Ethnicity and Path through Child Welfare Services ¹



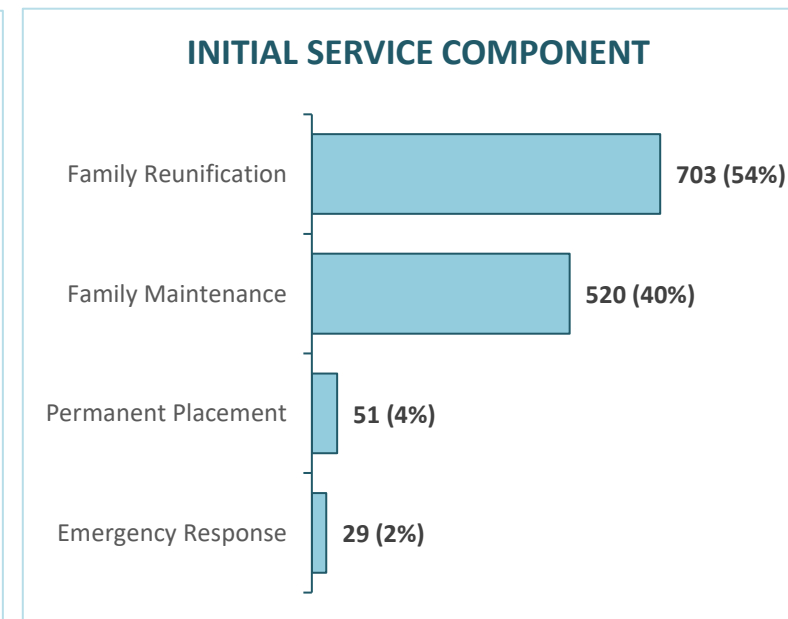
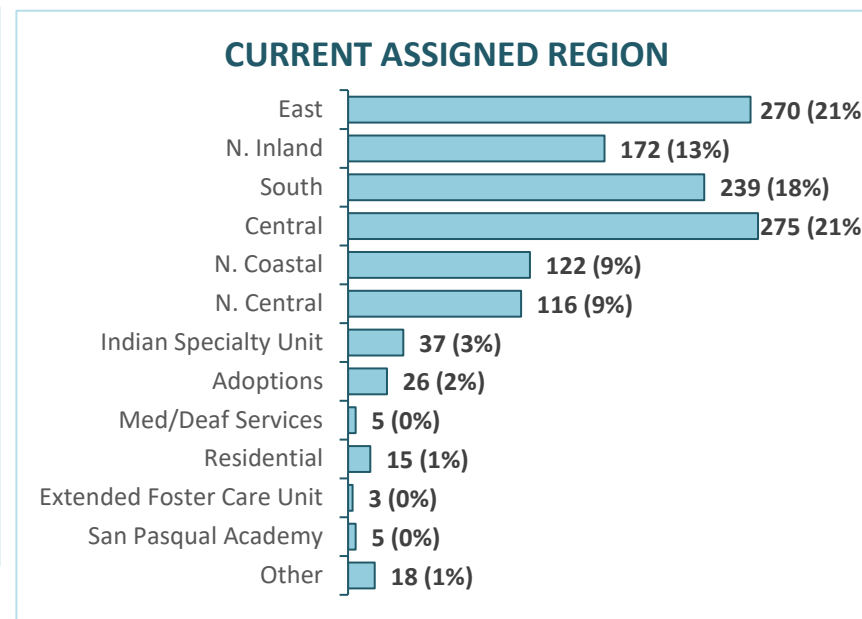
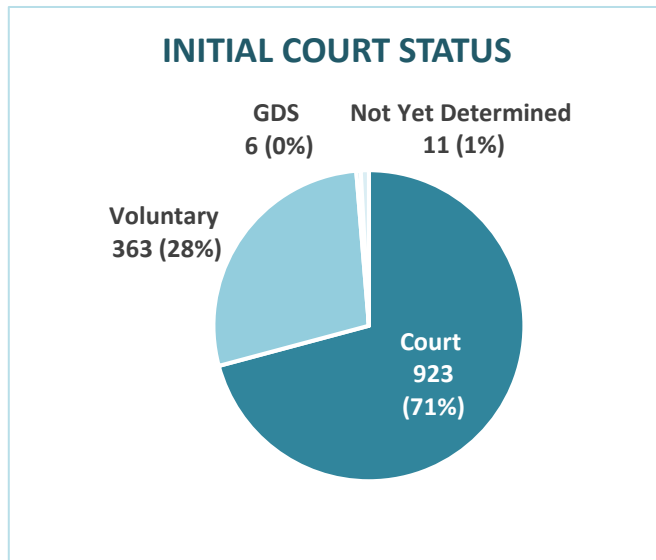
