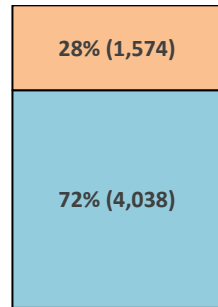

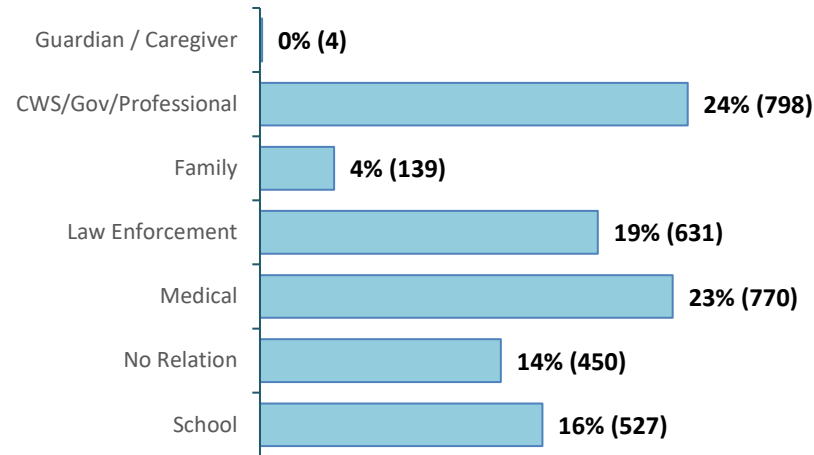

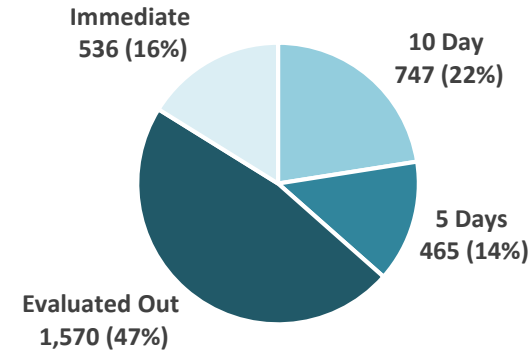

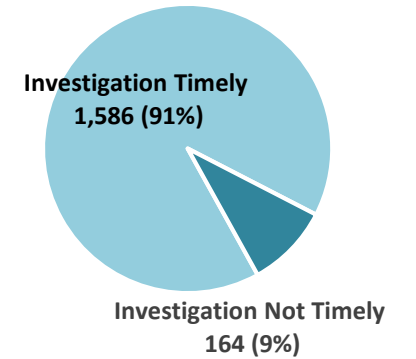

