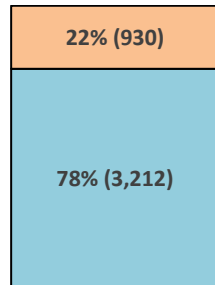

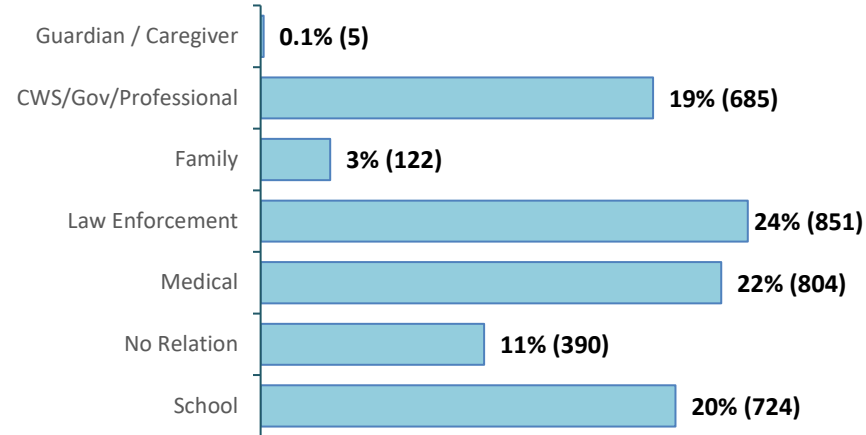

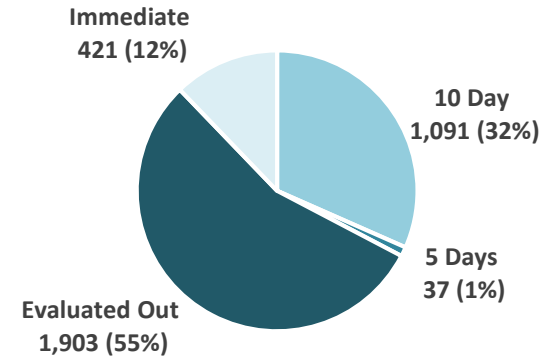

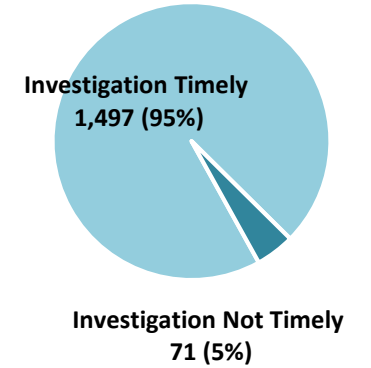

