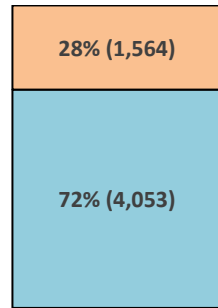

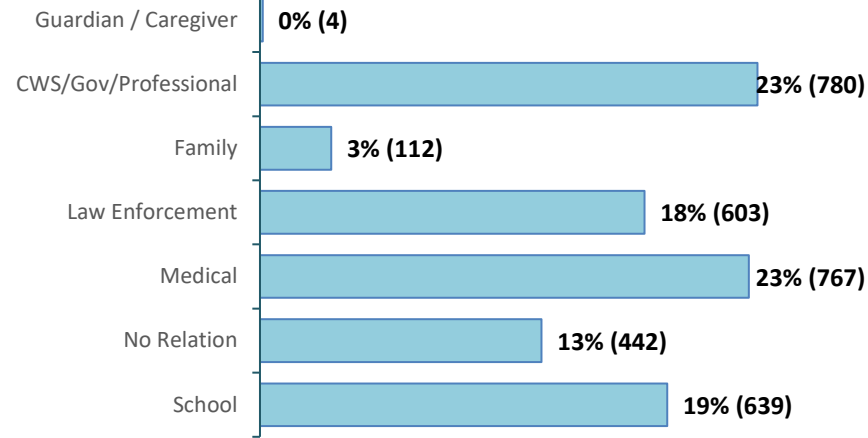

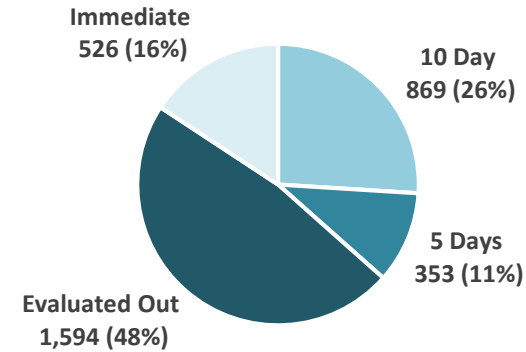