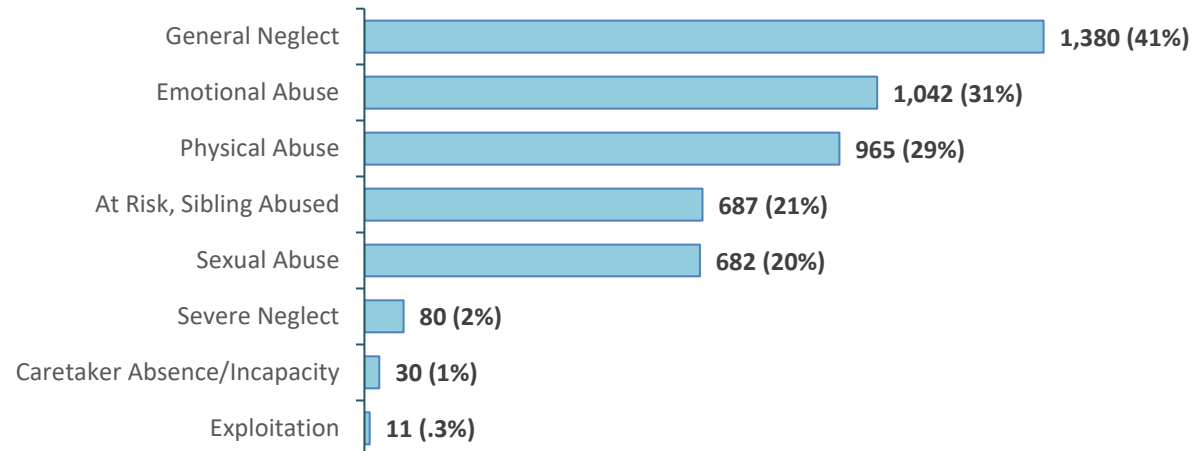

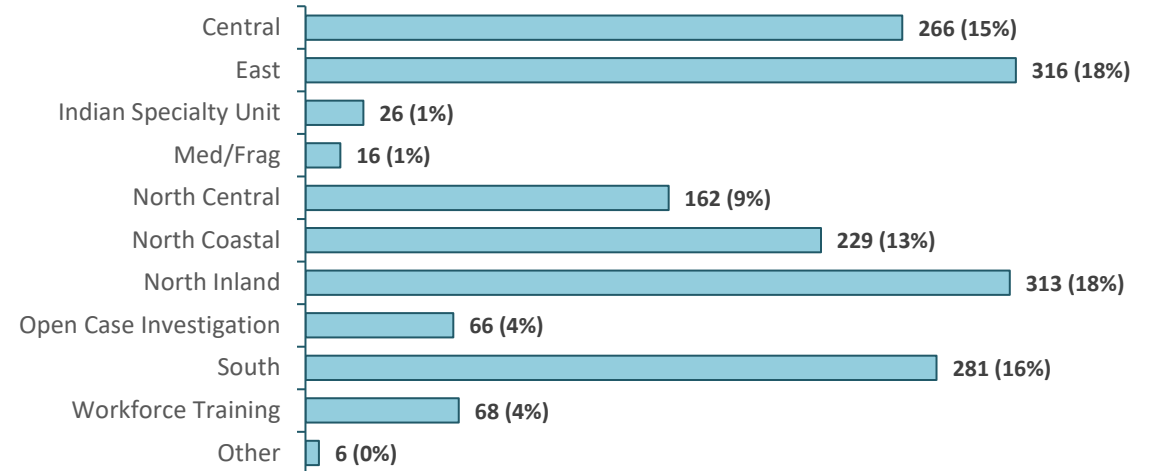


### ALLEGATION TYPE

# Ethnicity and Path