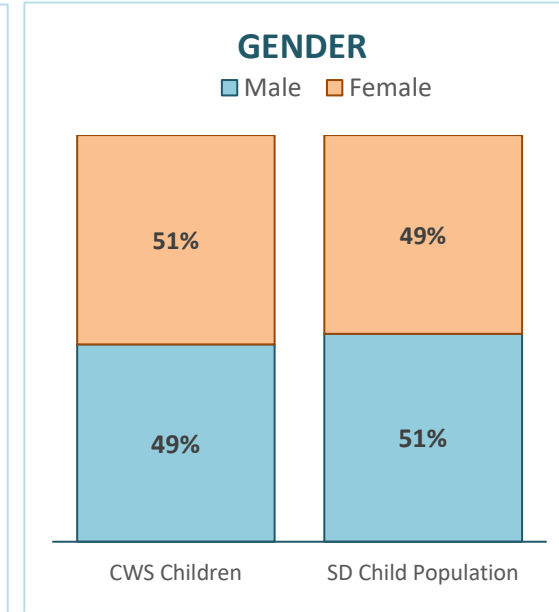
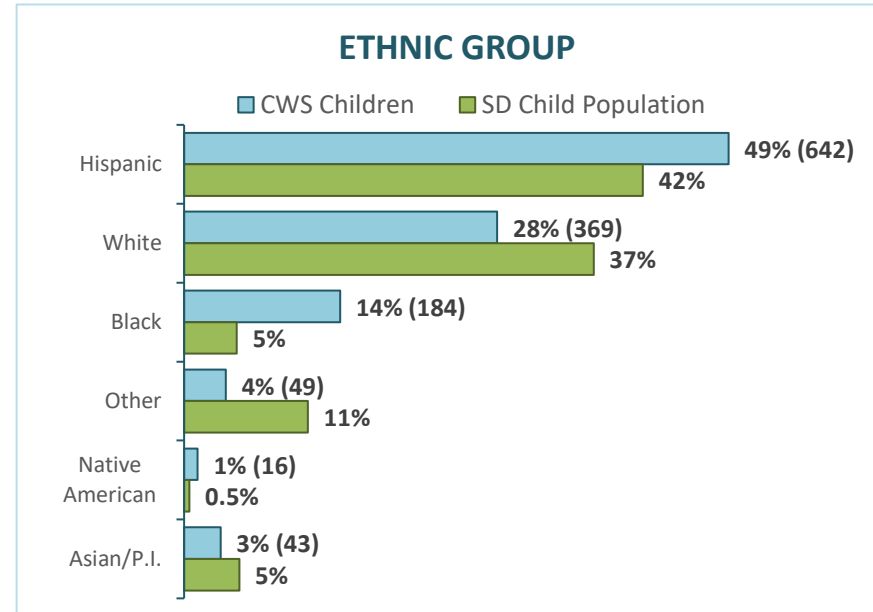
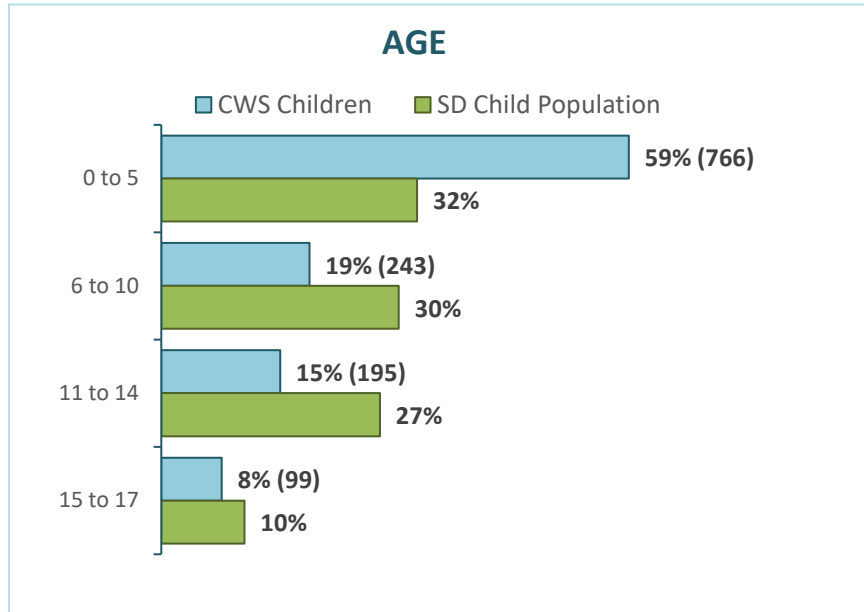

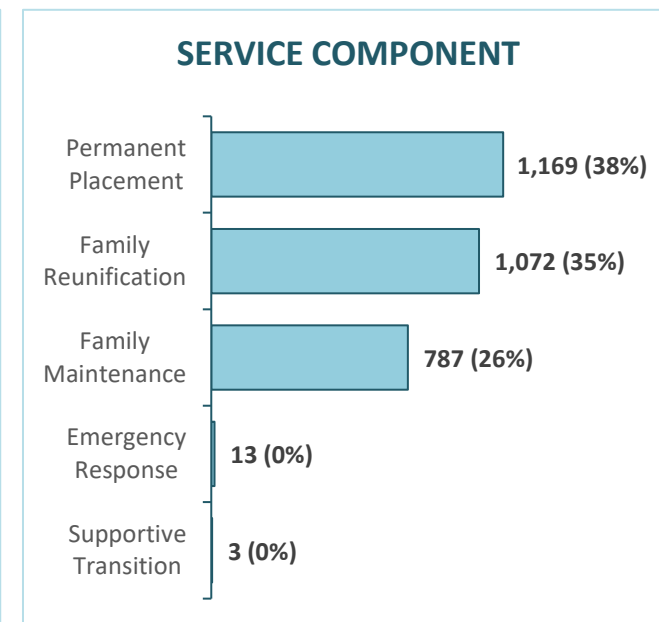
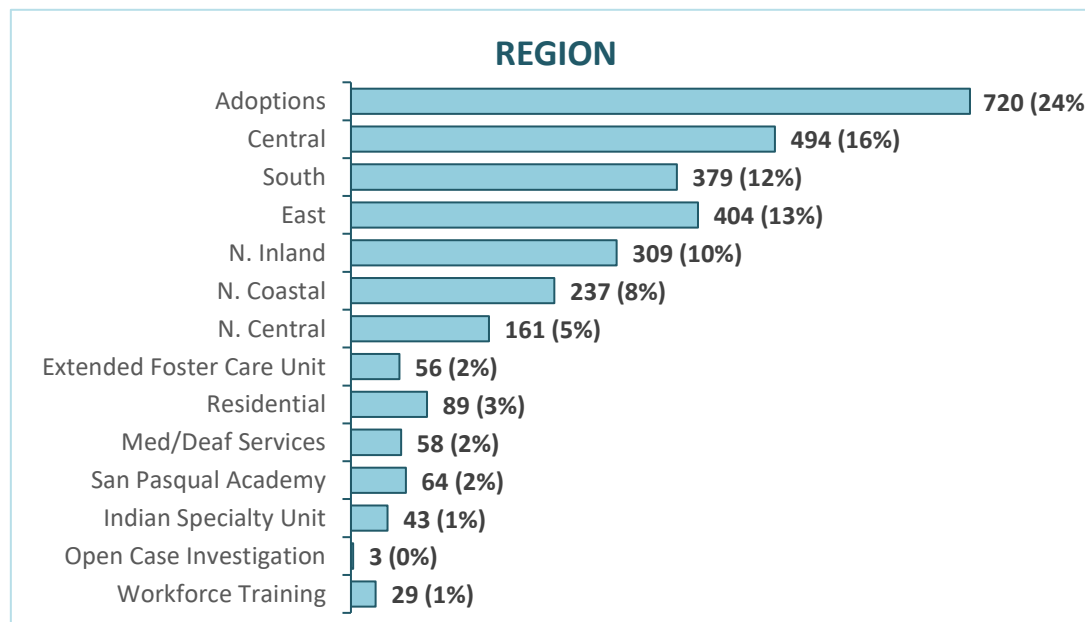