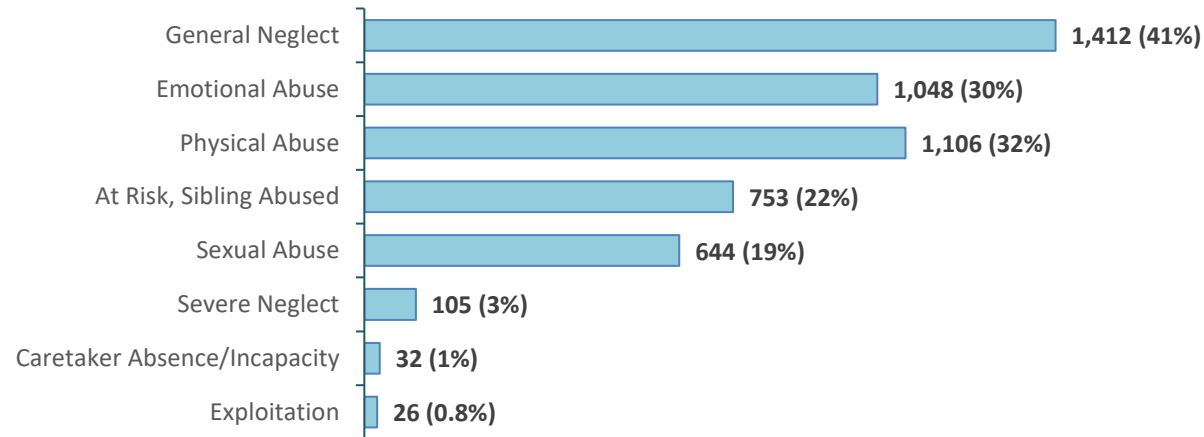
REFERRAL RESPONSE TYPE



TIMELINESS TO INVESTIGATION

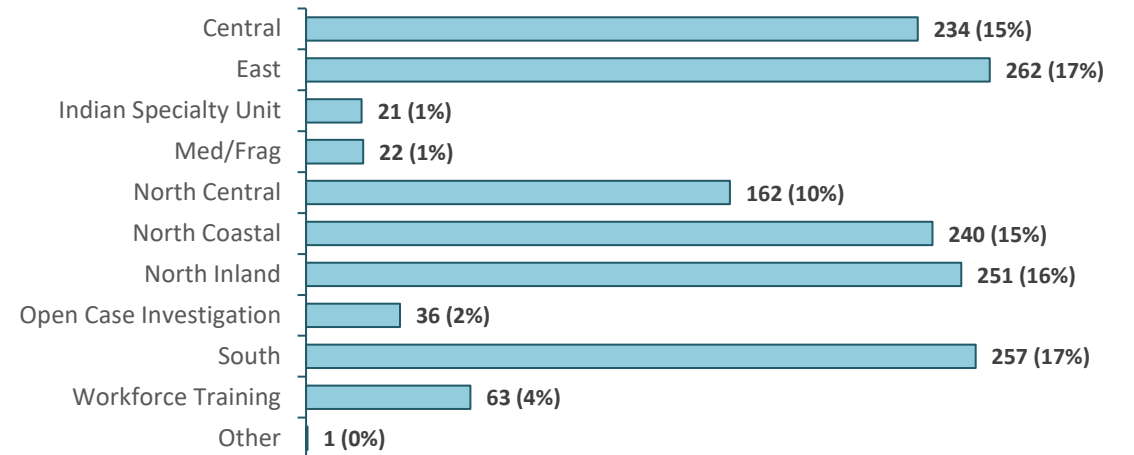


ALLEGATION TYPE

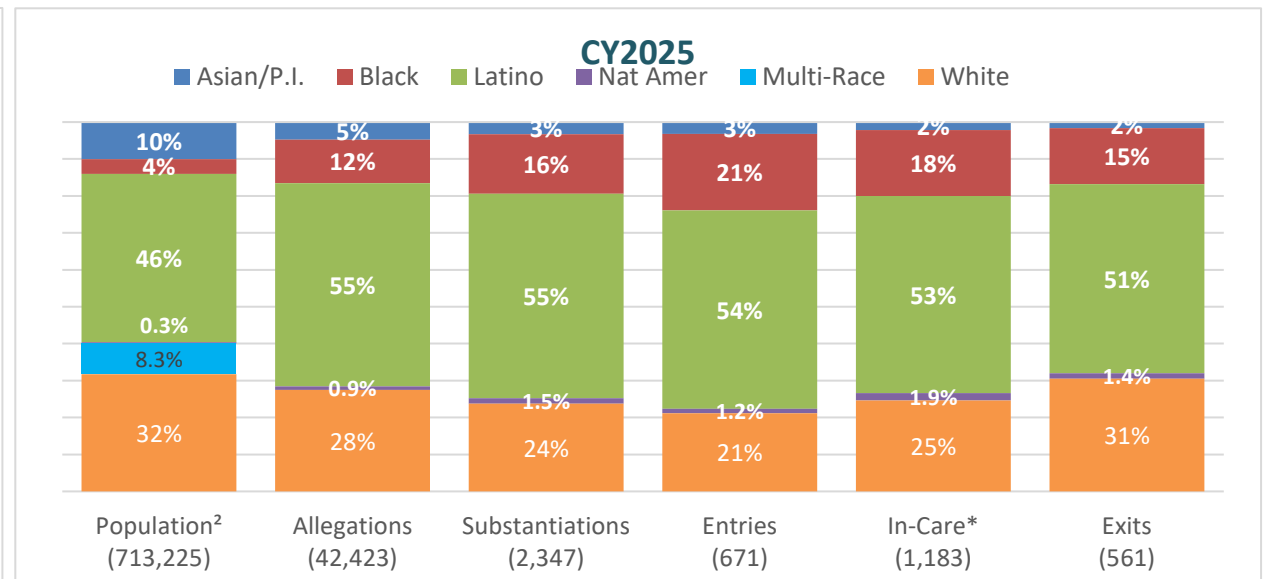
