## Children (age 0-17) in Investigated Referrals (July 2021)

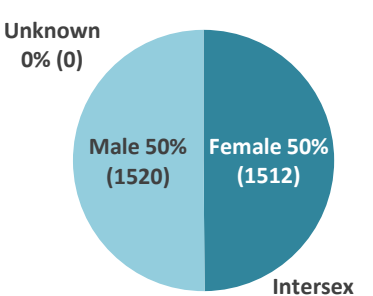

# Ethnicity and Path through Child Welfare Services <sup>1</sup>



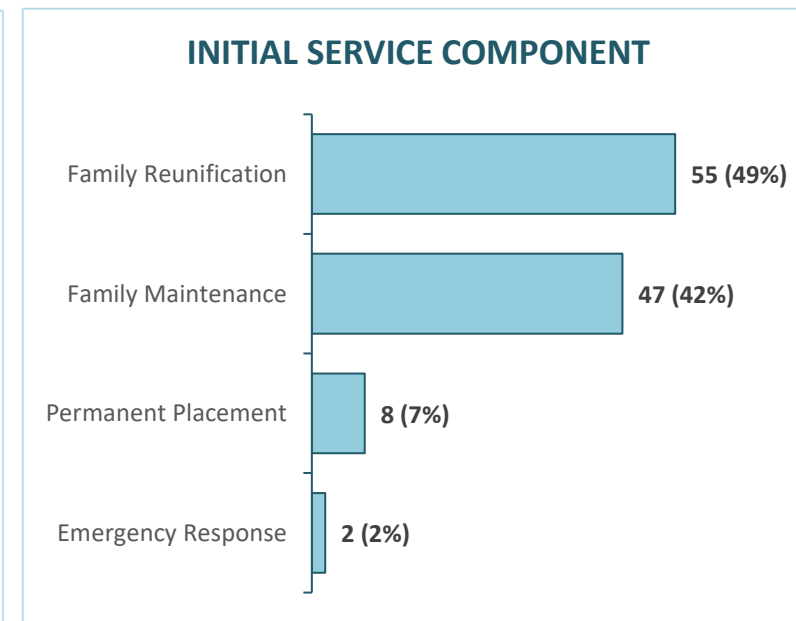
