



As a result of the generous contributions from community members and organizations in San Diego County for the past several years, PCC has received a substantial amount of donations that has benefitted and enriched the lives of thousands of children who are temporarily staying at the center.

PCC is grateful for and will continue to accept monetary donations (cash, check, money order, gift certificates, and gift cards), which serve to support special events and daily activities that directly enhance the children's well-being while in temporary care.

In order to manage, organize, and distribute the surplus of in-kind donation inventory on hand, PCC will temporarily stop accepting in-kind donations from **June 17, 2019 through October 31, 2019**.

Beginning November 1, 2019, in-kind donations will be restricted to the most needed and utilized items so as to help PCC consistently manage, track, and distribute the generous amounts of items received each year. PCC will only accept certain items in the following categories:

- **Art Supplies** (See the Arts & Crafts category from the Lakeshore® Learning <https://www.lakeshorelearning.com/> or Walmart <https://www.walmart.com> websites)
- **Electronics** (CDs, portable CD/DVD players, iPods, PlayStation, Nintendo Wii, Xbox, hand-held video games, radios, Amazon Fires, tablets, remote control vehicles, helicopters)
- **Sports Equipment** (footballs, basketballs, Nerf balls, Frisbees, soccer balls, rubber balls)  
*\*No golf clubs, bats, guns, bows & arrows, any soft projectile toys, tennis, or badminton rackets.*
- **Toys** (Legos of all sizes including classics, dolls, action figures, Hot Wheels with tracks, Play-Doh, television-inspired toys)  
*\* No board games.*
