PCC is grateful for and will continue to accept monetary donations (cash, check, money order, gift certificates, and gift cards), which serve to support special events and daily activities that directly enhance the children's well-being while in temporary care.

In-kind donations will be restricted to the most needed and utilized items so as to help PCC consistently manage, track, and distribute the items received each year. In-kind donations include non-perishable, non-food items and must be new, non-toxic, and Bisphenol A (BPA) free in order to maintain the health and safety of all children in care.

PCC will only accept certain items in the following categories:

- **Art Supplies** (See the Arts & Crafts category from the Lakeshore® Learning <https://www.lakeshorelearning.com/> or Walmart <https://www.walmart.com> websites)
- **Electronics** (CDs, portable CD/DVD players, movie players, iPods, earbuds, PlayStation, Nintendo Wii, Xbox, hand-held video games, radios, Amazon Fire tablets, remote control vehicles, helicopters, electronic learning toys)
- **Sports Equipment** (footballs, basketballs, Nerf balls, Frisbees, soccer balls, rubber balls)  
*\*No golf clubs, bats, guns, bows & arrows, any soft projectile toys, tennis, or badminton rackets.*
- **Toys** (Legos playsets of all sizes, dolls, action figures, Hot Wheels with tracks, Play-Doh, television-inspired toys)  
*\* No board games.*