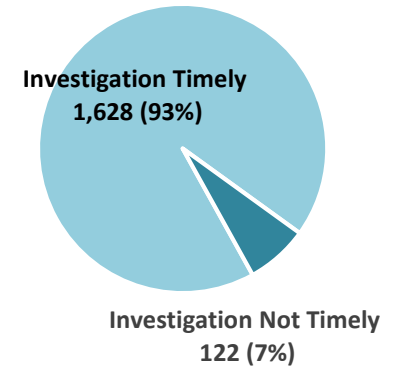

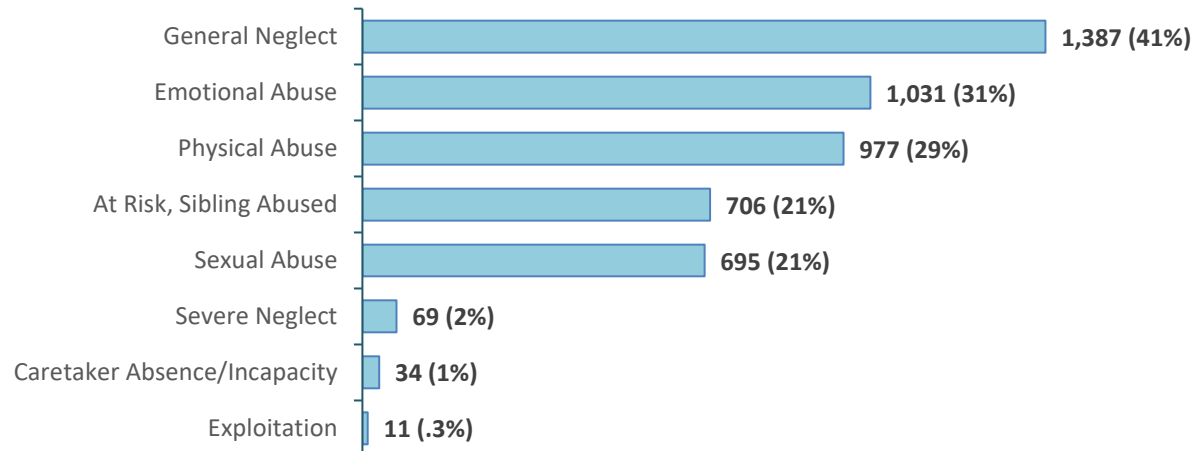
REFERRAL RESPONSE TYPE



TIMELINESS TO INVESTIGATION

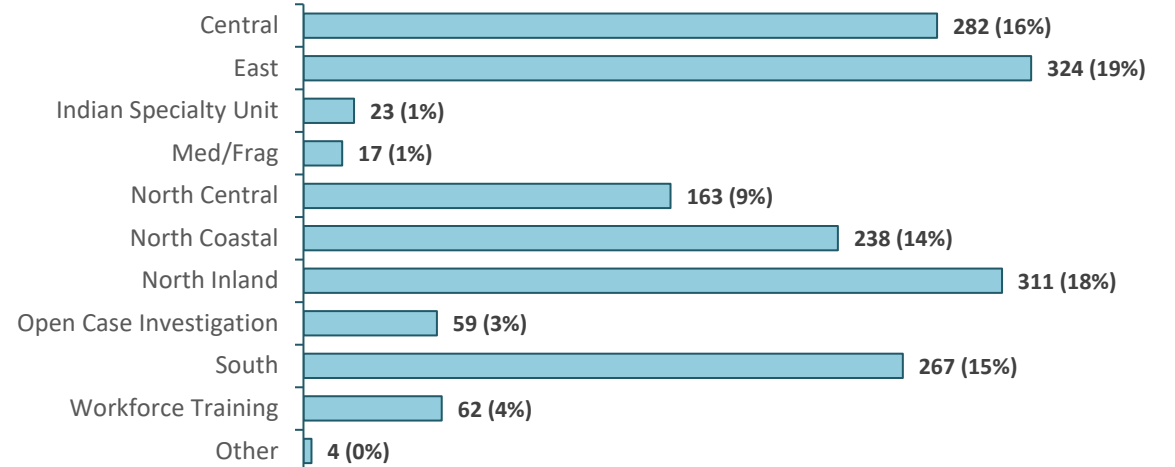