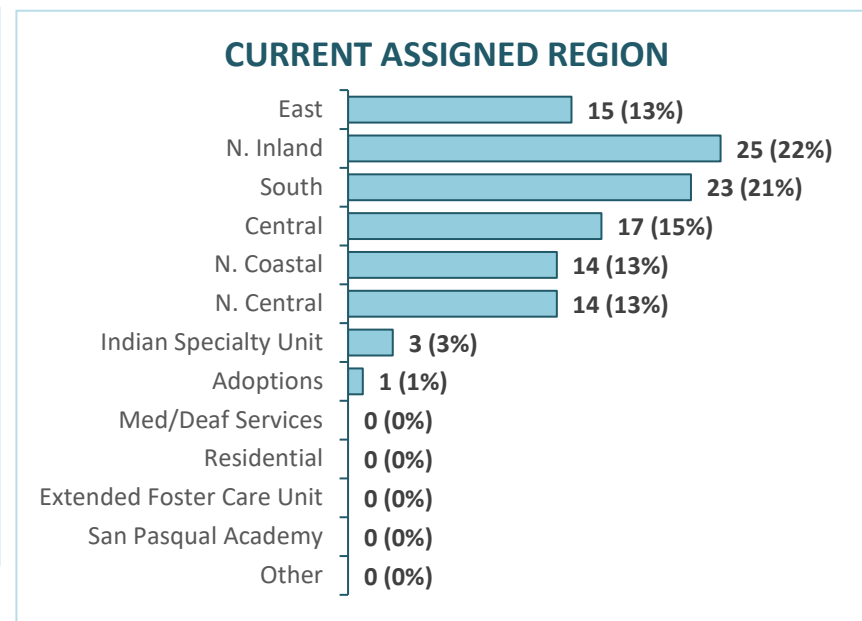
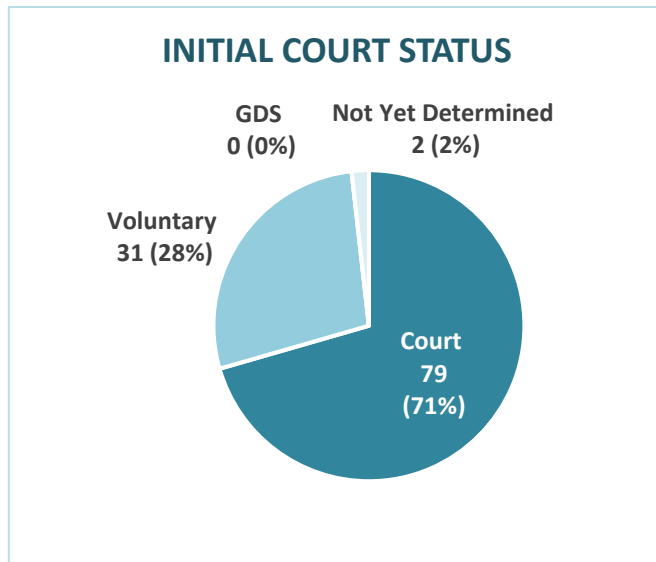
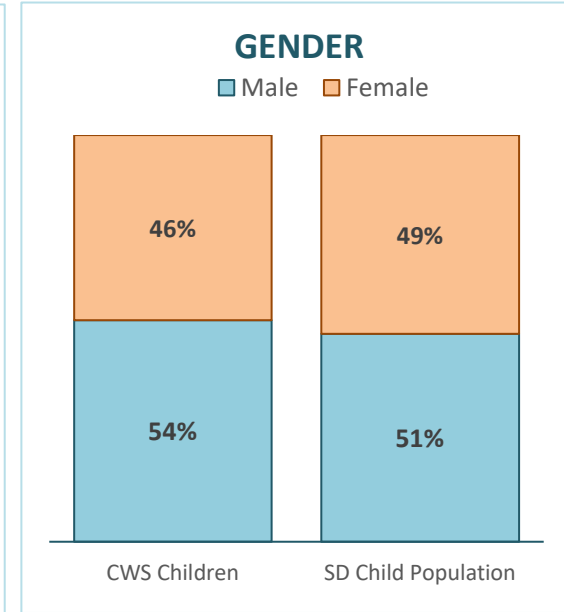
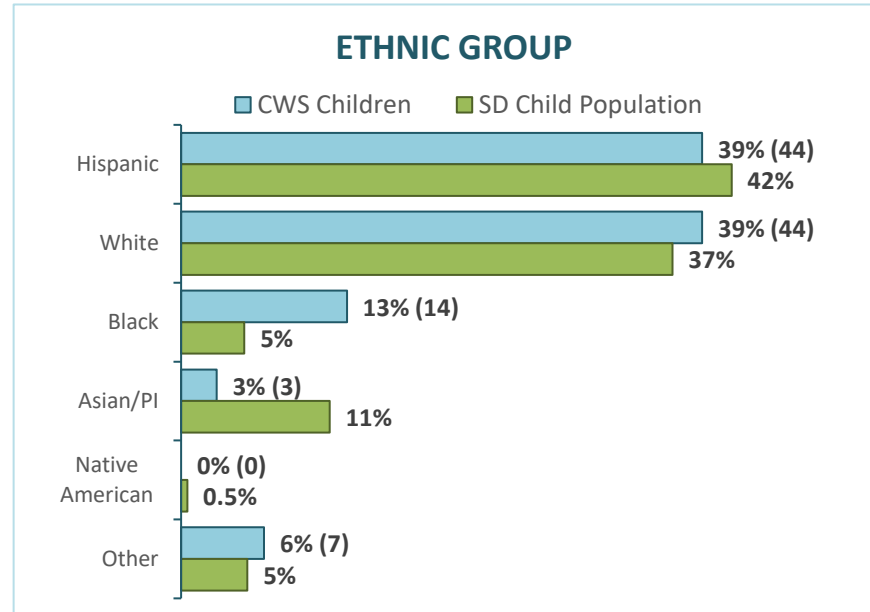
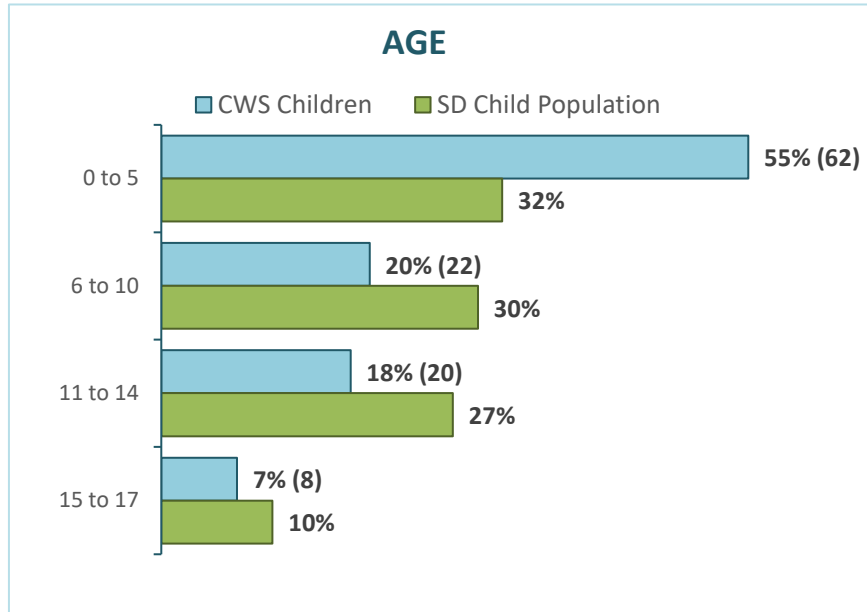