through Child Welfare Services <sup>1</sup>



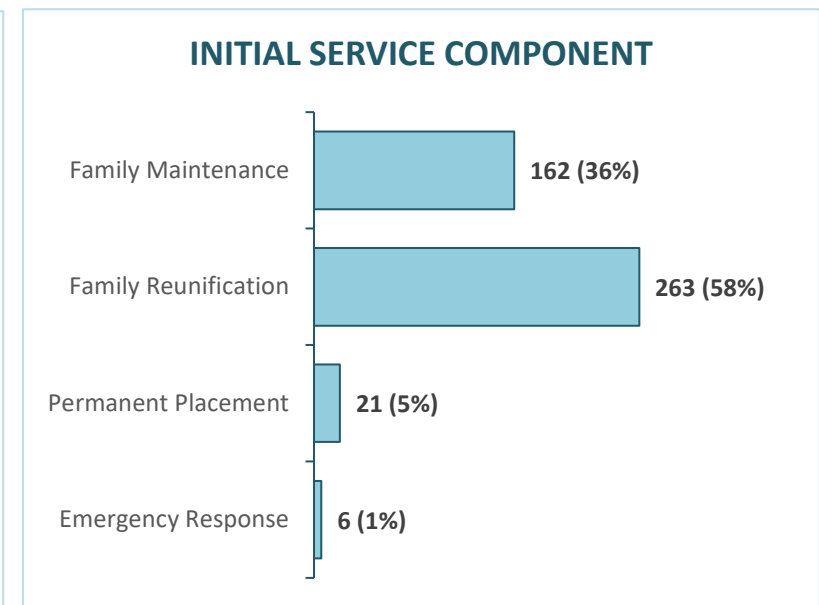
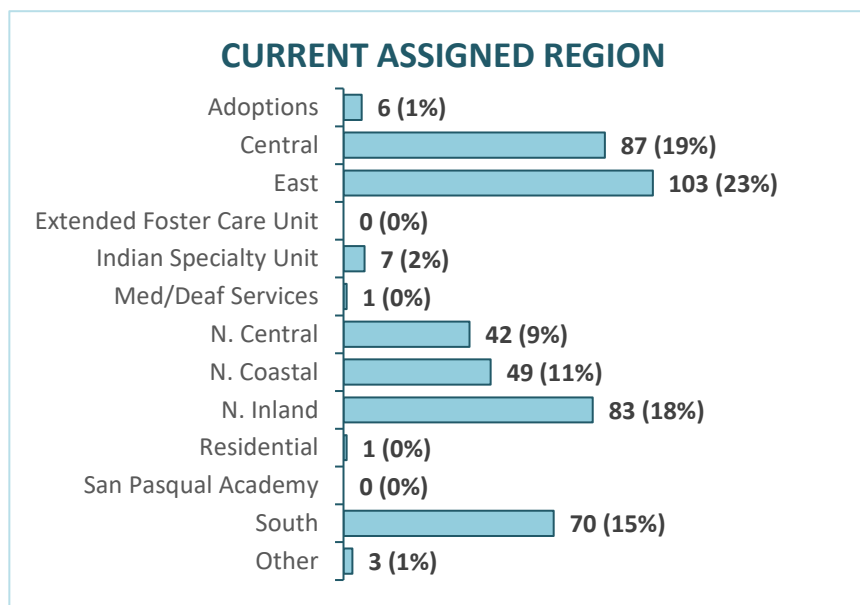