ALLEGATION TYPE

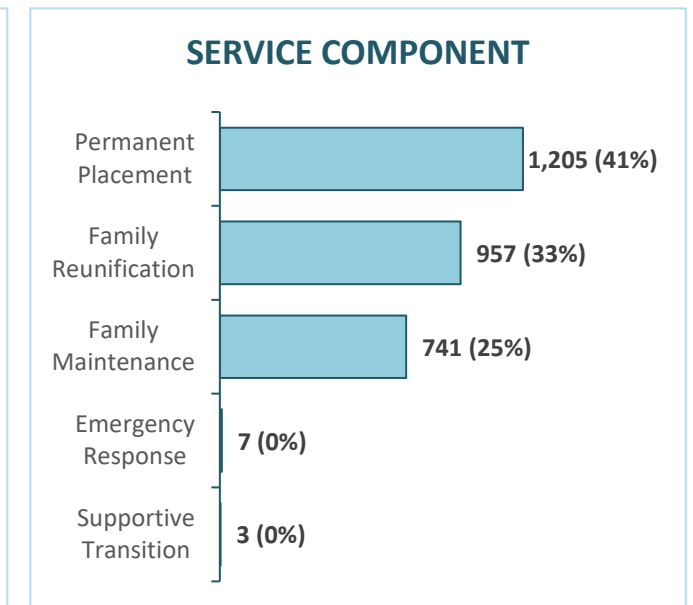
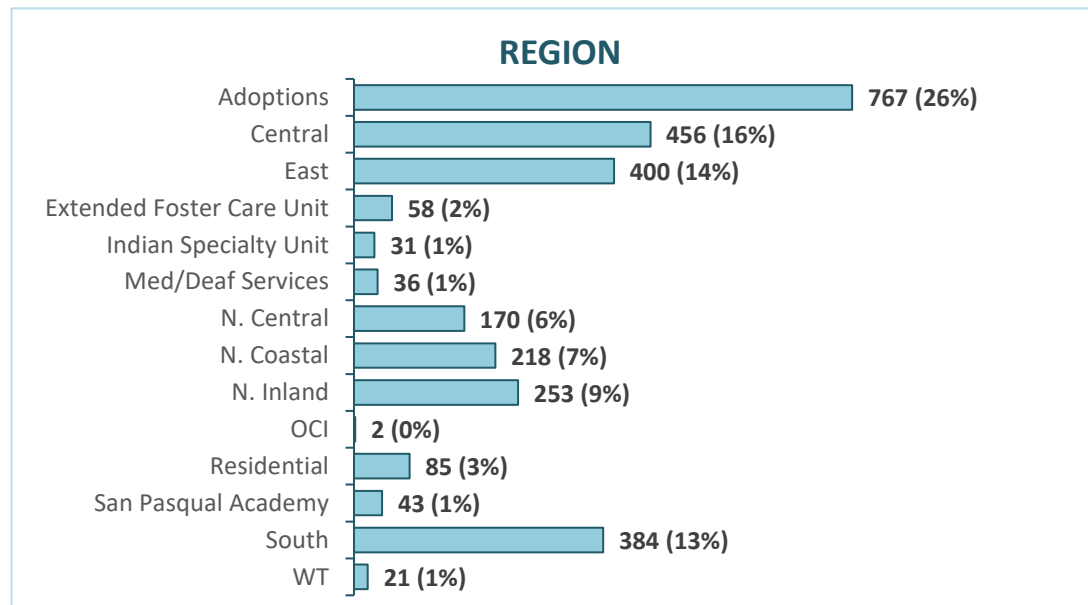
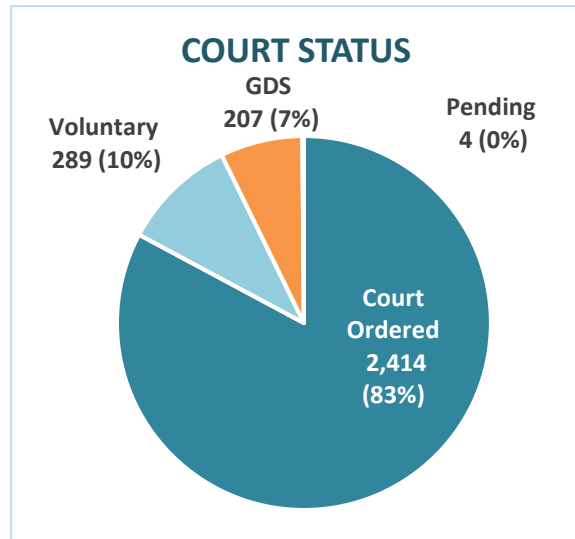