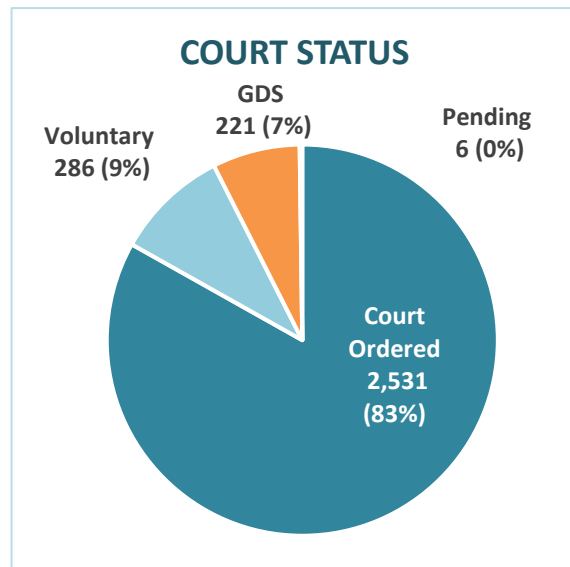
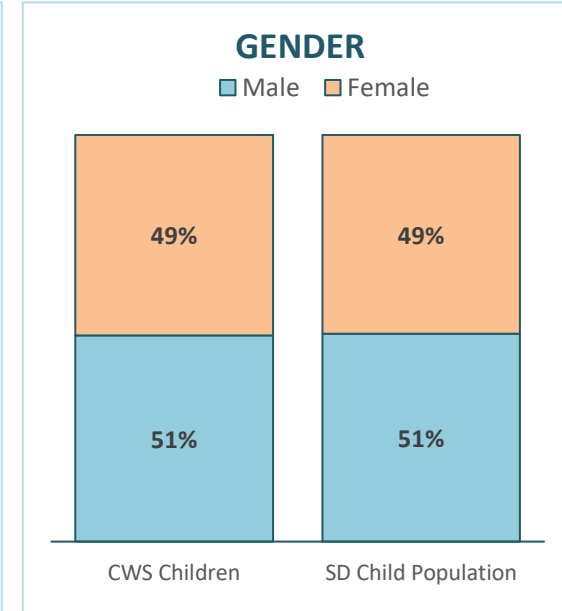
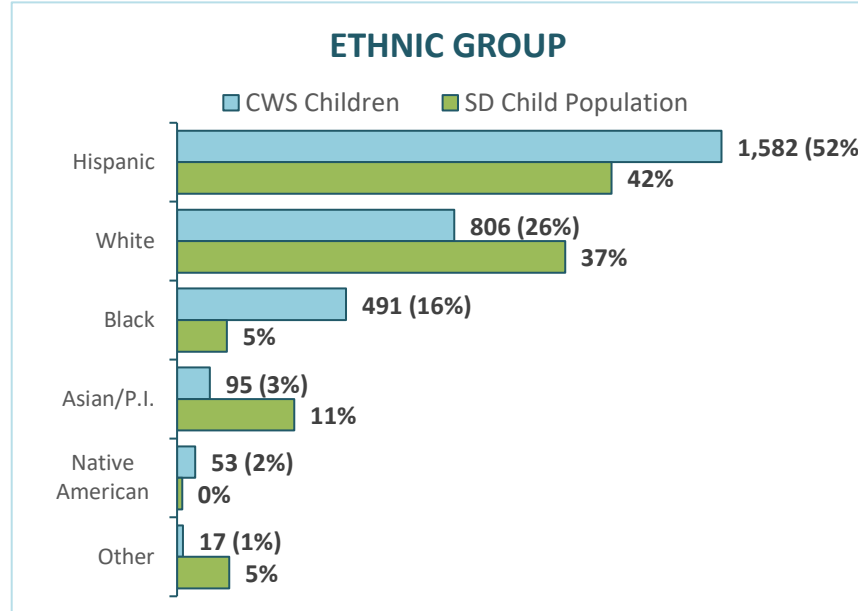
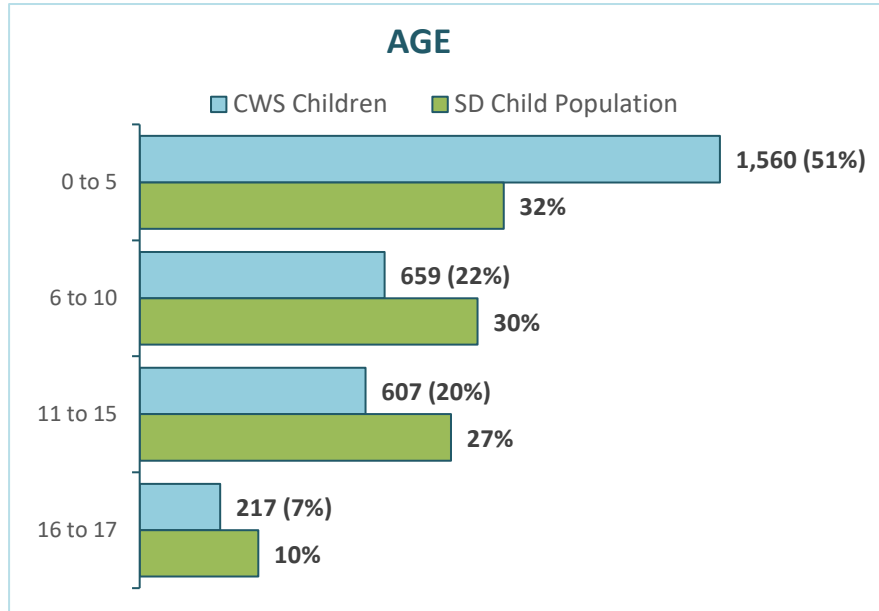


