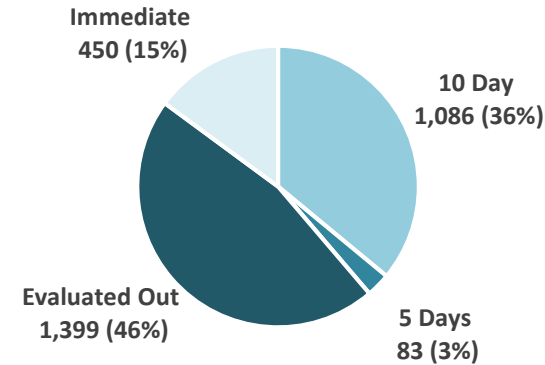

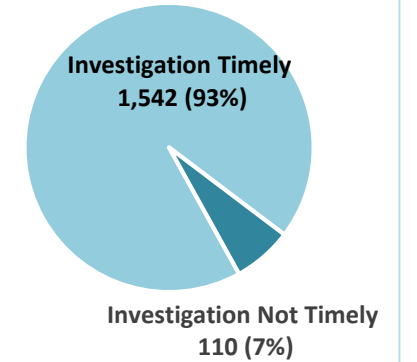

REFERRAL RESPONSE TYPE

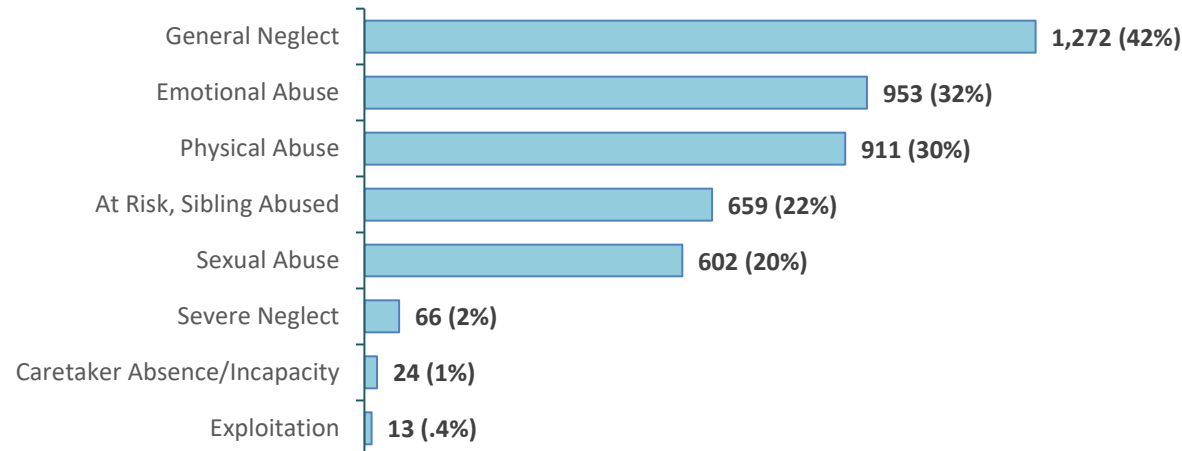