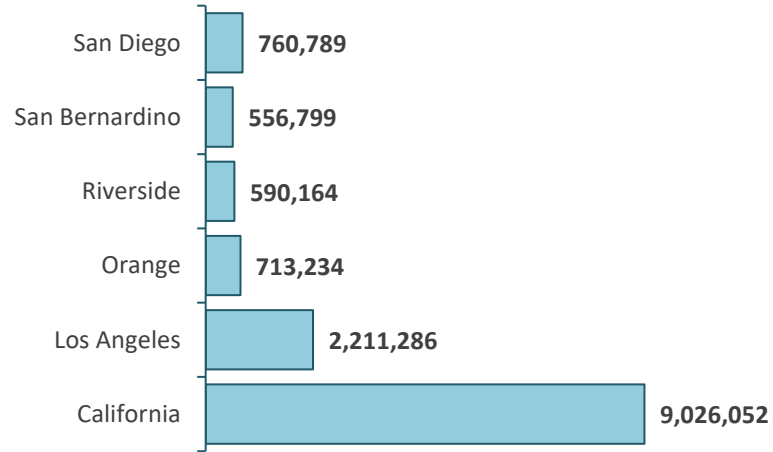

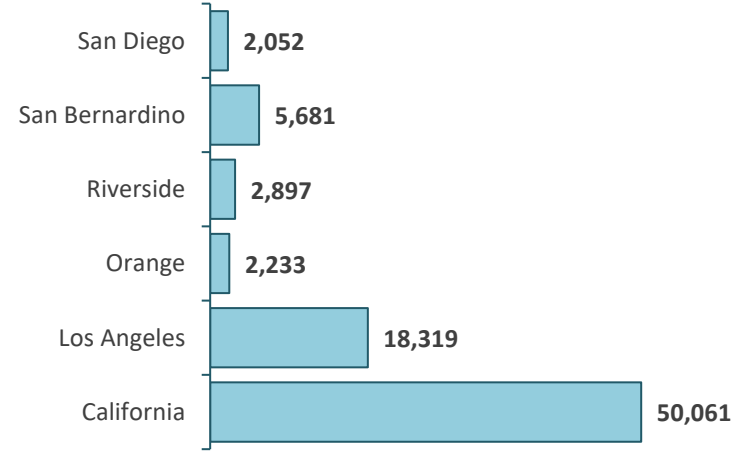

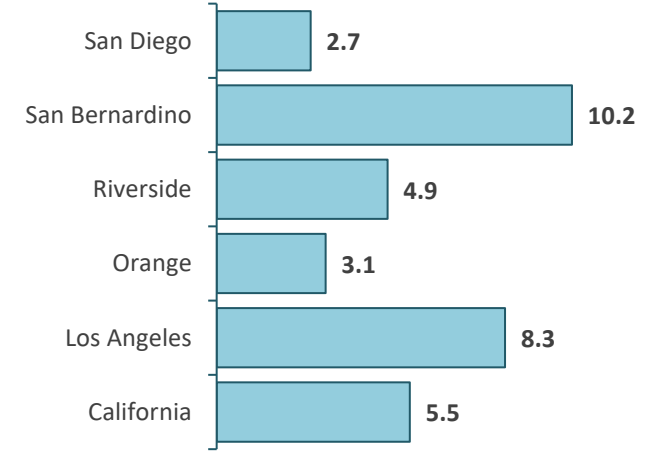

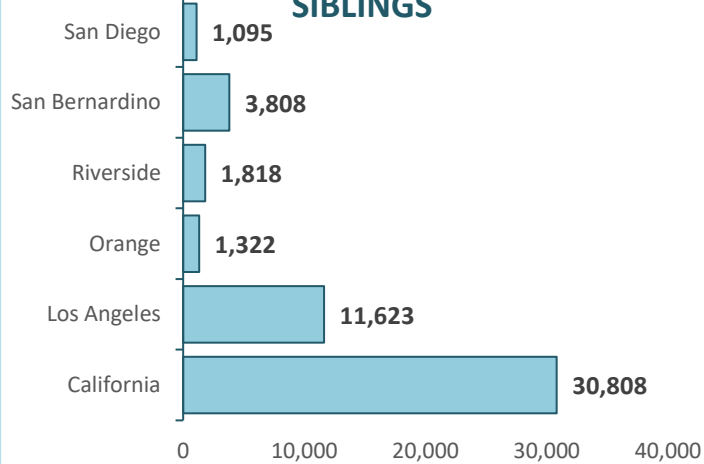