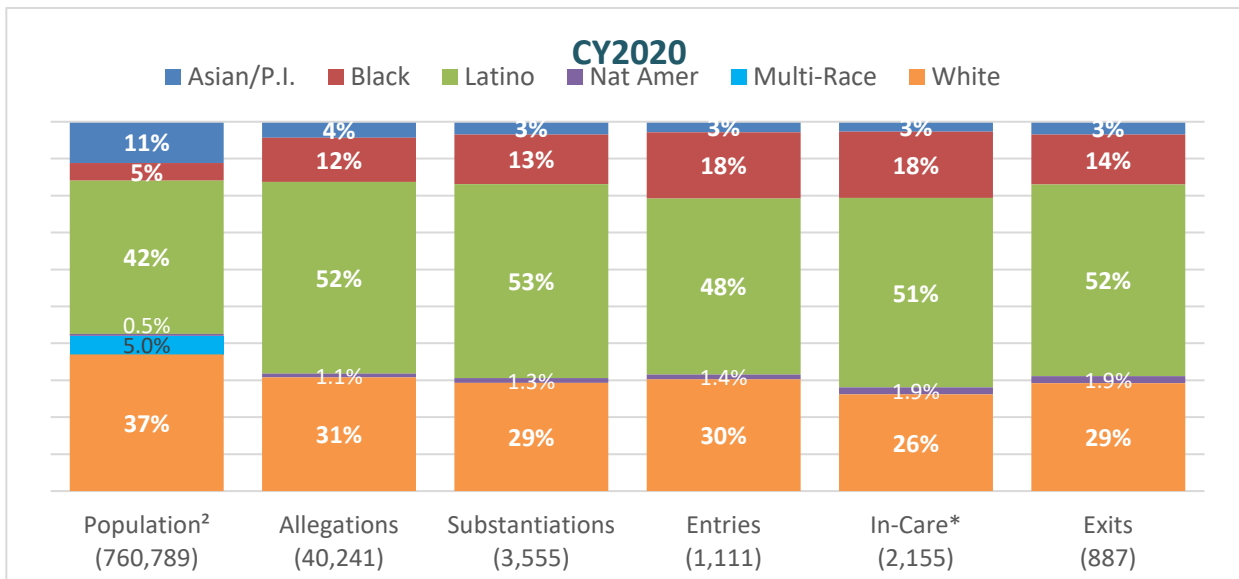
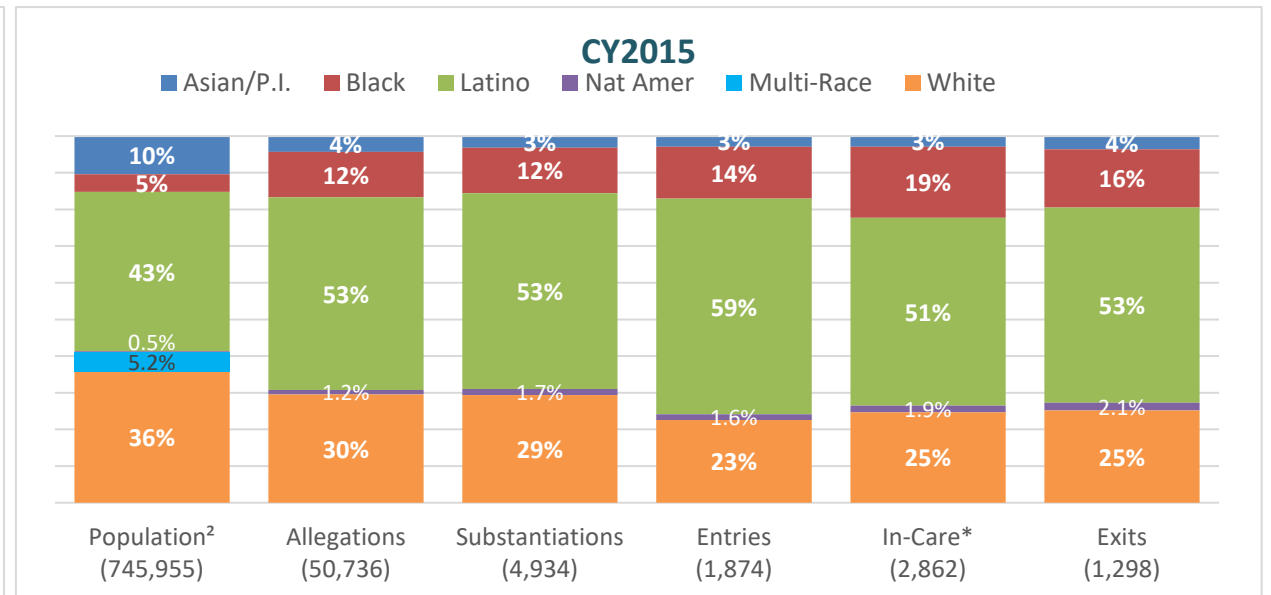
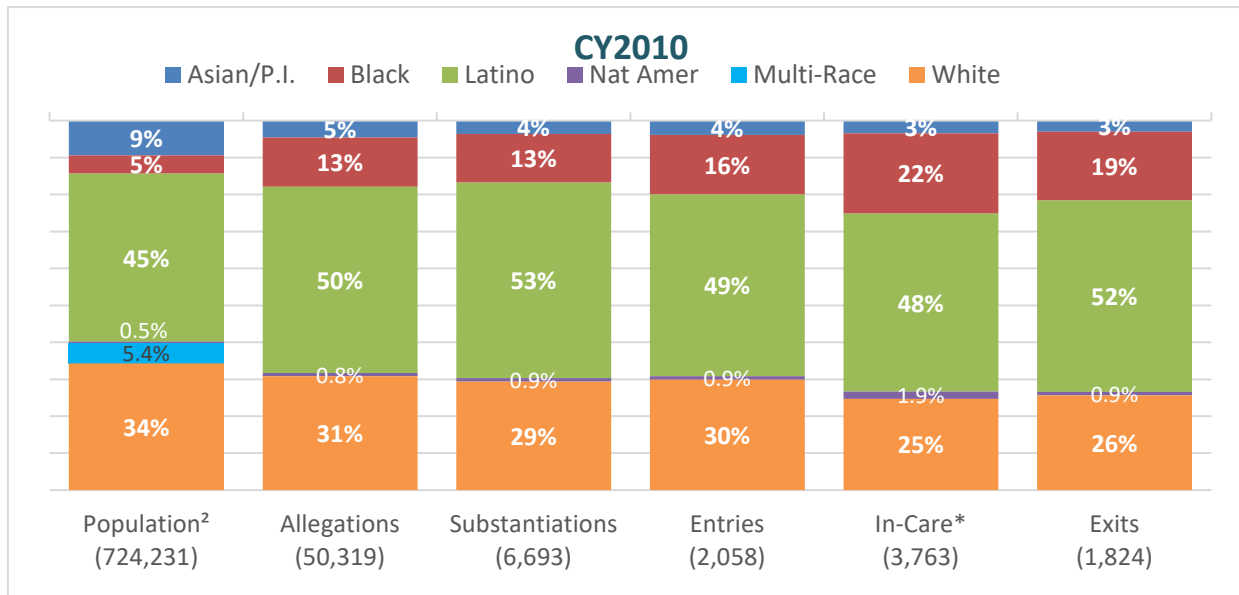
Children (age 0-17) in Investigated Referrals (April 2026)