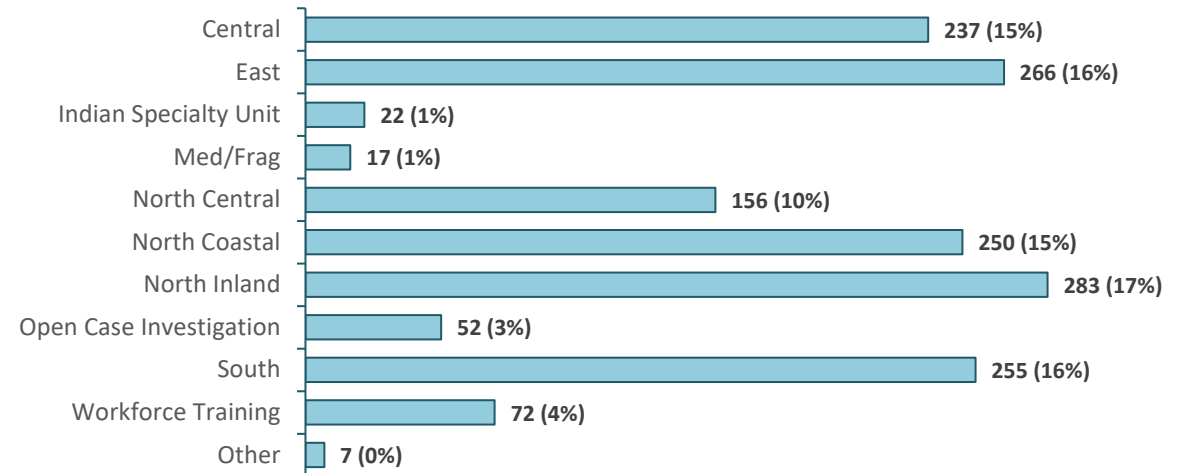

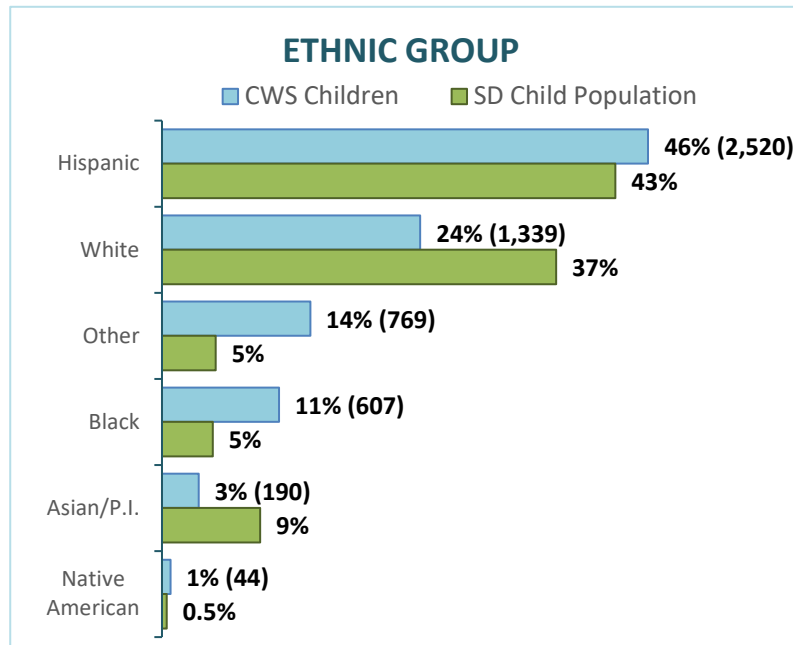

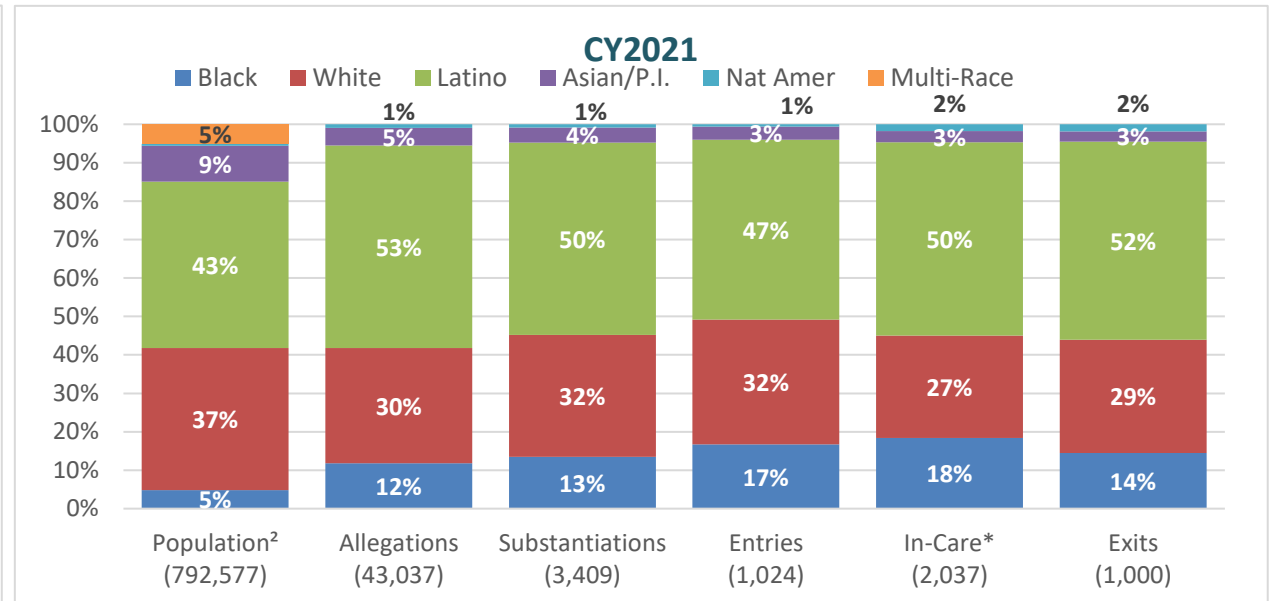
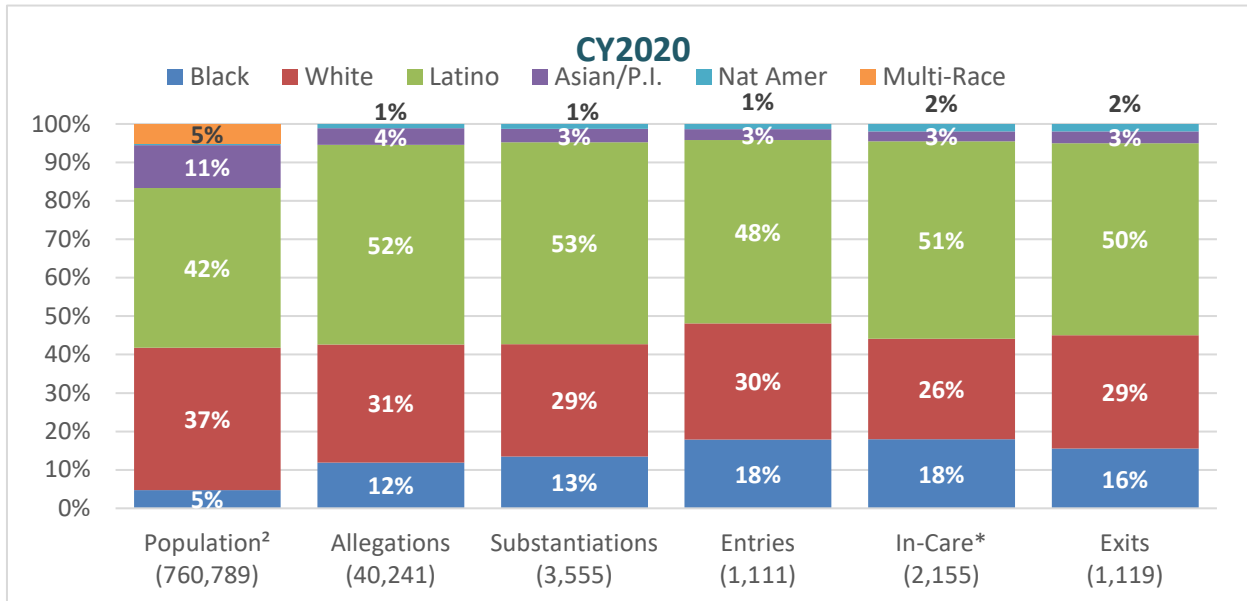