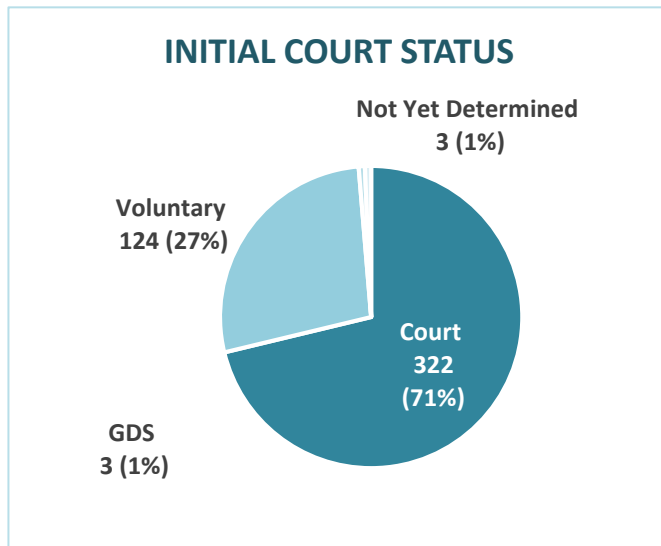
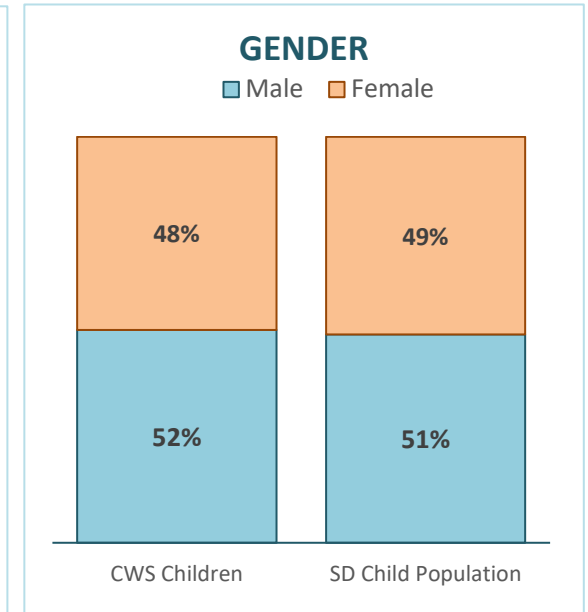
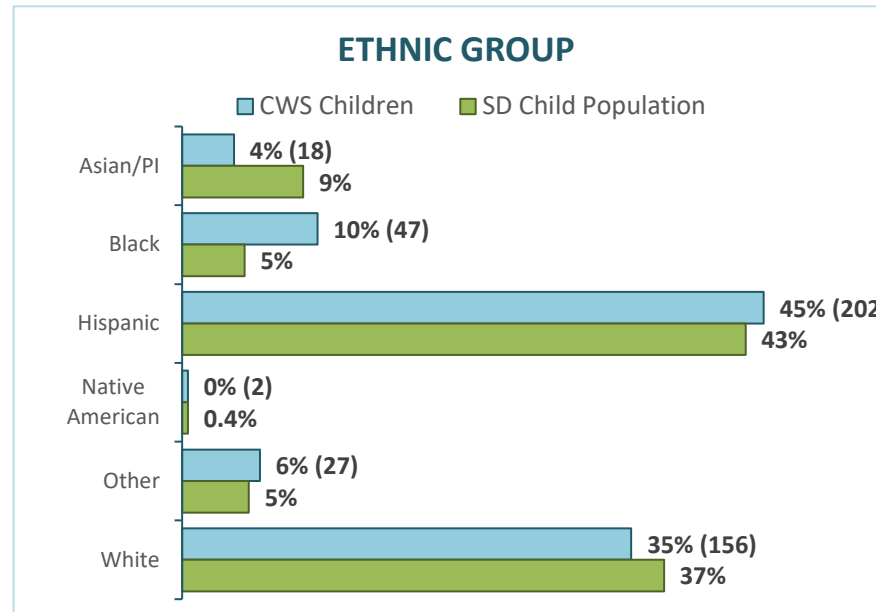
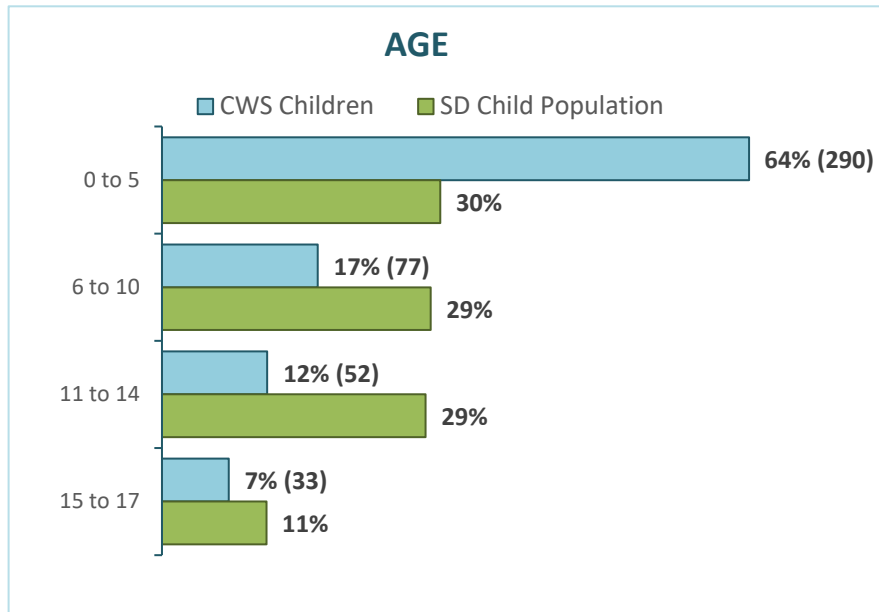