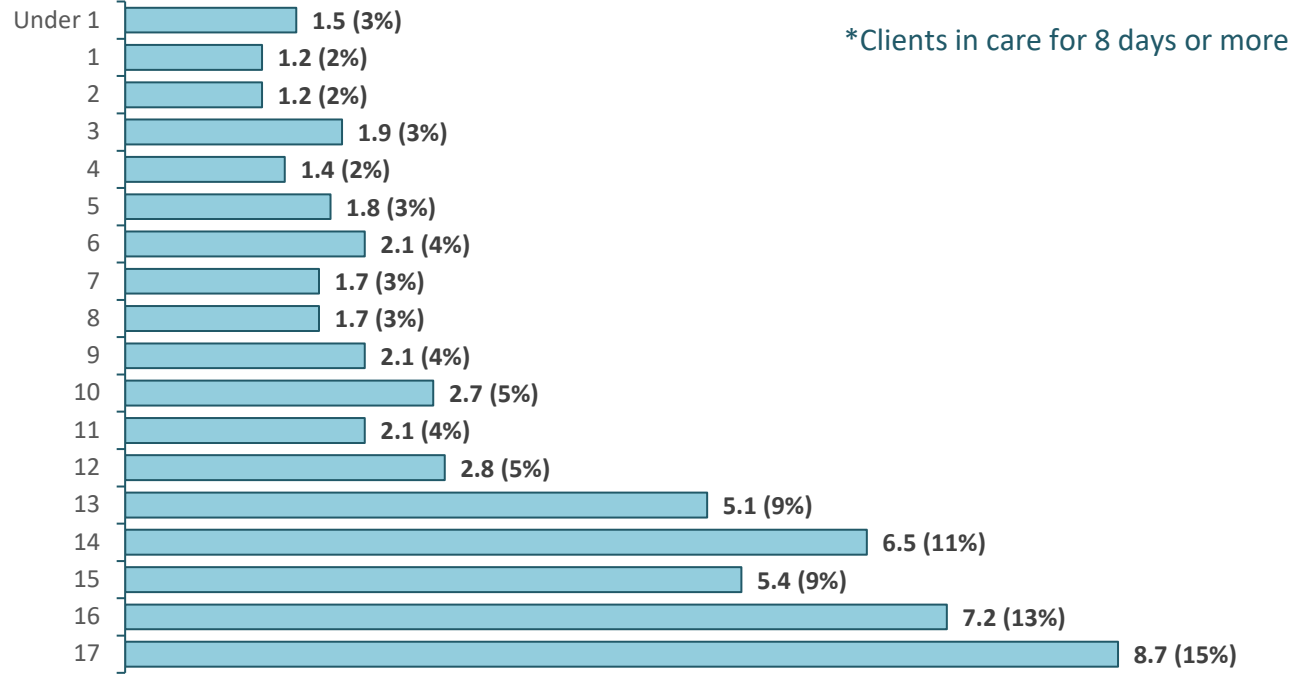

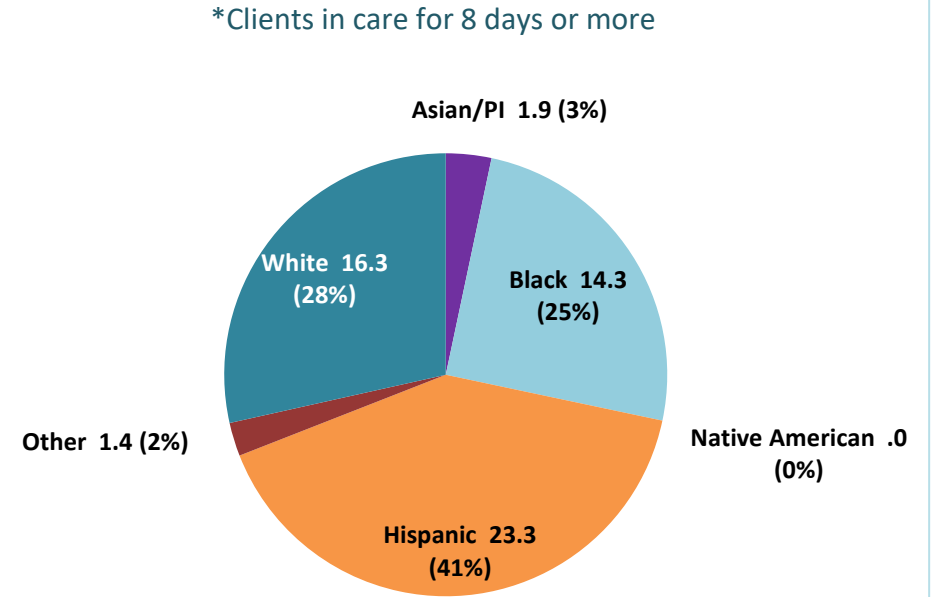

Clients at Polinsky Children's Center by Age



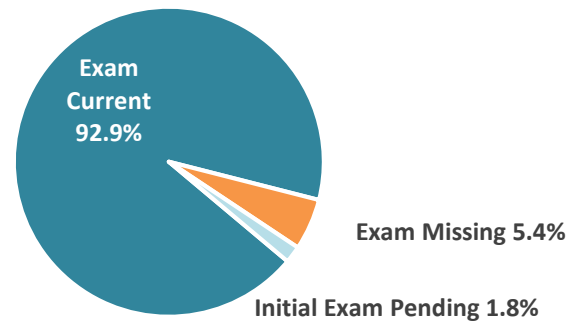
Clients at Polinsky Children's Center by Ethnicity