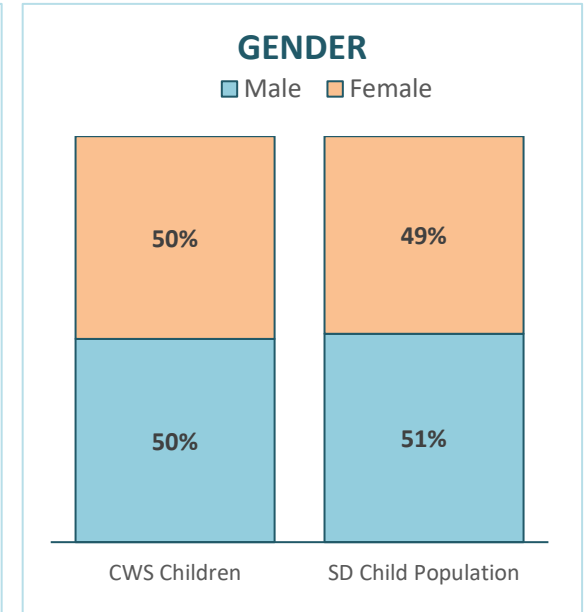
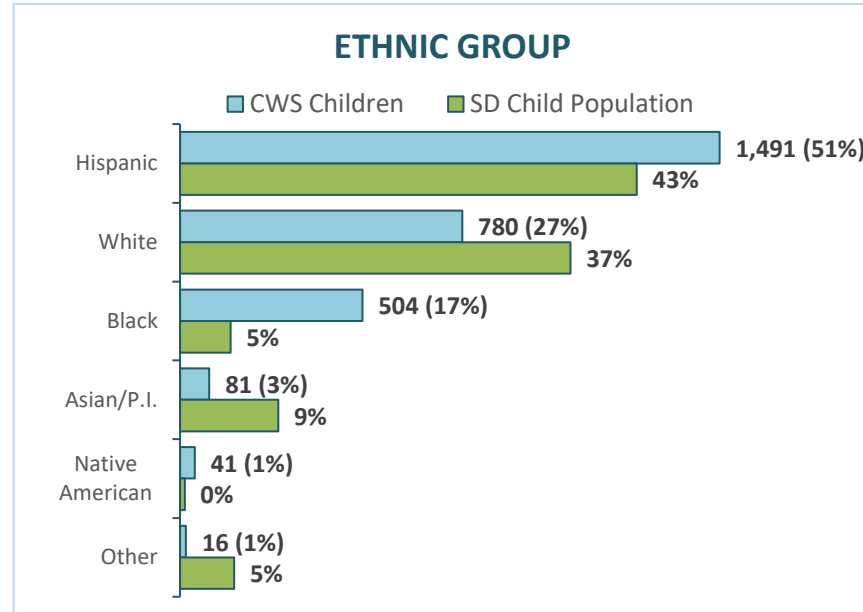
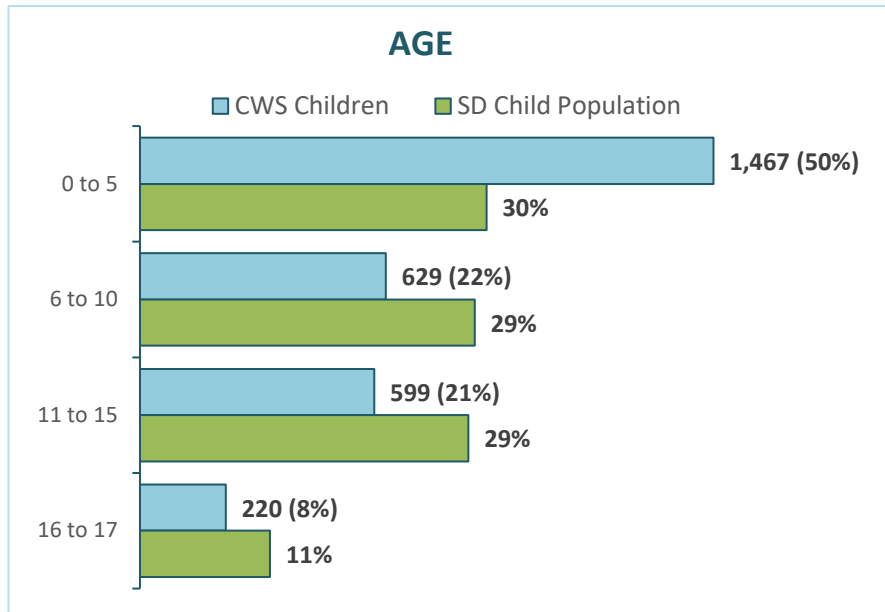