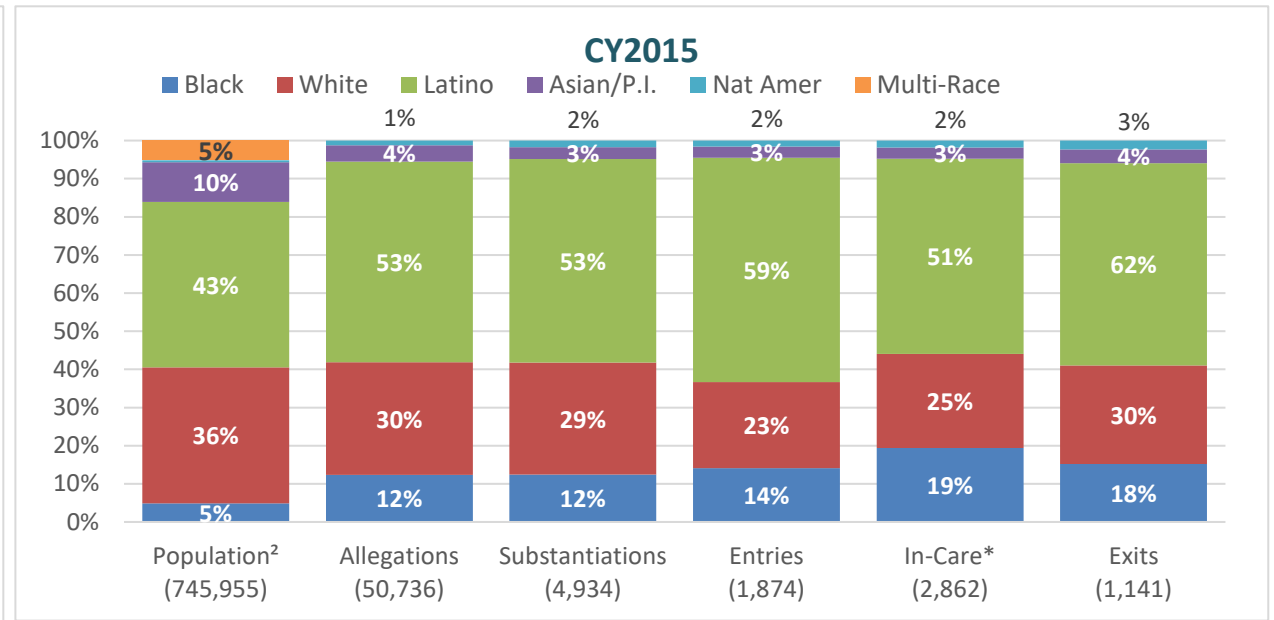
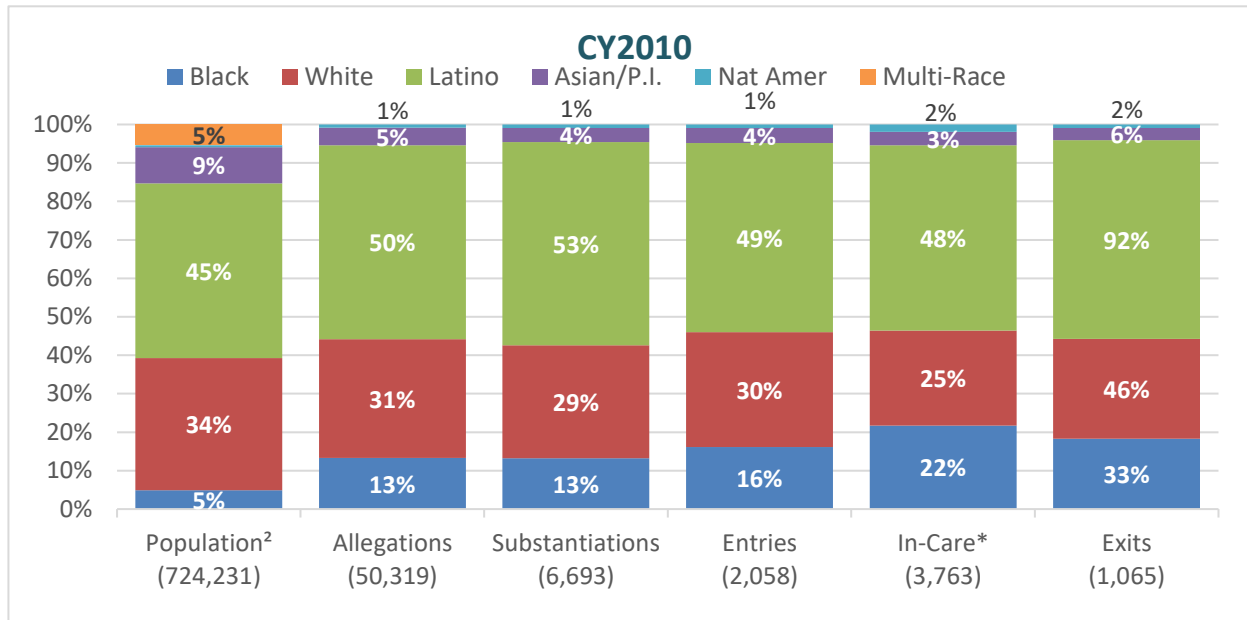
Children (age 0-17) in Investigated Referrals (January 2023)