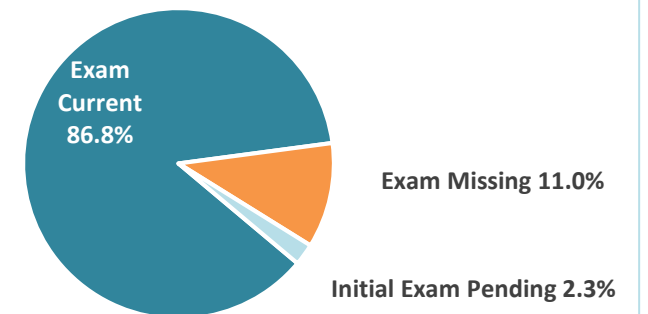

RATE OF SUBSTANTIATED ABUSE IN FOSTER CARE JAN2025-DEC2025

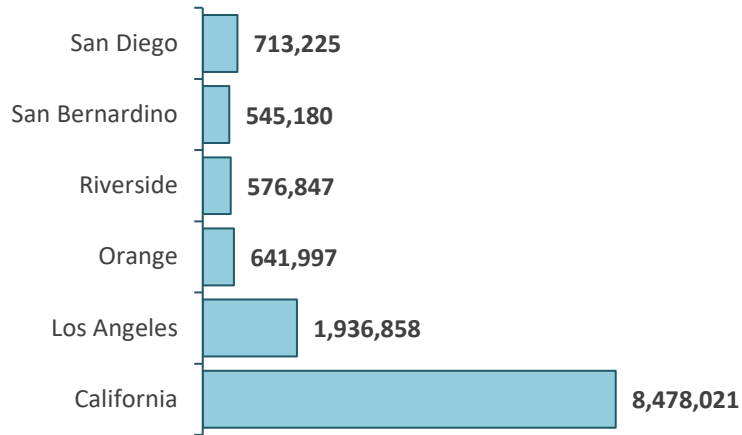

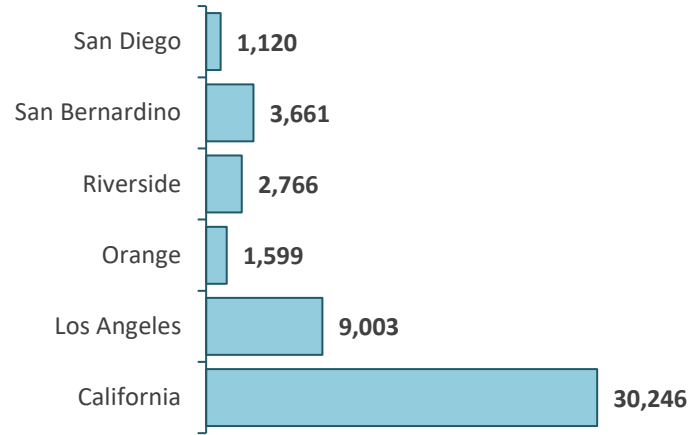

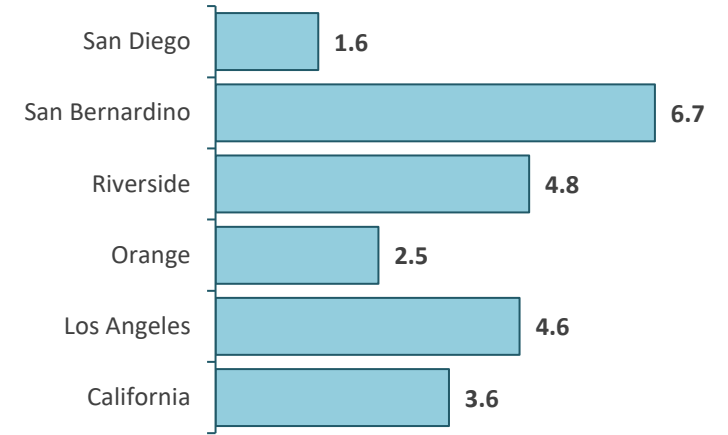
TOTAL CHILD POPULATION (0 to 17)