Cases Open each month - Monthly Averages FY2021/22 (through March 2022)

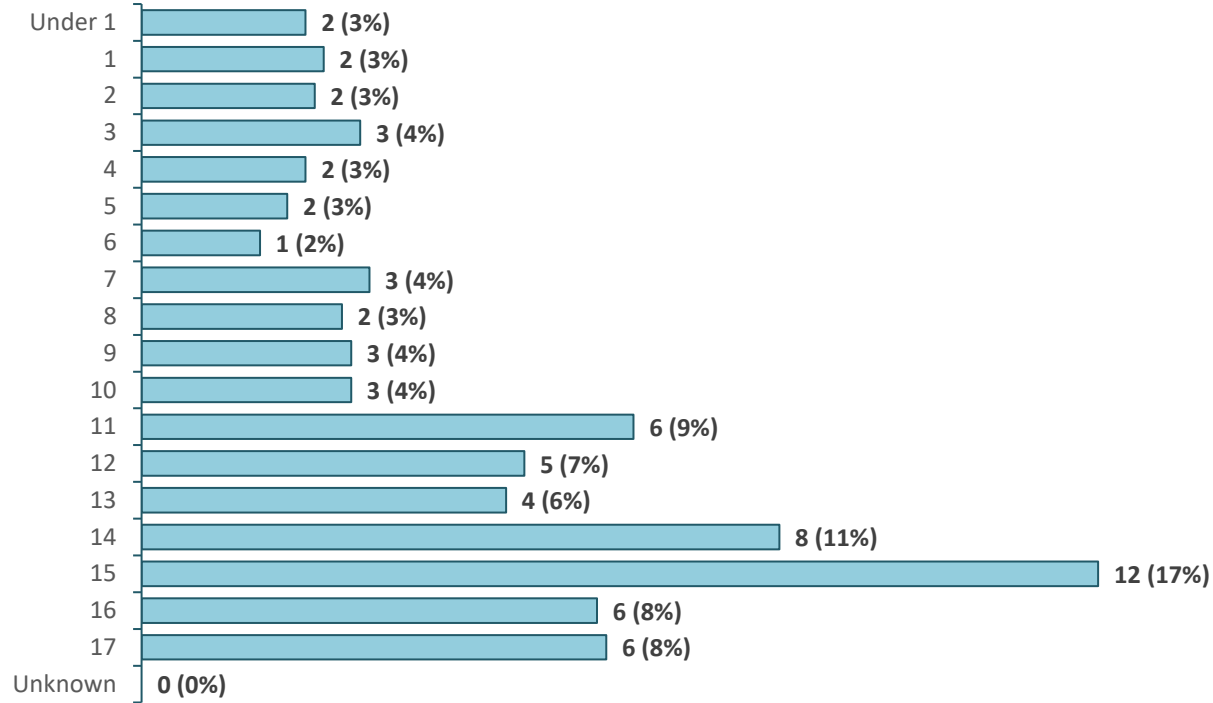

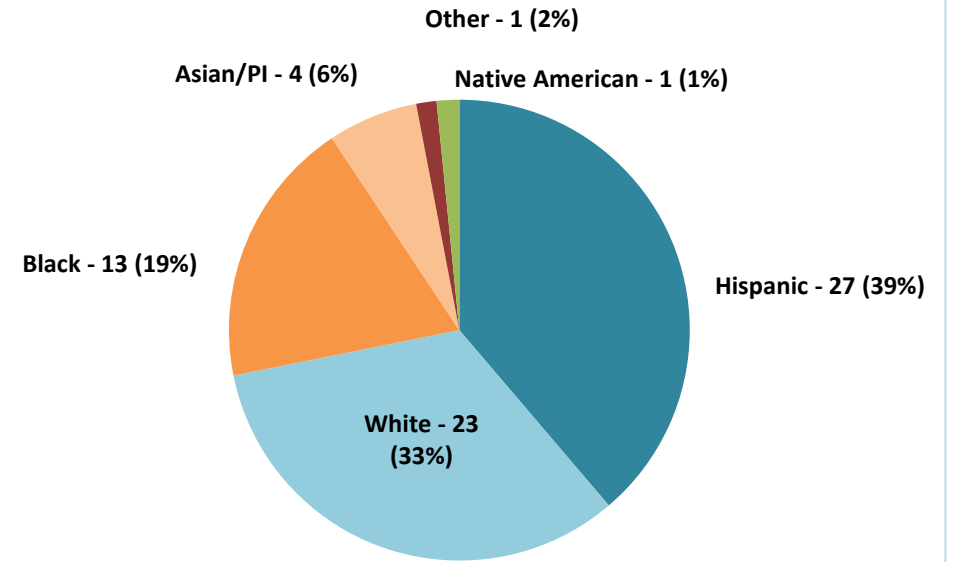

Clients at Polinsky Children's Center by Age (Monthly Average)