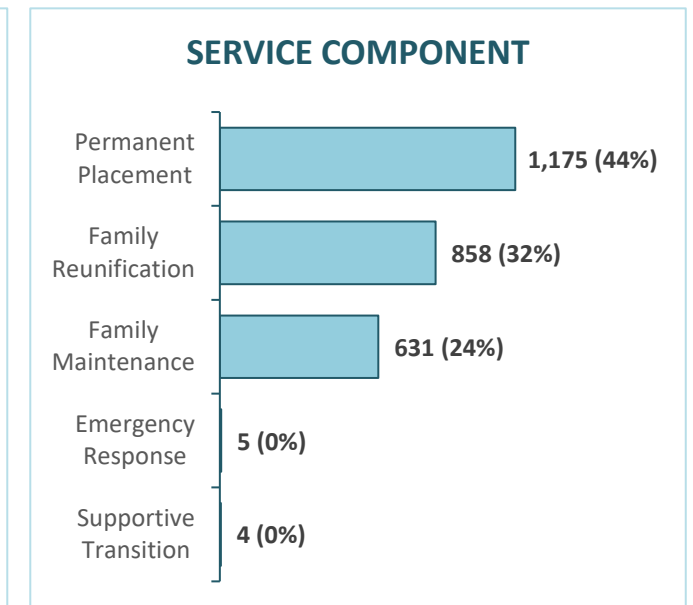
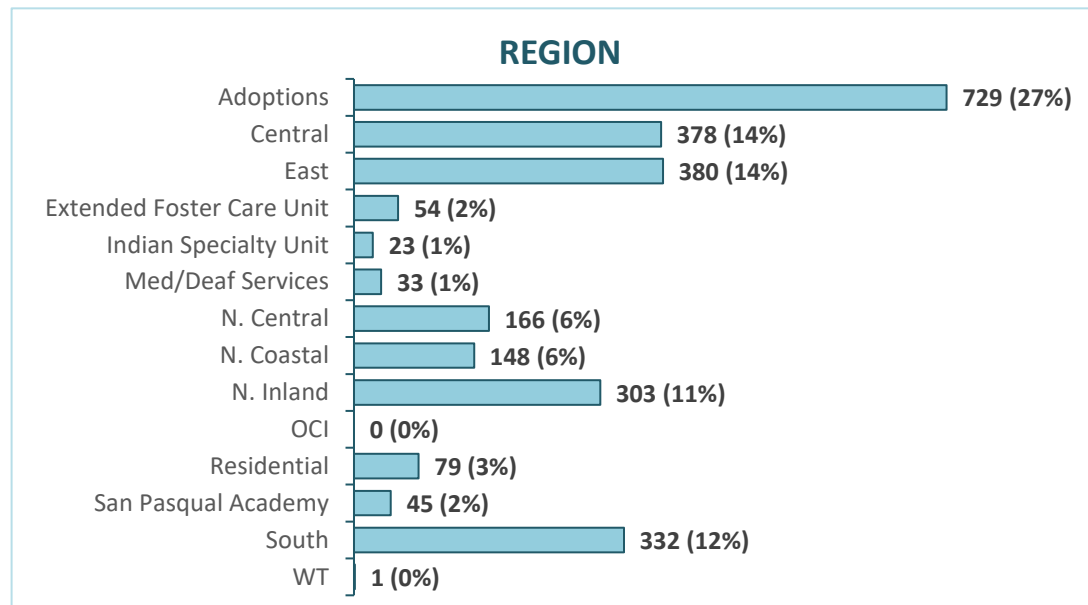
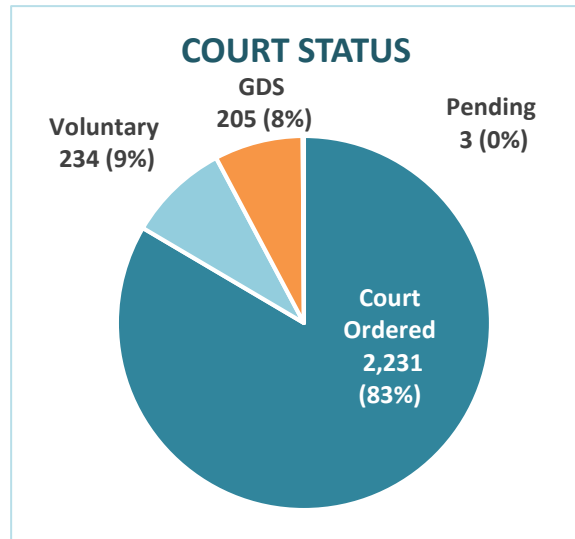