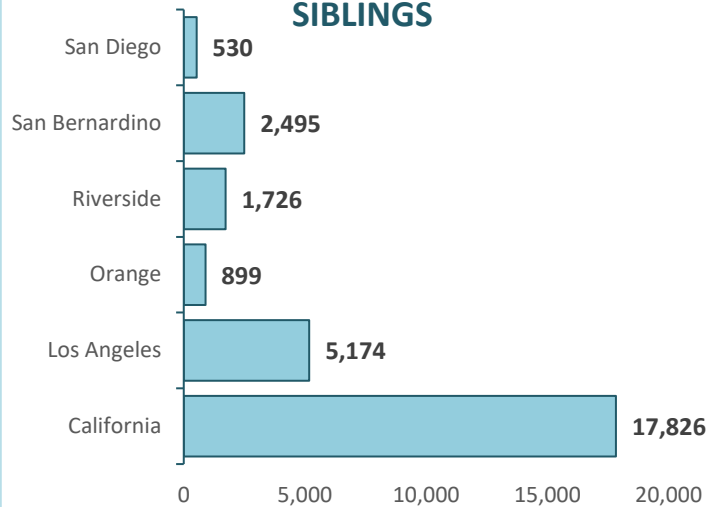
TOTAL CHILDREN IN OUT-OF-HOME



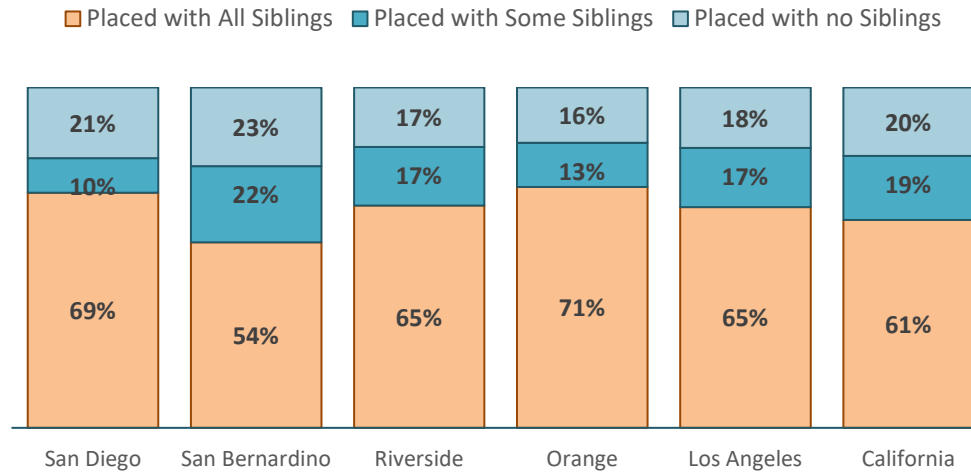
RATE OF CHILDREN IN OUT-OF-HOME CARE PER 1,000 CHILDREN