## TOTAL CHILDREN IN OUT-OF-HOME



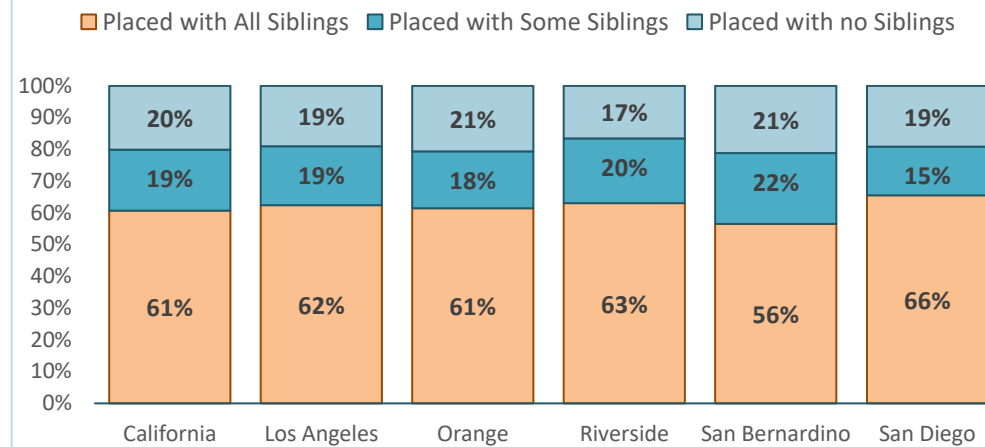
## RATE OF CHILDREN IN OUT-OF-HOME CARE PER 1,000 CHILDREN



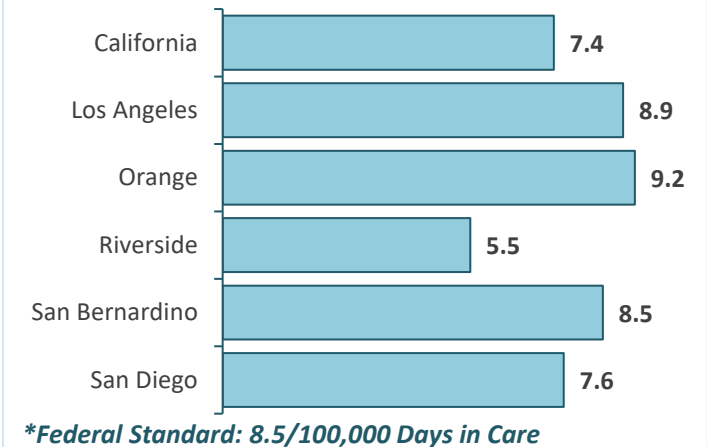