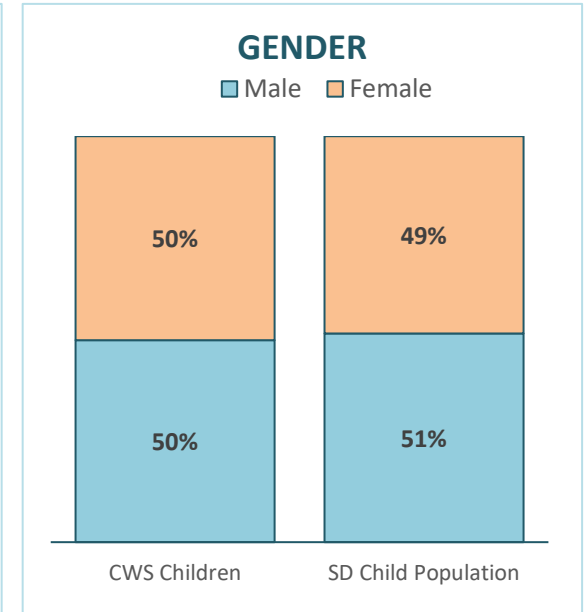
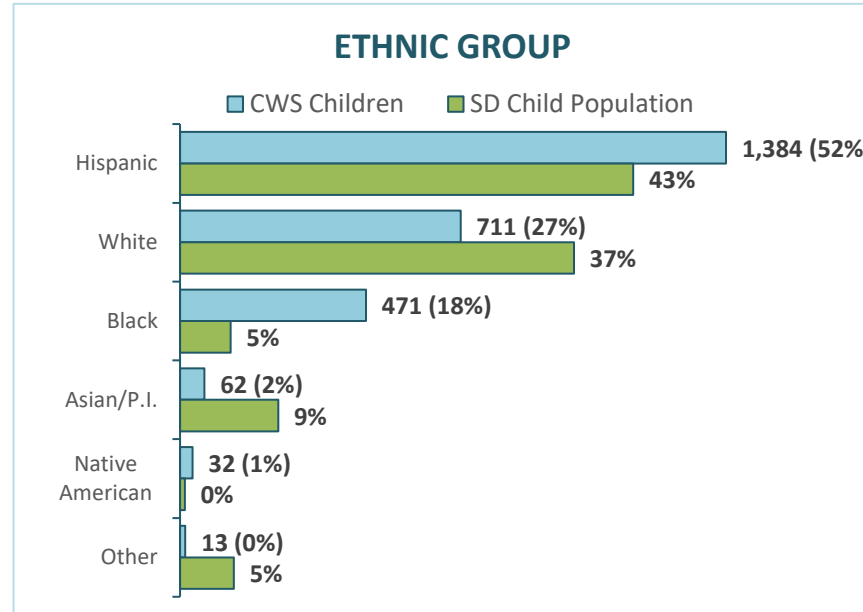
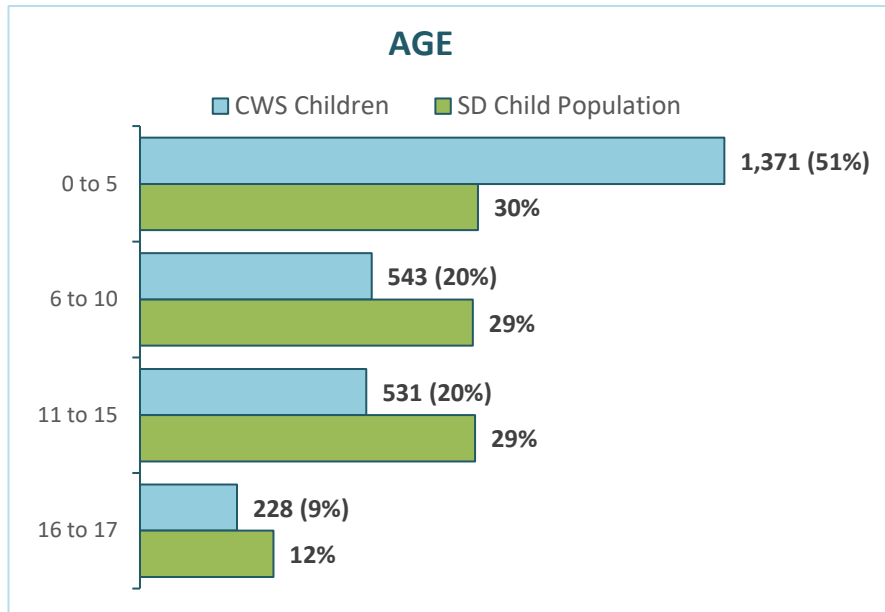