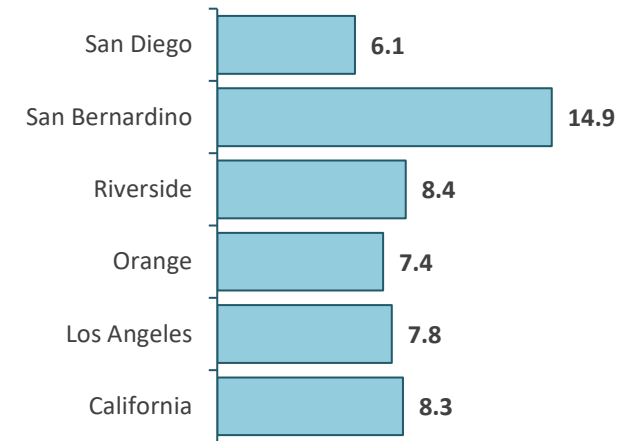

SUBSTANTIATED ABUSE IN FOSTER CARE - INSTANCES PER 100,000 DAYS IN CARE



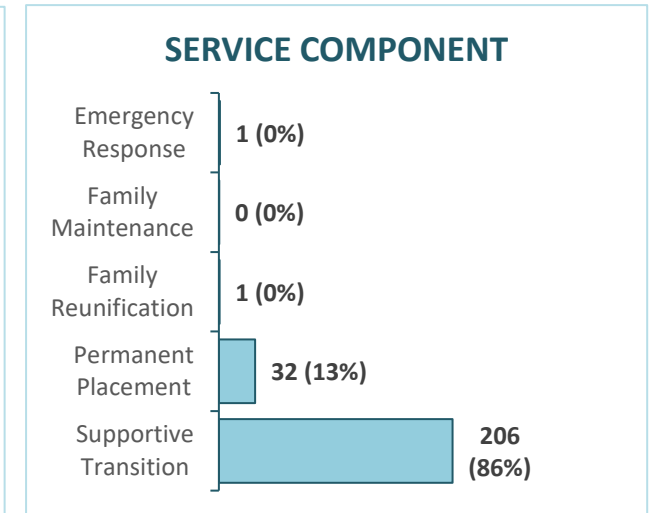
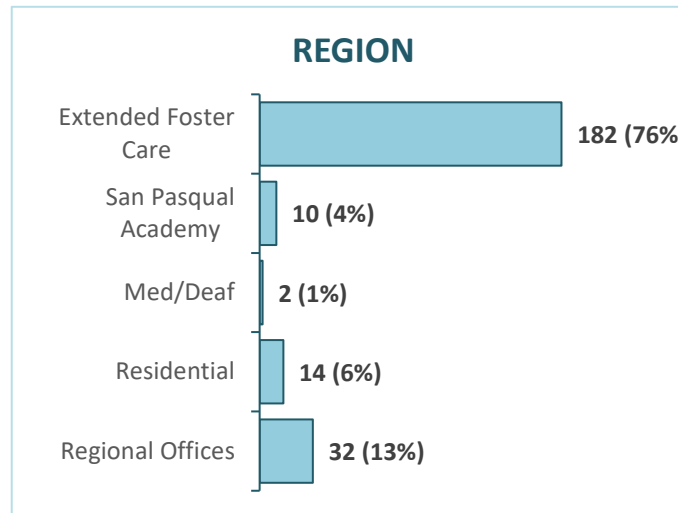
