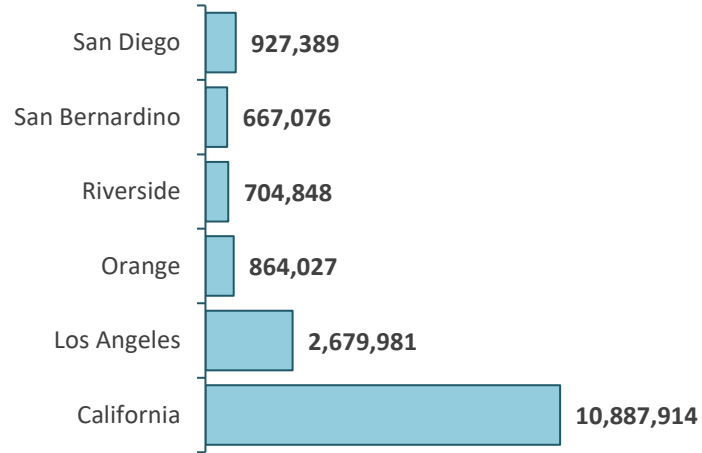

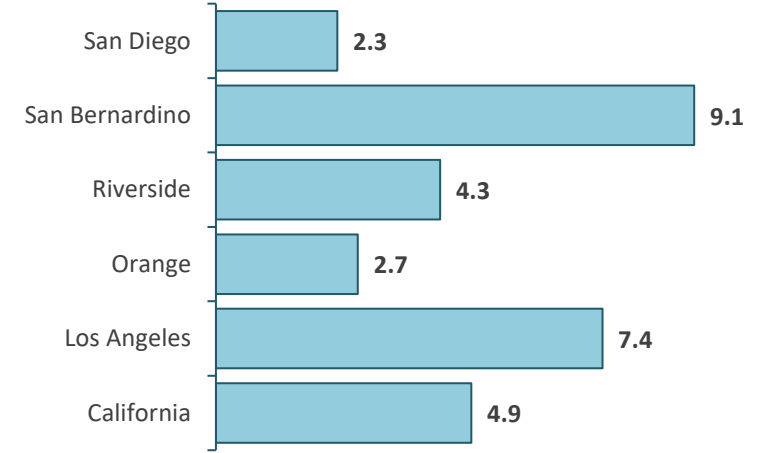

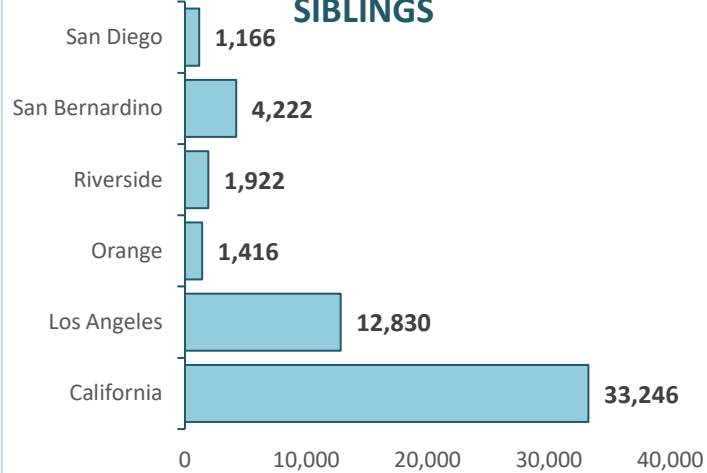
## TOTAL CHILDREN IN OUT-OF-HOME



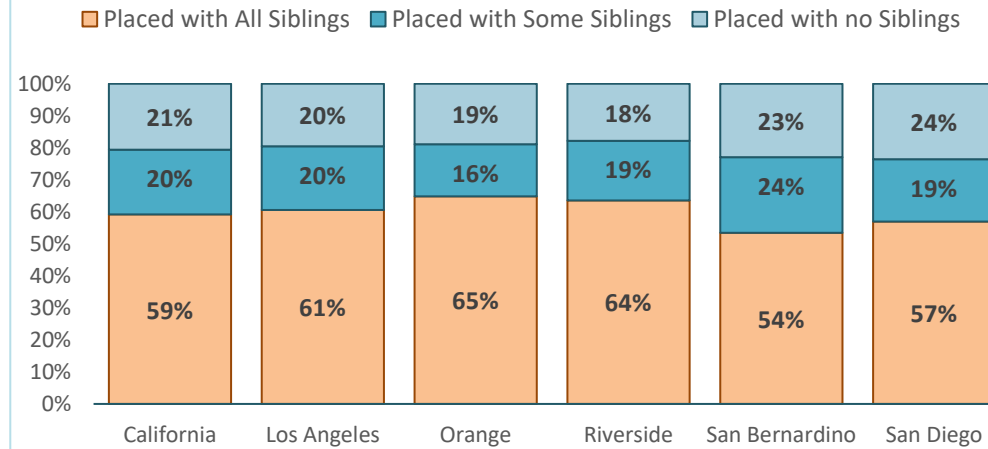
## RATE OF CHILDREN IN OUT-OF-HOME CARE PER 1,000 CHILDREN



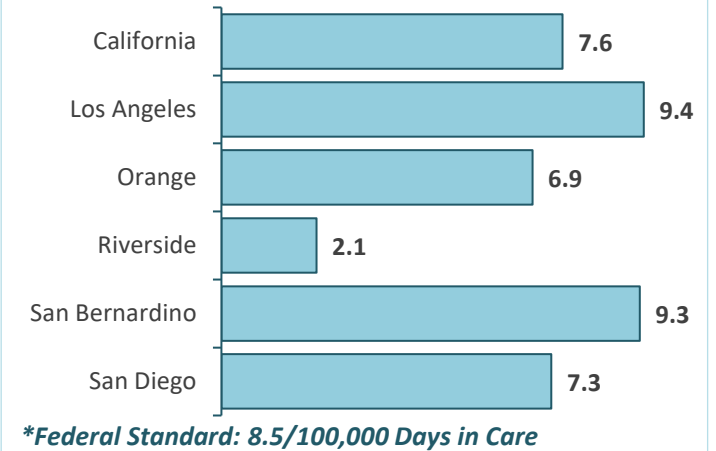

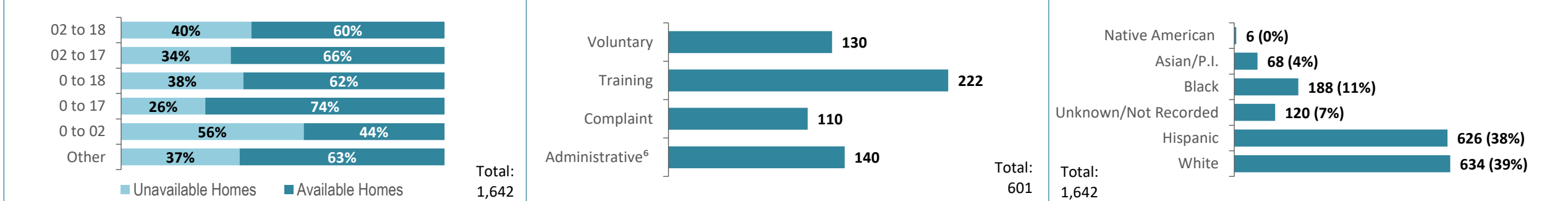