Cases Open each month - Monthly Averages FY2022/23 (through January 2023)

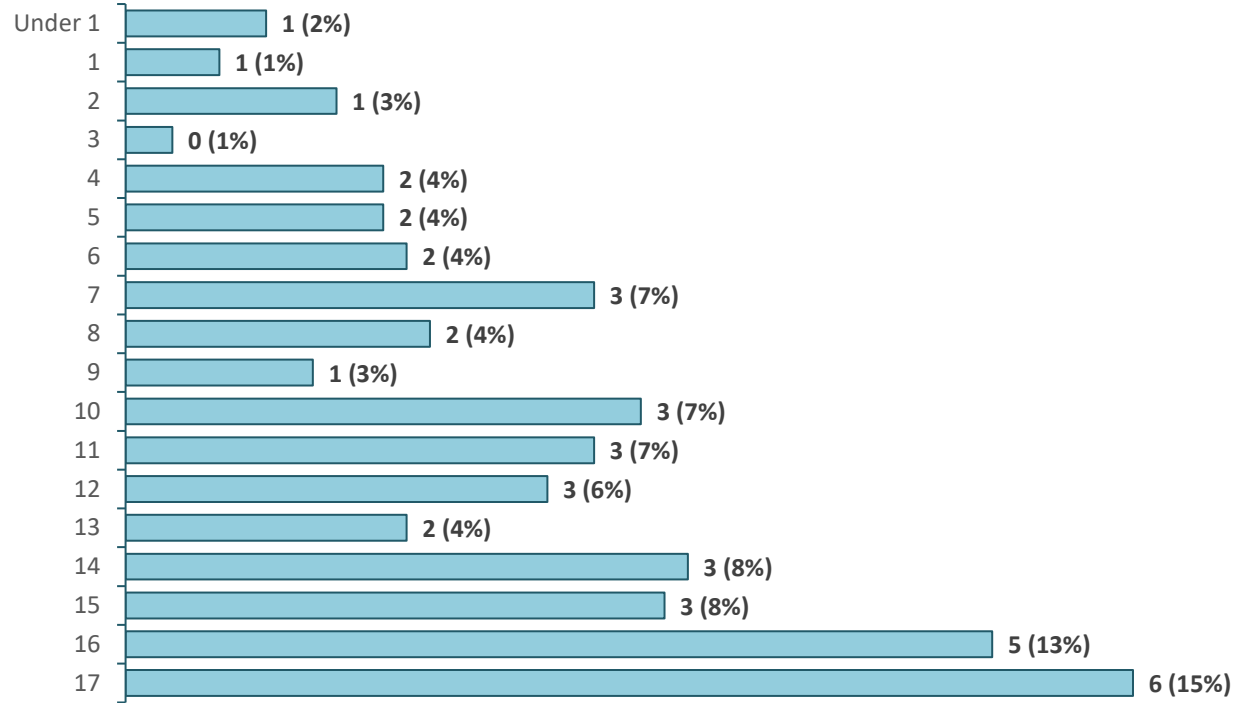

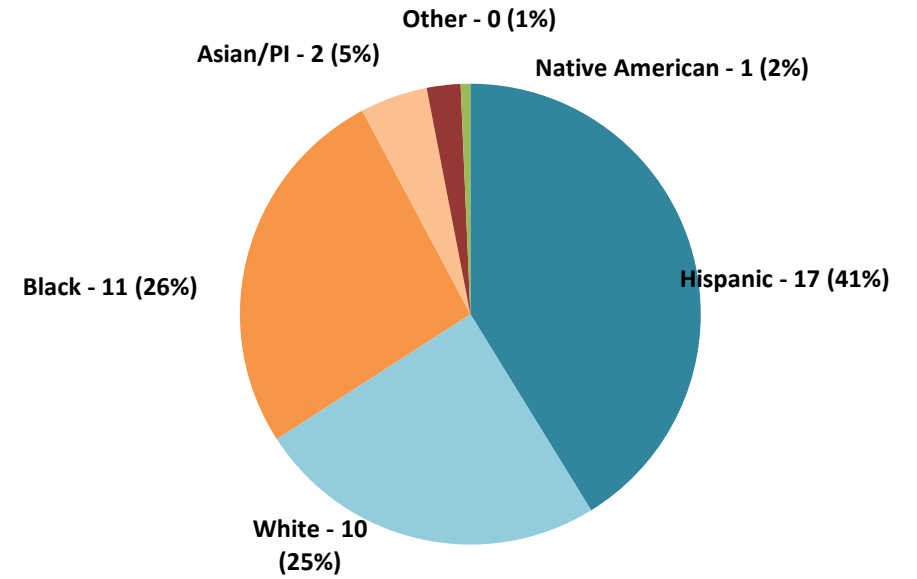


Polinsky / Adoption Finalizations / Petitions / Medical & Dental Exams - Monthly Average (through Jan 23)

Clients at Polinsky Children's Center by Age (Monthly Average)



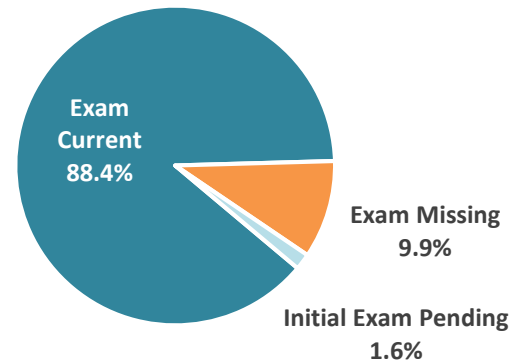
Clients at Polinsky Children's Center by Ethnicity (Monthly Average)