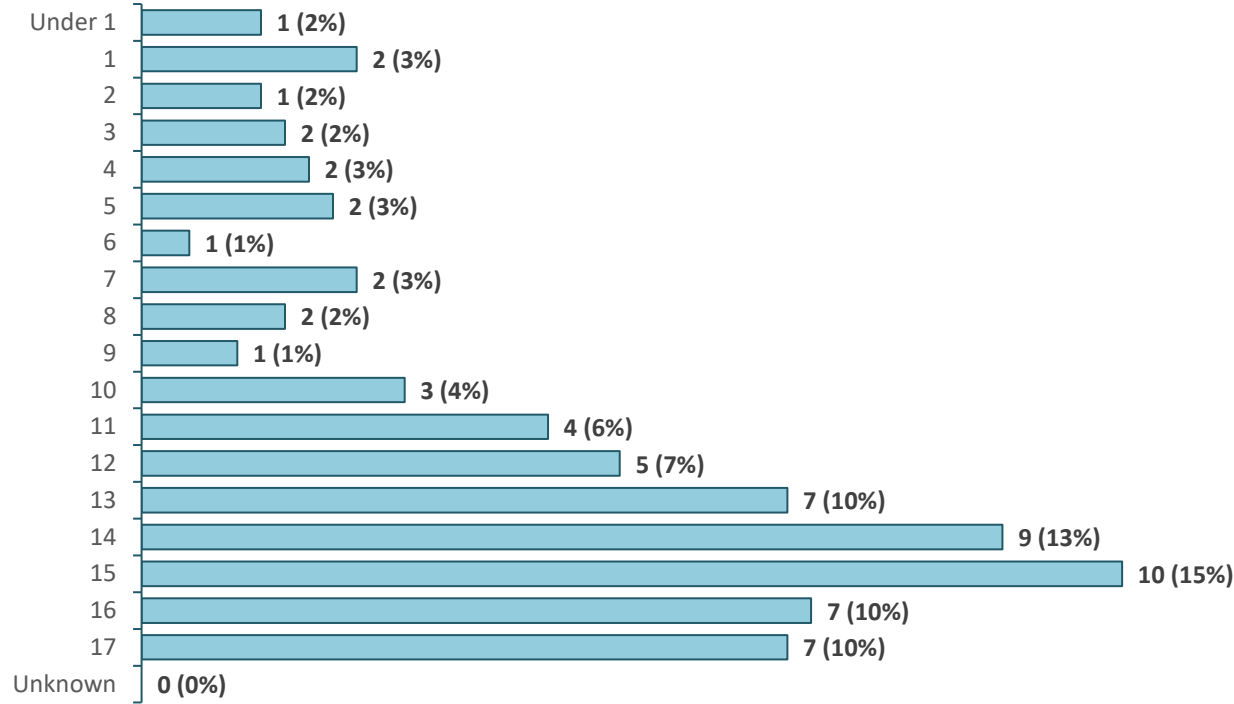

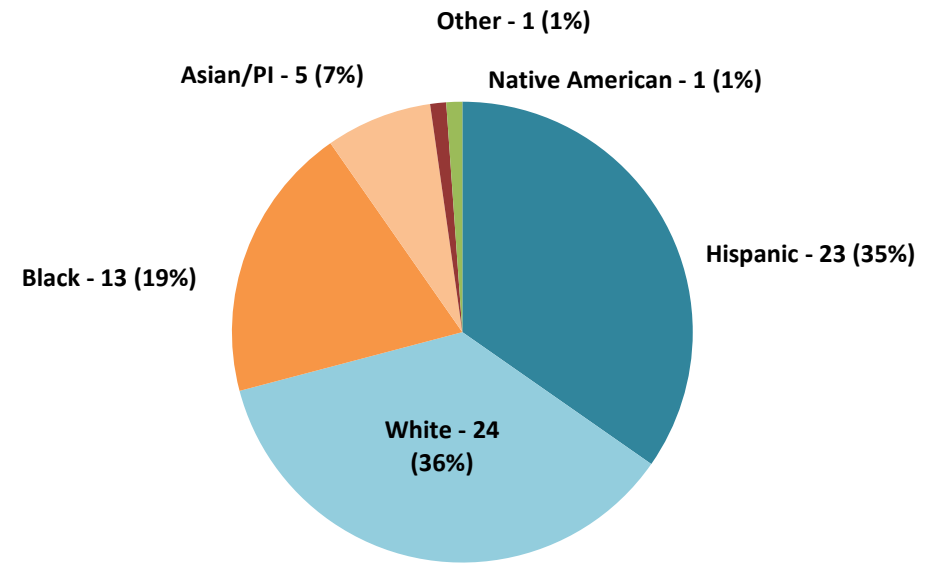

### Clients at Polinsky Children's Center by Age (Monthly Average)



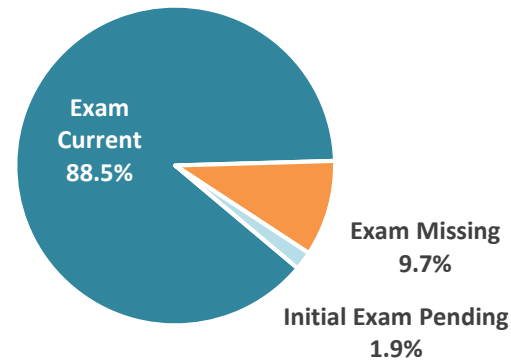
### Clients at Polinsky Children's Center by Ethnicity (Monthly Average)