Cases Open each month - Monthly Averages FY2020/21 (through May 2021)

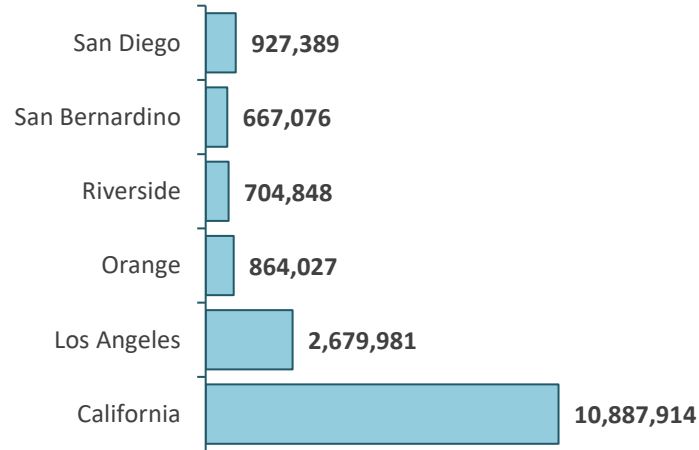

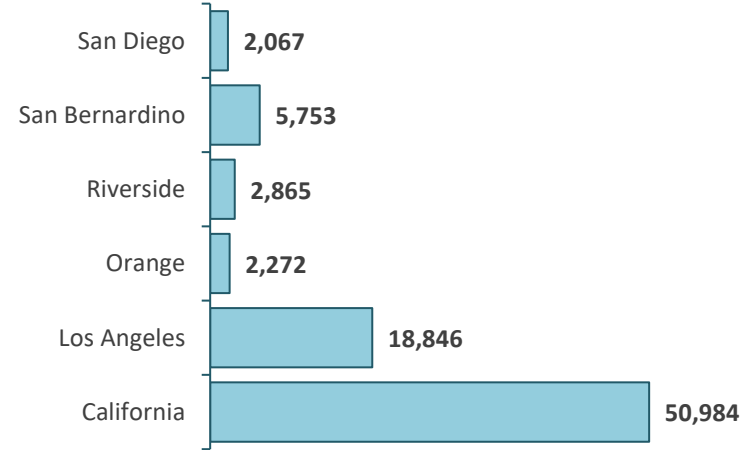

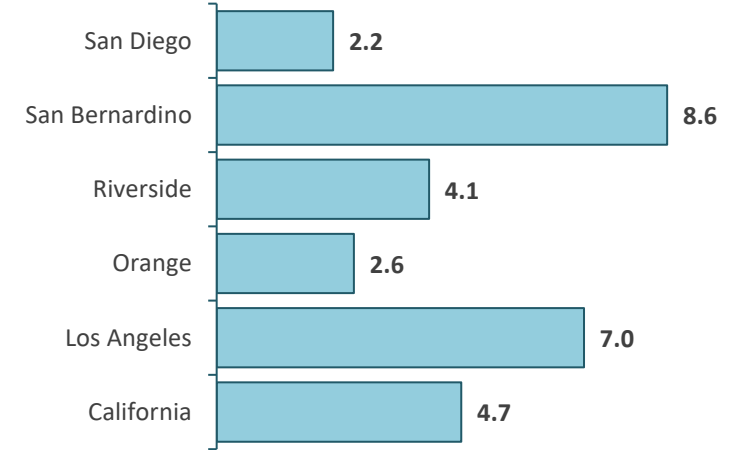