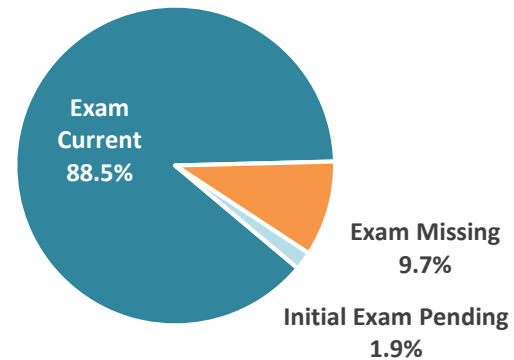
Clients at Polinsky Children's Center by Ethnicity (Monthly Average)



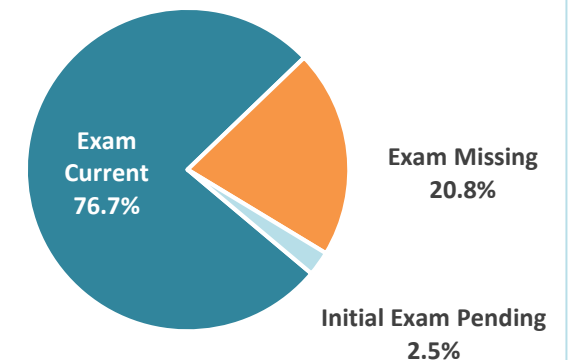