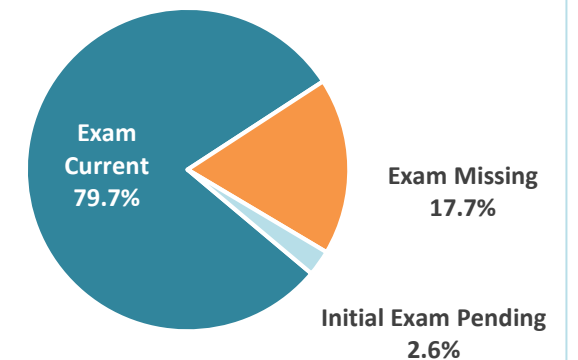

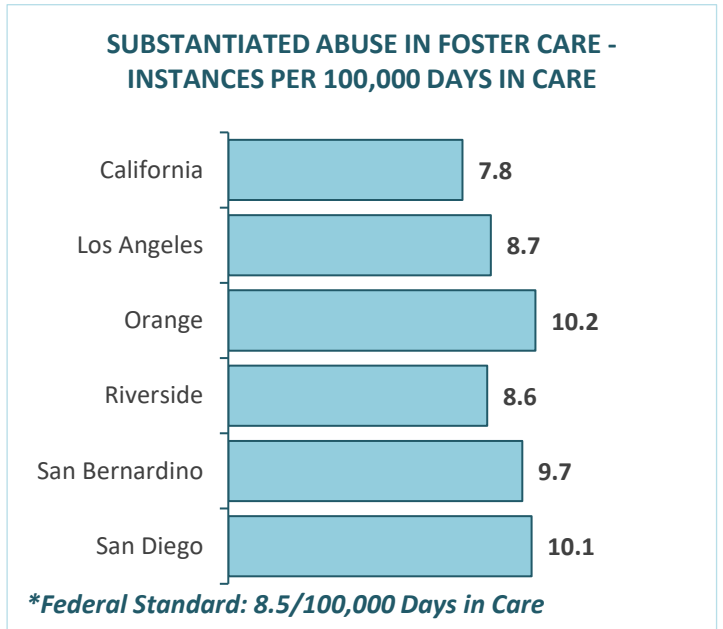
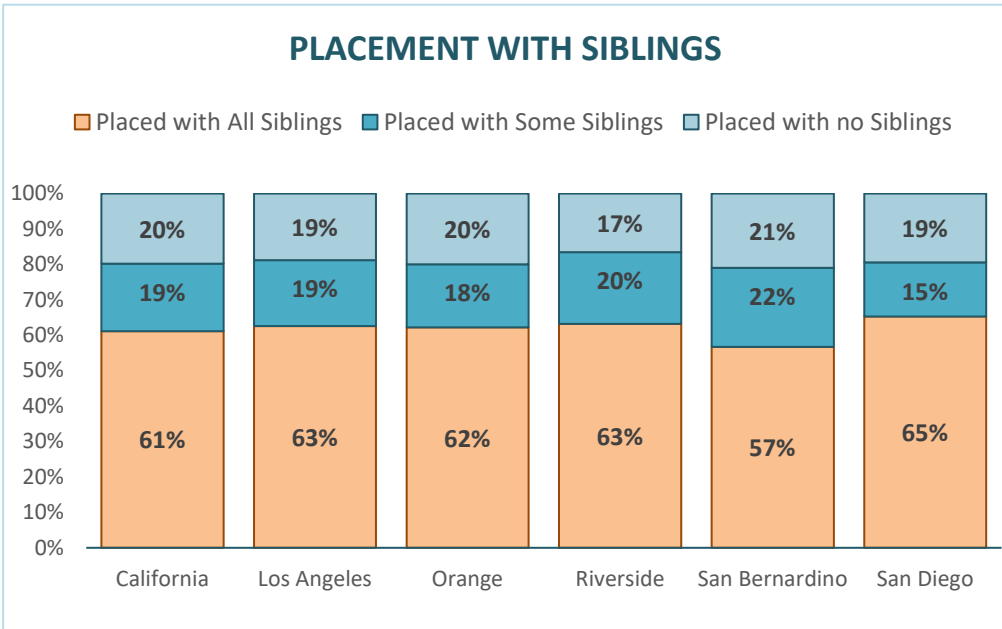