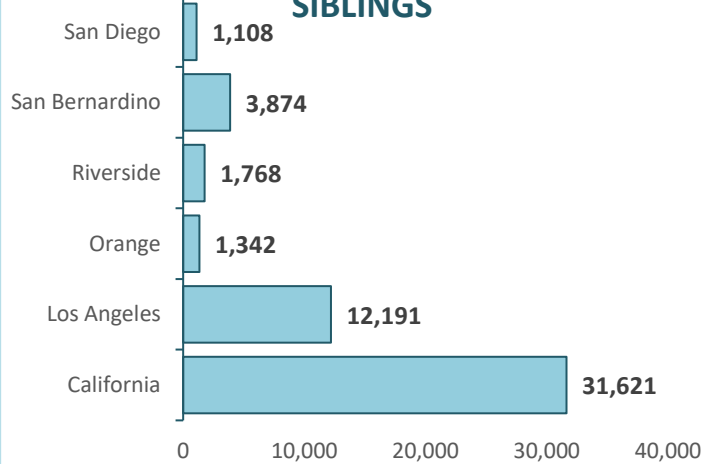
TOTAL CHILDREN IN OUT-OF-HOME



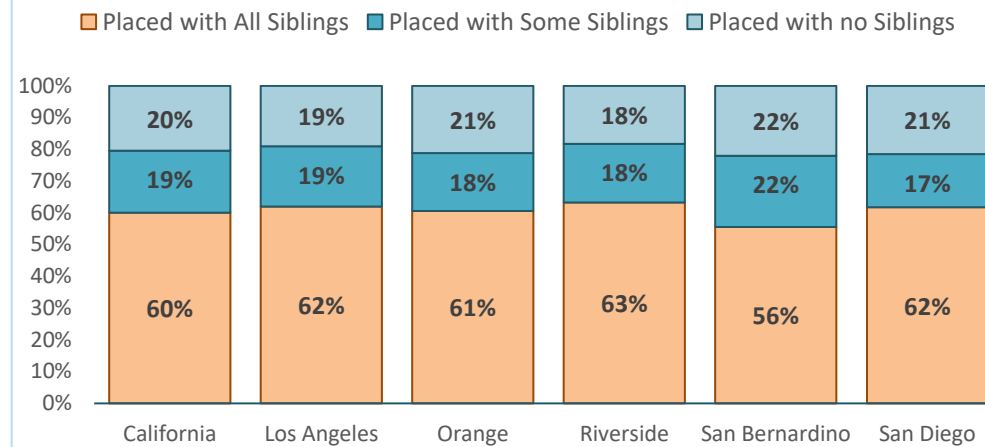
RATE OF CHILDREN IN OUT-OF-HOME CARE PER 1,000 CHILDREN