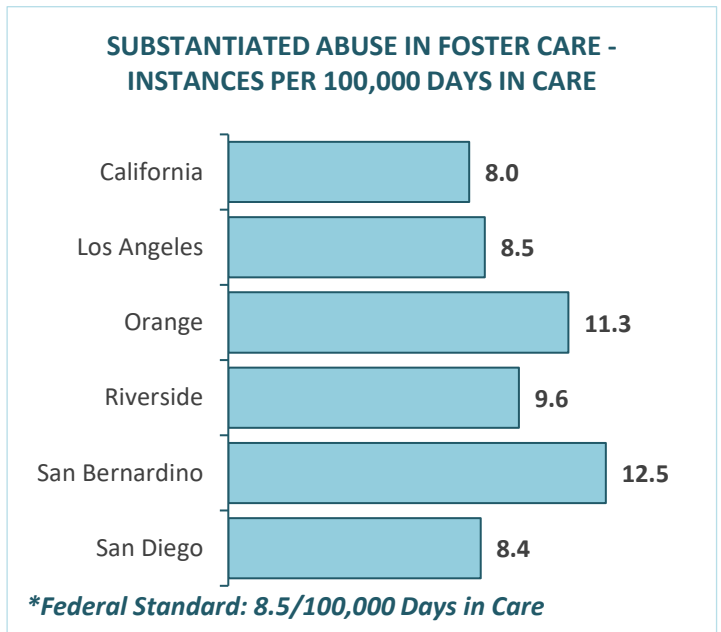
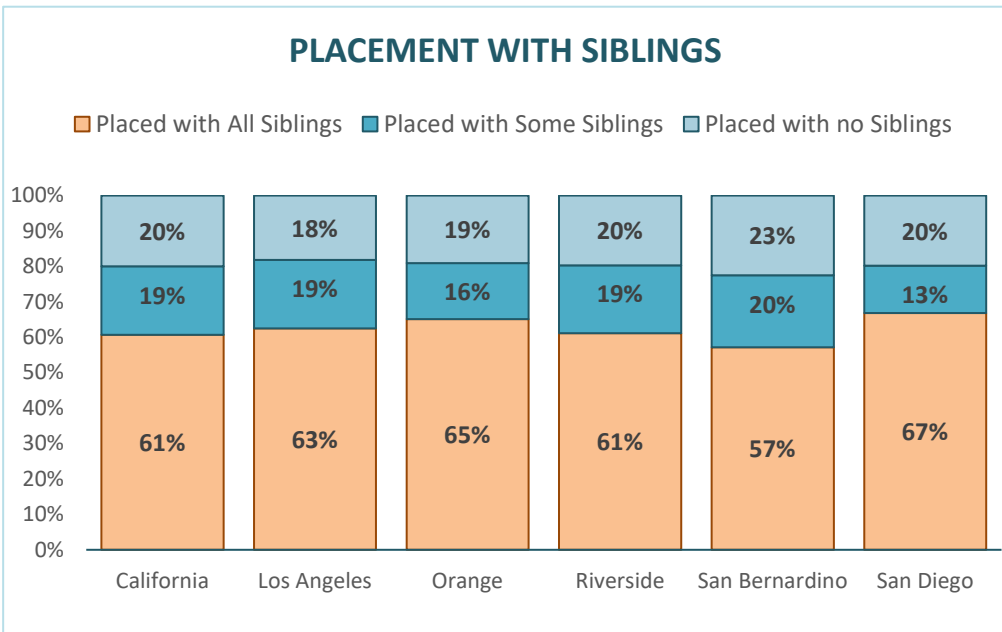
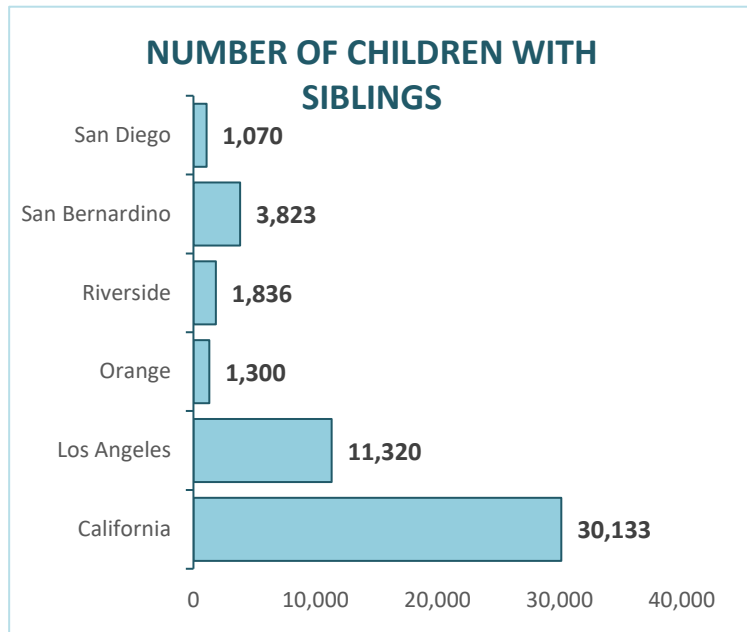
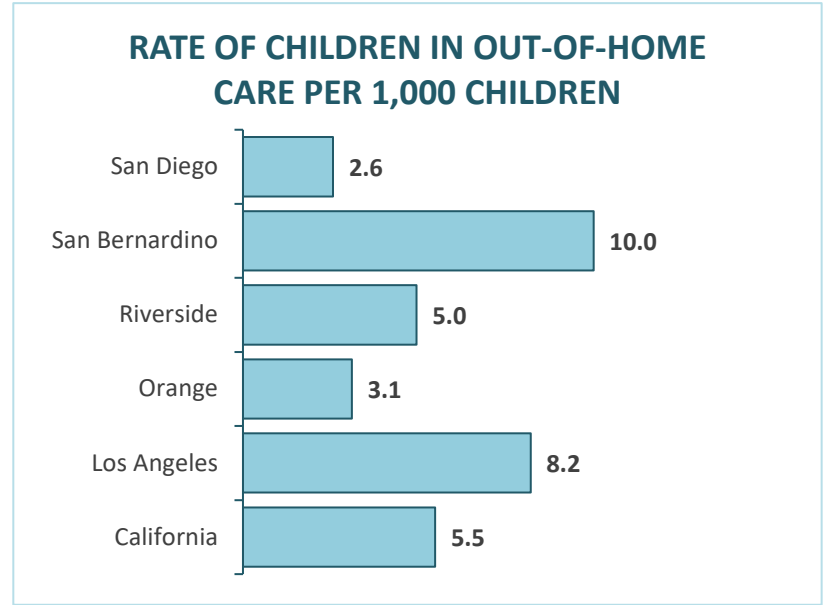