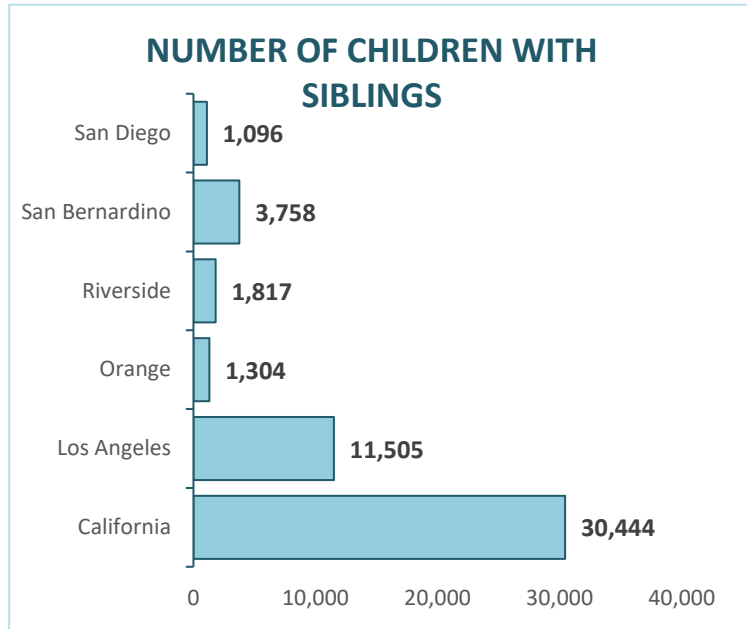
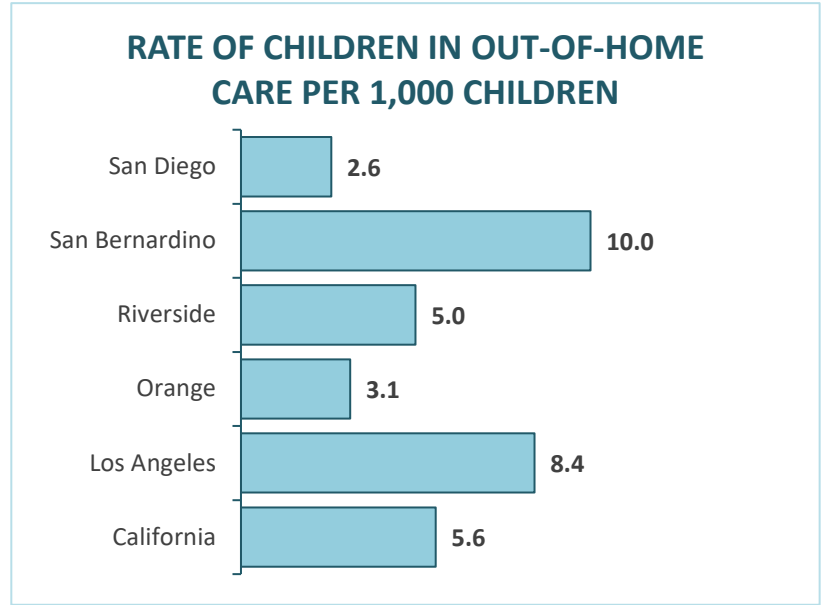
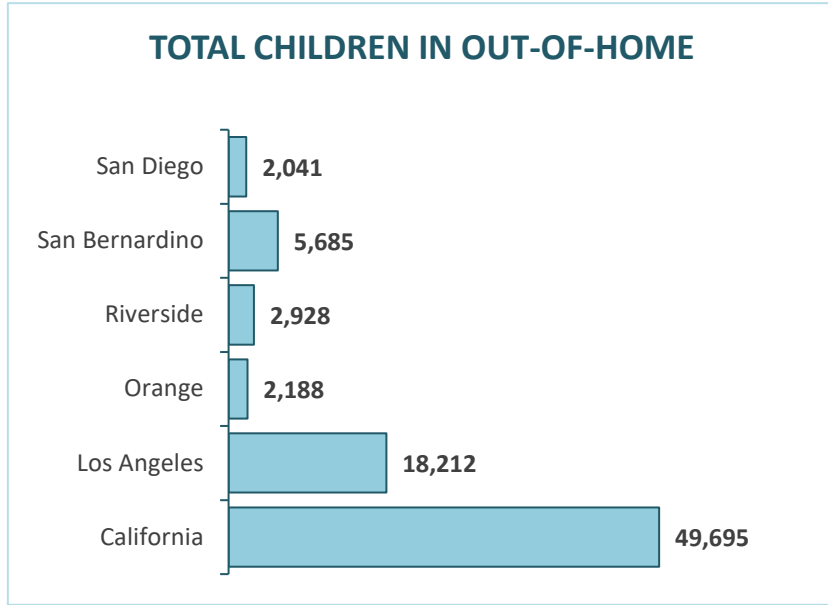