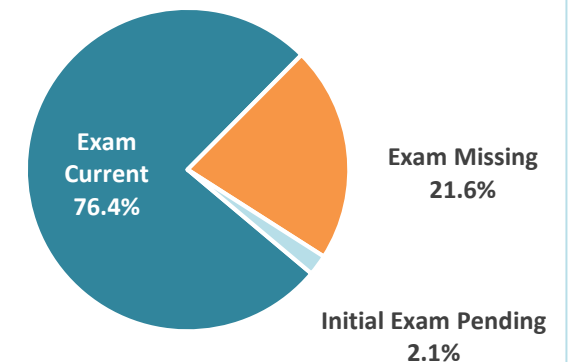

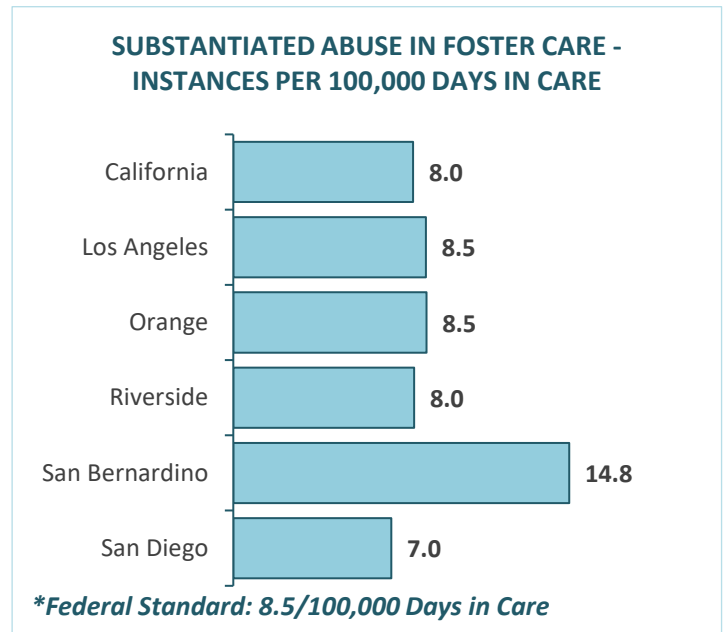
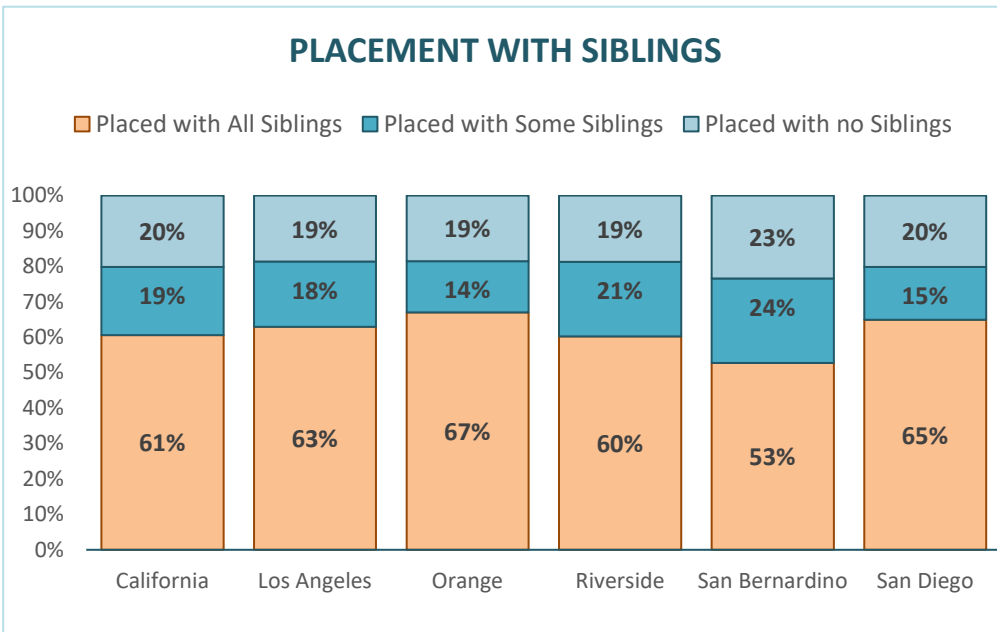
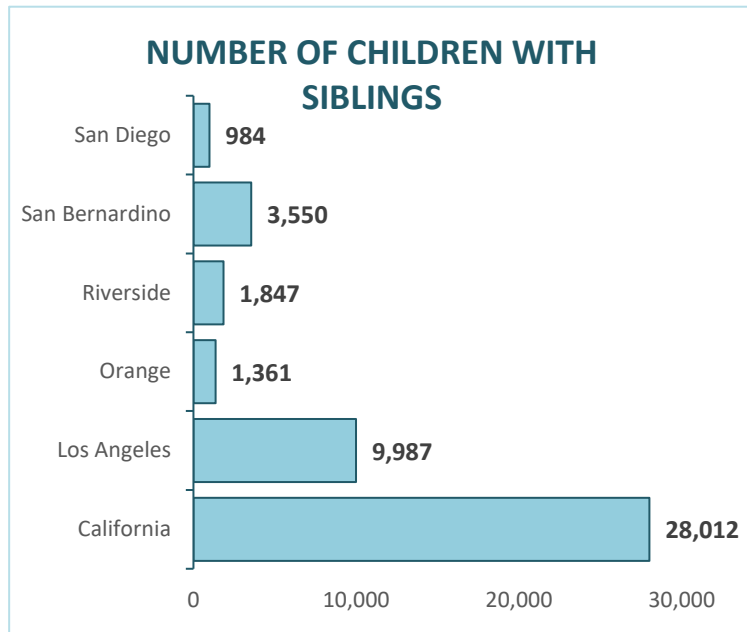