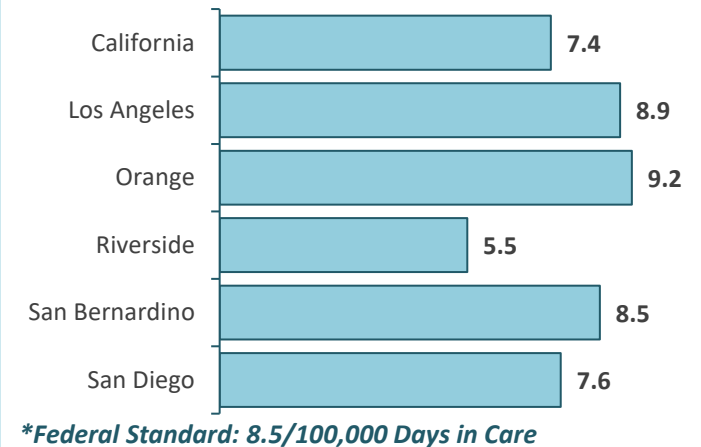

SUBSTANTIATED ABUSE IN FOSTER CARE - INSTANCES PER 100,000 DAYS IN CARE

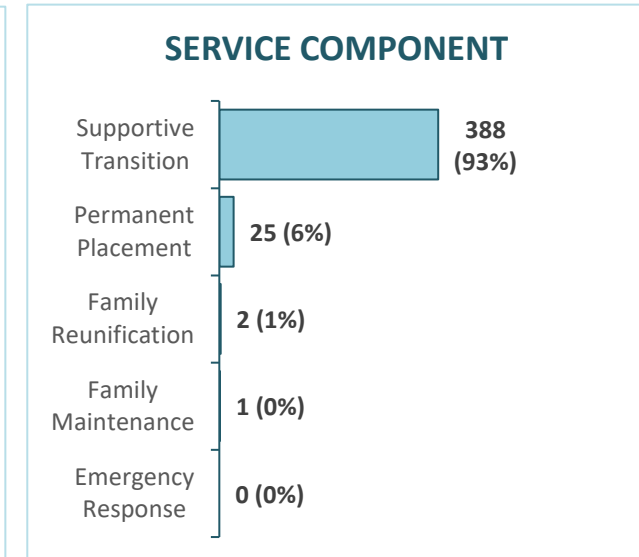
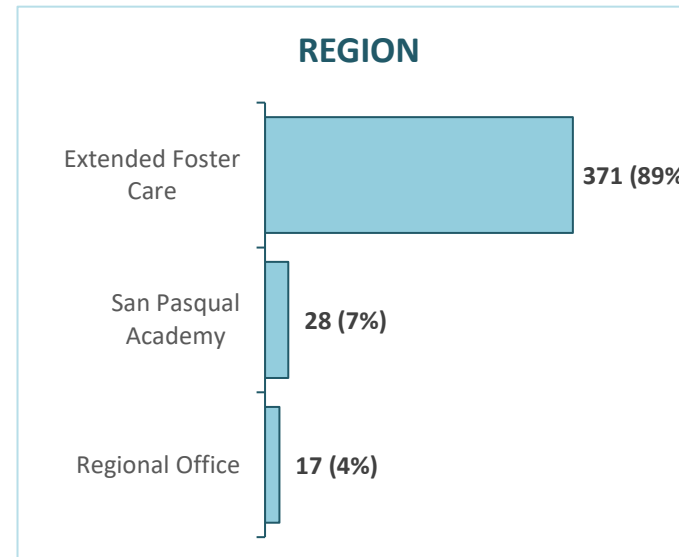