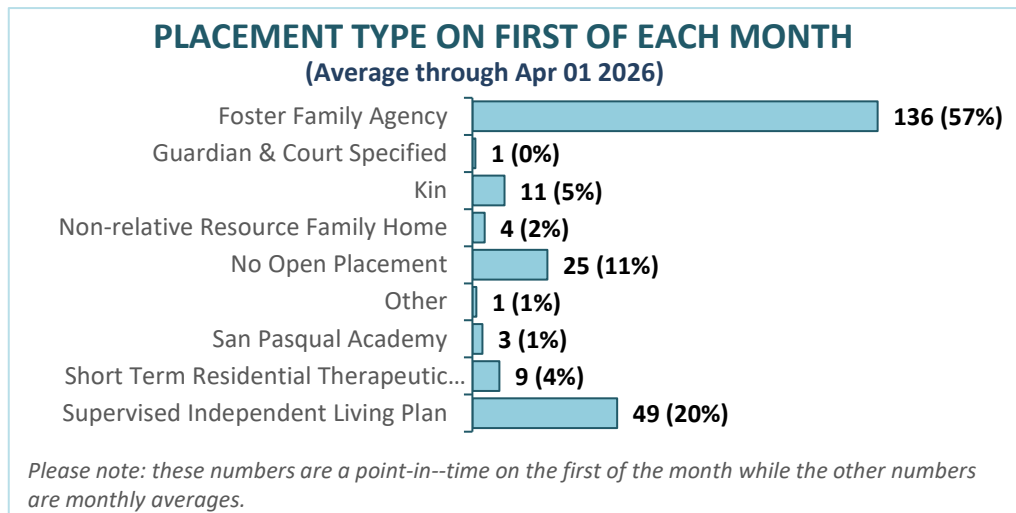
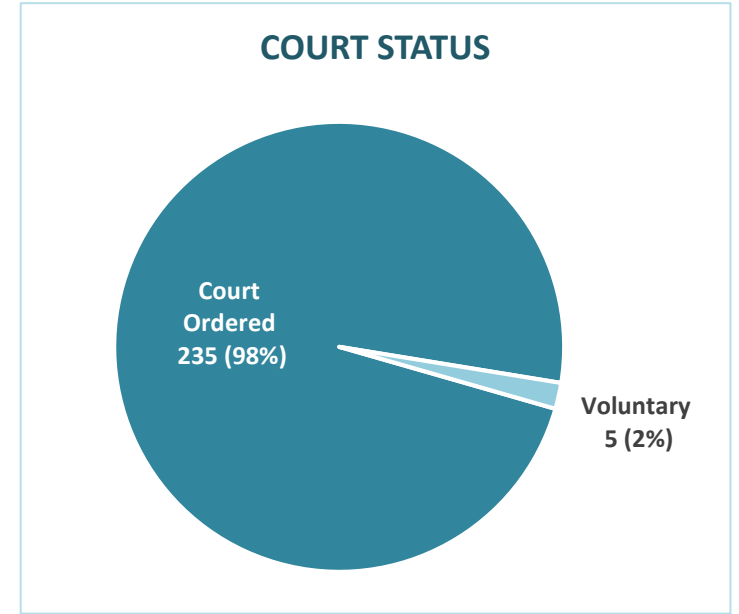
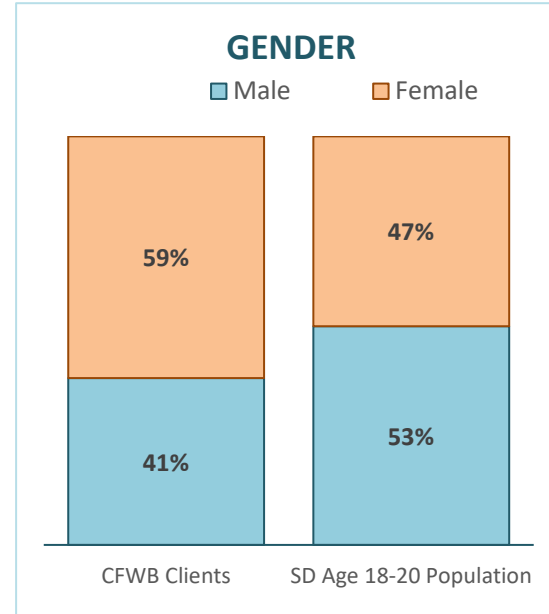
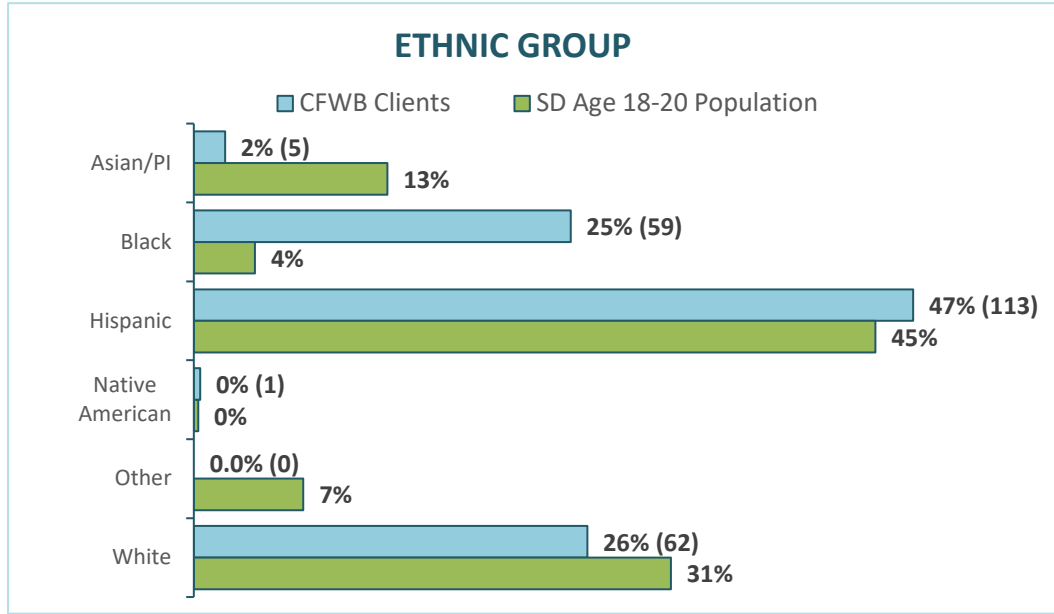