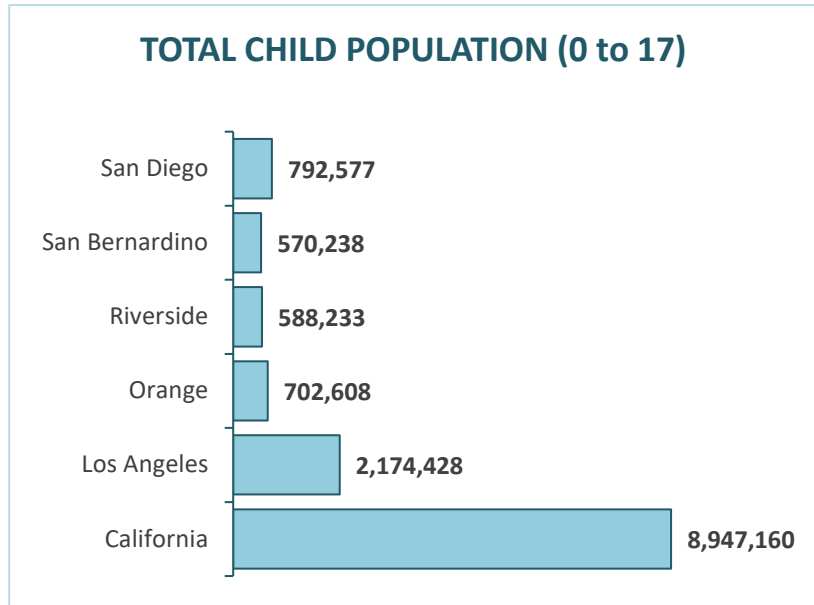


### RATE OF SUBSTANTIATED ABUSE IN FOSTER CARE JUL2020-JUN2021