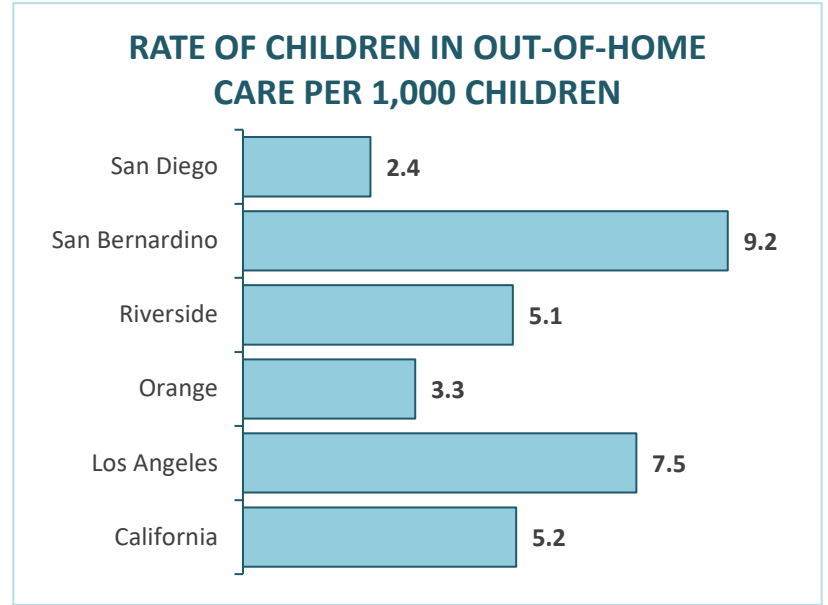
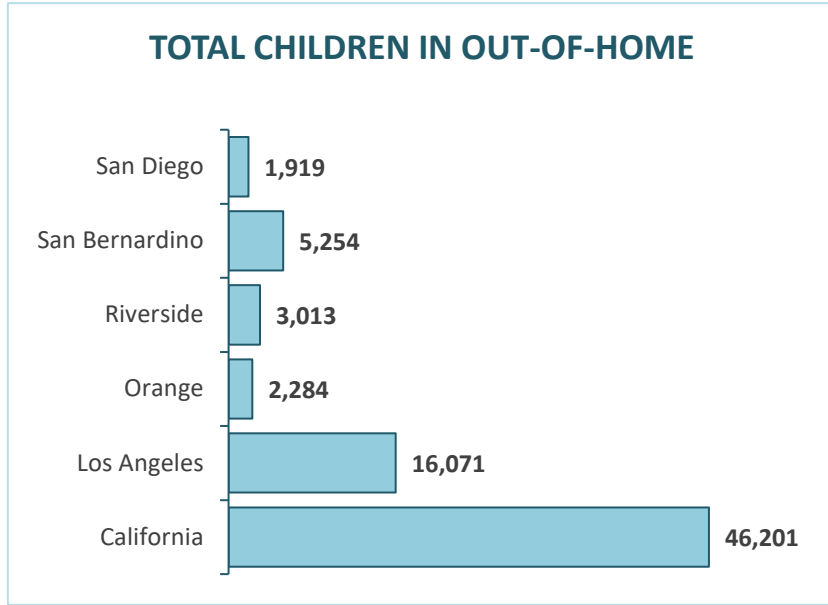
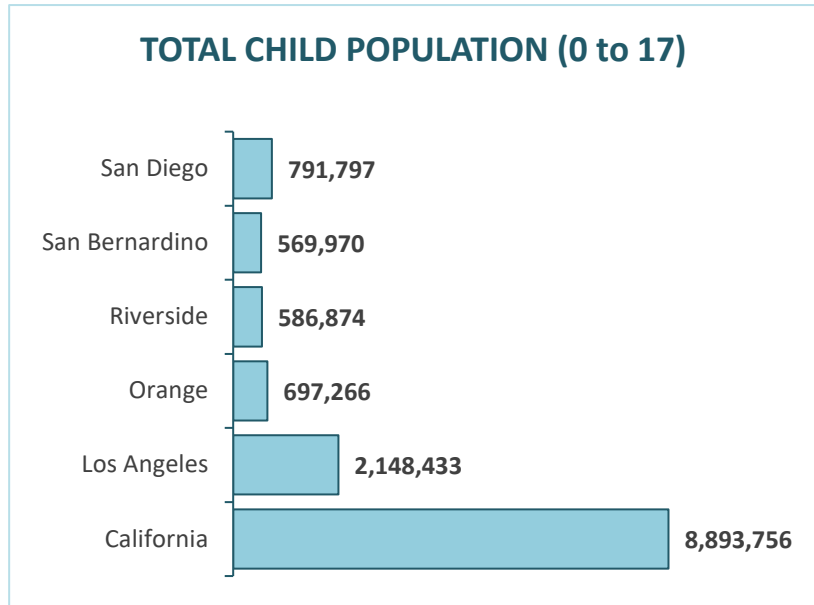


RATE OF SUBSTANTIATED ABUSE IN FOSTER CARE OCT2021-SEP2022