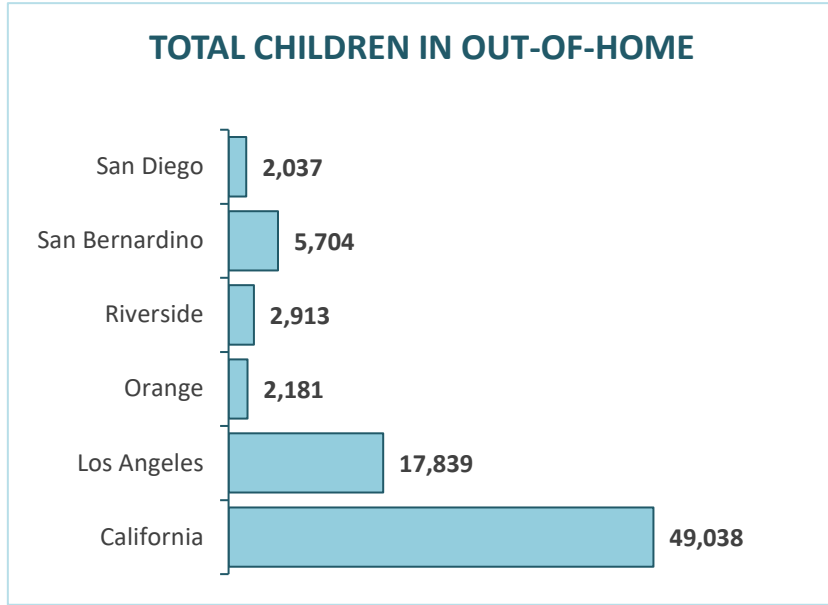
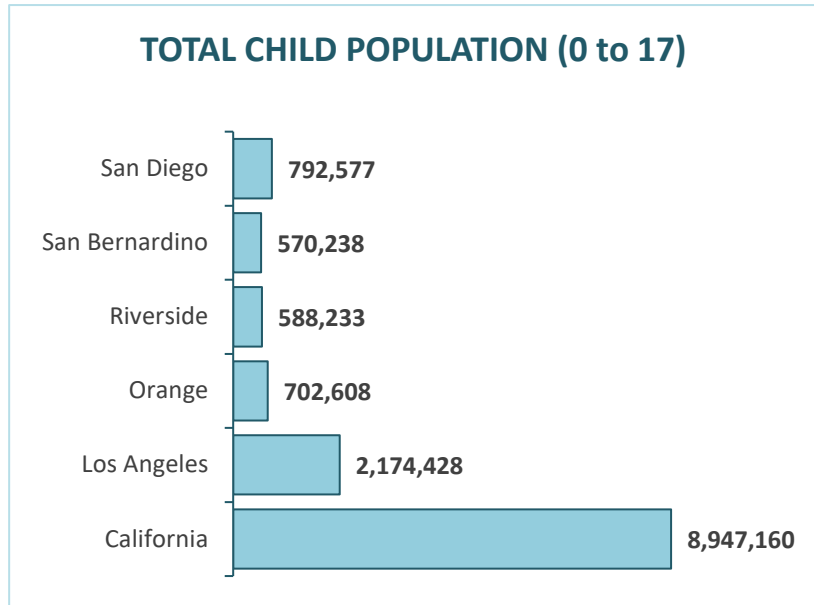


RATE OF SUBSTANTIATED ABUSE IN FOSTER CARE OCT2020-SEP2021
