HOPE Academy at San Pasqual

Given pilot program status by the California Department of Social Services to help demonstrate and test best practices under AB 403/Continuum of Care Reform, San Pasqual HOPE Academy is a unique model for serving the whole child via trauma-informed care. The Academy is a first in the nation coed residential education program designed specifically for foster youth, ages 12-17 years old.

The Academy, akin to a resource family placement, provides a comprehensive support system for the youth, including an individualized education, independent living skills training, therapeutic services, extra-curricular and enrichment activities, family connections and relational permanency.