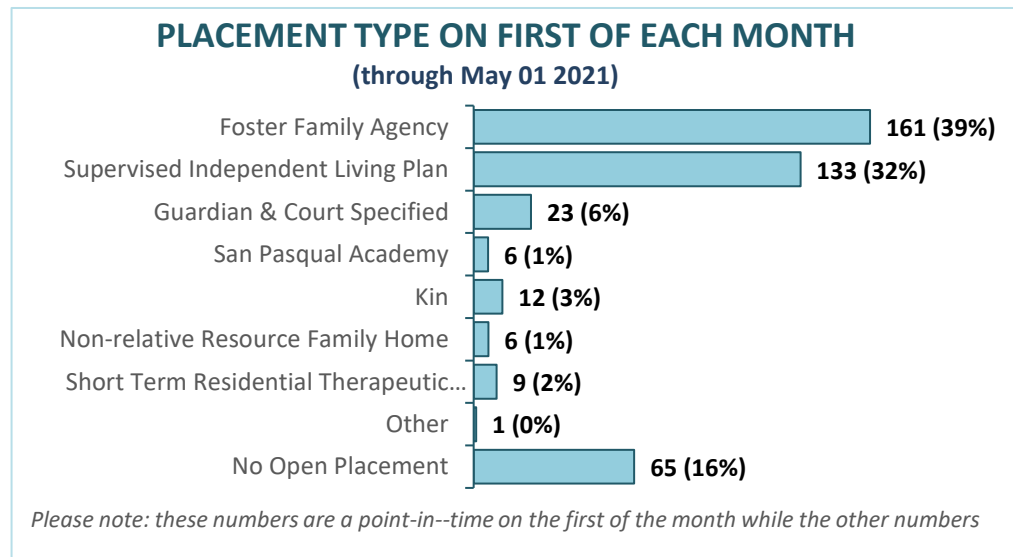
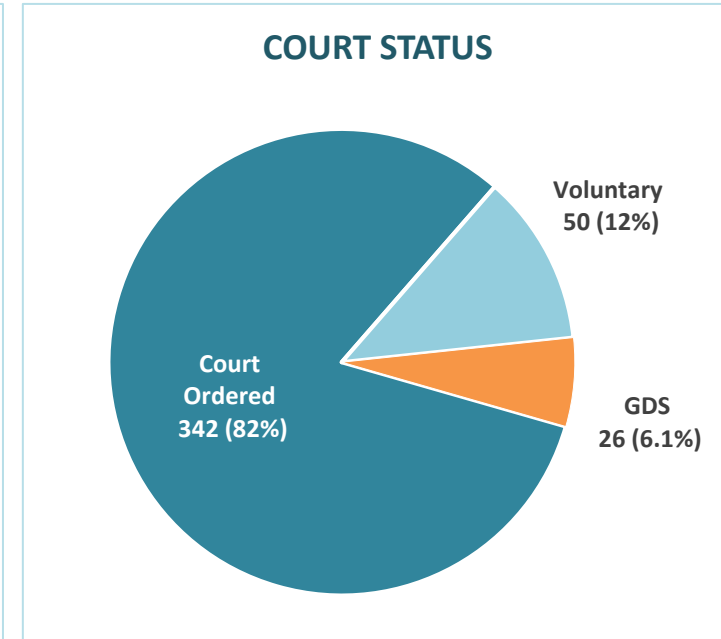
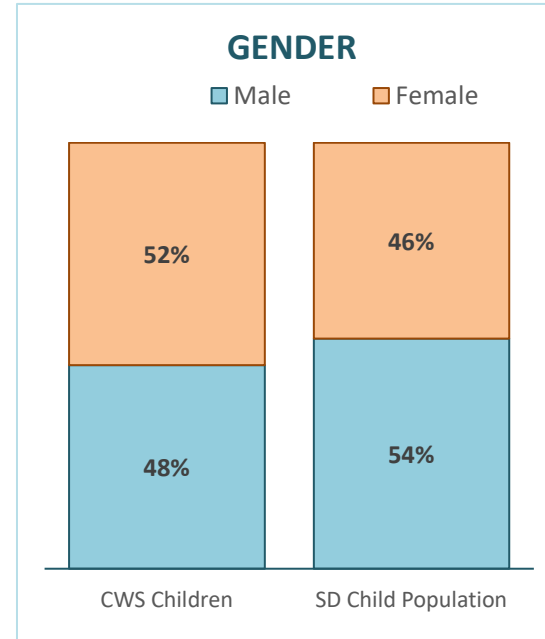
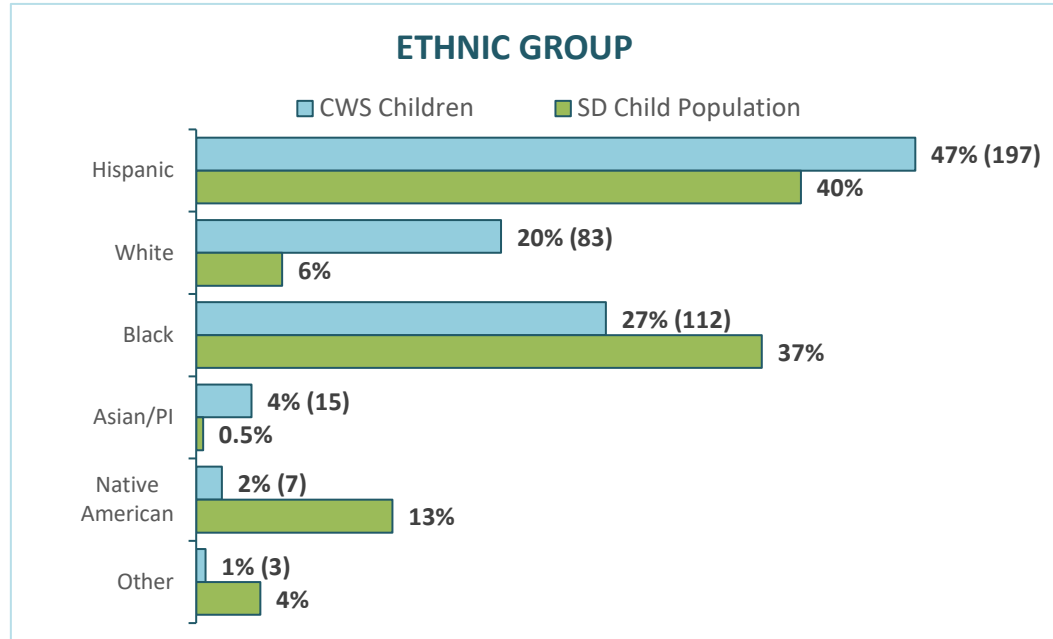

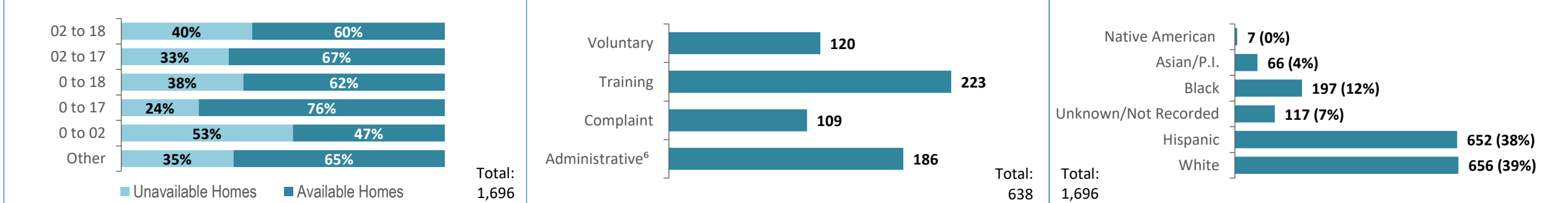

Home Accepted Age Range⁴ (by Availability) / Homes on Hold⁵ / Ethnicity of the Substitute Care Provider

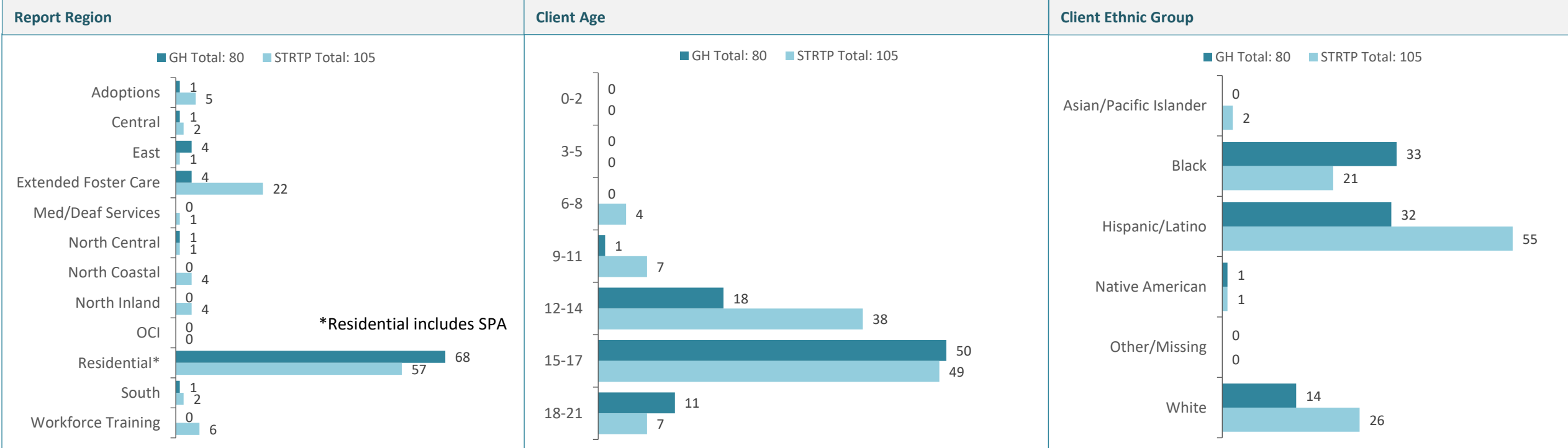
